Junior Puppy Dog (3)

1. Autumn Hill Ring Of Fire (Parente) Promising Ruby boy with good neck and shoulders, level topline. Good head and eyes, and good earset giving a soft gentle expression. Good depth of forechest and angulations, enjoying his day and moved well with verve and drive. **2. Wandris Believe It Or Not** (Gentil) Sweet Blen baby, good bone and body shape. Nice dark eyes and pigment. Sweet expression but just needs a little more filling to come together. **3. Robin's Nest Prince Andrew** (Prodanovich) B/T boy with the sweetest expression, short in back. Carrying his tail a little high today, needs to settle as rear movement a little erratic.

Senior Puppy Dog (5)

1. Ellisana Jupiter (Tyler) Well coated Blen boy beautifully presented with gentle head and expression. Large dark eyes and black pigment. Good neck and shoulders with good depth of forechest and spring of rib. Good topline and tailset. Moved well with drive. **Best Puppy Dog**
2. Lilium Autumn Flight Of Fancy (Almeida/Adkins) Nicely marked Tricolour. Lovely expression. Good size, body and angulations. Exuberant and moved with style. **3. Hathersage Intoxication, JW** (Fowler) Blen boy lacking in coat. But nevertheless nice head, neck and shoulders, good depth of forechest and body shape. Moved well. **4. Deltarose Enchanting Teodoro** (Fennel/McCoy) Well marked Blen, boy. Nice head and expression. Large dark eyes framed by long ear featherings. Good spring of rib and depth of forechest, good bone. Moved well.

Graduate Puppy Dog (6)

1. Maibee Agent Cody of Bentwood (Harrison) Gorgeous dog with outstanding head, eye and pigmentation with the softest of expressions, but being all male. Long ear fringes framing his face. Wonderful clarity of coat, soft and silky, richly marked with his white being pearly white and beautifully presented. Good neck and shoulders, with a good depth of forechest. Well boned, but not overdone. Good topline, tailset and carriage. Good rear angulations and feet well cushioned. I am sure this young man will have a very bright show career, and one I shall watch with interest. Moved with such drive and soundness which gained him WD. **Winners Dog, Reserve Best in Show, Best of Opposite Sex in Show, Best Blenheim Dog**
2. Denham Dynamite Joe (Maddox) Well made Blen boy. Large dark eyes and gentle head, not quite the expression of class winner, Good neck and shoulder placement with a level topline, good angulations, and bone. Showed and moved well. **3. Dancasa Cute As A Button, JW** (Tiedemann) Blen boy on finer lines. Sweet expression and large eyes. Nice head framed by well set ears. Nice body with a good topline. Needs time, but a nice boy. **4. Barrowmore Ivyline Its-A-Me Weege** (Giampapa) Lovely lad with an exuberant nature. Nice head and expression. Moved well.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (2)

1. Ch Forestcreek Dream On (Cline) Rich Blen boy with a lovely soft and gentle expression. Good head properties with nice large dark eyes. Good neck, shoulders and depth of forechest. Level topline and tailset. Good bone. Beautiful straight silky coat, which is well presented. Good rear angulation enabling him to move with drive. A lovely dog to be very proud of. **Reserve Winners Dog, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show, Best American Bred in Show**
2. Ch Beckwith Theres Only One (Smith) Another nice dog. Not quite the expression or build of one, but nevertheless a quality dog. Well marked silky coat in good condition. Moved and showed well.

Junior American Bred Dog (2)

1. Canyoncrest Star Blazer, JW (Du Ross) Well marked compact Blen, soft and gentle expression. Nice make and shape with good forechest and spring of rib. Carrying a level topline standing and on the move. Well- turned stifles. A very happy showman. **2. Lilium Quince At Crownrose** (Rosenberg) Longer cast boy, not quite the expression of one. Nice eyes. Good forechest and spring of rib, but a little stilted in rear movement.

