I would also like to thank the exhibitors for thei entries and for presenting me with some beautiful well turned out dogs.

On the whole I was pleased with my class winners, but we do need to watch out for movement on the back end; we are getting too many dogs that are very close behind.

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1. Linrica Milan, JW (Liu)

Very smart, well broken, small compact Blenheim boy with soft silky coat. He has a beautiful head well-cushioned with large dark round eyes with soft expression, jet black nose, correct dentition and finished off with well-set ears. Excellent angulations, good spring of rib, moved and showed well keeping a level topline with correct tailset. This little boy stole my heart and I'm sure there are exciting times ahead for him. It was a pleasure to award him <u>BEST PUPPY DOG and BEST</u> **PUPPY IN SHOW.**

2. Canyoncrest The Leader Of The Band (DuRoss)

This 6 month old Tricolor has a pleasing head. Nicely marked with rich tan markings in all the correct places, excellent bone and angulations, level back, moved well, just slightly close behind.

3. **Crossbow Horton Hears a Who** (Kubin/Schiffman) Heavier marked Blenheim boy with full white collar, moderate head with nice eyes, slightly longer cast, good rear angulations, moved ok.

4. Butterfield Music of The Night (Sparks)

7 month old Tricolor with rich tan markings, good ear set, needs to fill under eye, nice size with goo bone, he just wanted to play today so it was hard to assess movement.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

1. Briarcrest Going For Baroque (Katz)

Well-coated heavier marked Tricolor with rich tan markings, lovely head, well-cushioned, correct ear set with thick ear leathers, correct bite, excellent bone and rear angulations, good spring of rib, moved well both ways, keeping a level topline and correct tail carriage.

2. Dulce Carmel Awesome Sauce (Covell)

Nicely marked Blenheim boy with pleasing head, large round dark eyes and black pigment, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, excellent bone, level back, moved well, just needs to mature in body.

3. Snowbird Hocus Pocus (Miller)

This small compact Ruby boy is very rich in colour, he has a nice head and eyes with good length o ear leathers, correct bite, lovely shape and size, unfortunately he was throwing one of his back legs today.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4)

1. Forestcreek Back In The Saddle (Cline)

Well-coated Blenheim boy, pretty head, dark eyes and pigment, beautiful long well-feathered ears, adequate neck, level topline, lovely size and shape with good spring of rib, excellent bone, moved and showed well.

- 2. **Milbu Lovelace At Dulce** (Covell) Blenheim boy with rich tan markings, lovely head and expression, good reach of neck, moved well keeping a level topline, just slightly bigger cast than 1.
- 3. Mtnvista Ranger Rider (Cook/Curtis)

Small compact rich Ruby boy, pleasing head, dark pigment, nice size and shape, moved well with good rear angulations.

4. Cobrnik Hot Rod Lincoln At Robincreek (Ross/Cook)

Longer cast Blenheim boy with rich chestnut markings, attractive head, correct ear set, would benef from a slightly darker eye. Excellent reach of neck, good spring of rib, moved and showed well.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (2)

1. Veribas Eye Of The Tiger (Cusick)

This well-balanced Blenheim boy has a straight silky coat with rich chestnut markings. He has a beautiful head with large dark eyes, soft expression and good pigment, correctly placed ears with good length to leathers. Well bodied, moderate bone with good angulations, moved well keeping a level topline, just needs to watch his tail carriage.

2. Ch. Brookhaven Here Comes Hogan, JW (Ayers/Martz)

Strikingly marked Blenheim boy, lovely head, well-cushioned with large dark expressive eyes and good pigment, good length to correctly placed ears. Nice size and shape, good spring of rib, level back, moved well. Very close between these two boys, just lacked animation today.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1. Briarcrest Harris Tweed (Razowalli/Van Luchene)

10 ½ month old Blenheim boy with rich chestnut markings, masculine in head with large dark eyes and excellent pigment, long well-feathered correctly placed ears and the desired lozenge. He has a good reach of neck, well angulated with moderate bone, moved ok. I would prefer him in a smaller package.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

1. Belcarra Straight Shot Remington Of Bear River Ranch (Toepfer)

Pretty headed, nicely marked Blenheim boy with thick well-feathered ears, he would benefit from a slightly darker eye. Excellent reach of neck into well-laid shoulders, lovely size and shape, level topline, good rear angulations, moved ok, another boy proud of his tail today.

