We Are Moving Forward!

Dr. Jason Stull, our epidemiologist from the University of Prince Edward Island received the official word on Jan 31st that the CKCSC project is all set up in the University accounts (meaning all groups have signed off on it and its ready to be officially started). He has have found an excellent, keen 3rd year veterinary student (Annie) who is being hired to assist with some of the work. They are working to ensure our survey is not overly biased in terms of respondents and responses (at least as compared to others) and very pleased with the preliminary survey questions and structure we provided from our CKCC-USA Health & Education Committee. We look forward to our endeavor and will keep all posted on our progress and release date!
