I also want to thank the exhibitors for bringing me such nice dogs to judge. I thought that the quality of the dogs was exceptionally good and there were several that could have won top honors. There were several young dogs that should have an exciting future. The eyes were really good on almost all the dogs, nice, round and dark. We do need to be aware of all the bad croups. I saw more bad croups than the last time I judged, but overall I think the dogs are improving.

Junior Puppy Dog (6)

- **1. Dancasa Cute As A Button** (Tiedemann) This 8 month old blenheim boy was nicely marked with a really rich lovely coat. This boy flowed around the ring like he had been showing forever. He had a dead level topline with a good front and rear and a correct tail set. He had a lovely head and large dark eyes and a correct bite. He should have an exciting future. I was glad to give him **Best Puppy Dog** and **Best Puppy in Show**.
- **2. Denham Dynamite Joe** (Maddox) A 6 month old puppy who was showing like a show dog. Lovely blenheim boy with a shining coat. He moved well and looked good coming and going. He had a well-proportioned body with good height to length balance. He was well presented and showed well. Another boy with a promising future
- **3. Krystal Born On The Fourth Of July** (Torgersen) A 8 month old blenheim puppy with a lot of promise. Good for size with an attractive head. I loved his head and eyes, lovely soft head with nice dark eyes. He moved well around the ring with a nice rear and front. **4. Darane Leonardo Da Vinci** (Birbeck) This black and tan puppy was very well structured. He had a great topline and looked good going around the ring with a nice front and rear.

Senior Puppy Dog (2)

1. Noonvale Firewalker (Bertron) This nice Ruby boy had a very appealing masculine head, it was very soft and full with lovely dark round eyes. He had very nice rich color. I loved his movement. He looked nice coming and going with a nice topline on the move. He should really mature nicely and have a promising future. 2. Lynsfaire Country Gentleman (Hallsted) This Black and Tan boy had very nice overall construction. He had lovely movement with a good front and rear and a lovely head with nice dark eyes.

Graduate Puppy Dog (5)

Orchardhill Tough Enough, JW (Venier) I loved this boy as soon as he came into the ring. He is very much my type, a lovely Blenheim boy with an elegant shape. He had nice reach of neck and shoulder layback flowing into a level topline that made him able to move around the ring with ease. He showed like he owned the ring, not only was he well structured, he had a lovely head with just the right amount of fill. He had nice dark round eyes that we look for in our cavaliers. His coat was lovely and in great condition. I loved this boy and was happy to give him **Reserve Winners Dog**.

2. Pascavale Taylor (Welsh) Heavily marked Blenheim. He had a beautiful head with pleasing expression. Good overall shape with correct topline and tailset. He had a lovely coat and showed well for his owner. He should have a great future. 3. Merseyport Magical Mystery Tour of Chadwick (Eckersley) This Blenheim boy had a lovely balanced head with flat skull, high set ears with lots of flowing coat. He had lovely dark eyes and was shown in great condition. 4. Darane Smooth Criminal at Nightingale (Mulligan) A very nice Black and Tan boy with a lovely head. He had lots of lovely coat and was presented beautifully. He showed well and moved nicely. Overall a very nice dog.

Novice Dog (1)

1. Blewis V.H. Lamslag at Grandville (Grandemange) A lovely tri boy with very nice coat. He was presented well and gave his owner his full attention

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (1)

1. Castlemaine Bentley (Warme) This nicely marked Blenheim had the most pleasing head. Lovely dark eyes, well filled muzzle and a gentle soft expression. A lovely outline and his body was so well put together. Elegant and flowing on the move with good profile and strong rear action. Lovely coat and in great condition.

Junior American Bred Dog (3)

- 1. Forestcreek Brass In Pocket (Cline) Lovely blenheim dog that was just my type, he had a lovely head shape, good proportions skull to foreface, large eyes which were very dark, well set ears which framed his face. He had a lovely neck and shoulders, correct bone with good turn of stifle. When he moved he looked good coming toward you or moving away. He also looked lovely going around the ring carrying a good topline and a correct tail set. I loved this boy from the time he walking into the ring and I was glad to give him *Winners Dog* and *Best in Show*. He should have a great career.
- **2. Dreamvale Smart As Th Dickens** (Warshaw/Sage) Another nice moving boy. He moved correctly going around the ring and had a nice front and rear. Lovely tri colored boy who should do well in the ring. **3. Krystle Coleman**

(Torgersen) Well broken blenheim who showed well with nice eyes and coat. Moved well and showed nicely for his owners.

American Bred Dog (8)

I have watched him progress from a baby to a mature dog and I was not disappointed in him. He is a very lovely dog with nice eyes and coat and moved like a million dollars. Chadwick Scotch On The Rocks At Hudsonview, JW (Yassky/Eckersley) Well broken Blenheim boy with lots of nice coat and lovely eyes. He moved well around the ring.

- 1. Byermoor Queens Orb (O'Brien) Nice Blenheim boy with nice markings. He had lovely body proportions and well put together. Moved with ease and style both in profile and going and coming. 2. Kavalar Home Run For Windham (Hashagen) Lovely head with a soft and gentle expression. Good body shape with all parts fitting together. He had a nice full coated and was in top class condition. Great neck, shoulders and topline. 3. Saintbrides Seafarer (Kates) Good for size and balance with a well-made body. Masculine in head with nice flowing well broken coat. He moved around the ring well and showed well for his owner. 4. Angel's Pride Mini Cooper AX, OAJ, C-RA, C-NAJ (Gregory) Another nice dog with nice coat, very well trained and showed well for his owner. Special Limit Tricolor Dog (4)
