JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1. SHEEBA COVER BOY AT APPLE BRANCH (Bennett/Valenzuela Munoz) Caught my eye as he walked into the ring, lovely shape with great layback of shoulder and well turned stifles, elegant on the move in all directions and correct head with beautiful eyes. One to watch! *BEST PUPPY DOG, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW, AWARD OF MERIT*
- 2. **MARILEE BLUEBERRY** (Kelly Collins, DVM) Nice puppy of correct type, similar shape to winner with a very pretty head and eyes to die for just couldn't match the strong movement and elegance.
- 3. **MAYFIELD MARCO** (Marilyn Mayfield) Richly marked with strong pigment and good bone, another with lovely eyes and a a bit longer cast.
- 4. **QUAIL RUN PUZZLED** (Linda E. Kornhi) Sweet puppy with a great expression, a bit tentative on the day with time I expect he will be placing higher.

<u>SENIOR PUPPY DOG</u> (2)

- 1. FALLING SPRINGS FIREBIRD AT ASPENGLOW (Peterson/Peterson) Well marked and shown in good coat of correct texture, strong rear movement was not matched in front.
- 2. LA REINA CAN'T GET NO SATISFACTION (Roberts) Nice coat and in good condition, correct bone, a bit larger and topline could improve.

<u>GRADUATE PUPPY DOG</u> (4)

- 1. **CHADWICK EIGHTEEN CARAT GOLD** (Mitchell) Beautiful toy package, compact with nice substance, lovely head with the softest of expressions and large dark rimmed eyes.
- 2. FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDORR (Mixon/Mixon/Cline/Marshall) Sound, honest dog shown in nice richly marked coat.
- 3. CHADWICK WELL TEMPERED CLAVIER AT INTRYNZIK (Goodwin) Pretty boy in great condition with correct outline standing but did not hold together on the move.
- 4. **ROSEGLEN GRAND SLAM** (Lofhon/Colombo) Larger with a less compact shape, happy showman of a more old fashioned type.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (5)

1. **CH ASTARRING ALL THE CATS PAJAMAS** (Flowers Foster) Heavily coated boy with a beautiful head, well-cushioned muzzle and nice eyes, well made with correct shape and strong movement.

- 2. CH MARILEE INDICA FRED (Collins) Nice solid boy, well made with good angles and correct head type.
- 3. CH NIGHTINGALE WIPEOUT, JW, AW (Mulligan) Preferred the compact size of this fellow who had nice breed type, correct shape standing but could not match those above on the move.
- 4. **BELLAROSE CUCCI GU** (Becker) Handsome dog with softly cushioned muzzle giving a lovely expression let down by front on the move.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1. DULCE BACK IN THE SADDLE (Covell) This week constructed boy did not put a foot wrong. Lovely compact size and correct shape, he covered ground with ease driving off his well-angled rear and smooth reach from the front. Though his head was a bit stronger than I prefer there was no denying the quality. *RESERVE WINNERS DOG*
- 2. FORESTCREEK MAN IN BLACK (Tegg/Marshall) Solid bone in a compact size, very pretty try with rich tan and nice coat. *BEST TRI DOG*
- **3. BENTLANE HEAVEN SENT TO QUAIL RUN** (Kornhi) At 8 months this boy lacked maturity and needs time to body up to give a more balanced look.
- 4. LOCKESTAR KING OF THE CASTLE (Younger/Lockleer) Solid mover with moderate head and rich pigment, prefer a softer expression.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1. **COVINGTON NEVER SAY NEVER** (Brock/Gonyo) Classic masculine head, nice construction overall though a bit longer.
- 2. **MARILEE PLAY IT AGAIN** (Collins) Correct shape with a handsome head and good rich color, a solid mover who I thought would be my winner but let down by a high tail carriage.
- 3. **COVINGTON FULL METAL ALCHEMIST** (Christensen/Mayfield) Well-broken coat and nice soft expression, erratic on the move.
- 4. **HERCULES AT HIFLT** (Parris/Parris) Sound construction and solid on the move, honest dog who could be useful in a breeding program.

