JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- Blueday Hullabaloo (Gross/Gross) Ruby boy with correct head for his age. Well-balanced body. A bit thin at the moment, but good bone for his small size. Moved soundly going around. Round eyes and good dark pigment on a pretty head. <u>BEST JUNIOR PUPPY IN SHOW</u>
- 2. **Clarmarian Heir Apparent** (Young-May) Blenheim boy with good coat. Adequate bone and good turn of stifle. A bit longer on leg. Would have preferred a larger eye. Happy showman who moved well around the ring.
- 3. **Carlen Ordinary Miracle** (Close) Tri boy with a narrow blaze but well broken in color. Good dark pigment. Carrying his rear a little high today. Adequate bone but would have preferred a more solid rear.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

- Linrica Milan, JW (Liu) Blenheim boy with great coat, which was perfectly groomed. Sound puppy with short back, level topline, and good turn of stifle. Pretty head with big dark round eyes and good earset. Smaller dog overall with great rear. Moved well around the ring. <u>BEST SENIOR</u> <u>PUPPY, BEST PUPPY DOG & BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.</u>
- 2. Chadwick Shooting Upwards (Eckersley) Blenheim boy with dark eyes and pigment. Nice skull with good earset, dark eyes and pigment. Balanced in structure with good bone and good front and rear.
- 3. **Truluv Toughen Up** (Nikaci) Tri boy with narrow blaze and closely set eyes that distracted from a soft expression. Dead level topline and shorter in loin than boy placed below him. Preferred rear angles of those placed above him. Moved well around the ring.
- 4. **Truluv Prince Charming** (Nikaci) Nicely broken Blenheim boy. Eyes set closely together. Ears set nicely to frame face. Level topline with good bone. A bit weaker in rear and longer in loin than those placed above him. Happy showman.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1. **Brookhaven The Dream Lives On at Finnickyskye** (Utych/Utych) Smaller nicely-marked Blenheim with a lovely coat. Pretty dark eyes that were set well apart. Good pigment with good turn of stifle. Not best in shoulder layback, but moved well around the ring.
- 2. **Angel's Pride Zakkary** (Engel) Blenheim boy with a lovely long neck and nice coat. His outline and shape were good, but his rear was a bit weaker and closer than #1. Moved nicely around the ring. Preferred substance and head of #1.

3. **Truluv Ben Marcato** (Hayes/Nikaci) Small Blenheim boy with a massive coat. Loved his head shape. Small bit of white in the eye. Nice length of loin and depth of chest. Reach and drive was limited. Proud of his tail today.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (6)

- Ch Jadestone Legend Has It, JW (Peek) Smaller Blenheim boy with lovely head and expression. Long silky coat. Large dark round eyes contributed to that melting expression. Solid boy with adequate bone. Well-groomed and presented nicely. Moved happily around the ring. I was pleased to award him <u>RESERVE WINNERS DOG, BEST AMERICAN BRED DOG, BEST BRED BY</u> <u>EXHIBITOR DOG</u>.
- 2. Veribas Eye Of The Tiger (Cusick) Solid Blenheim boy with nice dark rich color. Pretty head and dark round eyes with good pigment. Good solid shape and make. Good front. Adequate bone, but would have preferred better rear assembly.
- 3. **Ch. Valentyne The Irish Tenor, JW** (O'Brien) Lovely well-broken Blenheim boy with rich color. Eyes were on the smaller side and he seemed a bit sleepy today, but a handsome boy in a compact package shown in a nice class of boys.
- 4. **Ch. Clarmarian Classic by Design** (Young-May) Dark rich-colored Blenheim boy. Nice skull with long feathered ears. Good pigment on eyes and nose. Solid boy with good turn of stifle. Preferred the front assembly on those placed above him.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1. **Orchardhill Toy Money** (Johns/Venier/Venier) Compact dog with dark rich color. Round eyes with a bit of white in one eye. Nicely placed dot on head. Level topline and solid structure. Active great showman who moved elegantly around the ring.
- 2. Chadwick Jet Setter at Hudsonview, JW (Glynn/Glynn) Pretty little dog with rich color. Longer in loin than one placed above him. Solid body with a good topline. Happy showman.
- 3. **Rutherford Olivier** (de Haas/Jones) Solid dog with good bone. Dark and well-broken color. Level topline. Nice skull/pretty head with white in corner of eye. Preferred the drive and movement of those placed above him.
- 4. **Darane I Drove All Night** (Longobardi) Ruby boy with good dark pigment, but a bit longer in muzzle than I prefer. Good earset. Solid structure, but was lacking in coat today. Moved around ring well.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (6)

