Junior Puppy Dog (2)

1. Denham Superstorm (Maddox) Ruby. Correct size, lovely eyes, and good color. Moved well around the ring. 2. Del Sol One More Night (McHenry) Blenheim. Another nice puppy with great eyes, a little out of control this morning should do well.

Senior Puppy Dog (3)

- **1. Brookhaven Kid Rock At Almeara** (Whitmire/Ayers/Martz) Blenheim. Beautiful marked, lovely coat, nice size. Correct coming and going. *Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show*

- 2. Bentwood Reason To Believe (Barton/Harrison) Blenheim. Another handsome Blenheim in fabulous coat. Nice masculine head, good expression, moved well. 3. Hiddencreek Hugo Boss, JW (Green) Blenheim. A heavily marked Blenheim, a striking dog, similar movement to 1& 2. Well balanced, correct coming and going, beautiful head and expression, Shown in beautiful coat. Loved love this dog, but felt he seems rushed in the ring today. 4. Rhoyal Macy Junior At Lyncrest (Jones) Black & Tan. Nice shiny coat in good condition. Sweet expression moved well.

Novice Dog (1)

- **2. Glencross Cailin At Shirmont** (Henry) Pretty, nicely marked Tri with a sweet expression. Well ribbed short body. Good rear angulations and turn of stifle. Moved around the ring with style. **2. Palanterlof Old Fashioned Love** (Tyler/Kutsch) 5 month old Blenheim girl, nicely marked, with a sweet expression. Good outline, moved well.

4. Delsol This Love (McHenry/Meyer) Another cute Blenheim, rich dark color, great eyes. Has a nice shape and the right size, was a happy exhibitor.

Senior Puppy Bitch (2)

1. Blackfire I Approved This Message (Weidig/Kennedy) Nicely broken Blenheim with a sweet face, large dark eyes. Short body with nice reach of neck. She showed in excellent condition. **2.** Shirmont Delightful Caper (Henry/Rosenberg) Another smart Blenheim with large dark eyes. A little longer in body, good going around the ring. Nice rich dark color. Needs time to mature.

Graduate Puppy Bitch (3)

1. Legacy Sumpin To Talk About (Lindemaier) Compact Blenheim in lovely coat. Super head with big dark eyes. Nice on the move keeping a level top line. Very happy today. 2. Belcarra Goodtime Carly At Ivyline (Giampapa/Lawson) Another nice Blenheim, sweet head with nice dark eyes. Movement was good with a nice top line. 3. Dulce Salt Water Taffy (Covell) Blenheim in good condition, handy size, nice, again a very pretty face with lovely eyes. Movement was on today.

Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (3)

1. Caddo P C (Henry/Dodson) Very feminine Blenheim girl. Lovely eyes and nice head. Her shape was great, with the right amount of bone. She held a nice top line around the ring. *Best Bred By Exhibitor Bitch* 2. Astarring Ought To Be A Lawra (Flowers Foster) A young girl holding her own in this class with a nice shape and size. She has great eyes with a very soft expression. On the move she looks good, level top line, good shoulders, and a nice turn of stifle. Considered givng her the class but I think she needs more time to mature. 3. Covington Morgana (Mohn) One more with the same qualities as 1 & 2. She has great eyes, good coat. She has a very good top line and she also moved very well.

Junior American Bred Bitch (2)

1. Orchardhill Social Secretary (Slusher/Venier) A very pretty 14 month old Blenheim, she has a lovely head and super eyes, her coloring is beautiful and the coat is in great condition. She had a great command of the ring, I liked her very elegant appearance. Her tail set was correct and she had a nice level top line. 2. Little Enjoy (Tyler) Nicely broken, short coupled Blenheim. Pretty head with large dark eyes, moved well coming and going.

American Bred Bitch (5) Super class.

She is a fuller body girl but oh so correct. Great top line and tail set, so sound coming and going. Sweet expression, large dark eyes, good pigment, always a plus on a whole color. Her movement was sound, nice angulations with a nice neck and shoulders, good rear with correct stifles and hocks. She enjoys the ring. Best Ruby Bitch 3. Pinecrest Mountain Dew (Rosenberg) Nicely broken Blenheim with a feminine head and large dark eyes. Good profile when moving and holding her top line. Well made stylish bitch. 4. Beckwith Only One For Me (Smith) A heavily marked Blenheim with a gorgeous head in fabulous coat. Her movement was just right, she moved with drive holding a level top line, good tail carriage. She looked splendid.

Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (4)

1. Orchardhill Ever After (Venier) Another outstanding Blenheim from this kennel. The style is the same, the eyes, the coat, the movement, the attitude. She is a nice size and shape, good pigment. Nice smooth movement, good top line I believe a tad shorter coupled than her Jr. American Bitch. Same Dam different Sire. 2. Covington Sassy Pants (Mohn/Smith) Heavily marked Blenheim. Lovely head, framed by beautiful ears. Very pretty well made her size was just right. Moving around the ring with a lot of panache she struck a nice picture. 3.
