Junior Puppy Dog (7)

- 1. Chewcreek Three Amigos Dusty Bottoms (DePhillip) A small blenheim dog with a great ATTITUDE. Well balanced, level topline and good side gait. Carried his tail correctly. A head with lovely expression and large dark eyes. *Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show*
- 2. Jayba Easy Does It (Lander) A heavier marked blenheim dog. Well shaped body with correct tail set. Slightly longer in body. Excellent side gait. Lovely head and expression with large dark eyes. 3. Darane Suddenly Seymour (Kates) Five month old very cute, small puppy. Had a good time moving. Sweet face. Slightly feminine. 4. Amantra Icicle at Marjorelle (Conley) Very pretty blenheim dog, well balanced. A lovely head and eye. Moved very loose both side gaiting and up and back.

Senior Puppy Dog (5)

- 1. Chadwick Snow Drift at Woodbury (Redniss) A very showy small dog. Moved well with a correct tail carraige. Kept a good top line considering that he was slightly over weight. Peretty head, large dark eyes. A little feminine. 2. Canyoncrest Pleasing Pumpkin (Du Ross) A good size male 10 months old. Showed with a great temperament and showmanship. Moved well with a good topline and tail set. A little all over the place on the up and back. Typical of a young happy dog. Good head for his age with a lovely dark eye. 3. Picketfence Moonlight Kiss (Frey) A young dog with an excellent temperament. Good neck and tail carriage when moving. Nice head and eye. Needs to mature.
- **4. Clarmarian Kiss and Cry** (Young-May) Well marked dog with correct bone for his size. Moved well but tended to carry his tail a bit high. Good head with large eyes and excellent expression.

Graduate Puppy Dog (9)

1. Pinecrest White Lightening, JW (Eubank) Excellent size and shape with correct bone. Moved well with correct tail carriage. Excellent shaped head with large dark eyes. Very well show trained. 2. Tassajara Sully Sullenberger (Seidman/Gardner) Well balanced dog. Moved well with a level topline and correct tail carriage. Lovely head and eye with melting expression. 3. Krystle Heart of Gold (Torgersen) Blenheim dog on the rangy side. Makes him seem imature for his 12 mnths of age. Moved well with a good topline. 4. Autumn Hill Spencer (Parente) A very nice ruby dog. Good moving with an exellent topline. Lovely head with dark eyes.

Novice Dog (3)

1. Clarmarian Classic By Design (Young-May) Young Blenheim male of good type. Moves well. Good expression, needs larger eye. Needs to mature. 2. Forest Creek Prince William (Koehring) A blenheim dog with a good out line. Moves well when side gaiting. Stands with his front too far forward. Moves weak in the front on the down and back. A very soft sweet expression. 3. Lynsfaire Above The Law (Fairchild) A black and tan dog with a lovely shape and good body. Moved well

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (7)

- 1. CA Cambridge Dream Weaver (Magera/Michell) A stand out black and tan dog. Moved well with a good topline and tail carriage. Lovely head with great expression. In outstanding coat and condition. *Reserve Winners Dog, Best Black & Tan in Show*
- 2. Canyoncrest Star Blazer, JW (Du Ross) A very well put together young dog. Moved well with a good topline and tail carraige. Good head with excellent expression. Large dark eyes. 3. Lynsfaire Hot Off The Press (Fairchild) blenheim dog with great attitude. He was happy to be here. Moved well with an excellent topline. Well marked blenheim. Decent head with large eyes. 4. Denham Dream Boat (Maddox) Very well shown rich ruby dog. Moved well with a good topline. Carried his tail high. In excellent condition. Was a little reserved. Best Ruby Dog 4. Oggbrae Don Giovanni (Bales) Blenheim dog of good size. Moved well but did not want to be at the show today. American Bred Dog (8)
- 1. Ingold Whispered Promise (Pickett/Dalton) A blenheim dog that showed with great style and presence. Moved very well with a good topline and tailset and carriage. Lovely head with excellent dark eye. 2. Redbud Northern Dance (Scott) A smaller blenheim male with rich clour. Moved well both coming and going and down and back. Appealling head and eye. He carried his tail a little higher than I like to see. 3. Forestcreek Apollo (Walzer/Cline) Moved well with a good topline, excellent head and ear set with good dark eyes. Very heavily marked. 4. Krystle Born On The Fourth of July (Torgersen) A blenheim dog, very sound, moved with a good topline and excellent tail set. Plain head but very good expression.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (9)

1. Kinvaar's Mile High Club (Harrison) A very finished, well presented dog. Moved well with a good topline and tail carriage, sound coming and going. Soft expression on an excellent head. Good substance. On the larger size. 2. Aranel Fanatic (Adair) A dog on the small side. Great outline. Very well put togeather. Moved well with good topline and tail carriaige. Sweet expression with lovely dark eyes. Coat not as in good condition or presented as number one. 3. Chantismere Caruso of Chadwick (Eckersley) A very promising young dog. Excellent outline. Pleasing head. Was not on his game today. 4. Toraylac Bravado For Kean (Keane) Well marked with deep rich colour. Moved well.

Special Limit Tricolor Dog (2)

- 1. Signaturez Chocolate Chunk (Hallock) Good type. Nice moving, well marked. *Best Tricolor Dog* 2. Veribas Point Break (Cusick) Good type, well marked. Moved well. Carried his tail high. Special Limit Ruby Dog (2)

- 1. Ch Bonitos Companeros Halli Galli (Eubank/Kirschbaum/Vorderstrasse/Morrison) A nice sized dog, moved well around the ring. Excellent hindquarters, sometimes moves a little wide in the front, but not always. Excellent head and eye. Very well trained and shown. Puts on a great show. Winners Dog, Best in Show, Best Blenheim in Show
- 2. Ch Chadwick Scotch On The Rocks at Hudsonview, JW (Yassky/Glynn) A dog that came with a great attitude. Moved well. Good head and expression. Not quite as finished as number one. 3. Ch Liane's Happy Jack, JW (Westfall) A very well put together smaller dog. Great attitude. Could move better. 4. Ch Chantismere Cast A Spell On Corduke (Mulligan) A well put together dog that moved alright. Needs body. Junior Puppy Bitch (10)
- **1. Darane Jezebel** (Kates) A very pretty tri bitch with a very good attitude. Moves well, very pretty face, good ear set. **2. Pinecrest Soul Sister** (Eubank) An excellent moving blenheim bitch, moves with good topline and tail set. Lovely head, eye and expression. **3. Roseriver Tri Quintessence** (Young) Very young tri bitch with loads of

promise. Moved well with a good topline and tail set. Lovely face. **4. Markley Frostbite** (Storey) A very lightly marked blenheim. Sweet expression. A bit weedy.

Lovely face, expression put off by the off centre blaze.

1. Jayba Tres Jolie, JW (Lander) A very feminine and cute blenheim puppy bitch. Excellent outline on the move, very sound, excellent head and expression. Lovely dark eyes. 2. Bonitos Companeros Je T'Aime (Adair) A good sized, well boned puppy bitch. Good outline. Lovely head and expression with melting dark eyes. Topline rolls when moving. 3. Amantra Minuette at Majorelle (Conley) A very pretty young bitch. Needs to mature. Novice Bitch (2)

1. Darane All About Eve (Kates) Very showy and well trained. Moved well, very pretty face. **2. Lynsfaire Spread The News** (Sams/Fairchild) A nice size tri, very heavily marked.
