I would like to take the opportunity to thank the board of The Cavaliers Of The Northeast and to all the exhibitors for the lovely entry. Overall I found the quality to be very strong, especially in the bitches and this bodes well for the future of the breed .

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1. **BROOKHAVEN MR TAMBOURINE MAN** (Ayers/Martz)
Quality Blenheim of a beautiful type. Nicely proportioned head for age. Large round dark eyes, black pigment, good teeth and correct ear set. Lovely make and shape with a short cobby body. He moved well coming and going.
Delighted to award him **BEST PUPPY DOG**.
2. **BROOKHAVEN FOREVER YOUNG** (Ayers/Martz)
Litter brother to one. Similar in type to winner with large dark soft expressive eyes. Correct scissor bite and good nose pigment. Well placed shoulders , good topline and spring of rib for age. Just not moving as positive as one.
3. **AUTUMNHILL WILD CHILD** (Parente)
5 month old Blenheim who is nicely marked. Classic head with dark eyes and pigment pigment. Short coupled , balanced in outline and moved ok. Just not the maturity of one and two.
4. **NIGHTINGALE SUGAR DADDY** (Mulligen)
Well marked Blenheim of a pleasing type. Large dark expressive eyes , super pigment and well feathered ears. Liked his body and substance.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

1. **ISLEPOSEA WALK ON FERRY** (Hoehn)
Richly coloured Blenheim who is well made. Moderate neck into well angulated shoulders and a good spring of rib. Level topline and a good turn of stifle, he moved well coming and going with drive from the rear. Head containing large eyes, good pigmentation and correct muzzle.
2. **ORCHARDHILL NEWS TO ME** (Venier/Venier)
Appealing Blenheim with a good outline and everything in moderation. Big round eyes, correct dentition and pigment. Moved well, just not the drive of one. Presented well with coat of correct silky texture.
3. **BENTWOOD LIVELYOAK BLACK TIE AFFAIR** (Borton/Harrison)
Small Tricolour male with moderate bone, smart outline, but lacks the substance. Nicely presented with coat of correct texture. Moved ok, although I would prefer a bit more reach in front.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)

1. **BROOKHAVEN IM A BELIEVER, JW** (Martz/Ayers)
Well coated and marked Blenheim. Pleasing head , almost flat skull, well set and feathered ears. Large round dark eyes topped off with good nose pigment. Nice to go over with everything in moderation fitting nicely together.
2. **TRULUV SWAGGER** (Nikaci)
Quality Blenheim whom I liked a lot. Pretty head with good proportions. Large dark eyes with a soft expression. Pleasing in outline with good angulation front and rear. He is well broken with moderate bone. Just wasn't moving as positively in the rear as the winner.

NOVICE DOG (1)

1. **HUNTLAND HONOUR** (Land/Land)
Typy blenheim with pretty big round dark eyes. Full headed and plush in muzzle with good teeth and pigment. Decent angles and short backed with a wealth of coat which was soft and silky and well presented.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (5)

1. **CH TUDOR RHYTHM N BLUES, JW** (Mixon)
Heavier marked Blenheim with rich chestnut coat. Pretty in head with large dark and soft expressive eyes, correct pigment and bite. Pleasing neck and shoulders into a firm spirit level topline which he kept at all times, topped off with a level tail that came straight off his back. Lovely make and shape and a sound mover. **[BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG](#)**
2. **CH KEAN ON THIS, JW** (Kean)
Beautiful Blenheim who was put down in excellent condition. Masculine, but pretty head with good broad skull and well set ears which framed his face. Large dark eyes which were round and soft. Plenty of fill and cushioning to muzzle. He is of good construction and as such moves well. He has ample bone and is in good coat. Unfortunately not as happy as one.
3. **CHADWICK TELLTALE AUTHOR, JW** (Eckersley)
Typy Blenheim with large dark expressive eyes. Generous in head with good pigment, moderate bone and decent shoulders. He is well angulated in rear and was put down in good condition and moved well.
4. **RANLYN DIAMONDS ARE FOREVER** (Bragg)
Blenheim male of overall good type and with large dark soft eyes. He is a little taller on the leg to the first three and rounds off a little at the croup, however he moved well.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (7)

1. **ALMEARA I BELIEVE, JW** (Parente)
Blenheim of a nice make and shape. Arched neck into well laid shoulders. Good spring of ribs, level topline and well angulated rear and a correct tail set. Moves with drive and good reach in front. His coat is of a rich colour and silky to the touch. A good honest dog.

