Ellisana Jupiter** (Tyler) Well made dog, good head and expression, clear eye nice and round. Good front and shoulder, nice shape body. Coat a bit on the fly. Moved well. A difficult decision between 1 and 2. **3. Legacy Born to be Wild** (Lindemaier) Rich markings and good eye shape. Level back, front a bit narrow, but moved well, good real angulation. **4. Royalmark Aisle of Innisfree** (Tegg/McCoy) Nice overall, solid markings, nice shoulder, short level back, moved okay.

Senior Puppy Dog (4)

1. Lillium Autumn Flight of Fancy (Almeida/Atkins) Very nicely made Tri. Good expression, long ears. Nicely arched neck, good lay of shoulder, square dog. Level back, good rear angulation, good tail set, moved very well. *Best Puppy Dog*

2. Delta Rose Teodoro (Fennel/McCoy) Nice eye, head coming along nicely, good front, level back, good spring of rib. Moved well enough. **3. Bonitos Companeras Dom Perignon** (Paulson) Lightly marked Blenheim. Straight front, nice ear set, in very good condition. **4. Phantom Peaks Sir Winston Churchill** (Hennington) Handsome boy, nice eye, long ears, well broken markings, moved a bit close behind.

Graduate Puppy Dog (2)

1. Laughing Louie Louie (Hughes) Nice broad head, dark eye, good shoulder plenty of chest room, moved well. **2. Sikeleli Monet at Quail Run** (Kornhi) Very handsome boy, lovely ears, straight front, top line raises over the loin. Good coming, not the rear angulation I would like.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (1)

1. Riverview Cool Hand Luke (Barrois) Full headed, dark eye, good bite, nicely arched neck and a parallel front. Moving toward me he was toeing in, but moved away well. Firm body, slack shoulder, good rear end.

American Bred Dog (4)

1. Quail Garden Tad O Magic (Barrett/Geller/Mittleman/Subramanian) All round very nice dog, handsome lad, good eye shape and colour, straight front, good tight shoulder, short, level back, good spring of rib, strong loin, good rear end, moved well. 2. CanCh Quail Run Royal Colonial (McCarver/Kornhi) Another very handsome boy, long ears, dark, round eye, good neck and shoulder, firm bodied, strong rear end and moved well. 3. Briarcrest Star Chaser, JW (Mitchell) Excitable boy, nice head, had enough neck, good body and angulation, moved well. 4. CanCh Quail Run Hearts Aloft (Forbes/Bevis) Blenheim boy with the longed for lozenge. Good bite, a bit stuffy

around the shoulders and a bit loose. Might use a bit of road work. Firm body.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (4) This class was excellent. The first and second probably change places every time they show.

1. Beckwith There's Only One (Smith) Well proportioned head, dark round eye with good pigmentation. Nice arch to the neck, good tight shoulders, Richly coloured coat, good spring of rib with a good strong back. Good rear angulation, moved well. *Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Best in Show, Best American Bred in Show, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show*

2. Pascavle Nathan (Cline) Everything above applies to this boy as well. Lacking nothing, showed like a dream, had a good tail-set. **3. Maibee Perfect Pitch** (Mayfield/Wornall) Lovely large eye, dark and well pigmented. Ears well set and long, good arched neck, level back with a good shoulder, rich chestnut coat, and a good mover. **4. Cinderlace Sheer Milkeyn** (Jones) A very nice boy, had to meet the others in such good form, never let himself down, good conformation, good tail set moved very well.

Special Limit Tricolour Dog (1)

1. Blewis V. H. Lamslag at Grandville (Grandemange) Stood alone but would win in good company anyway. Handsome boy, dark eye with good expression, long ears, good length of neck, tight shoulders well angulated, level back, good angle of stifle, moved well coming and going.

Special Limit Ruby Dog (5)

Little Knight Truffle (Tyler) Nice size Ruby, well balanced head, darkest eyes, good neck strong front well angulated shoulder, firm body with good rear angulation. *Best Ruby in Show 2.* Tanglewood Rebellion (Saban/Fairchild) Next size up from #1, but super coat colour, well presented, dark round eye, good ear set, moved very well. 3. Grandville Paddington Bear, JW (Grandemange) Super temperament, good proportions, dark round eye, level back, good rear angulation and moved well. 4. Kellene Barnaby Jones (Carter) Large dark eye, needs to fill in under the eye, good ear leathers, firm body, moved okay.

Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (2)

1. Cockney Rebel of Woodville at Grandville (Grandemange) Nicely formed head, good rich tan, dark eyes, parallel front, good neck, tight shoulders, level back, good tail set, moved very well. *Best Black & Tan in Show 2.* Legacy Winchester (Lindemaier) Appealing expression, darkest of eyes, good front, nice body length, good rear angulation, needs to tighten up on his pasterns, was a bit down on them today.

Open Dog (3)

1. Ch Pascavale Stefano, JW (Cline) Full of breed type, lovely expression, dark brown eye, well cushioned face, good front, shoulders tight to the chest, level back, great tail set, very well angulated rear, moved to perfection. *Winners Dog, Best in Show, Best Blenheim in Show*

2. Deeriem Cosmopolitan Man at Quail Run (Kornhi) Handsome looking boy. Dark round eye, good pigment, long straight ears, good front, well ribbed, good rear end and he moved well. **3. Ch Rockcreek Baccarat** (Steagall) Overall nice outline, well set ears, good neck, level back and moved well.

