Junior Puppy Dog (8)

1. Jayba Easy Does It (Lander) 7 month old blenheim. Lovely head with large dark eyes and black nose pigment. Well made with a good reach of neck. Richly marked and very well coated. Confident mover. **2. Jalesto Super Trooper** (Gentil) Ruby, excellent type, sound mover. Although 2 months older than the winner, he was not as mature in body or coat as the class winner. **3. Mileslip Withalittleluck Of Tailgate** (Skidmore) Ruby with a soft gentle expression. Not as masculine as 1 or 2. Well balanced dog with good angulation and nice spring of ribs with plenty of coat. **4. Chewcreek Three Amigos Dusty Bottoms** (DePhillip) Beautifully marked blenheim with rich broken coat. Smart and stylish with clean cut lines.

Senior Puppy Dog (2)

1. Chadwick Snow Drift at Woodbury (Redniss) Blenheim, 10 months old. Beautifully coated, flashily marked puppy who was nice and compact with good spring of rib and bone. Attractive head and expression with large dark eyes. Moved with drive and showed well. *Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show*
2. Aubinwood Barkley (Gibson) Smart little blenheim, compact with a good spring of rib, well balanced. Good type, of similar make and shape in type to winner, but not as mature.

Graduate Puppy Dog (6)

1. Bonitos Companeros Kaleo At Diorchavon (Bialek) Attractive blenheim, good head with sweet expression and with enough cushioning below his large dark eyes, dark deep pigment, good neck and shoulders, adequate bone. A very happy dog a pleasure to go over, moved soundly. **2. Autumnhill Spencer** (Weinstein/Parente) Richly coloured ruby, nice size. Very nice head with dark eye. Pleasing proportions, good ribs and level topline. Moved well, just needs to settle to the task at hand. **3. Denham Dreamboat** (Maddox) Large dark eyes, well feathered ears. A little longer in nose than I prefer. Mature body, very well developed ribcage, ruby coat is of the correct, silky texture and in very good condition. Quite proud of his tail today. **4. Rosehill Cosmic Creation** (Ames/Hess) Well broken blenheim of good rich colour. Nice head with soft expression Good make and shape.

Novice Dog (2)

1. Evergreen Fred Weasley (Garstin) Richly marked blenheim. Pleasing head with dark eyes. Well put together, good bone and ribcage. Outgoing temperament. **2. Darane Suddenly Seymour** (Kates) 6 month old Blenheim. Lovely colour. Pleasant head, longer in nose than I prefer, dark eyes and good pigment. Nice size. Moved and showed very well.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (3)

1. Dancasa Cute As A Button, JW (Tiedemann) Stood out in this class. Blenheim, rich in colour. Glorious head with beautifully presented profuse straight silky coat. Plenty of substance in such a compact and short shape. Well angulated both in shoulders and stifle. Lovely dark round eyes, dark pigmented rims, well cushioned muzzle of the correct length. Flat skull and good ear carriage. **2. Ch Autumnhill Ring Of Fire, JW** (Parente) Ruby. Very correct head with the required soft expression. Good front and rear drive. Moved with purpose. Out of coat today making him look unbalanced. **3. Lynsfair Hot Off The Press** (Fairchild) Larger type, well marked blenheim, good round dark eyes, nice shape body with good rib, correct ear set, well balanced and good angulation on the move.

Junior American Bred Dog (2)

1. Orchardhill Kid You Not, JW (Venier) 13 month old mature, well boned, richly marked blenheim, exceptionally well presented, with plenty of coat. Large dark round eyes in a very full head gave a handsome expression. Good shoulders and top line. Lovely type. **2. Jayba Southern Voices At Autumnhill** (Parente/Hayes)

Lovely breed type in a larger jacket than 1. Well shaped blenheim, lovely head, correct ear set, expressive eyes, good rib depth, moved freely and with drive.

