1. Chewcreek Red Solo Cup (DePhillip) Quality 8 month old tri with super head, large round dark eyes and good ear set. Compact body with everything where it should be and an ideal size for age. He moved round the ring with drive, keeping a level topline. So stylish. One to watch. *Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show, Best Tricolor in Show* 

2. Hiddencreek Mason (Green) Richly coloured Blenheim of 8 ½ months old. Good head and ear set. Large round dark eyes and black nose. Nice type, well made puppy who moved around the ring with confidence. Promising. 3. Angel's Pride Just A Gigilo (Gentil) Much the same remarks apply to this 6 month old puppy as #2. Another typey, promising puppy. 4. Rutherford Eros (Jones) 5 ½ month old, nicely made Blenheim. Heavier marked with good pigment. Moved well once settled.

# Senior Puppy Dog (3)

**1. Lacouture King Of Rock** (Gentil) Black & Tan boy with large round dark eyes and black nose. Lovely silky coat. Well made so moved round the ring with balance and drive. Well presented. **2. Chadwick Cheers At Hudsonview** (Glynn) Heavily marked tri with correct tan markings. Good conformation. Moved well with drive, keeping a level topline. Well presented. **3. Rosehill Recalculating** (Sage/Warshaw) Nice tri boy with round dark eyes and good pigment. Well made but just preferred the tail carriage of #2 on the move.

# Graduate Puppy Dog (3)

**1. Darane Hellboy** (Kates) Small compact ruby with large round dark eyes, black nose and richly coloured coat. Level topline which he held on the move. Typey. Well presented. **2. Bonitos Companeros Eldorado, JW** (Magera/Mitchell) Another small, compact Blenheim with dark eyes and good pigment. Well marked. Moved with style around the ring. Nice type. Well presented. **3. Dreamvale Motley Crue** (Sage/Colbert) Richly marked Blenheim. Dark eyes and pigment. A little unsettled today.

# **Bred By Exhibitor Dog (1)**

**1. Ch Brookhaven Believe It Or Not** (Ayers/Martz) 2 year old Blenheim with richly coloured, well marked coat. Large round dark eyes and good pigment. Handsome head with well set ears. Well made with good bone for size. He moved round the ring with style. Lovely exhibit.

# Junior American Bred Dog (4)

 Brookhaven Kid Rock At Almeara, JW (Whitmire/Ayers/Martz) Blenheim of nice type with handsome head, large round dark eyes and black nose. Rich well broken coat markings. Moved well and shown to advantage. 2.
Foxcreek Brown Eyed Handsome Man (Johnson) Tri of 11 months old. Nice head, dark eyes and good pigment. Moved and showed well when settled. 3. Darane Frodo Baggins (Kates) Blenheim boy with rich chestnut markings. Moved and showed well. Smaller than but just preferred the head of #2. 4. Regis Westgate Coconut Breeze (Brown) Tri with nice head, dark eyes and black nose. A little close behind, but could improve with age. American Bred Dog (6)

**1. Clarmarian Classic By Design** (Young-May) Blenheim with masculine head, large dark eyes and good pigment. Richly marked coat. Liked his size. Moved soundly round the ring keeping a level topline. *Best Blenheim Dog, Award of Merit* **2. Bentwood Reason To Believe** (Barton/Harrison) Blenheim with handsome head, large dark eyes and black nose. Heavier marked. Preferred the tail set and carriage of #1. **3. Krystle Heart Of Gold** (Torgersen) Masculine headed Blenheim with dark eyes. Small snippet on otherwise black nose. A nice example of the breed. **4. Brookhaven Jessie** (Parente) Well broken Blenheim with round dark eyes and good pigment. Well presented.

#### Health & Conformation Dog (1)

**1. Avia Sgt. Pepper** (Marler) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> year old Blenheim with large round dark eyes. Richly coloured, well broken coat. Moved well when settled.

#### **Special Limit Blenheim Dog (5)**

1. Clarmarian Covertly Wicked (Gogol/Young-May) Blenheim with pleasing head, large dark eyes and good pigment. Moved well keeping a level topline. Liked his size. Well presented. 2. Hillwood Candid Expression (Bennett) Another nice type Blenheim with dark eyes and black nose. Well broken up coat markings. Moved well, at one with handler. 3. Althof One N Only (Hansen) Lightly marked Blenheim with round dark eyes and good pigment. Moved well, at one with handler. Well presented. 4. Sweetbriar Shakespeare (Legerretta/Longar) Smaller type Blenheim, showing slight white of eye. Stop too deep and nose too short for me.