- 1. Almeara Extra Ordinary (Whitmire) Rich colored boy with large round dark eyes and pigment. Pretty head with lozenge. Nice full coat. Short loin with good topline. Well shown and wellgroomed.
- 2. **Mimric American Heartthrob** (Bolster/Hodges) Blenheim boy with pretty head and nice round dark eyes. Good pigment. Preferred shorter loin of one placed above him. Happy showman.
- 3. **Tassajara Stoli** (Meager) Pretty little dog with well-broken color in a nice long coat. Full ears and good pigment on a lovely head. Front assembly was lacking, so did not move as well going around as those placed above him.
- 4. **Stellar Romancing The Stone at Tyewyn** (Knauss/Rose) Heavily-marked Tri boy with narrow blaze. Round eyes with dark pigment. A bit high in the rear so threw off topline. Good showman.

2ND GENERATION AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1. **Foxwyn Woodbury Rise N Shine of Ceilimor** (McCarty/Redniss) Smaller Blenheim boy with lovely head. Pretty round dark eyes and pigment. A bit straight in rear. Well-groomed, but not in great coat today.
- 2. **Oggbrae Don Ottavio** (Bales/Bales) Nice Blenheim boy with a good skull, good dark pigment and earset. Coat a bit curly today. Moved well around the ring.

HEALTH & CONFORMATION DOG (1)

 Charteroak Claude Monet (Obadowski) Black-and-Tan boy with nice straight coat with lovely long ears. Long feathered feet. Lovely disposition and moved well around the ring. <u>BEST</u> <u>BLACK-AND-TAN DOG</u>

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (9)

- Dreamvale Follow All My Moves (Perini/Sage) Nicely-marked smaller Blenheim boy with lovely well-groomed coat. Full ears set nicely on pretty head. Good compact shape. Moved well coming and going and showed well. <u>AWARD OF MERIT #2</u>
- 2. **Bonitos Companeros Vahir** (Lemon/Lemon) Blenheim boy with pretty head and full dark coat. Large eyes with good pigment. Nice short back. Preferred rear structure of one placed above him. Moved well around the ring.
- 3. **Foxwyn Cool Water** (Norton/Baker-Fox) Rich dark colored Blenheim with pretty head and eyes with rich dark pigment. A smaller compact boy who was well-groomed and at one with his handler. Was a bit proud of his tail today.
- 4. **Rockcreek Mark Me First at Hiflt, JW** (Parris/Parris/Steagall) Pretty smaller boy with a narrow blaze. Rich dark coat with full ears. Compact structure. Another who was proud of his tail. Moved around the ring with ease.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (1)

1. **Rosehill Recalculating** (MacMullin/Sage/Warshaw/Warshaw) Heavily-marked Tri with small white collar and narrow blaze. Lovely long ears and feathers on legs. A bit long in loin. Moved well away.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY

- Kabaret Million (Meager/Wise) Ruby boy who was a nice little package. Lovely skull. Lighter in color, but beautifully groomed and moved well, both down & back and around the ring. <u>BEST</u> <u>RUBY IN SHOW, BEST RUBY DOG</u>
- 2. Kolaci Magic Cinnamon Spice (Legerretta/Gray) Ruby boy with pretty head. Dark pigment. Longer on leg than one placed above him. Preferred the rear on #1.