2. **TRULUV PRINCE CHARMING** (Nikaci)
Blenheim of a nice breed type. Large round dark eyes , almost flat skull with good earset and thickly feathered ears. Well balanced and pleasing to go over. Moved well coming and going.
3. **ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE** (Cameron)
Heavier marked Blenheim of the most exquisite breed type. Head of good proportions. Large dark round eyes giving the softest of expressions. No exaggeration in head at all. He has a moderate neck, good topline and rear angulation, but was not as positive in rear action as first two.
4. **DREAMVALE DEVIL WITHOUT A CAUSE** (Perini/Sage)
Good type Blenheim who was well marked and of a good make and shape. Nice eyes with pleasing expression, just not the substance of the first three.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (2)

1. **BRAEMARRA RUBEN OF SAMARA** (Gentil)
Richly marked Blenheim in good coat of correct texture. Pleasing head, eyes and pigment. Good width to skull and well placed ears. Moderate neck and shoulders into a firm topline. Well sprung ribs and good turn of stifle.
2. **KRYSTLE LATITUDE ALTITUDE** (Torgersen/Torgersen)
Well marked Blenheim, although not as rich in colour to the winner. Classic head with large dark eyes and well set ears which were well feathered .

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR DOG (5)

1. **CHADWICK CODE BLACK** (McCarty/Eckersley)
Masculine male with generous head and large round dark eyes, black nose pigment and correct scissor bite. Moderate bone and pleasing outline, moved well.
BEST TRICOLOUR DOG
2. **JUST DRESSED TO IMPRESS OF GILLBROOK** (Venier/Venier)
Well marked male who just lacked the maturity and coat finish. Pleasing head with large eyes, correct pigment and dentition. Nice neck into moderate shoulders. Good topline and well set tail was pleasing on the move and in profile .
3. **STELLAR ROMANCING THE STONE AT TYCWN** (Knauss/Rose)
Nicely headed tri. Attractive large round dark eyes , good pigment and bite. Long feathered ears which frame his face. Short coupled and moved ok .
4. **ONE MORE TIME VOM KANINCHENGARTEN** (James/Stahl)
Plainer headed Male with rich tan marking and good pigment and bite. Moderate neck and shoulders with a level topline. Longer cast than I like, but moved ok.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1. **TOMNEE'S GOLDEN SKY** (Meager/Wise)
Quality male of good breed type. Large round dark expressive eyes with that true cavalier expression. Black nose pigment and correct bite. Nice width to skull, well set and feathered

ears. Moderate neck shoulders and bone. Good angulation in front and rear and well balanced, which showed in his movement.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN DOG (2)

1. **DARANE HAPPY SONG** (Markijohn/Kates)
Male of a nice breed type. Long silky raven black coat with rich tan markings. Large round dark eyes, black nose pigment and correct scissor bite. Pleasing neck and shoulders and well angulated rear, moved well.

2. **LYNSFAIRE CELTIC CHARM** (Fairchild)
Pleasing male with attractive head. Large round eyes, correct bite and moderate neck and shoulders.
Good topline, just not the coat finish or the rear movement of the winner .

OPEN DOG (6)

1. **CH CHADWICK JET SETTER AT HUDSONVIEW J.W** (Glynn/Glynn)
Beautiful and masculine headed Blenheim with large round dark eyes with an enchanting expression. Nice ear fringes framing a well balanced face. I loved his overall make, shape, balance and soundness on the move. He caught my eye as he entered the ring and he didn't disappoint me in anyway on inspection. Delighted to award him

2. **ENG CH HARANA ERROL BROWN** (Ayers/Martz)
Masculine but pretty headed ruby with large round dark eyes, good pigment and correct bite. His coat is of the richest of reds, which was presented in excellent condition. Elegant neck, great shoulder placement topped off with a short coupled back, he moved accurately.