#### **Special Limit Tricolor Dog (2)**

**1. Chadwick Midnight Sun At Hudsonview** (Glynn) Handsome headed boy with large round dark eyes and good pigment. Well made and moved well with drive. At one with handler. **2. Mysticknight Jack Pot** (Hassig) Smaller type with well broken tri markings. Well made. Moved and showed well. Just preferred head of #1.

#### Special Limit Ruby Dog (2)

**1. Sevenwoods Wildberry** (Shidler) Soundly made Ruby with handsome head, dark eyes and good pigment. Level topline and good tail set on the move. Showed well and at one with handler. **2. AutumnHill Spencer, JW** (Weinstein/Parente) Nice rich colour to this boy's coat. Pleasant head with round dark eyes and black nose. Moved and showed to advantage. Well presented.

## Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (3)

1. Westwind Reverand Roy (Koehring) Handsome headed boy with rich tan markings. Dark eyes and black nose. Correct size. Moved with drive keeping a level topline. Well handled. *Award of Merit, Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog, Best American Bred Dog 2.* Elyzian Double Take (Arnold) Dark eyes and good pigment. Level topline which he kept on the move. Silky coat with rich tan markings. Larger than and just preferred #1's head. 3. Lynsfaire Above The Law (Fairchild) Smaller boy with dark eyes and good pigment. Showed well keeping a level topline. Open Dog (3) Excellent class of worthy Champions and very close between 1 and 2.

**1.** Ch Melrose Gold For Bonitos Companeros, JW (Magera/Mitchell) Handsome Ruby dog of rich colour, shown in gleaming condition. Large round dark eyes giving desired soft expression in masculine head with correct ear placement which he used to advantage. Excellent neck and lay of shoulder. Short coupled. Good turn of stifle. Moved with drive holding a level topline at all times. Excellent size. At one with his handler. *Winners Dog, Best in Show, Best Ruby in Show* 

2. Ch Turretbank Magic Spell (Green/Sloan) Quality Black & Tan. Another fine example of the breed, just slightly larger than #1. Handsome head with large round dark eyes and good ear placement. In excellent coat, which shone. Again moved well with drive keeping a level topline. At one with his handler. *Reserve Winners Dog, Best Black & Tan in Show* 

**3.** Ch Dreamvale Tri Your Luck At Parkbury, JW (Parker) Well made tri with handsome head and black nose. Well furnished with correct tan markings. Good neck and shoulders with well turned stifles. Moved positively with balance and drive. Well shown.

Junior Puppy Bitch (6) A lovely puppy class.

1. Rutherford Electra (Jones) Pretty Blenheim of lovely size with large dark eyes and good pigment. Rich chestnut markings and good conformation. Moved round the ring with style keeping a level topline. Well presented. Very promising. 2. Angel's Pride Jive Sensation (Gentil) Another very promising Blenheim and much the same remarks apply as for 1. Just preferred the head of the winner. 3. Blackfire Big Girls Don't Cry (Weidig/Kennedy) Black & Tan with pretty head, dark eyes and black nose. Moved well keeping a level topline. Well presented. Promising. 4. Clarmarian Here Comes The Sun (Young-May) Heavily marked tri with nice head, dark eyes and good pigment. Moved well. Well presented. Promising.

Senior Puppy Bitch (3)

**1. Almeara Look At Me** (Whitmire) Pretty headed Blenheim with large dark eyes and good pigment. Lightly marked coat of good texture. Good conformation and moved with drive, keeping a level topline. Well presented and a happy showgirl. *Best Puppy Bitch* 

**2.** Althof Café Rouge (Hansen) Another pretty headed Blenheim with dark eyes and good pigment. Rich chestnut markings. Nice size. Moved well, at one with handler. **3.** Roseriver Last Tango N Paris (Young) Tri girl with nice head and gentle expression. Good tan markings. Good coat. Just needed to settle.

Autumnhill Desire Me, JW (Parente) Ruby with pretty head, large round dark eyes and black nose. Moved with style holding a level topline. Liked her size. Happy showgirl. Promising. 3. Dreamvale Guns N Roses (Sage/Colbert) Blenheim with pleasing head, dark eyes and good pigment. Rich chestnut markings. Moved well keeping a level topline. Well presented. 4. Roseriver Claire De Lune (Young) Blenheim with pleasing head, dark eyes and black nose. Level topline when standing and on the move. Happy showgirl.

**1. Panna Cotta Azalia** (Patkowski) Blenheim with sweet head, dark eyes and good pigment. Kept a level topline standing and on the move. Well presented. **2. Regis Westgate Lucky Lady T** (Brown) Pretty Ruby with round dark eyes and black nose. Longer cast and preferred head of winner. Well presented.