OPEN DOG (5)

 Ch You're My Sunshine Vom Kaninchengarten, JW (Hansen) The most beautiful large dark eyes on this lovely Blenheim boy. Rich dark coat in excellent condition and well-groomed. Lovely structure and was a joy to go over. Very correct body with good front and rear assembly. Moved elegantly around the ring with good reach and drive. A great showman who could not be denied. I was proud to award him <u>WINNERS DOG, BEST IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW,</u> <u>BEST BLENHEIM DOG.</u>

- 2. Ch & Eng Ch Stonepit Franco I Believe (Gentil/Searle) Well-broken Tri boy with a beautiful head and melting expressing. A compact solid boy with good bone. Could not resist him. I was pleased to award him *BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW, AWARD OF MERIT #1*.
- 3. Ch & Eng Ch Brookhaven Believe It Or Not (Ayers/Martz) Well-broken smaller Blenheim boy with narrow blaze. Compact dog with good angulation in front and rear. Moves well around the ring. Nice rich color, but out of coat and didn't seem interested in showing his best today.
- 4. **Ch Clopsville Meridian** (Rychlik) Blenheim boy with pretty head with big dark eyes and pigment. Well broken with nice color. Level topline, but longer in loin than those placed above him.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (2)

- 1. Wildroses Keuka Oh Riley (Sutherland) 12 ½ year old Blenheim boy with tons of well-broken coat and the perfect lozenge on his head. Pretty head with sweet face. Rear did not keep up with him well today. Happy to show.
- 2. **Stellar Fireball** (Knauss/Gregg) A nearly 12-year-old Ruby gentleman with a pretty head, dark pigment and good topline. A bit closer in rear than one placed above him. Quiet and reserved showing.

- 1. **Rutherford Ulalee** (Jones) Five-month-old Blenheim girl with the cutest cushy puppy expression. Large dark round eyes and good pigment. Well-broken coat. Good turn of stifle. Happiest little showgirl.
- 2. **Brookhaven Temptation** (Ayers/Martz) Well-broken Blenheim girl with lovely shape. Nicely balanced puppy with level topline. Moved well around the ring, down and back. Preferred head of one placed above her.
- 3. Nightingale Against The Wind (Grimm Curley) Another lovely Blenheim girl with good bone and solid structure. Active happy puppy who moved well.
- 4. **Chadwick Oh La La** (Eckersley) Dark coated Blenheim with perfect dot on a pretty head. Dark eyes and pigment. Moved well. A bit longer in loin than those placed above her.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (4)

- Marjorelle Rumour Has It (Conley) Heavily-marked Blenheim with rich dark color. Large dark eyes and good earset placed on a pretty skull. Level topline with tail right off the spine. Good turn of stifle. Nicely balanced puppy who moved well. I was pleased to award her <u>BEST PUPPY</u> <u>BITCH</u>.
- 2. **Delsol Love In An Elevator** (McHenry) Another Blenheim girl with a well-broken dark coat. Dark eyes and full well-placed ears with dot on head. Good bone but a bit longer in loin than one placed above her.
- 3. **Gracelyn Dream Weaver** (Gregory) Well-broken Blenheim with adequate bone, but a bit straighter in the rear. A bit longer and preferred the head and 'cush' of those placed above her.
- 4. **Chantismere Carrieanna** (Tibbetts) Blenheim girl with dark rich coat. Short hocks, but longer on leg. Slopes off at croup a bit. Preferred the head and "cush" of those placed above her.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

- 1. **Tudorr La Dolce Angela** (Mixon/Mixon/Cline) Well-broken 15-month-old puppy with beautiful large eyes and dark pigment on a pretty head. Ears well placed. Moved well coming and going. Nice topline and front & rear angles. A lovely overall solid bitch who will do well in the future.
- 2. **Bonitos Companeros Josephine of Welmforth** (Lasser) Lightly marked Blenheim girl with pretty head and sweet expression. Good earset with round dark eyes and good pigment. Good tailset and rear angles. Moved well. Happy showgirl.
- 3. **Chadwick Hpnotiq** (Taub & Eckersley) Well-marked Blenheim girl with rich dark coat. Perfect lozenge on head. Good bone on a solid bitch. Did not enjoy the show today.