3. **CH FOXWYN COOL WATER** (Norton/Baker-Fox)
Another pretty male of good type. Large round dark eyes, which were very expressive. Well feathered ears which really framed his face. Ample neck into moderate shoulders, level topline with correct tailset and carriage. Moved well.
4. **CH DREAMVALE FOLLOW ALL MY MOVES** (Perini/Sage)
Blenheim of a good type with large dark eyes. Good nose pigmentation and correct bite, although I would prefer a softer lip line. Nicely marked coat of good quality.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

1. **KARVALE BROOKHAVEN FINN** (Utych)
Well-marked Blenheim. Pretty head with large round dark expressive eyes, which were soft. Good pigmentation and correct scissor bite. Pleasing width to skull and well set and feathered ears. Nicely made with everything where it should be. He has drive, good reach and motored around the ring.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

1. **LINRICA REACH FOR THE STARS** (Liu)
Ultra feminine Blenheim with lovely head properties, topped with large round dark eyes, good pigment and bite. Rich chestnut colouring on a short neat body. Moved well, she's a quality well balanced exhibit.
2. **TUDOROSE SONG OF ICE AND FIRE** (Mixon)
Thought this girl would be my class winner when she entered the ring, unfortunately the heat got the better of her and she started to flag at the end. Pretty bitch of lovely breed type. Soft expressive eyes. Generous neck into well placed shoulders and moderate bone. Good depth to chest for her age. Firm topline and well angulated quarters. Quality coat which was gleaming. One with a bright future ahead of her .
3. **RUTHERFORD EVELINE** (Jones)
Another quality bitch of pleasing breed type. Large round soft expressive eyes and correct stop. Nice width to skull and well set ears that frame her face. Well marked and neat in outline. She has moderate bone, just needs to firm in topline .
4. **CHADWICK TRAVEL BUG** (Eckersley)
Very much the baby in this class, but so sassy. Prettiest of heads with lovely soft expressive eyes and good pigmentation. She strutted round the ring like she owned it, doing everything her handler asked of her and never stopped showing.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

1. **ORCHARDHILL GOTTA ADORE ME** (Venier/Venier)
Classic headed Blenheim with large eyes which were soft and gentle in expression. Correct nose pigmentation and bite. Good width to skull and well set feathered ears. She is lovely to go over with everything fitting together correctly. She glides around the ring with drive from behind and plenty of reach in front covering plenty of ground, and this was topped off with good head carriage and topline and stylish outline.
Delighted to award her **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW and BEST PUPPY BITCH.**
2. **CHADWICK SAY YES TO THE DRESS** (Eckersley)
Quality well marked Blenheim of a good overall breed type. Moderate bone and neck. Shoulders are of a good lay into a firm level topline. Beautifully presented as were all dogs from this kennel.
3. **CHADWICK RIOTOUS** (Eckersley)
Tricolour who was nice to go over. Neat Cobby body. Moderate bone, neck and shoulders. Good spring of rib and moved positively. Slightly different in head type to second in this class, but never the less a pleasing exhibit.
4. **ANGELS PRIDE MISS MAGIC AT MARJORELLE** (Conley)
Well marked Blenheim who was a little plainer in head to the previous three. Moderate neck into pleasing shoulders. Good spring of rib and firm topline.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (5)

1. **BONITOS COMPANEROS XAVERIA, JW** (Lasser)
Feminine Blenheim of a very nice breed type complemented with large dark eyes. Pleasing pigment and bite. Well set and feathered ears which framed her face. Short coupled body. Make and shape was ok, but would prefer a more positive rear.
2. **BROOKHAVEN I BELIEVE** (Ayers/Martz)
Small neat compact ruby of a nice type. Large dark soft expressive eyes, correct pigment and bite. Good bone and depth to chest on a neat package.
3. **CHADWICK WISH UPON A STAR** (Eckersley)
Tricolour of good breed type with good pigment. Pleasant eyes and tapered muzzle. Well marked with ample neck into a level topline. Very smart outline.