Senior Open Dog (1)

1. CanCh Legacy Crsmatic Reflection (Stevens) In very good condition, soft expression, dark round eye, good ear leathers, good neck and shoulder, good rear end, moved very well for a Sr. Dog.

Junior.Puppy Bitch (5)

1. Mayfield Miracle at Broberry (Thornberry-Brogan/Mayfield) Mature for her age, coming along nicely, pretty head, dark eye, super neck, level back good angulation, moved well. 2. Quail Run Royal Renaissance (Kornhi) Very pretty baby with good conformation, straight front, well balanced head, good bone, and moved well. 3. Quail Run Cosmic Candy (Kornhi) This girl will be nice when she comes together, just a bit rangy at the moment, another pretty head, darkest of eyes, good neck, good rear-end, moved well. 4. Quail Run Royal Celebration (Kornhi) Well handled, with the handler working very hard, nice confirmation, well assembled and moved well. Senior Puppy Bitch (5)

2. Beckwith Brown Eyed Girl (Smith) A very classy baby, great in outline, dark eye good neck, strong in shoulder developing nicely, level back, front and back angulation good, flopped a bit when moving. **3. Sonesta Patience** (Ellingson) Good honest bitch, good head, dark eye, arched neck, level back and moved well. **4. Grandville Emmanuelle** (Grandmange) Another tri a bit on the long side at the moment. Spring of rib and her chest dropping might change the outline as she matures. Broad head, dark brown eye, strong neck, good shoulder, moved well **Graduate Puppy Bitch (3)**

1. Crizwood A Minute at Mayfield (Mayfield/Wornall) This Blenheim girl presented a very nice overall picture, well developed head, dark eye, good ear leathers, straight front, good neck level back firm shoulder, good chest and rib. Well set rear stifle, moved very well. 2. Pensrick Black Powder Ace (Liebler/Fellows) B & T Sweet girl, nice size, darkest of eyes, good neck with a level back, good rear angulation and moved well. 3. Delta Rose High Society (Wendorff) Pretty Blenheim, good head proportions, dark around eyes, good neck with a level topline, good rear end, just a little loose in the front.

Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (4)

1. Covington This Kiss (Mohn) Very well made Blenheim. Very pretty has a well proportioned head, nice round eye, super ears, neck flowing into the shoulder, nicely level back, good bone, strong rear end, moved well, just a slight toeing in coming back. *Reserve Winners Bitch*

2. Legacy Puttin on the Ritz (Lindemaier) Another well made Blenheim, prettiest of heads, long ear leathers, good neck and shoulder, well made rear end, moved with drive. 3. Harrington Pardon my French (Gonyo) Strong Blenheim bitch, plenty of her, head and ears framed well, good neck, strong back, firm rear end, and moved precisely. 4. Thandie's Grand Marnier (Forbes/Bevis) Blenheim. Good ear leathers, dark round eye, carrying a bit of weight over her shoulder, but she has a strong back, good stifle, moved away okay, but was loose coming back. Junior American Bred Bitch (3)

1. Quail Run the Avenger (Kornhi) Won this on her super conformation. Very pretty dark round eye, nice ear leather, super neck, level back, nice colouring, good bend of stifle, moved steady. 2. Cailloux Fire Dancer (Lawson) Nicely headed bitch, large eye with good pigment, straight front, good shoulder angulation, shade longer than #1 but moved very well. 3. Cedar Creek Miles of Style (Owens) Heavier in type. Cute head with dark eyes, showing her heart out, plenty of coat, a shade loose in front, good chest and ribs, nice back end, moved okay.

American Bred Bitch (2)

1. Mimric Marilyn Moonroe, JW (Hodges/Perkins) Blenheim. Very close in this class, just preferred the softer expression, nice in head, dark round eye, black nose pigment, long ears tumbled off the head, smooth neck line to shoulder, level back, nice compact size. Good rear end and tail set. **2. Quail Run April in Paris at Cuddlemore** (Moulton) Blenheim Plenty of ear leather to the head. Large dark round eye, enough neck, firm back, good tail set deep chest and good rib. Moved well

Special Limit Tricolor Bitch (1)

1. Hathersage Irish Rose (Gonyo/Fowler) Well made Tri, good tan pigment, dark round eye, long ear leather, good neck and shoulder, level back, straight front, well angulated shoulder and rear, moved away well, but toed in coming back

Special Limit Ruby Bitch (1)

1. Pensrick Cherry Jubilee (Liebler/Fellows) Ruby with a dark, large eye, good neck, good in shoulder, plenty of chest and rib, good bone, one of the best movers today.

Special Limit Black & Tan Bitch (1)

1. Pensrick Legacy Poison Ivy (Lindemaier) Sweet Black & Tan, cute head, well proportioned, dark eye, nice ear leather in silky condition, never stopped wagging her tail moved with energy.

Open Bitch (1)

1. Ch Aranel With Love, JW (Foster) Pretty Blenheim bitch with a lovely head and good proportions. Long ear leather, good tightly tucked in shoulder, parallel front, neat neck with a level back, good rear end, sadly moving wide in front.
