- 1. Tassajara Sully Sullenberger (Seidman) Bl. Very good type, level topline, excellent moving, shows himself well. *Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show*
- **2. Riverview Who Dat** (Barrois) Bl. Solid color, good head shape, excellent depth of chest, good topline, shows some white in the eye. **3. Denham Dream Boat** (Maddox) Ruby. Excellent eye shape and color, good length of head, sound moving. **4. Tudorose Apollo** (Mixon) Bl. Excellent expression, correct round eye, level topline, slightly out in front.

## Senior Puppy Dog (2)

**1. Autumn Hill Ring of Fire, JW** (Parente) Ruby. Good overall balance of body with level topline, good depth of chest, pleasing head. **Best Ruby Dog 2. Circlecity Walk In The Park** (Matters) Bl, excellent expression, pleasing overall head shape, level topline, good depth of chest, carries tail higher than I would like to see when moving.

# **Graduate Puppy Dog (5)**

- 1. Chantismere Chandos of Valentyne (O'Brien) Bl. Shown in excellent condition, deep rich red color, masculine headpiece with good expression, excellent angulation front and rear, uses himself well when going around the ring. Winners Dog, Best of Opposite Sex in Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Blenheim Dog in Show
- **2. Brookhaven Jessie** (Ayers/Martz) Bl. Excellent overall shape of body with very good angulation, level topline, requires more confidence in the ring which will probably come with more showing. **3. Tudorr All That Jazz** (Bennett/Mixon) Good angulation, pleasing expression, moves well, would like a little more fill under the eyes. **4. Two Rivers Finishing Touch** (Adair) Very good head shape with excellent eye shape and color, moderate angulation, good topline, needs more confidence in the ring.

# Novice Dog (1)

**1. Denham Dynamite Joe** (Maddox) Bl. Heavily marked dog, excellent expression, very good spring of rib with excellent depth of chest. Very good rear angulation, needs slightly more angulation in front

#### **Bred By Exhibitor Dog (1)**

**1. Ch Mimric Monogram, JW** (Hodges/Perkins) Bl. Very pleasing dog overall with a masculine head, excellent expression good fill under the eyes, correct eye shape and color, level topline, heavily marked. Slightly wide in front while moving.

# Junior American Bred Dog (1)

**1. Forestcreek Apollo** (Walzer/Cline) Bl. A very pleasant dog to go over, well balanced head, uses his ears well, correct eye shape and color. Very exuberant showing dog with excellent carriage of tail.

### American Bred Dog (4)

1. Sheeba Guccio Gucci (Adair/Mitchell) Good overall shape of body, excellent expression, good eye shape and color, level topline, uses itself well when moving. 2. Darane Jon Bon Jovi (Kates) Bl. Very close between this dog and my first in the class, excellent overall type, gorgeous headpiece, moves well. 3. Tassajara Hugh Jackman (Seidman/Hughes/Berkau) Good overall angulation, shows well, heavier head than I'm used to, excellent topline, good tailset. 4. Piaffe Lord Of The Dance (Rychlik) Bl. Moves well going around the ring, pleasant expression, requires more angulation in front. Short in length of body. Carries tail high. Special Limit Blenheim Dog (7)

- **1. Aranel Fanatic** (Adair) Excellent expression, uses his ears well, overall well balanced dog, level topline, excellent movement going around the ring. **2. Pascavale Smarty** (Ayers/Martz/Cline) This is a dog of excellent type with good overall proportions in body, correct eye shape and color, good length of muzzle, unfortunately on the day he did not show himself to his best advantage.
- **3.** Chantismere Cast A Spell On Corduke (Mulligan) A well moving dog with very good angulation, level topline, good eye shape and color, requires a little more fill under the eyes. **4.** Lanola Only Make Believe (Matters) A well bodied dog with level topline, good overall shape, good head shape with lots of fill under the eyes, moves around the ring well.