4. **INGOLD LADY BIRD** (Pickett)
Classic headed Blenheim who, for me, just lacked a little fill under the eyes. Large dark eyes, correct pigment and bite. Pleasing to go over with a good front, but could be stronger in the rear.

NOVICE BITCH (3)

1. **NIGHTINGALE MAKIN WAVES** (Mulligan)
Rich coloured nicely marked Blenheim with large round and soft expressive eyes. Correct pigment, ear set, and nice width to skull. Moderate neck, shoulders and bone. Moved well.
2. **BRYREWOOD YOU SEND ME** (Torgersen/Baldwin)
Tricolour who is very much the baby still and lacks the maturity of the winner. Just five months of age. Strikingly marked with a pleasing neck and firm topline. Moved well from rear but would prefer more reach in front.
3. **NIGHTINGALE COPACABANA** (Mulligan/Duke)
Richly coloured Blenheim with a good topline who was well presented. Just not me in type or movement .

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (4)

1. **CH FORESTCREEK FANTASY GIRL, JW** (Cline/Cline/Cline)
Quality Blenheim with a glamorous long straight silky coat which was presented to perfection. Nice arched neck into well placed shoulders and well sprung ribs. Good rear angulation, tailset and carriage. Super on the move with plenty of reach front and rear with proud head carriage, level topline and tail topped off with dark round eyes with a sweetly softening outlook.
Delighted to award her **[RESERVE WINNERS BITCH and RESERVE BEST IN SHOW](#)**.
2. **LINRICA ROSE PETALS** (Liu)
Heavier marked Blenheim with long well feathered ears, large dark round eyes with super expression. Correct pigment and bite. Good angulation front and rear and, as such, moved soundly with good head carriage and firm topline. Just not the coat of the winner.

3. **PARLETT PINKY PROMISE, JW** (Williams/Williams)
Well marked Blenheim with a short cobby body who was presented in lovely condition. Jet black pigmentation and pleasing eyes with soft expression, well placed and feathered ears, feminine and unexaggerated. Moved well from rear.
4. **REGIS CAMERON MADE YOU LOOK IVY** (Cameron)
Blenheim with well feathered and set ears, large dark eyes and pigment. I would prefer more fill under the eyes. She has a moderate neck, although her lay of shoulder could be a little better and this showed in her movement.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (2)

1. **CHADWICK IN MY OPINION** (Eckersley)
Well marked Blenheim of good breed type. Pleasing head, eyes, pigment and correct bite. Neat outline with good neck, shoulders and moderate bone. Short coupled and moved well.
2. **KRYSTLE LILY OF THE VALLEY** (Torgersen/Monroe)
Tricolour of just 5 months of age and as such lacks the maturity to the winner. Moderate head with well tapered muzzle. Rich tan which was in all the right places. Needs to drop into herself.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (5)

1. **CHADWICK OH LA LA OF CHARDOMANT, JW** (Greak/Comer/Eckersley)
Blenheim of a nice breed type with well set feathered ears framing her face, complemented by large dark eyes, correct pigment and bite. Pleasing outline with moderate neck, shoulders and bone. Well sprung ribs and level topline. Straight and well set down hocks, moved well.
2. **LINRICA MIGNON MOCHI, JW** (Liu)
Another quality Blenheim from this exhibitor and they certainly breed a type. Richly coloured, heavier marked and smartly presented. Long well feathered ears. Dark eyes and pigmentation and correct bite. Well angulated front and rear, moved well.
3. **BROOKHAVEN TEMPTATION** (Ayers/Martz)
Well marked Blenheim of a nice breed type with a pleasing head. Moderate bone and nice in outline. Just not the drive in rear as the first two.
4. **FOXWYN CHARMED I'M SURE** (Baker-Fox/Norton)
Well broken Blenheim with Lozenge. Nice head with good width to skull and well set and feathered ears. Moderate neck, shoulders and bone, with well sprung ribs and a level topline.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM (4)