NOVICE BITCH (5)

- 1. Clopsville Willow (Mandeville/Rychlik) Well-broken Blenheim with nice silky coat. Pretty head with large round dark eyes. Good pigment. Balanced bitch with good turn of stifle and level topline.
- 2. **Bluegarden Aussie Girl at Chadwick** (Eckersley) Another solid Blenheim girl with good bone. Compact body with rich red coat. Good reach of neck. A bit of white in eye. Moved well around the ring.
- 3. **Chantismere Catarina** (Tibbetts) Heavily-marked rich red Blenheim girl. Level topline. Longer on leg. Preferred the angles and movement on those placed above her.
- 4. **Treygens Simply The Best** (Thorp/Thorp) Tri girl with silky coat. Narrow blaze. Would have preferred more "cush" below her eyes. Good bone. Did not maintain her topline on the move. Happy showgirl.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

- Ch Kean La Ti Da, JW (Keane) One of my favorite picks of the day. This girl has a lovely rich dark coat which was groomed perfectly. She has perfectly set ears with long feathers and large dark eyes set on a beautiful head. Nice solid bitch who had excellent angles, a fabulous rear when moving away, and flowed around the ring with ease. She showed beautifully, standing and moving. Was at one with her handler. I was happy to award her <u>WINNERS BITCH, BEST OF OPPOSITE</u> <u>SEX TO BEST IN SHOW, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN</u> <u>SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY</u> <u>EXHIBITOR BITCH, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH, & BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH.</u>
- 2. Ch Orchardhill Plum Pretty (Venier/Venier) Another lovely Blenheim girl with pretty head, good earset and round dark eyes with good pigment. Good bone with level topline. Nice solid girl with all the right angles. Preferred the rear movement of the one placed above her.
- 3. Ch Bluegarden Exclusive, JW (Matos/Glynn) Well-broken Blenheim girl who is a bit larger than the two placed above her. Dark round eyes with good pigment. Lovely coat that was well-groomed. Another solid bitch who moved well around the ring, but was unlucky on the day to be in such a wonderful class. Happy showgirl and well presented.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

1. **Chadwick Sentimental Journey, JW** (Eckersley) Nicely-marked Blenheim with a small pretty petite head. Large dark round eyes with good pigment and good earset. Nice shape and size. Level topline. Good bone on a nice overall shape. Moved well around the ring, showing perfectly.

- 2. Veribas Wild Thing Heart Sing Joliet (Mitchum/Cusick) Well-broken Blenheim girl with good bone. Another nice solid girl with good depth of chest and angles in the right places. Moved very well around the ring, and down & back. Preferred the size and head of #1.
- 3. **Chewcreek Devil May Care** (DePhillip) Black-and-Tan girl with big eyes and a pretty head. Adequate in bone with a level topline. Nice rear. Seemed a bit longer in leg due to shortness of coat. Carrying her tail slightly high today, but moved well around the ring.
- 4. **Piccadil Goddess Of Brightness And Radiance** (Comer/Greak) Well-broken smaller Blenheim girl. Smaller eyes and would have preferred more "cush" underneath. Good turn of stifle, but turned in a bit at hocks when going away. Preferred the heads of others placed above her.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (7)

