- 2. **Cruisin Mighty Mouse** (Rackler) 7 month old Ruby. Dark pigment, rich colour. Good length of neck and lay of shoulder. Moved enthusiastically.
- 3. **Dallarock Knight Thyme at Falling Springs** (Curley) 8 month old tri, small, compact, good bone. Happy baby.
- 4. Nightingale Riptide (Mulligan) 8 month blenheim. Dark eye. In good coat.

### **SENIOR PUPPY DOG (2)**

- 1. Valentine The Irish Tenor (O'Brien) Simply lovely blenheim of 11 months. Correct, classic outline and shape. Lovely soft expression set off by dark eye, dark pigment, proportionate cushioning, high ear set giving balanced head. Good reach of neck, well laid back shoulder and length of forearm. Well sprung ribs and length of loin. Level topline. Well angulated stifle and short let down hock. Correct set of tail. Quality coat. Moved with drive and impulsion. Confident baby. Will have a great future. Richly deserved *Best Puppy Dog* and *Best Puppy in Show*. Great weekend for him winning all his classes over the three days.
- 2. **Saranade Dancing in the Rain at Jobren** (Menke/Tonn/Freberg) 10 month blenheim in good coat, dark eye and pigment, up to size. Moved with enthusiasm.

#### **GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)**

1. **Covington Alexandrite** (Barrois) Stood alone. Year old blenheim. Dark pigment, level topline. Length of neck, good coat, well presented, first time out.

#### **BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (3)**

- 1. Clarmarian Classic by Design (Young-May) Well proportioned blenheim. Rich colouring in good coat. Well cushioned head set off by dark pigment and eye. Good lay of shoulder and length of neck. Level topline, well sprung rib, well angulated stifle. Correct tail set. Moved well with enthusiasm and confidence.
- 2. **Ch Foxcreek Hear Me Roar, JW** (Johnson) Another nice blenheim. Dark eye and pigment. Good reach of neck and lay of shoulder. Well angulated hind quarters. Showed well.
- 3. **Ch Nightingale the Eyes Have It, JW** (Mulligan/Duke) Compact blenheim. Rich colouring. Dark pigment and eye. In good coat and moved well coming and going.

## **JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)**

1. **BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES HOGAN** (Ayers/Martz) Stood alone, but could not be denied his place. Dog of great quality. Rich colour. Lovely outline and shape. Quality coat and presented in tip top condition. Well cushioned head with soft expression. Dark eye and pigment, correct ear set. Well laid-back shoulder, good length of neck with desired crest. Proportionate length of forearm. Well sprung rib, straight topline and well angulated stifle. Correct tail set. Moved true coming and going. Showed his socks off. Pleased to award him *Winners Dog*, *Best in Show*, *Best American Bred Dog in Show*, *Best Bred by Exhibitor in Show*, and *Best Blenheim in Show*.

- 2. **Forestcreek Heart of Rock N Roll, JW** (Painter/Cline) Well coated boy with dark eye and pigment. Level topline. Enjoying his day in the ring.
- 3. **Hiddencreek Mason** (Green) Dark eye and pigment. Good ear set, level topline, good angulation. Moved enthusiastically.
- 4. **Covington Kilgharrah at Riverview** (Barrois) Dark eye and pigment. Good topline and coat. Happy in the ring.

#### SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

Correct length of forearm, straight topline, correct tail set, good angulated stifle and well let down and short hock. Moved with drive and impulsion. Happy in the ring.
- 2. **Chadwick Cheers at Hudsonview** (Glynn) Well proportioned, good pigment, straight topline, well angulated, good tail set, presented well.
- 3. **Mysticknight Jack Pot** (Hassig) Enthusiastic boy. Good tail set, presented well.

- 2. **Cruisin On Pixie Dust** (Rackler) Black-and-Tan cheeky little girl. Pretty expression, rich tan, good tail set. Very ebulliant on the move.

#### **BRED BY EXHIBITOR (3)**

- 1. **Ch. Brookhaven Im No Angel, JW** (Ayers/Martz) Small pretty Blenheim. Sweet feminine expression. Well-cushioned face with dark rich eye and dark pigment. Correct ear set. Good length of neck and lay of shoulder. Proportionate forearm. Well-sprung rib, straight topline, correct tail set, good angulation and short well let down hock. Moved true there and back with enthusiasm and drive.
- 2. **Ch. Rockcreek Cowgirls Don't Cry** (Steagall) Another feminine well-broken Blenheim with dark eye and dark pigment. Good lay of neck and length of forearm. Moved well there and back.
- 3. **Ch Linrica Moonwalk, JW** (Liu) Blenheim, nice small size. Straight topline. Well angulated hindquarters. Moved with enthusiasm.