## **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (4)**

1. Ch Kean Ultraviolet, JW (Keane) Very glamourous Blenheim with pretty feminine head, large round dark eyes and good pigment. Well broken up silky coat of rich chestnut color. Excellent reach of neck, well laid shoulders and good turn of stifle. Move with style holding a level topline at all times. Oozes breed type. Winners Bitch, Reserve Best in Show, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show, Best American Bred in Show, Best Blenheim in Show

2. Pinecrest Flamin Gogh (Eubank) Pretty Blenheim with sweet head, large round dark eyes and good pigment. Good conformation. Showed and moved well. Loved her size. Well presented. 3. Lynsfaire Catch Me If You Can (Fairchild) Well made tri with lovely head, dark round eyes and good pigment. Kept a level topline on the move. Well presented. 4. Huntcrest Sweet Dreams (Weiner-Pope) Blenheim with pleasing head, dark eyes and black nose. Moved well, at one with handler.

#### Junior American Bred Bitch (5)

1. Rutherford Byoncee, JW (Jones) Pretty Blenheim with dark eyes and good pigment. Well broken coat of good texture. Moved well, at one with handler. Happy showgirl. 2. Roseriver Fanfare (Young) Ruby with appealing head, large dark eyes and black nose. Coat of good color. Moved well. 3. Chewcreek Piper (DePhillip) Another very nice Ruby. Smaller but not in as good coat and just preferred head of 2. Moved positively. 4. Seraphaven Put A Spell On You (Gogol) Pretty Blenheim with dark eyes and good pigment. Rich chestnut markings. Moved well. American Bred Bitch (2)

**1. Brookhaven Mystic Sky** (Ayers/Martz) Blenheim of lovely size and type. Large round dark eyes and good pigment. Sweet head, well cushioned under eyes. Would prefer slightly shallower stop. Good showgirl. **2. Veribas Leaps And Bounds** (Cusick) Blenheim with dark eyes and black nose. Nicely made and moved well. Just preferred type of winner.

#### Health & Conformation Bitch (1)

**1. Sheeba Madeline Rose** (Johnson) Well made Blenheim with well broken coat. Larger than I prefer but moved and showed well. Well presented.

#### **Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (4)**

**1. Brookhaven In The Garden, JW** (Ayers/Martz) Pretty headed bitch with large round dark eyes giving a soft expression. Good pigment. Well broken coat of rich chestnut. Nicely made with compact body. Moved and showed well. At one with handler. *Reserve Winners Bitch* 

**2. Brookhaven Harper** (Milosevic/Ayers) Pretty Blenheim with lovely expression. Liked her size. Moved well. Of equal quality to 1 but just preferred the head of the winner. **3. Orchardhill Ever After** (Venier) Blenheim with

pretty head and good pigment. Nicely marked. Well made and moved well keeping a level topline. Slightly longer cast. **4. Lilium Southern Magnolia** (Thorp) Bitch with pleasing head, dark eyes and black nose. Rich chestnut markings. Moved well. Larger size.

Althof Yours In Spirit (Hansen) Pretty headed girl with round dark eyes and good pigment. Lovely type and size. In good coat. Moved with style and handled well. *Award of Merit, Best Tricolor Bitch 2.* Orchardhill Unadorned (Venier) Similar in type but just preferred overall size and shape of winner. 3. First Capital Daisy Mae (Arnold) Pretty head with dark eyes and black nose. Well marked. Nice type. Showed and handled well. 4. Monarch's That's My Little Margie (Bellflower) Nicely made girl with well broken coat markings. Just preferred heads of the others.

## Special Limit Ruby Bitch (2)

**1. Darane My Darling Clementine At Chewcreek** (DePhillip) Pretty head with dark eyes. Excellent breed type. Moved positively keeping a level topline. Well presented. *Best Ruby Bitch* **2. Chiyoda Hot Tea In Pot** (Lemon) Pleasing head with good pigment. Longer cast than 1. Happy showgirl.

## Special Limit Black & Tan Bitch (3)

1. Rutherford Venus W, JW (Jones) Pretty head with dark eyes and black nose. Soft coat and rich tan markings. Moved positively keeping a level topline. Happy showgirl. Well presented. *Best Black & Tan Bitch 2.* Cruisin Minnie Mouse (Rackler) Pretty girl. Round dark eyes and good pigment. Excellent topline which she held on the move. Well presented. Just preferred the head of 1. 3. Veribas Be Proud To Point Black (Cusick) Another pretty girl and much the same applies as 2. Coat has a slight wave.

**1.** Ch Pinecrest Destiny's Child, JW (Eubank) Very pretty Blenheim bitch with large round dark eyes, good pigment and rich chestnut markings. Loved her size and shape. Moved with style keeping a level topline. Well presented but just lacking finish today. *Award of Merit*