## **Special Limit Tricolor Dog (5)**

1. Dreamvale Smart As The Dickens, JW (Warshaw/Sage) A well balanced dog with excellent expression and uses his ears well, level topline, sound movement. *Best Tricolor Dog* 2. Verbas Point Break (Cusick) Excellent shape of body, well marked dog,

excellent type, good shape and color of eyes. **3. Lanmar Eclipse** (Hubbard/Bucy) The largest dog in the class, mostly white in color, good angulation, level topline, shows some white in the eye. **4. Darane Boys Don't Cry** (DePhillip) Exuberant dog, travels around the ring very well, does very well coming and going, good eye shape but shows some white.

# Special Limit Ruby Dog (1)

**1. Tanglewood Rebellion** (Saban/Fairchild) A good expression, good body shape with deep brisket and level topline, deep rich color, uses ears well, moves slightly wide in front.

# Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (3)

- **1. Brookhaven Bob Bailey** (Schilling) Beautiful overall shape and balance, exceptional expression with good eye shape and color, level topline, moves around the ring with ease, well presented. *Reserve Winners Dog, Best Black & Tan in Show*
- **2. Darane Michaelangelo at Blueheart** (Berg) A nice moving dog with good overall balance, level topline, very good expression, good angulation in front and rear. **3. Lynsfaire Country Gentleman** (Hallsted) Well balanced head with good ear set, excellent eye shape and color, level topline, moderate angulation in front, on the day a happy mover but gets his tail a little higher then desired.

### Open Dog (2)

1. Ch Castlekeep Cimaron at Triplecrown Panache (Keane/Brouck) Well broken body color with good angulation front and rear, excellent head piece with very good fill under the eyes, good ear set, appropriate length of neck, level topline. 2. Ch Byermoor Queens Orb (O'Brien) Excellent eye shape and color, very good shape of head, good expression, level topline, body color not as well broken as my first place dog and he sometimes gets his tail a little high when moving.

## **Junior Puppy Bitch (5)**

- **1. Forestcrest Pippa M** (Mixon/Cline) Bl. Excellent type, very appealing head, excellent expression, level topline, shows herself off well when moving. *Best Puppy Bitch*
- 2. Tassajara Dawn Dunlap At Greentree (Chenevert) Bl. Excellent length of neck into a level topline with good tail set, uses her very good angulation to advantage when moving. 3. Bonitos Companeros Je T'Aime (Adair) Bl. Very good body shape with excellent angulation front and rear, good depth of chest, level topline, very outgoing needs a little more ring time. 4. Liane's Xaviera (Poti) Ruby. Excellent type with good angulation, correct eye shape but shows a little white around the eye, good expression.

## Senior Puppy Bitch (1)

**1. Brookhaven Lucky Penny** (Schilling/Ayers) Ruby. Excellent balance of body with good angulation, good round eye shape and of dark color, pleasing expression, very good fill under the eyes, good depth of chest, moves true in front but a little close behind.

### **Graduate Puppy Bitch (6)**

1. Kean Juicy Couture (Keane/Campbell) Bl. Well balanced and presents an excellent outline especially when moving, beautiful type, good front and rear angulation, level topline, pleasing head, would like to see her use her ears a little more. 2. Granlaurel I'm Just Sayin' (Painter) Bl. Moves around the ring well, very good expression, uses its ears well, level topline, good depth of chest, needs a little more fill under the eyes. 3. Tudorr Lipstick N Lace (Mixon) Bl. Overall good balance with a level topline and good depth of brisket, correct round eye but shows a little white. Good mover. 4. Brookhaven Darbie (Ayers/Martz) Tri. Pleasing outline, excellent angulation, very good eye shape and color, level topline with an excellent tailset.

#### Novice Bitch (2)

1. Kyneslane Lil' Miss Daisy (Paplauckas) A very typey bitch that uses herself well when moving, carries a good topline, very nice expression, needs some practice on the table. 2. Blueday Come Fly With Me (Gross) Tri. Very good expression, moderate angulation, tail is carried a little high when moving.