2. **Bentwood Cartier** (Covell/Harrison) This heavier marked Blenheim boy has a straight silky coat, pretty head with dark eyes and pigmen correct ear set. Nice size and shape, moderate neck, excellent bone and angulations, moved well, juslightly proud of his tail today.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

1. Bonitos Companeros Vahir (Lemon/Lemon)

Small compact well-presented heavier marked Blenheim boy in full coat, very attractive head, large dark eyes, good pigment and well placed ears. He has a moderate neck, deep chest and good spring of rib, excellent bone and good angulations, showed well, just close on rear movement.

- 2. Aranel Mackenzie (Green) Very pretty headed Blenheim boy, well-feathered ears correctly placed, good pigment, showed sligl white of eye, small and compact with good rear angulations, moved ok.
- Mtnvista Buffalo Bill Cody (Curtis/Curtis) Nicely marked Blenheim boy with pretty head, would benefit from a larger eye, good reach of neck well ribbed, Crabbed on the move and very close behind.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (3)

- Chewcreek Red Solo Cup, JW (DePhillip)
 Loved the size and shape of this small compact Tricolor boy, very pretty head with soft expression,
 long ear leathers, rich tan markings, excellent bone and angulations, moved well keeping a level
 topline. <u>BEST TRICOLOUR DOG.</u>
- Mysticknight Jack Pot (Hassig)
 Tricolor boy with pleasing head and well-feathered ears, nice size and shape, level topline, good rea angulation, close behind on movement.

Legacy Orfeo (Goodwin)
 Well broken Tricolor boy with rich tan markings, masculine head, good pigment and long ear leathers, moderate neck, good turn of stifle, slightly longer cast, close behind on the move.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (3)

1. Kolaci Magic Cinnamon Spice (Legerretta/Gray)

Ruby boy, rich in colour and of lovely size and shape, attractive head, well-cushioned with nice eye and correct ear-set, moderate bone with good angulations, moved well, needs coat to finish the picture. **BEST RUBY DOG.**

- Cruisin Mighty Mouse (Rackler)
 12 month old boy with rich ruby coat, lovely head with large dark eyes and long ear leathers, slightl
 longer cast than 1, moved ok.
- 3. **Mysticknight Orbiting Comet** (Brandvold) Very richly coloured ruby boy with pleasing head, good bone, didn't move well.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN DOG (3)

- Intrynzik Beauxregard (Goodwin)
 Nice size Black-and-Tan with pleasing head and nice eyes, correct dentition, rich tan markings in al
 the right places, adequate neck, moved ok keeping a level topline. <u>BEST BLACK-AND-TAN DOC</u>
- 2. Saltayre Cabernet At Cobrnik (Cook) Black-and-Tan with lovely head and eyes, well-feathered ears and rich tan markings on a raven black

coat, good spring of rib, moderate bone, moved well, just not animated today.

3. Elyzian Portrait In Black (Ramos)

Black-and-Tan with masculine head and rich tan markings, larger cast boy with good bone, well ribbed, level topline, close behind on the move.

OPEN DOG (4)

1. Ch. & Eng. Ch. Brookhaven Believe It Or Not (Ayers/Martz)

This well-balanced Blenheim boy caught my eye when he entered the ring, and he certainly did not disappoint. He is short, compact with a nicely marked soft silky coat, his thick long ears frame his beautiful head, he has large round eyes, with a slightly tapered muzzle, altogether giving a very soft and gentle expression. Excellent angulations, good spring of rib, level topline and correct tail-set, h moved a dream and demanded top honours, which I was honoured to give him. <u>WINNERS DOG, BEST BLENHEIM DOG, BEST AMERICAN BRED DOG, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG AND BEST IN SHOW</u>.

2. Ch & Eng. Ch. Charalier Dress To The Nines For Charlesworth Eng, Eng JW (Engel/Greenhall)

I have had the pleasure of judging this dog before in the UK, another quality Blenheim boy with ric chestnut markings, lovely head, dark eyes with soft gentle expression, long thick ear leathers. He h a good reach of neck into well-laid shoulders, level topline, good spring of rib, moved soundly roun the ring. *RESERVE WINNERS DOG*.