American Bred Dog (7)

1. Shirmont Back For More, JW (Dodson/Henry) Well marked pretty Blen boy having the much desired lozenge. Good shape. Short in body and carrying a good topline, tailset and carriage. Good bone. Nice angulations, moving well. **2. Quail Garden Tad O Magic** (Barrett/Mittelman/Subramanian/Geller) Well broken Blen. Little shorter in neck. Good topline and good bone. Moved well. **3. Cloudbase Oh So Handsome** (Davis/Scanlan Johnson) Longer cast Blen boy with the desired lozenge. Nice head and eye. Good topline

standing, but lost it a little on the move. **4. Boleyn Shakespeare In Luv At Ivyline** (Giampapa/Holm) Blen boy full of himself. Well marked, good topline. Pretty head, but eyes could be a little larger.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (5)

1. Pascavale Nathan (Cline/Sedgwick) Lovely Blen boy very pretty head with nice eye and pigment. Good angulations, well cushioned feet. Good bone. Level topline and tailset and carriage. Moved well. **Award of Merit 2. Ricksbury Royal Defender** (Cortes/Londono) Blen dog larger than 1. Good body and very sound. Moved well. **3. Pascavale Smarty** (Ayers/Martz/Cline) Blen dog nice type. Good make and shape, Moved well, just needs a little more animation. **4. Clopsville Durango** (Warner) Blen dog, sweet expression with those lovely doe eyes. Good neck and shoulders. Good bone.

Special Limit Tricolor Dog (2)

1. Pinecrest Dixieland Band (Scanlan Johnson) Small Tri boy nice expression, having a narrow blaze, but did not spoil the expression. Large dark eyes. Good forechest. Level topline, good tailset. Moved well. **Best Tricolor Dog 2. Orchardhill Charismatic** (Venier/Hodgkinson) Handsome well marked Tri boy, not quite the front of 1. Level topline. Good tailset and carriage. Good bone. Moved well

Special Limit Ruby Dog (4)

1. Elyzian Prime Mover (Davis) Larger boy with good straight silky coat. Pigment a little off colour which did not spoil the overall expression. Nicely made. Moved well. **2. Lilycroft High Seas** (Karcher) Sweet expression, but again pigment was lacking. Nice size. Good level topline and tailset. Moved well. **3. Little Knight Truffle** (Tyler) Ruby boy who was out of coat. Sweet head. Nice eyes. Did tend to loose his topline on the move. **4. Sir Riley Of Bear River** (Toepfer) No comments given.

Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (2)

1. Turretbank To Sir With Love (Miller) Beautiful headed B/T boy with profuse straight silky coat in wonderful condition, framed by wonderful long ear featherings. Lovely large dark eyes. Level topline, good tail set and carriage. Good bone. Moving well. **Best Black & Tan in Show 2. Brookhaven Bob Bailey** (Schilling) Smaller boy, good type. Nice expression, good angulations. Moved well.

Open Dog (6)

1. Sheeba Espresso (Ostmann) Delightful Blenheim dog, well broken glamorous boy and of ideal size. With a gentle head, large dark eyes, giving a soft melting expression. Nice body shape and angulations, with coat in excellent condition, presented to perfection. Considered for top honours, but sadly today just didn't pull himself together to reach the top spot. **Award of Merit 2. Ch Pascavale Stefano, JW** (Cline) Larger boy than 1. Nice for type, good bone. Good neck and shoulder placement. Nice head with large dark eyes. Moved well. **3. Ch Brookhaven Harrison At Almeara, JW** (Whitmire) Well marked Blen boy, good expression, nice dark pigment. A little wide in front. Nice rear angulation. **4. Ch Forestcreek Brass In Pocket** (Cline) Blen boy with nice head and eyes, good neck and shoulders and good depth of forechest. Although out of coat, it was of good quality.

