My impressions of the quality of dogs entered in the Specialty are as follows: I was delighted with the quality and breed type of the exhibits I judged. It is certainly turning into a head breed, as is evident in so many types of toy breeds. BUT, this wonderful little dog's place, in the world of dogs, was originally bred as a small hunting and sporting dog, in spite of it being in the toy group, in the U S A. I would like breeders to keep in consideration with their breeding programmes, its original purpose. It is important for this breed to be sound in conformation and to have the correct movement for its original purpose. Hunting and as a companion to its owners. Please take the importance of having strong rear quarters and sufficient angulation to give the drive required for the terrain it would have been working in. Fore-quarters, as a whole, seem to be in good shape. Breeders should take more care with the rear hind quarters in this delightful small sporting dog. I thank you for all your lovely entries.

Junior Puppy Dog (4) I like the Cavalier head type of all of these 4 puppies.

1. Chadwick Snow Drift at Woodbury (Redniss) Very good type. Appealing expression, good coat. Nice cushioning on foreface, good top line. Would like to see more bend of stifle. 2. Dreamvale Olivander (Hallsted/Sage) Would like more cushioning under eyes. Appears a little out at elbow. Could use more spring of rib. Appears to be moving a little loosely in front. 3. Linrica Bye Bye Birdie (Hsiung/Liu) Typey. I would like to see a better tail set. Could use more spring of rib. 4. Copper Hill Tanner (Mitchell) Shows promise. Good turn of stifle. Pleasing set on of neck. Good pigment.