1. **FORESTCREEK FLORENCE** (Cline)
Stronger headed Blenheim of an overall good type. Large dark expressive eyes. Long well feathered ears. Dense nose pigment. Appealing outline with moderate neck, bone and well angulated all round. Good strong rear with plenty of drive, which won her this class with ease.
2. **BONITOS COMPANEROS JOSEPHINE OF WELMFORTH** (Lasser)
Well marked Blenheim. Large dark eyes which were round. Good pigment and bite and well set and placed ears. Moderate neck and shoulders and bone. Just not the drive in rear or outline of the winner.

3. **KRYSTLE STAR QUALITY** (Torgersen)
Blenheim who was deeper in stop to the previous two, but with large round dark eyes and good pigment. Moderate neck, although I would prefer a better lay of shoulder. Level topline and good tail carriage.
4. **CAMERONA PAISLEY PARK IVY** (Cameron)
Nicely marked Blenheim of a pleasing breed type. Moderate neck, but like the third in this class would prefer a better lay of shoulder and more angulation in rear.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY (2)

1. **BROOKHAVEN PUMPKIN PIE** (Ayers/Martz)
Small neat compact girl. Charming outline with pleasing angles front and rear. Moderate neck and bone and well placed shoulders. Large round eyes, good pigment and rich ruby colour. She moved well coming and going, holding a level back and she correctly carried her tail. Delighted to award her **BEST RUBY BITCH and BEST RUBY IN SHOW.**
2. **AVIA CORAL** (Poti/Poti)
Another nice girl with large eyes which could be softer in expression. Black nose pigment and correct bite and stop. Long, well set and feathered ears. Moderate neck, level topline and well angulated rear. Coat of rich red and put down in good condition.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN (1)

1. **HUNTLEIGH PEEK-A-BOO AT HOLLYTREE** (Seymour/Palmer)
Charming girl with pretty head and large round dark expressive eyes. Correct pigment and bite. Attractive outline with a moderate neck, bone and shoulders. Well angulated rear and a level topline. Moved with drive and reach.

OPEN BITCH (3)

1. **CH CHADWICK SENTIMENTAL JOURNEY** (Eckersley)
This girl had everything I was looking for. Breed type, shape, make, soundness and depth of quality. Did I like her? No, I **loved** her. Exquisite head with large round dark lustrous eyes with an endearing expression. Correct stop, dense pigment and correct scissor bite. Ultra feminine with long well feathered and set ears which framed her face. Generous neck into well laid shoulders and firm topline with good tail set and carriage. Well angulated with precise movement in front and rear. Complemented with an ideal temperament and coat of good texture. Delighted to award her **WINNERS BITCH, BEST IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH, and BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH.**
2. **CH CHADWICK DRAMA** (Hoehn/Eckersley)
Attractive Blenheim of delightful breed type. Large dark round soulful eyes. Long well feathered ears. Dense pigment and correct scissor bite. Pleasing outline when viewed from across the ring. Nice neck into well angulated shoulders. Good topline and turn of stifles, she moved soundly.

3. **LINRICA KISSED BY AN ANGEL** (Liu)

Another attractive Blenheim of good breed type. Amazing long well feathered ears which frame a pretty face with large soft expressive round eyes. Good pigment and bite. Pleasing outline and nicely constructed throughout she moved well in all directions.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

1. **CH CHESHAM A MINUTE OF YOUR TIME** (Taub/Eckersley)

I can see why this girl is every bit the champion even at the age she is now. Pretty feminine head with large dark round eyes giving the most gentle of expressions, topped off with well set and feathered ears. Well constructed throughout and this shows in her precise movement. She is a quality exhibit.

VETERAN DOG (2)

1. **KARVALE BROOKHAVEN FINN** (Utych)

2. **STELLAR FIREBALL AT TYEWN** (Knauss/Gregg)

Thirteen year old ruby with good broad skull and large dark eyes. Moderate neck and shoulders, good spring of rib and bone. A little longer cast than the winner and not as exuberant on the move.