American Bred Dog (7)

1. Nightingale Wish Upon A Star At Nebyula (Birbeck) Mature blenheim with a masculine head but appealing expression. Very large dark round eyes and well feathered ears. Good neck and shoulders, short coupled body leading into a level top line. In excellent coat although paler in colour than I prefer. Moved well both coming and going. **2. Brookhaven Jessie** (Parente/Ayers) Another handsome richly marked blenheim with large dark eyes and full ears. Good neck and shoulders, well balanced, excellent top line and tail set. Nice size. Not the furnishings of 1. Moved with great drive from behind. **3. Nightingale Jackson Browne** (Birmingham) A nice sized and well balanced blenheim with a glamorous coat. Large dark eyes and good full ears give a lovely expression Good neck and shoulders. Moved well coming and going holding a level top line. **4. Piccadil Peppermint Twist** (York) Nice size richly coloured blenheim. Pretty head, very large full round dark eyes and full length of ear featherings giving a lovely endearing expression. Good neck and shoulders. Level top line. Moved well coming and going and held a level tail. Longer cast than my ideal.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (5)

1. Jordanic Luigi Of Sumara (Gentil) Nice size. Well coated dog of rich blenheim on pure clean pearly white ground, beautifully presented. Large dark eyes framed by full ears gave a beautiful gentle expression. Good neck and shoulders leading into a level top line. Moved well. **2. Toraylac Bravado For Kean** (Keane) Rich colour on a clean white ground, very well presented. Dark eyes, black nose and good ears gave a lovely expression. Good reach of neck and well laid shoulders. Good top line. Preferred the size of 1. **3. Chantismere Caruso of Chadwick** (Eckersley) A nice size. good rich colour. Pretty head, round dark brown eyes, good neck and shoulders leading to a level top line. Longer cast than 1 and 2. Moved well. **4. Brookhaven Jacob At Lynsfair** (Fairchild) Nice size richly coloured blenheim. Small and cobby with a lovely endearing expression. Good neck and shoulders. Level top line. Moved ok.

Special Limit Tricolor Dog (4)

1. Veribas Point Break (Cusick) Beautifully presented, well marked tri. Gorgeous soft expression with well cushioned muzzle and correct ear set. Good shoulder placement and turn of stifle. Moved well with good top line and tail carriage. *Best Tricolor in Show* **2. Dreamvale Smart As Th Dickens, JW** (Warshaw/Sage) An enchanting tri, very pretty head again with correct eye and pigment colour, immaculately presented, well constructed throughout. Not as good a mover today as 1. **3. Bozi V.H.Lamslag** (York) Masculine tri boy, heavier in head, smaller eye than those above. Nicely put together and moved soundly. **4. Darane Boys Don't Cry** (DePhillip) Tri with plenty of substance. Plainer in head than those above. Lacked coat and furnishings. Well made body with good sound hindquarters. Showed well

Special Limit Ruby Dog (4)

1. Turretbank Beaujolais (Green) This ruby dog caught my eye the moment he entered the ring. Although in a larger jacket than my ideal he was such an exquisite type, in lovely bloom, well balanced outline, rich tan shining, straight coat, beautifully presented, wonderful head, with soft expression, filled out muzzle, flat skull, correct stop, large dark eyes, correct bite, enough neck set into correct shoulder placement, good bone, short coupled, well turned stifle, overall excellent angulations. He kept a level topline as he moved freely and effortlessly round the ring.

Winners Dog, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Ruby in Show

2. Windham Lost Sailor (McCauley/Hashagen) A lovely rich colour ruby who sadly had left his clothes at home. Nice size, very sweet masculine head, pleasing expression with dark eyes, well filled muzzle, correct neck, flat top line, nicely angulated stifle, hocks set low, nice tail set and carriage, positive drive action, moved at one with handler. **3. Copperhill Romeo** (Mitchell) Loved his size and body shape, sufficient coat, well set ears, pretty head enough neck, well laid back shoulders, a pleasing outline, well muscled hindquarters, moved with style and soundness, carried tail correctly. **4. Tanglewood Rebellion** (Saban/Fairchild) Larger in size. Dark eyes, longer in muzzle, good shoulders and depth of chest, sufficient bone, moved with positive drive action from the rear, correct tail carriage.

Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (5)

1. Mileslip Licorice, JW (Skidmore) Very well made compact boy. Handsome full head with lovely gentle eyes, correct ear set, good bone, nice front and ribcage. Well angulated hindquarters, lovely outline when standing and carried himself really well on the move keeping his head held high. Lovely straight gleaming, black coat. **Best Black & Tan in Show** **2. Darane Leonardo Da Vinci At Nebyula** (Birbeck) Another compact dog with a pleasing head and expression. Good dark eyes, decent bone and front. Compact, well balanced body. Such a sweetie with a lovely temperament. A happy dog who moved so well. **3. Darane Smooth Criminal At Nightingale** (Mulligan) Nice size, small neat boy with huge dark eyes and good ear leathers. Enough neck, good bone and well made body. In plenty of coat of good texture. Moved ok. **4. Brookhaven Bob Bailey** (Schilling) Pleasing size. Good pigment, correct bone. Nice body with plenty of substance, coat in good condition. Moved well.

Open Dog (3)

1. Ch Chantismere Chandos Of Valentyne, JW (O'Brien) Lovely, short compact blenheim with an attractive head, huge dark eyes. Head framed with lovely long ears, good pigment, correct muzzle. Good reach of neck, well placed shoulders, good depth of chest. Well made body with good turn of stifle. Furnished with a lovely richly marked silky coat. **Reserve Winners Dog, Best Blenheim Dog**

2. Ch Chadwick Scotch On The Rocks At Hudsonview, JW (Yassky/Glynn) Lighter marked and lighter coat colour. Beautifully headed Blen, lovely soft expression with lustrous eyes, in excellent coat and condition, moved well both ways, had the desired Cavalier temperament and showed accordingly. **3. Ch Chantismere Cast A Spell On Corduke** (Mulligan) Larger framed richly coloured Blen, again with the desired eyes that give a soft expression. Longer cast than above but moved very well with a correctly carried tail giving a balanced picture.

Senior Open Dog (2)

1. Taron Brandys Ricky (Close) B/T, takes the eye because of his confident attitude, liked his size, fairly compact, beautiful outline and such good hind angulation, moved around the ring so smooth striding and happy and his coat gleamed. **2. Fair Oaks Oooh Marcus** (Meager) Larger type B/T. Rich colour and in lovely bloom, well shaped and balanced head, good bone, excellent ribcage and ample hind angulation.

Junior Puppy Bitch (9)

1. Orchardhill Here Kitty Kitty (Venier) What an accomplished showgirl this delightful little blen is, really good head, charming in expression, compact, well ribbed body, smooth outline and very good angulations, jacket was soft and sparkling, moved around with such grace and confidence. Shows much promise. **2. Licketysplit Maybe I'm Amazed** (Geoghegan) Another little charmer. Smaller in size than 1. Loved this blenheim's head, nice flat skull, ear set frames the face so well, well arched neck, firm body, lovely outline, moves around the ring with soundness and attitude. **3. Darane All About Eve** (Kates) Lovely size, so well ribbed and bodied, compact in loin, good croup moulding and well set and carried tail. Head is a delight, large, round eyes which are dark and bright in expression. She moved beautifully. **4. Chadwick Curiosity** (Eckersley) Another blen and so much to admire, has undoubted quality, her head, eyes and expression are a delight, enough neck, well ribbed and not overdone in loin, well laid shoulders, rear angles are used efficiently on the move. A very quiet bitch that will hold her own once she gains her confidence.

Senior Puppy Bitch (3)

1. Brookhaven In The Garden, JW (Ayers/Martz) 9 month old pretty little Blenheim, very much a baby, but all the required attributes were there. Soft melting feminine head with just enough cushioning below dark round eyes, tapered muzzle, good pigment. Lovely texture to her coat. Well balanced little girl, moved well. Not quite the outgoing showgirl yet but at one with her handler. **Best Puppy Bitch**

2. Chadwick Paparazzi (Matos) Very pretty 10 month old Blenheim. Larger and rangier than 1. Nice coat with rich chestnut markings and the desired lozenge, appealing feminine head of correct proportions, round dark eyes, good facial pigment. Moved well. **3. Truluv Tara** (Nikaci) Very pretty Blenheim bitch. Well marked. Lovely size for age, dark pigment, not the bone of above. Moved well.