3. Ch. Forestcreek Heart Of Rock and Roll, JW (Painter/Cline)

Blenheim boy, nice size and shape, masculine head, lovely dark eyes with soft expression, wellcushioned, adequate neck, moderate bone, moved well keeping a level topline, just slightly close behind.

4. Ch. Pascavale Bijou (Cline)

Tricolor with rich tan markings, pretty head with long thick ear leathers, black pigment, but did sho slight white of eye. Short and compact with good spring of rib, he would benefit from a little more length to neck, moved well keeping a level topline.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

1. Ch. Nightingale Heat Wave, JW (Mulligan)

This 9 year young nicely marked Blenheim boy showed his socks off, masculine in head, lovely large dark eyes and excellent pigment. Adequate neck, level topline and correct tail set, well sprun ribs, correct rear angulations, moved soundly. *BEST VETERAN IN SHOW*.

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

1. Delsol Love In An Elevator (McHenry)

This nicely marked Blenheim girl has a pretty head, large dark eyes, correct ear-set and the lozenge Excellent reach of neck into well-laid shoulders, level topline, good rear angulations, moderate bon moved well both ways.

2. Rockcreek Maybelline (Ross)

5 month old heavier marked Tricolor, pleasing head, needs to fill under eye but it's early days, good reach of neck, short coupled, moderate bone, moved well.

3. Butterfield A Dream Remembered (Goodwin/Sparks)

Pretty headed, richly marked Blenheim girl, good reach of neck, nice size, very much a baby, move well.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1. Chadwick Sentimental Journey, JW (Eckersley) Very pretty Blenheim girl, large dark eyes, jet black pigment, correctly placed ears of good length, good reach of neck into well-laid shoulders. She has a level topline and correct tail-set on the stand but slightly lost her topline on the move. **BEST PUPPY BITCH.**

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (2)

- 1. **Redbud Lilo & Stich** (Rackler/Scott) This well-broken Tricolor girl has a pretty head, good ear-set and rich tan markings, short coupled with a well sprung rib, good rear angulations, moved and showed well.
- 2. **Cobrnik At Last** (Cook) Nicely marked Blenheim girl, lovely soft expressive eyes, would benefit from a little more fill unde eye, good reach of neck, lovely size and shape with good angulations.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

1. Forestcreek Bewitching Girl (Cline/Cline)

This well broken, richly marked Blenheim girl was in full coat. She has a beautiful head with large dark eyes giving a soft expression, jet black pigment and correctly placed ears, adequate neck, good spring of rib and moderate bone. She moved and showed well keeping a level topline and correct tail-set. I believe she gained her title today. *WINNERS BITCH, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH, BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH AND BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST IN SHOW*.

- 2. **Mimric Fiddle Dee Dee, JW.** (Hodges/Perkins) Heavier marked Blenheim girl with rich chestnut markings, very pretty head with a clean looking face, large dark eyes and good pigment. Lovely size and shape, good spring of rib and correct angulations, moved well both ways keeping a level topline. It was a very close decision between 1 and 2.
- 3. Briarcrest Oh So Rococo (Van Luchene/Van Luchene)

Heavier marked Tricolor girl with rich tan markings, pretty head, small and compact body, moderat bone, good spring of rib, moved ok, just dipped slightly in shoulder.

Windnsea Dancing Queen (Peterson)
 This longer cast, well broken Blenheim girl has a pleasing head, nice eyes, just needs a little more fill, correct ear set and good reach of neck. Moved ok.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

1. Nightingale Sloe Gin Fizz At Hollytree, JW (Seymour)

Blenheim girl, feminine in head with large dark eyes and good pigment, correct ear set and lovely long thick ear leathers, moderate neck, good spring of rib and well angulated. She moved well both

ways keeping a level topline and correct tail carriage.

