- 2. **Cruisin Mighty Mouse** (Rackler) Ruby, shade longer cast, also very promising, lovely head and eye, well set ears which he used well, well boned, good angulation, coat in between at the moment.
- **3.** Chadwick Jet Setter (Eckersley) Just 5 months old, nice head and eye, good pigment, well set ears, dark eyes, good bone, needs to grow to look in proportion.
- 4. **Briarcrest Going For Baroque** (Katz) Tricolour, heavily marked, good head and eye, well set ears, needs more body, well angulated, long cast at the moment.