HEALTH AND CONFORMATION DOG (1)

1. **CAN CH DEL SOL ONE MORE LOOK AT QUAIL RUN** (Kornhi/Wells) 9 year old in great condition, well made and moved like a youngster, handsome head and rich pigment, hats off to his breeder and owners.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (2)

- 1. **NIGHTHAWK'S GREAT EXPECTATIONS** (Dirks/Mitchell) Superbly constructed with good bone and compact shape, this boy excelled on the move, would like top see a more moderate head with softer expression.
- 2. **MINGCHEN YUKON RIVER AT HIGH FLIGHT** (Parris/Parris) Very pretty boy, compact toy package but not strong on the move.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

 O'NEIL DE LA GEODE (Neiser) Lovely shape, compact toy dog with good substance, nice head and deep ruby color, okay mover. <u>BEST RUBY DOG, BEST RUBY IN</u> <u>SHOW</u>

OPEN DOG (3)

- 1. CH KENDALL KASTLE LOVE IS IN THE HEIR (Ogle) Wow this boy had it all, a true toy spaniel with nice substance in a neat compact body of correct shape and proportion. He was shown in excellent richly marked coat and top condition. He moved cleanly around the ring. Top it off with a lovely head with well cushioned muzzle and big dark eyes and he made quite the picture. *RBIS, BOS, BEST BRED BY, BEST* <u>AM BRED</u>
- CH SORELLA GOD OF THUNDER (Castro/Savage Green) Similar to the class winner in size and shape and also fluid on the move. Preferred the softer expression of the winner. <u>AWARD OF MERIT</u>
- 3. CH NIGHTINGALE HEART OF GOLD, AW (WeeksWeeks) Handsome-headed boy was a size bigger and not as strong on the move.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (2)

- FALLING SPRINGS CROWNROSE BLACK VELVET (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) -Sweet expression shown in lovely coat with rich tan markings, nice angles and profile though a bit longer in loin. <u>BEST PUPPY BITCH</u>
- 2. **GYLDEN I'M A BELIEVER** (Ellingson/Ellingson) Another with a pretty head and nice eyes, she was a happy showgirl with nice short hocks and good rear drive but upright in shoulder.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1. **MARILEE SAVANNAH** (Collins) Well-made and petite with a lovely compact body level topline and correct tail set, sound on the move, beautiful eyes, head a bit over done for me.
- 2. **DARANE OTHERWORLDLY** (Kates) Extremely glamorous with a head to die for, lovely coat and correct shape standing, clean coming and going but did not hold topline and profile in side gait.
- 3. NIGHTHAWK'S JINX YOU'RE IT! CGC (Mitchell) Rich chestnut color, nice cobby body with good substance, big dark eyes but lacked soft expression.

4. **ROSEGLEN DIAMOND IN THE SKY** (Colombo) Pretty head and soft expression, nice topline and rear angles, upright in shoulder.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1. **TSAREVICH'S BREEZE IN THE SIERRAS AT GOLD COUNTRY** (Neiser) Sweet tri with correct head and sweet expression, lovely coat with big white collar, needs ring practice and confidence.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (4)

- 1. **FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY** (Grimm Curley) Lovely head with nicely arched neck transitioning to well laidback shoulders, nice shape but did not hole together on the move.
- 2. **IVYLINE IMA DOLL** (Giampapa) Very nice shape with richly marked coat, sound mover but carried tail a bit too high, another with lovely big eyes whose head was a bit extreme for me.
- 3. CH CEMPA CEDAR CREEK SILVER LINING (Owens/Creary) Pretty moderate head with lovely eyes and expression, topline not level on the move.
- 4. **CROSSBOW WHITNEY FLIRTING WITH LIFE** (Schiffman) Pretty head in the classic style, nice coat and correct breed type, didn't seem to be enjoying her time fun the ring.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

- 1. **DREAMVALE AMERICAN DYNASTY AT CROWNROSE** (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) Nice bitch of correct size and shape who looked balanced standing and on the move, with maturity she should have a bright future. *AWARD OF MERIT*
- 2. **BEARIVER ROCKIN THE PARADISE** (Toepfer) Solid bitch well-made and a sound mover, big dark eyes, head a bit strong.
- 3. **DEL SOL BREAKFAST IN BED** (McHenry) Petite girl, nice overall shape, needs maturity to body up.