2. No. 258 – No Name In Catalogue Lightly marked Blenheim girl, pretty in head with good pigment and correct ear-set, would prefer h to be a little shorter in back, moved ok.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (1)

1. Brookhaven Bless Your Heart At Sorella JW. (Green/Savage/Ayers)

Richly marked Blenheim girl, pretty head, nice eyes and long thick ear leathers, moderate neck, lev back, well sprung ribs, good rear angulations, moved ok, fell away slightly at the croup.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (2)

- 1. La Reina's What About Me (Roberts-Espinosa) This happy well broken Tricolor girl has a pleasing head with dark eyes and pigment, correct ear placings, nice size and shape, moderate bone, moved ok, very attentive with owner.
- 2. **Shadowbrook Delta Darlin, CGC, CGCA** (Moody/Moody) Heavier marked Tricolor with rich tan markings, nice size, well sprung rib, good bone, down on pasterns.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (3)

- Madryn Port Royal (Weeks/Weeks)
 Ruby girl rich in colour, pleasing head with good ear set, lovely reach of neck, good angulations, level topline, nice size and shape, moved and showed well. <u>BEST RUBY BITCH and BEST RUB</u> <u>IN SHOW</u>
- 2. Cobrnik Reflection Of Glory (Cook) Ruby girl, feminine in head, would have liked a bit more cushioning under eye, lovely size and shape, level back, very close behind on movement.
- 3. **Mysticknight Lady Kiri Osity** (Loechler) Very richly coloured Ruby, large dark eyes, very deep in stop which gave her quite a harsh look, well sprung ribs, slightly longer cast than 1 and 2, moderate bone, level topline.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH (3)

1. Legacy Wicked Shadow (Goodwin/Stevens-Lindemaier)

Pretty Black-and-Tan girl, nice eyes, correct ear set, good bite, moderate neck, good spring of rib, lovely size and shape, good angulations, moved well keeping a level topline, just needs to watch he tail carriage.

2. Bonitos Conpaneros Biscaya (Lemon/Lemon)

Black-and-Tan girl turned out to perfection, pleasing head with rich tan markings, lovely size, too deep in chest, moderate bone, good rear angulations, showed well, but very close behind on movement.

OPEN BITCH (4)

1. Ch. Linrica Just A Dream, JW (Hsiung/Ming Liu)

- Nicely marked Tricolor girl with rich tan markings, feminine head with lovely large dark eyes and good pigment, small and compact with well-sprung ribs, level topline and correct tail-set, well angulated front and back, moved and showed well. <u>RESERVE WINNERS BITCH AND BEST</u> TRICOLOR IN SHOW.
- 2. **Ch. Carmas Penne Pasta At Crizwood** (Moulton/Wornall) Nicely marked Blenheim girl with deep chestnut markings, ultra-feminine head with lovely long ears, dark eyes and pigment, moderate neck, good spring of ribs, moved and showed well, slightly larger package than 1.
- 3. **Tassajara Forestcreek Cristal** (Cline/Sedgewick) Pretty Blenheim girl, nice eye, good spring of rib, level topline, straight silky coat, I would prefer a deeper chestnut colour, moved well with good rear angulations.
- Hoo Dite Ilan Du Jardin De Claire Of Sumara, JW (Gentil) Black-and-Tan with rich tan markings, pretty head, small and compact, level topline, good rear angulations, moved well. <u>BEST BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH and BEST BLACK-AND-TAN IN</u> <u>SHOW</u>.

VETERAN DOG (1)

 Ch. Nightingale Heatwave, JW (Mulligan) See Senior Open Dog For Critique. <u>BEST VETERAN IN SHOW</u>.

VETERAN BITCH (2)

- Nottinghill Annalise (Barnfather) 8 ¹/₂ years young, this Blenheim girl has a pleasing head with large round eyes, correct ear-set, excellent dentition, good angulations, moved ok, she would benefit from losing a few pounds.
- 2. Aspenglow Double Delight C-CD, C-BN, C-RE, CD, BN, RA, OAJ, OAP, APJ, NF (Peterson) Nicely marked Blenheim girl almost 8 years old, pleasing head, I would have preferred a slightly shorter muzzle and a little bit more cushioning, good spring of rib, moved ok, keeping a level topline.

BRACE (1)

1. Deltarose Devine Diva Of Shadowbrook CGC,CGCA,RA,RN,CRN,CBN Shadowbrook Delta Darlin CGC,CGCA (Moody) See Critique in Special Limit Tricolor These two Tricolor girls are very similar in type, both heavier marked and similar in size.
