Heads were variable, a few too long in the muzzle and some lacking cushioning under the eyes. I had a few very good dogs in the younger classes that had wrong mouths, which hopefully in time will go right.

# **Junior Puppy Dog (3)**

**1. Brookhaven Kid Rock** (Ayers/Martz) A very smart 5 month old blen, a lovely head, large dark eyes, good front, neck and topline, well made quarters, moved and showed well for one so young. **2. Cruisin Mr Ted E Bear** (Rackler) 8 month old ruby, good head, dark eyes and soft expression, good pigment, well made body with level topline, good coat, moved OK, very happy. **3. Starmarc Sugar Bear** (Hooper) 7 months blen, well marked, dark eyes, pleasing expression, too long in body, movement needs to tighten up.

# Senior Puppy Dog (5)

- **1. Elyzian Double Take** (Arnold) Black & Tan with lovely black glossy coat, rich tan markings, pleasing head, dark eyes, good outline, level back, nicely balanced, moved really well with drive. *Best Puppy Dog*
- 2. Bentwood Reason To Believe (Barton/Harrison) Blen of good type, good head shape, dark eyes, soft expression, short coupled, level topline, well balanced, moved OK but carrying his tail a bit high today. 3. Chadwick Midnight Sun at Hudsonview (Yassky/Glynn) Nicely marked tri in good coat with bright tan markings, good head, well made body, good bone, good tail carriage, movement needs to tighten. 4. Hiddencreek Hugo Boss, JW (Green) Heavily marked blen, pleasing head, nice eyes, well made body, good angulation, lacked sparkle today.

## **Graduate Puppy Dog (7)**

1. Turretbank Magic Spell (Green/Sloan) B/T. Lovely coat, rich tan, masculine head, lovely eyes and expression, good front and neck, well constructed throughout, correct tail carriage, moved well. 2. Dreamvale Tri Your Luck (Parker) Well marked tri with good tan, nice outline, level topline, good angulation front and rear, good head and eyes, well balanced, moved well. 3. Jayba Easy Does It, JW (Lander) Blen, good colour, pleasing head and expression, level topline, good hindquarters, a little loose in front, should tighten up with exercise. 4. Cavilera Perfect Storm (Gentil) Blen, good head, dark eyes and good pigment, well constructed, needs a bit more body and movement needs to tighten, both should come in time, very promising.

## Novice Dog (3)

1. Clarmarian Covertly Wicked (Gogol/Young-May) Blen, rich tan, nice size and shape, short level back, good angulation front and rear, masculine head and nice eyes, good bone, moved out well round the ring. 2. Brookhaven Enchanted Dreamer (Brown) Well broken blen, lovely head, eyes and pigment, short level back and good angulation, moved well when he concentrated on his handler. 3. Numen Bryan (Sage) Ruby, lovely colour, good head, dark eyes and good pigment, a little long in back and larger than desirable, very happy.

# **Bred By Exhibitor Dog (4)**

1. Ch Veribas Point Break (Cusick) Tri, nicely marked, rich tan, lovely head with gentle expression, very good all over construction, short level back and lovely tail carriage, moved and showed well. *Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog* 2. Brookhaven Believe It Or Not (Ayers/Martz) Well marked blenheim, nice size, pleasing head and expression, well made body with good angulation, well muscled hindquarters, moved well. 3. Canyoncrest Pleasingly Pumpkin (DuRoss) Very sweet blen, mice outline, good head and eyes but nose a bit off today, needs more muscle, movement needs to tighten. 4. Almeara Kiss The Girls (Whitmire) Well marked blen, masculine head, good front, too long in the back for me, moved OK.

- 2. Chewcreek Three Amigos Dusty Bottoms, JW (DePhillip) Nicely marked blen, carrying his tail too high today but a nice dog, good head and front, stood all four square, moved OK. 3. Dreamvale Olivander (Sage/Hallsted) Well broken blen showing well, very sound but larger than I like.

### American Bred Dog (4)

1. Kinglys Clint Black of Bekenhall (Hall/Herrington) Blen, lovely coat, well balanced, pleasing head, soft expression, short level back, well angulated front and rear, moved and showed well. 2. Clarmarian Classic By Design (Young-May) Another well marked blen, nice size and shape, good front and neck, back a little longer than #1, very happy, moved well. 3. Quail Garden Tad O Magic (Barrett) Lightly marked blen with lovely coat and long ears, a nice dog but too large for me, moved well. 4. Sikeleli I Wanna Be A Rock Star (Nel) Nicely marked tri, well made, good head shape, eyes dark but a bit small and also showed some white which tends to give a hard expression, very happy.
