There were several young dogs that should have an exciting future. The eyes were really good on almost all the dogs, nice, round and dark. We do need to continue to try to improve our croups and tailsets. Overall I was very pleased with the dogs and really had a lovely day judging them.

Junior Puppy Dog (6)

- 1. Jayba Smokin (Lander) This Blenheim moved around the ring like he had been showing forever, He had a dead level topline with a good front and rear and a correct tail set. He had a lovely head with a soft expression and large dark eyes and correct head tapering to a plush muzzle with a correct bite. He is a lovely dog and should have an exciting future. 2. Shirmont Caddo Balliol (Henry/Dodson) A lovely Blenheim boy with the prettiest of heads. He was very happy in the ring today and having a hard time settling down. I loved this boy and when he matures he will be the one to beat. 3. Chadwick Paddington Bear (Eckersley) Another lovely Blenheim boy with a lot of promise. Good for size with an attractive head and a lovely coat. He had a lovely soft head with nice dark round eyes. He moved well around the ring with a nice front and rear. 4. Darane Spider Man (Kates) Lovely ruby boy with a nice head and eyes. His coat was a lovely dark color and he was presented well and moved gracefully around the ring. Senior Puppy Dog (5)

Good overall shape with correct topline and tailset. He had a lovely coat and showed well for his owner. He should have a great future.

1. Canyoncrest St. Elmos Fire (Shepard/Du Ross) A lovely Ruby boy with very nice coat. He was presented well and gave his owner his full attention. **2.** Mysticknight Orbiting Comet (Brandvold) Ruby boy with a lovely head, he also had a lovely coat with dark, rich color.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (3)