- 1. Valentyne Pillow Talk (O'Brien) Pretty heavily-marked Blenheim girl with silky long coat. Lovely head marked with large dark round eyes, good pigment, and well-set ears. Nice short loin with good bone. Good shape and make. Moved well around the ring, but would have preferred better rear/drive.
- Nightingale Sloe Gin Fizz At Hollytree, JW (Seymour) Pretty Blenheim girl with tons of coat a bit lighter in color than #1. Adequate bone on a nice shape and size but would have preferred more neck. Nice head with proper placement of ears, but preferred the eyes on one placed above her. Moved well.
- 3. **Padamere Timeless Jewels** (Miller/Miller) Another Blenheim girl with a rich dark coat. Dark pigment. Adequate bone. Good topline and tailset. A bit longer than those placed above her.
- 4. **Sherah Oops A Daisy** (Crommett) Larger Blenheim girl with a well-broken silky coat. Round eyes. Good earset. Level topline. Moved a bit close in the rear.

2ND GENERATION AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

- 1. **Clarmarian Ooh La La** (McFarland/Young-May) Heavily-marked Blenheim with lovely head. Good pigment surrounding round eyes. Solid body with good length of loin, depth of chest, good bone and turn of stifle. Moved easily around the ring.
- 2. **Rutherford Pippa, JW** (Jones) Rich colored Blenheim girl with perfect dot on her head. Nice earset on a pretty head. Good bone on a small package with nice topline and tailset. A bit longer than #1. Moved around the ring well. Preferred the placement of eyes on the one above her.
- 3. **Huntlee Mayla at Hollytree** (Seymour) Well-broken Blenheim with lots of coat, but lighter in color. Would have preferred more "cush" on head. Good bone with decent angles, but tailset a bit low. Happy showgirl.

HEALTH & CONFORMATION BITCH (1)

1. **Clopsville Santa Ana** (Rychlik) Small well-broken Blenheim 6-year-old girl with a beautiful petite head. Pretty expression with big round dark eyes and good earset. Adequate bone, nice length of loin, and good turn of stifle. Balanced little girl. Nice package overall.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

1. **Dreamvale Follow Fashion, JW** (Sage/Colbert) Heavily-marked Blenheim girl with dark rich coat. Pretty head with sweet expression set off by nice round eyes. Nice shape and size with good bone, angles and topline. Moved and showed well.

- 2. **Piaffe In The Tulips** (Rychlik) Larger well-broken Blenheim girl with sufficient coat. A bit longer in loin than #1. Dark eye color and pigment. Good bone with good turn of stifle, but limited in reach.
- 3. **Howlinwinds Summer Lady** (Donahue/Curtiss) Heavily-marked Blenheim girl with narrow blaze. Adequate bone and movement, but would have preferred more substance.

(NO SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH CLASS)

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (2)

- 1. **Padamere Love Potion** (Miller) Ruby girl with pretty head set off with dark round eyes and good pigment. Level topline with good coat who moved happily around the ring. I was pleased to award her *BEST RUBY BITCH IN SHOW*.
- 2. **Carlen Nutin But Trouble Fergie** (Close) Another pretty Ruby with nice earset, level topline, and good bone. Sufficient coat. Preferred the movement of the one placed above her.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH (3)

- Iloo Dite Ilan Du Jardin De Claire of Sumara, JW (Gentil) Lovely smaller black-and-tan girl with the sweetest melting expression. Pretty head with dark round eyes. Lovely well-groomed coat. Nice shape and size. Moved well with good turn of stifle. Sweetest disposition. Although a bit bored today, it was hard to deny her <u>BEST BLACK-AND-TAN IN SHOW</u> and <u>BEST BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH.</u>
- 2. **Darane True Colors** (Kates) Another nice black-and-tan girl with good coat and earset that framed her head nicely. Level topline and adequate angles front and rear which made her move well around the ring. A bit longer in loin than one placed above her.
- 3. **Carlen First Pict Sangiovese** (Close) Black-and-tan girl with good coat. Good bone. Showed well with good rear movement, but a bit low in croup. Tail wagging and happy to be showing.