#### **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (4)**

1. Ch Two Rivers Take Me As I Am, JW (Adair) Bl. A very nice class of bitches, this bitch has excellent overall balance, floats around the ring, excellent expression with correct eye shape and color, good ear set, excellent length of muzzle, level topline with good tail set. 2. Jayba Buttons N Bows (Lander) Very close behind the bitch placing first, level topline with good depth of brisket, excellent head shape with very good pigment, correct eye shape and color, pleasing expression, excellent rear angulation, requires a little more angulation in front. 3. Ch Darane Billie Jean (Kates) Ruby. Very good expression, good angulation, good head shape with eyes of very good shape and color, requires a little more work on the table. Best Ruby in Show 4. Ch Granlaurel Uptown Girl, JW (Painter) Bl. A very showy bitch who travels around the ring with enthusiasm, level topline with good angulation, a pleasing head shape with nice expression.

## **Junior American Bred Bitch (1)**

**1. Foxcreek Sophia Rose** (Johnson) Bl. A smooth moving bitch for her age, excellent expression, level topline, excellent ear set. Tail gets up a bit when moving.

## American Bred Bitch (8)

1. Lanmar Pometini (Hubbard/Beavers) Bl. Exquisite type with a beautiful headpiece, very good ear set, excellent eye shape and

color, moved effortlessly with a level topline. Reserve Winners Bitch

2. Primrose Hearts Afire (Lovett) Bl. Very close behind the first place bitch with excellent type, very feminine, carries a good topline, very good type of head with excellent fill under the eyes. 3. Jayba Violetta (Lander) Bl. An excellent moving bitch, very well constructed with excellent overall balance, level topline, I would like her to be a little more feminine in head. 4. Jayba Riviera Gold (Cusick) Also an excellent bitch with good type but on the day didn't use herself to her best advantage, excellent angulation, level topline, well balanced head, needs to show a little more expression.

#### **Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (7)**

- 1. Rosscrea Summertime (Flowers Foster/Mohn) I had a hard time taking my eyes off this bitch the first time I saw her go around the ring. She just knocked my socks off! This was in every way a bitch with so much femininity. Her head piece was beautiful, excellent eye shape and color, excellent fill under the eyes, gorgeous expression, excellent length of neck flowing down into a level topline, she moved with ease and to her best advantage, She was very much a pleasure to judge and eventually was my Best in Show for the day. Winners Bitch, Best in Show, Best Blenheim in Show
- 2. Chesham A Minute Of Your Time, JW (Eckersley/Taub) A good moving bitch with a very good type of headpiece, excellent round, deep colored eye with good expression, very good angulation, level topline. 3. Jayba Sweet Tea (Lander) Excellent side gait with level topline, good overall balance with moderate angulation front and rear, requires a little more fill under the eyes. 4. Royalcaper Bluebell Bliss (Clayton) Excellent front and rear angulation, good expression, a very good moving bitch, very true coming and going.

## **Special Limit Tricolor Bitch (2)**

**1. Darane Paradise City, JW** (Kates) Moves around the ring with ease, level topline, good expression, uses her ears well when baited, good bone, obviously enjoys showing herself off. *Best Tricolor in Show 2.* Chadwick Pickety (Taub) A heavily marked bitch with a nice expression, adequate angulation, moves with a slight rise over the loin.

# Special Limit Ruby Bitch (1)

**1. BackNTime Red Roses On Velvet** (Niemi) A bitch of good size with excellent angulation front and rear, a very good moving dog, excellent overall balance with good length of neck.

#### Special Limit Black and Tan Bitch (1)

1. Avia Camellia (Poti) An excellent moving bitch, very true coming and going, good depth of chest, level topline, good angulation, excellent expression, correct round eye but does show some white. Best Black & Tan Bitch

#### Open Bitch (2)

1. Ch Mimric Marilyn Moonroe JW (Hodges/Perkins) Bl. An excellent quality bitch with a good overall balanced outline, level topline, very good angulation, well defined rich color, excellent expression with good eye shape and color, good pigment, excellent presentation. 2. Avia Gardenia (Poti) Ruby. A good moving bitch with an excellent topline, good depth of chest, adequate angulation front and rear, moved with a good outline.

### Senior Open Bitch (1)

**1. Oggbrae Button Gwinnett** (Bales) Bl. Moved around the ring with enthusiasm and was obviously enjoying herself, excellent angulation, carried a level topline, pleasing head with good eye shape and color.