Graduate Puppy Bitch (6)

1. Chantismere Charlie's Angel (O'Brien) Eye catching well proportioned blen of quality, exquisite head with soft well cushioned muzzle and large luscious dark eyes, lovely outline, super reach of neck, well placed shoulders, her

correct angulation moved her effortlessly and positively round the ring carrying her head proudly, happy girl who showed well. **Reserve Winners Bitch, Reserve Best in Show**

2. Rutherford Xtacy (Jones) Blenheim bitch finer in head than 1, with good pigment, feminine expression. Correct size, moved well. Just needs time to mature. **3. Sunjays Annabella** (Hellman) Soft expression, good pigment and eyes with rich tan. Very good outline standing and going around, covered ground with ease. **4. Kayangee Kinsey Millhone** (Kates) Well marked Blenheim, feminine head, good pigment with good outline on move and standing, covered ground well.

Novice Bitch (2)

1. Darane My Darling Clementine At Chewcreek (DePhillip) 6 mth old ruby, just in-between coats. Sweet pretty head with very kind, dark eye and soft expression. Lovely make and shape. She moved soundly both ways. **2.**

Dreamvale Chasing Rainbows (Sage/Colbert) Blenheim with rich chestnut markings and beautifully feathered coat. A cheeky character with attractive head, dark eye and pigment, with good reach of neck and lovely outline standing. Not as positive a mover as 1.

Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (5)

1. Truluv Pirouette (Nikaci) Well constructed and compact blen with plenty of silky coat, very pretty head, flat skull, beautiful dark eyes, well set on ears with long feathering, well presented and moved with drive, happy personality showing herself off to perfection. **2. Nightingale Walkin' On Sunshine** (Mulligan) Well marked lighter coloured blen than 1. In super condition, good bone, angulation and tailset, nice neck, lovely head with sweet expression and dark eyes, delightful girl who showed happily. **3. Licketysplit Lughnasa** (Geoghegan) Charming blen. Nice head but not such a soft expression as above, large dark eyes and lovely compact size, well made all through, moved well and showed herself off. **4. Welmforth Standing Ovation** (Lasser) Heavily marked tri, lovely dark eyes giving her a gorgeous expression, good reach of neck held her head proudly, moved effortlessly with plenty of drive from her strong quarters, well presented.

Junior American Bred Bitch (3)

1. Nightingale Kit Kat (Mulligan) Blen, small cobby type, nicely turned out in good coat, well bodied, level topline, straight in forequarters, good turn of stifle to rear, good muscle throughout, lovely head, with lozenge, large dark eye and nose pigment with soft expression. **2. Darane Casablanca At Chewcreek** (DePhillip) Quality young tri with nice head and eye, richly marked tans and in good coat. Short coupled, she has a firm level topline, well set tail and shows well. **3. Kalais Pirate's Booty** (Hess) Pretty headed b/t, larger type with dark expressive eyes and well cushioned foreface, well set ears, good reach of neck onto well laid shoulders, level topline, good front, well angulated, moved and showed well.

American Bred Bitch (2)

1. Blueday Chelsea (Gross) Blenheim with a super head, she has the most lovely eyes and that lovely soft expression that is so desired, lovely shape and size, nicely bodied, good turn of stifle. **2. Nightingale Sun Kissed Rose of Cantia** (Kent) Richly marked blenheim with lozenge, well placed ears, good forehead, good depth of rib, well bent stifles, showed well.

Health and Conformation Bitch (1)

1. Blackfire Trifecta (Weidig/Kennedy) Tricolour with appealing pretty head and rich tan markings, well feathered ears, good reach of neck, good topline, nice bone, a nice mover who showed really well.

Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (3)

1. Orchardhill Indiscreet, JW (Venier) Very appealing blenheim. Typy head with lovely large round dark eyes. Softly tapered muzzle, correct pigment and mouth. Ok for neck and carried a level topline and tail. Small and neat, I loved her 'never stop showing' attitude. **2. Truluv Hugs N Kisses** (Nikaci) Pretty blenheim. A correct head, moderate neck and well laid shoulders. Super substance and bone, topline and tail. Very well marked with a pleasant temperament. Preferred the eyes of 1. **3. Gayhalo Mosaic** (Ayers/Martz) Blenheim of obvious quality. Large dark round eyes in an appealing head of good proportions creating a soft look. Feminine throughout. Good neck and moved well with a tidy reach and carrying a super topline and tail. Not as confident a mover as 1 and 2 at the moment.

Special Limit Tricolor Bitch (4)

1. Prima Quartett Bloody Mary (Bronowicka/Carter) Heavily marked tricolour. Feminine face with pretty eyes, nice tapered muzzle and pigment. Construction is adequate with no exaggerations. Neck, shoulders and topline all good. Carries her tail perfectly and moved easily with a friendly disposition. **Best Tricolor Bitch** **2. Ch Jayba Black Eyed Susan** (Lander) Animated tri of quality. Well bodied with a wealth of silky coat. Generous head with large dark expressive eyes. Excellent reach of crested neck. Lots of drive on the move maintaining her level topline, although erratic at times. **3. Sheeba Discover Mona Lisa** (Gross) Tri with pretty head, dark eyes and black pigment. Well constructed. Nicely marked coat. **4. Kayangee Lilly Rush** (Kates) Nice overall, pretty in type, finer in bone. Did not use her ears to show off her expression. Good conformation, moved with ease.

Special Limit Ruby Bitch (3)

1. Kalais Mamma Mia (Hess/Casey/Cornog) Smart ruby, soft expression, dark eyes and shallow stop, level topline. In good coat of lovely colour and texture. Moved well. **Best Ruby Bitch** **2. Brookhaven Lucky Penny** (Schilling/Ayers) Pretty headed ruby with lovely dark expressive eyes, soft expression. A little longer cast than 1, with a good spring of rib, well turned stifles. In good coat, moved well. **3. Bryndael Carlen Roxie Hart** (Close) Ruby of correct size. Sweet headed, cobby, good earset, head and shoulders, good movement. Not the coat or ring presence of 1 or 2.

Special Limit Black & Tan Bitch (1)

1. Jewelcroft's Dala Midnatt Sol (Sands) B/t, appealing head, bright tans, adequate reach of neck. Good shape with level topline both moving and standing with jet black straight coat.

Open Bitch (5)

1. Ch Chadwick Embrace, JW (Eckersley) Blenheim, well marked coat with desired lozenge. Full of quality, fabulous reach of neck, generous head and feminine expression, good pigmentation, level back, nice bone, her striking outline was seen to good effect when moving, good balance, plenty of enthusiasm, showed very well.

Winners Bitch, Best in Show, Best Blenheim in Show, Best American Bred in Show, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show

2. Orchardhill Travel In Style (Venier) Well marked blenheim of lighter colour than 1. Nice head, not such a melting expression as 1. Good bone and body, moved well in profile, good tail carriage and topline, very nice condition, shown well. **3. Sunjays Georgia Peach** (Hellman) Elegant blenheim, dark eye and pigment, well set neck, good bone, firm level topline, good rear, showed very well, nice balance on the move. **4. Nightingale Kismet At Kyneslane, JW** (Paplauckas) Blenheim with large dark round eyes. Nose pigment not as good as ones above. Lovely expression, liked her size and overall balance, in good coat and condition, moved and showed very well.

Veteran Bitch (1)

1. Ch Chadwick Bewitched At Blackfire (Kennedy/Weidig) Blenheim, pretty head with round dark eyes, good pigment and was in nice condition. Carried a level topline and moved nicely both going and coming. **Best Veteran in Show**