Senior Open Dog (1)

1. Shado Run Rush To Ministik (Swatko) Lovely boy, so well put together. Lovely soft gentle head, large dark eyes, and good pigment. Coat of good quality and presented in lovely condition. **Best Ruby Dog**

Junior Puppy Bitch (5)

1. Lawson Greyhawk Sugar Express to Ivyline (Giampapa/Holm) Well marked Blen bitch, nice make and shape. Good body, nice coat. Moved well. **Best Puppy Bitch, Best Puppy in Show 2. Greyhawk Remembrance At Del Sol** (McHenry/Kubin) Richly well broken Blen girl with good pigment. Good bone, nice reach of neck and good angulations. Moved well. **3. Brookhaven Lucky Penny** (Schilling/Ayers) Ruby of nice make and shape, good forechest. Very pretty head. Nice size. Good topline, tailset and carriage. Moved well. **4. Wandris Believe In Me** (Gentil) Lovely baby girl with the desired lozenge, who needs time to reach her full potential, but has all the makings of a quality girl.

Senior Puppy Bitch (8)

1. Ch Lilium Autumn Festival, JW (McCoy/Fennel) Super Tri bitch, very sound. Lovely reach of neck and good shoulders. Well made and good bone. Sweet expression. Good coat in lovely condition. Moved well. **2. Orchardhill Indiscreet** (Venier) Pretty Blen bitch. Well marked. Super body. Just needs more coat, unfortunate to meet 1st in this class. **3. Royalcaper Saturday Matinee** (Clayton) Lovely puppy still with all her puppy fluff. Nice rich colour coming through. Lovely head with cute expression. Nicely made and showed herself well. **4. Benchmark Shameless** (Hoorman) Nice Tri carrying her tail a little high today. Pretty head. Slightly longer in body. Moved well.

Graduate Puppy Bitch (3)

1. Miletree Wendy McKenzie at Shirmont, JW (Henry) Small Blen bitch, well broken with a cute expression, completing the picture with lovely ear fringes. Good reach of neck and good shoulder placement. Level topline. **2. Ch Crizwood A Minute At Mayfield, JW** (Mayfield/Wornall) Richly marked Blen bitch good expression. Not quite the eyes of 1. Nice body, well sprung ribs. Moved well. **3. Quail Garden Tis Magic** (Colombo/Geller) Blen bitch, nice markings and sweet expression. Nice body, needs to tighten. Moved ok.

Novice Bitch (1)

1. Crossbow Jubilee Jolie Of Glenellen (Murphy) Blen girl who stood alone in this class, but nevertheless she was of a nice type, good make and shape. Good forechest and topline, good bone. A very happy showgirl moving well with drive.

Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (6)

1. Ch Pincrest Rockabyebaby (Eubank) Loved this baby, small very pretty girl of lovely type with the most beautiful eyes and expression. Nice angulations, moving well at one with her handler. *Reserve Winners Bitch*

2. Ch Darane Billie Jean (Kates) Ruby of lovely size. Very pretty and feminine, nice rich colour. Liked her very much, unfortunate to come up against 1st in class. *Best Ruby in Show* **3. Ch Autumnhill New Kid In Town, JW** (Parente) Another lovely Blen bitch with lozenge, Good neck and shoulder placement and good overall conformation. Nicely broken coat markings and large dark eyes and pigment. **4. Bekenhall Blue Suede Shoes** (Kent/Hall) Nice bitch, but would prefer just a shade darker in eyes, but this didn't detract in her expression. Nicely made moved well.

Junior American Bred Bitch (1)

1. Deltarose High Society (Wendorff) Blen girl standing alone. Very pretty. Good neck and shoulders, well broken coat markings, nice colour. Moved ok.

American Bred Bitch (6)

1. Shirmont Apple McIntosh, JW (Henry/Dodson) Blen bitch, nicely marked good pigment and nice expression with nice ear feathering. Good angulations. Moved well. *Award of Merit*

2. Crossbow Lil Ninja Grasshopa (Schiffman/Fannon) Nice type of bitch with the desired lozenge. Gentle expression and large dark eyes. Carrying a little too much weight which did affect her movement. **3. Crossbow All Fired Up At Oakbrook** (Tonius) Blen bitch well broken. Good body. Nice expression, very pretty. Moved ok. **4. Quail Run April In Paris** (Moulton) Blen bitch, nice eyes. Lovely ear fringes. Good topline and tailset. Moved ok.