OPEN BITCH (7)

- 1. Ch Chadwick Leura, JW (Eckersley) A lovely heavily-marked Blenheim girl with a beautiful head and sweet expression. Shown in lovely coat that was well-groomed, she had a nice overall structure with good shape and smaller size. Nice short loin and good angles helped her sweep around the ring. Well trained for the ring, she could not step a paw wrong. I was pleased to award her *RESERVE WINNERS BITCH*.
- Ch Carmas Penne Pasta at Crizwood (Moulton/Wornall) Another lovely Blenheim girl who was well-broken and possessed a beautiful head with dark round eyes, good pigment and full ears, complete with the dot on the head. Good bone with excellent structure including her level topline, tailset, and front and rear assembly. I was pleased to award her <u>AWARD OF MERIT #1</u>.
- 3. Ch Linrica Just A Dream, JW (Hsiung/Liu) A well-broken Tri girl with a lovely head and nice round dark eyes. Adequate bone. Good turn of stifle. Moved nicely around the ring. Preferred the front assembly on the one placed above her. <u>BEST TRICOLOR BITCH</u>
- 4. **Ch Orchardhill Girl Talk** (Venier/Venier) Larger well-broken Blenheim girl who was wellbalanced with good structure. Good bone and level topline. Would have preferred more neck. Preferred the heads on #1 and #2.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (2)

- 1. **Ch Rosscrea Summertime** (Foster/Mohn) This 11-year-old Blenheim still has it! Her big dark eyes and sweet expression can still melt you. Holding her incredible topline and moving like a youngster around the ring, she is hard to deny even at this age. A lovely bitch who continues to hold her lovely shape and make. I was pleased to award her *AWARD OF MERIT #2*.
- Ch Chesham A Minute Of Your Time (Taub/Eckersley) A 7-year-old petite Blenheim girl with a beautiful head. She has dark round eyes, a compact shape and possesses a wonderful silky coat. Although her nose pigment has started to lighten a bit, she continues to show that she is a Champion. A lovely shape and type.

VETERAN DOG (3)

- 1. Ch Chadwick Scotch On The Rocks at Hudsonview (Glynn/Glynn) Although it's been a few years, when I saw this lovely 7 ¹/₂-year-old Blenheim in the ring with his pretty head, lovely coat, and sweet expression, I felt the same as I did when I judged him as a young boy. A lovely, solid boy who still moves around the ring with ease.
- 2. Ch Nightingale Heat Wave, JW (Mulligan) Another lovely 9-year- old Blenheim who is smaller and a bit lighter in color. He has lovely dark round eyes placed on a nice head. Although he didn't have the coat of #1, he has good front and rear angulation, good bone, and moves well. Vied heavily with the winner in this class.
- 3. **Karvale Brookhaven Finn** (Utych) Larger 8 ¹/₂-year-old well-broken Blenheim with a beautiful long silky coat. Pretty head with the perfect lozenge on top. Still spunky (he barked for his bait) and happy to show. Lighter in color than the others in the class. His true Cavalier spirit drove him around the ring well.

VETERAN BITCH

- 1. Ch Chadwick Laphroaig, JW (Eckersley) Smaller 11-year-old Blenheim with long silky coat. She had big round dark eyes with excellent pigment. Topline held steady as her nice shape carried her around the ring with her tail wagging. I was happy to award her <u>BEST VETERAN IN SHOW</u>
- 2. **Sheeba Discover Betty Boop** (Gross/Gross) An 11-year old larger Blenheim girl inching forward for her bait. Lightly marked with a silky long coat. Her ears still frame her pretty head and round eyes. She made it around the ring like a pro.
- 3. Chadwick Idol Gossip at Markley (Storey/Eckersley) Well-broken 10-year-old heavier set Blenheim with a pretty head. Good rich coat color. Still has 'mascara'- just a shade lighter. Maintained a good topline as she happily made it around the ring.
