**1. Darane Frodo Baggins** (Kates) Blenheim. Good pigment, large round eye with correct set, nice cushioning, good topline with correct croup. *Best Puppy Dog* 

 Denham Superstorm (Maddox) Ruby. Good expression, excellent condition, good ear set, on the day would have preferred a better topline. 3. Autumnhill Lone Ranger (Parente) Blenheim, good markings, large round eye.
Jamanda Rolex Cosmograph (Weinstein) Not making the most of its self today, a bit unsure in the ring. Had a good croup and correct tail set.

### Graduate Puppy Dog (4)

**1. Dreamvale Tri Your Luck** (Parker) Tri, good outline, good coat, well developed nostrils, lovely expression, sound going and coming. **2. Elyzian Double Take** (Arnold) Black and Tan, excellent markings, good tail set and carriage, good ear set, a bit loose in front (still a puppy), nice round eye. **3. Hiddencreek Hugo Boss, JW** (Green) Blenheim, good markings, lovely blaze, good expression, made the most of himself. **4. Lynsfaire Enchanted Evening** (Fairchild) Black and Tan, not making the most of himself, has a good round eye, nice ear set, neck set smoothly into shoulder.

#### Novice Dog (2)

1. Krystle Lil Big Man (Torgersen) Blenheim puppy, sweet, gentle expression, dark round eye, good markings, correct ear placement, carried itself well. 2. Oggbrae Don Giovanni (Bales) Not making the most of himself today, very unsure.

#### **Bred By Exhibitor Dog (6)**

1. Ch Piccadil Peppermint Twist (York) Excellent outline, correct proportions, large round dark eye, soft and sweet expression, nice cushioning, strong muzzle. Good coat, level topline with correct tail set. Masculine, carried himself well. Went on to Winners Dog. *Winners Dog, Reserve Best in Show, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Blenheim Dog, Best American Bred Dog, Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog* 

**2. Chewcreek Three Amigos Dusty Bottoms, JW** (DePhillip) Excellent expression, with good ear set and strong muzzle, nice silky coat with the correct body proportions. **3. Clarmarian Classic By Design** (Young-May) Made the most of himself, nice round eye with good cushioning under the eye, soft expression, neck set correctly into shoulder. **4. Circlecity Walk In The Park** (Matters) Nice outline, good head and expression, would prefer a better tail set and carriage.

## American Bred Dog (7)

**1. Pinecrest White Lightning, JW** (Eubank) Blenheim. Excellent condition, good outline, soft expression with round eye and correct cushioning, level topline, neck long fitting into shoulders smoothly. Good tail set carried correctly. Excellent coat and condition. Went on to *Reserve Winners Dog*.

**2. Oggbrae Don Ottavio** (Bales) Very difficult decision between this dog and the 1st place. Excellent head with soft expression, good topline, lovely coat, good outline. **3. Brookhanven Enchanted Dreamer** (Brown) Very happy today, good expression, good tail set, correct body proportions. **4. Krystle Coleman** (Torgersen) Good expression with dark eye, nice outline.

Health & Conformation Dog (1) I think this is an excellent class to offer. I wish more had participated. 1. Avia Sgt. Pepper (Marler) Blenheim, nicely marked, soft, sweet expression, good outline, moved well coming and going with a good tail carriage.

## **Special Limit Blenheim Dog (8)**

1. Clarmarian Covertly Wicked (Gogol/Young May) Good soft expression with correct round dark eye, good ear placement, nice outline, carried himself well with correct tail placement and carriage. 2. Jayba Easy Does It, JW (Lander) Nice round dark eye, would have like a slight more width to the muzzle, good coat, level topline when moving. 3. Almeara Kiss The Girls (Whitmire) Good outline, pleasing head and expression, moved well. 4. Miletree Carnival at Shirmont, JW (Henry) Pleasing head and expression, good proportions.

## **Special Limit Tricolor Dog** (1)

**1. Veribas Point Remembered** (Cusick) Nice outline, good cushioning under eye, correct ear set with long ears, carried itself well.

### Special Limit Ruby Dog (3)

**1. Sevenwoods Wildberry** (Shidler) Correct balance, good outline, very soft expression, with beautiful round eye, good ear placement. Excellent tail placement and carriage. *Best Ruby in Show* **2. AutumnHill Spencer, JW** (Weinstein/Parente) Good head and soft expression, nice outline, carried itself well. Correct tail set, the tail never stopped wagging. **3. Jalesto Super Trooper of Sumara** (Gentil) Good head and expression, with nice cushioning, good coat texture. On the day moving very close in rear.

### Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (4)

1. Turretbank Magic Spell (Green/Sloan) Excellent head with dark eye and soft expression, correct outline, moved soundly and made the most of himself, good coat texture, silky. *Best Black & Tan Dog 2.* Infinidad Grandville Te Amo (Laliberte) Very difficult decision between this dog and the first place. Good head and expression, correct outline, carried itself well, good coat. On the day 1st place had a softer expression. **3.** Roseriver Mohito (Cusick) Nice head and expression, good outline. **4.** Brookhaven Bob Bailey (Schilling) Nice head and expression, on the day not moving well.

Forestcreek Prince William (Koehring) Good outline, excellent coat, nice expression

**1. Margann Archibald Leach** (Boos/Susnis) 14 years old, covered ground like a youngster, good head and expression, in good condition, level topline. **2. Sevenwoods Highfield Dune** (Shidler) Much younger, good head with nice round eye and expression, soft silky coat, carried itself well.

1. Shirmont Delightful Caper (Henry/Rosenberg) Excellent outline, sweet and soft expression, melts you when you look. Beautiful markings, Carries herself well will be curious to see how she grows up. 2. Linrica Femme Fatale (Liu) Very similar to first place bitch, excellent outline, good tail set with correct croup. 3. Denham Over The Moon (Maddox) Black and Tan, good expression with dark round eye. Good tail set and outline. 4. Promontory So Fine (Solomon) Well balanced, good expression, neck into shoulders very well. Senior Puppy Bitch (3)

**1. Pincrest Flamin Gogh** (Eubank) Blenheim, super outline, neck fitting into sloping shoulder, body of correct proportions, melting expression with dark round eye, moved with level topline and correct tail set. *Best Puppy Bitch, Best Puppy in Show* 

**2. Roseriver Fanfare** (Young) Ruby, good expression, dark eye, carried herself well, would like a slightly shorter loin. **3. Autumnhill California Dreamin** (Parente) Good outline, with nice expression and good coat.

#### Graduate Puppy Bitch (3)

**1. Piccadil Destined To Be Rich, JW** (York) Excellent outline, soft, warm expression, correct muzzle, moves well with a good tail set. *Reserve Winners Bitch* 

**2. Midaywin Dances Into A New Beginning** (Fitzgerald/Cusick) Black and Tan, good expression, correct coat. **3. Linrica Apple Of My Eye** (Liu) Blenheim being very much a puppy today, nice eye with dark color and correct placement.

### Novice Bitch (2)

**1. Krystla Queen of Denial** (Torgersen) Tri, 7 month old puppy. Good expression, good markings and a super attitude. **2. Anara Frivolity** (Neumeier) Ruby. Lovely expression with a dark round eye.

## **Bred by Exhibitor Bitch (2)**

**1. Pincecrest Destiny's Child, JW** (Eubank) Blenheim. Excellent head with dark round eye, good muzzle and lovely cushioning. Good outline with correct body type. Good markings and color, excellent movement with correct tail carriage. *Winners Bitch, Best in Show, Best Blenheim in Show, Best American Bred in Show, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show* 

**2. Linrica Alice In Wonderland** (Liu) Not quite sure of herself in the ring, but a good ear placement and neck flows into sloping shoulders.

## Junior American Bred Bitch (1)

**1. Sheeba Royal Expression at Foxcreek** (Johnson) Blenheim, very typey bitch, good coat, nice expression. **American Bred Bitch (6)** 

**1. Piccadil Gone With the Wind** (York) Good example of breed type, correct coat, pleasing head with excellent expression, correct croup and tail set. **2. Linrica Sugar Baby** (Hsiung/Liu) Body proportions are very good, soft expression with nice dark round eye. Good coat, good tail set. **3. BackNTime Red Roses On Velvet** (Niemi) Ruby, Good eye and ear placement, which added to the expression. Good croup. *Best Ruby Bitch* **4. Markley Frostbite** (Storey) Blenheim, balanced, good tail set, puppy.

**1. Liane's Xaviera, JW** (Poti) Mature, good coat and condition, round dark eye with correct placement, soft expression, very typey. **2. Darane My Darling Clementine at Chewcreek** (DePhillip) Excellent coat and condition, good tail carriage and pleasing expression

Ch Jayba Tres Jolie, JW (Lander) Hard decision between first and second. Excellent outline, warm expression, large round eyes, correct tail set and carriage. Would like a very slight more cushioning. 3. Ch Pinecrest Shirmont Moonlight Madness, JW (Henry)

Very typey bitch, warm expression and very large expressive eyes, excellent condition. **4. Feandor Felicity Comet** (Hill) Nice expression, carried itself well.