Second Generation American Bred Bitch (1)

1. Hathersage Irish Rose (Fowler/Gonyo) Tri girl. Stood alone. Nicely constructed with good bone. Lovely head, eye and expression. Good rich tan. Moved well.

Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (5)

1. Rosscrea Summertime (Flowers Foster/Mohn) A bitch I have always admired. Beautiful head and gentle expression. Good pigment and large dark eyes all framed by long ear feathering. Lovely make and shape. Good topline. Coat in excellent condition. Moves with grace and style. **2. Charnell Monte Lucia, JW** (Ayers/Martz) Lovely Blen bitch, so unfortunate to meet 1st in this class. Lovely size, with the most gentle head, lovely dark eyes and gorgeous expression. Does not look her age and moved beautifully around the ring. **3. Spindlepoint Hope** (Compton) Gorgeous Blen bitch richly marked. Lovely. Such a pretty girl, but unfortunately did not like the carpet and was bothered by the large pattern, which made movement hard to assess, but gained her placing on her overall quality. **4. Royalcaper Bluebell Bliss** (Clayton) Pretty bitch with the sweetest expression, well broken markings. Nicely made, moved well.

Special Limit Tricolor Bitch (4)

1. Pinecrest Dixie Melody (Eubank) Well broken Tri girl with good tan. Pretty face. Small in type. Good neck and shoulders with good topline and tailset and carriage. Moved well. *Best Tricolor in Show* **2. Orchardhill Nxt Stp Wndrland** (Venier) Larger type. Nice quality girl. A little longer in body than 1. Good forechest and angulations. Moved well. **3. Sheeba Standing Ovation Of Windnsea, JW** (Sutton) Smaller Tri girl. Nice large dark eyes. Good forechest, neck and shoulder placement. Good body. Moved well. **4. Little Day Dreams** (Williams/Tyler) Tri girl, well broken, who unfortunately didn't show herself off to advantage. Moved ok.

Special Limit Ruby Bitch (2)

1. Nottinghill Autumn Belle (Oboyski) Richly coloured Ruby girl with nice expression. Nice body and good topline, tailset and tail carriage. Well sprung rib. Lovely coat in good condition. Moved well with animation. **2. Robin's Nest Torch Song** (Prodanovich) Young bitch with lovely expression. Good topline. Needs to tighten up more. Moved ok.

Special Limit Black & Tan Bitch (5)

1. Harana Midnight Star (Malinak) Feminine B/T girl. Nice head. Good make and shape, but did tend to lose her topline on the move. Good depth of forechest. Nice bone. Nice overall girl with lots to like. **2. Roseriver Hallelujah** (Young) B/T, nice size. Good topline and angulations. Moved well, but not quite the expression of 1. **3. Katesmoore Enchanting Garbo** (Moore) Sweet girl. Pretty head. Good overall shape, but needs more coat to complete the picture. **4. Desertsy Dawn Of A New Day** (Estabrook) Heavier made girl of good shape. Sound mover.

Open Bitch (4)

1. Ch Aranel With Love, JW (Flowers Foster) Striking Blenheim bitch that I have judged on another occasion, and my opinion of her is still the same, for me she epitomizes a toy spaniel, she has the most delightful gentle expression with dark eyes which are the windows to the soul, all framed by long ear featherings, with her

glamorous coat in excellent condition completed the picture, and I was pleased to award her **Winners Bitch, Best in Show, Best Blenheim in Show**

2. Ch Maibee Just My Imagination Of Bentwood, JW (Harrison) Another beautiful girl, unfortunate to meet 1 today. Excelling in neck and shoulders with a good depth of forechest, level topline, and tail carriage framed by a glamorous coat in good condition. Good head and eyes, giving a nice expression framed by long ear fringes. Moved positively with drive. Pleased to award her an **Award of Merit**. **3. Ch Luxxar Cara Mia, JW** (Fennel) Lovely Tri, beautiful type. Ideal for size and very pretty. Moved well. **4. Ch Darane Holly Blue** (Kates) Happy showgirl with good neck and shoulders. Level topline, tailset and carriage. Moved well.