#### **JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (5)**

- 1. **Nightingale Sloe Gin Fizz at Hollytree, JW** (Seymour) Sweet feminine Blenheim. Well pigmented, dark eye, high set ears, cushioned muzzle. Correct length of neck and shoulder placement. Level topline and short hocks. Correct tail set. Moved with impulsion and confidence.
- 2. **Rosearbor Bijou** (Eckersley) Black-and-Tan who pushed hard for 1<sup>st</sup> place. Only 10 months old and lost only on maturity. Cute expression with dark eye and pigment. Correct ear set. Good topline and tail set. Good angulation. Happy in the ring moving true and with confidence.
- 3. **Seraphaven Cupids Crush** (Gogol) Year old Blenheim. Good neck and shoulder. Dark eye. Moved well.

## AMERICAN BRED BITCH (5)

- 1. **Chadwick Drama, JW** (Hoehn/Eckersley) Small compact Blenheim. Sweet expression. Dark round eye, good pigment, high ear set. Good reach of neck. Good spring of rib, well angulated stifle. Moved well there and back. Well presented and shown. *Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Blenheim Bitch in Show*
- 2. Valentyne Portabello Rd (O'Brien) Another Blenheim girl with sweet feminine expression. Well pigmented, dark eye, high set ears. Well sprung ribs, good topline and angulation. Moved correctly with confidence and drive.
- 3. **Hiddencreek Butterscotch Schnapps** (Parente/Green) Blenheim. Dark pigment. Good neck and shoulder. Level topline. Moved with enthusiasm.
- 4. **Closeburn Bonny Baronet** (Fairchild) Blenheim with dark eye and pigment. Rich colour. Well laid back shoulder and good reach of neck. In need of more confidence.

- 1. **Seraphaven Put A Spell On You** (Gogol) Blenheim. Well cushioned head. Dark eye and pigment. High ear set. Well laid back shoulder, good topline, well sprung rib, correct tail set. Moved and showed confidently.
- 2. **Inez Whispered Wishes At Jobren** (Menke/Tonn) Blenheim with good reach of neck. Dark pigment. Good topline. Correct tail set. Presented well.
- 3. **Nightingale Bewitching** (Mulligan) Smaller girl. Dark eye and pigment. Feminine expression. Good topline, short hock. Moved freely.
- 4. **Avia Gemini** (Poti) Dark pigment, good reach of neck, level topline, correct tail set. Presented well.

#### SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR BITCH (4)

- 1. **ANGEL'S PRIDE PIPPA, JW** (Green) Heavily marked, but pretty well cushioned head, dark eye and pigment, and high set ears. Good bone and substance. Well set back shoulder. Good reach of neck. Level topline which she maintained on the move.
- 2. CLOSEBURN BONNY WEE KILT (Fairchild) Well broken, rich tan, dark

- pigmentation and eye. Well sprung rib. Good tail set. Level topline, short hock. Moved with confidence
- 3. **VERIBAS A LOOK TO REMEMBER** (Cusick) Another well broken tri. Rich tan, dark eye. Well angulated. Moved well.

## SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

1. **DARANE STARDUST** (Kates) Simply stunning little girl. Correct size, rich ruby coat. Well cushioned head with sweet feminine expression complemented by dark eye an pigment. Correct ear set. Good reach of neck. Well set back shoulder and correct length of forearm. Level topline and well sprung rib. Correct tail set. Short hock, good angulation. Moved correctly with extension and drive. Quality coat. Great little person. Winners Bitch, Reserve Best in Show, Best of Opposite Sex, Best American Bred Bitch, Best Bred By Exhibitor Bitch, Best Ruby Bitch.

#### SPECIAL BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH (1)

1. **ILOO DITE ILAN DU JARDIN DE CLAIRE OF SUMARA, JW** (Gentil) Pretty girl I have judged before. Feminine expression set off by rich tan, dark eye and pigment. High set ears. Good reach of neck and crest. Well laid back shoulder. Proportionate length of forearm. Good spring of rib. Level topline and correct set of tail. Short well let-down hocks. Moved well and with enthusiasm. *Best Black-and-Tan in Show*.

# **OPEN BITCH (3)**

- **1. Ch. KALAIS NEVER TOO LATE TO PARTY** (Hess) Small Black-and-Tan. Rich tan dark eye and pigment. Good front, shoulder angulation and reach of neck. Well angulated. Correct tail set. Well sprung rib. Moved well particularly behind.
- **2. Ch. LINRICA JUST A DREAM, JW (Hsiung/Liu)** Small, compact, well covered tri. Well cushioned head. Rich tan, dark eye and pigment. High set ears. Level topline. Good tail set and bone. Well broken quality coat. Moved well. Challenged for 1st place. *Best Tricolour Bitch in Show*
- 3. **Ch. CARMAS PENNE PASTA AT CRIZWOOD** (Moulton/Wornall) Quality Blenheim. Dark eye and pigment setting off feminine expression. Long profuse ear correctly placed. Good reach of neck, good topline. Correct tail set. Moved with confidence.
