Firstly I should like to thank Cavaliers of the West for the honour to Judge your Cavaliers. I couldn't have been made more welcome and enjoyed my day with some really lovely Cavaliers. Thank you also to the exhibitors for accepting my decisions in such a sporting manner, which is in fact the "norm" wherever one is judging our lovely breed. My overall impression of the Breed today was one of general satisfaction as regards to size and type, and I was delighted with my class winners. Breeders need to be a little more aware of the standard for bite which clearly says full scissor bite and some exhibits just about made that. One other important point in my mind is EYE, and here as in other countries we must be aware of the white of eye which has crept into the Breed, and which to my mind can totally spoil the expression.

### **Junior Puppy Dog (5)**

**1. Lilycroft Little Knight Madeir** (Tyler/Karcher) Ruby boy correct size and proportions with excellent dark eye, soft expression and moved soundly both ways. **2. Legacy Stand By Me** (Lindemaier/Goodwin) Bl boy, nice cobby and well made, nicely balanced in outline, good head and moving correctly. **3. Dulce Lucky Charm** (Covell) Younger Bl boy (baby in class), however was good size, well put together, sweet head, and moved well. **4. Jalesto Super Trooper** (Gentil) Ruby boy, correct proportions and balance, and moved well.

### **Senior Puppy Dog (2)**

**1. Royalmark Crystal Blue Persuasion** (Barrett) Well made Bl toy spaniel of excellent proportions, lovely angulation. With correct head and lovely dark eye and sweet expression, he covered the ground with drive and such ease, one to watch in the future, and I finally awarded him Reserve Winners Dog. **Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show, Reserve Winners Dog, Best Blenheim Dog.**

**2. DarkStar's International Incident** (Reiley-Lince/Lince) B/Tan boy little bigger than winner however he had good dark eye and a nice expression, his front movement today not his best asset.

### **Bred By Exhibitor Dog (3)**

**1. Ch Beckwith Theres Only One** (Smith) 4 ½ old Bl. Boy, nice balance and outline, lovely large dark eye with soft expression, good mouth and moved well. **2. Legacy Raising The Bar** (Lindemaier) Bl, nice size, not the reach of neck as first, however he has nice expression, good level topline and moved correctly. **3. Ch Autumnhill Ring Of Fire, JW** (Parente) Ruby boy, not quite the balance in outline, he has good dark eye, with nice expression, and moved well.

### **Junior American Bred Dog (1)**

**1. Lyncrest Up To No Good** (Jones) 10 month old Bl boy, correct size and balance, good front and nice rear angulation, sweet head and expression and moved correctly. Nice young boy.

### **American Bred Dog (1)**

**1. Legacy Lastat** (LIndemaier) 2 year old, cobby, well balanced, nice head and expression, good topline, carrying himself well with confidence on a slightly looser lead!

### **Special Limit Blenheim Dog (3)**

**1. Canyoncrest Star Blazer, JW** (DuRoss) Bl boy with nice head, dark eye and nice expression, good spring of rib and nice level topline, good angulation giving plenty of drive. Level bite. **2. Ellisiana Jupiter** (Tyler) Bl boy, well presented with lovely coat quality, did not have the same male head of winner, he was correctly made and moved well. Again bite not best asset. **3. Phantom Peaks Sir Winston Churchill** (Henington) Bl boy, well balanced and nice size, still needs a little more in head for me and not giving of his best on the move today. Bite again not great.

### **Special Limit Tricolor Dog (2)**

**1. Veribas Point Break** (Cusick) 3 year old Tri, beautifully made overall, nicely marked, lovely size with excellent head and full soft expression, so well put balanced and put together with correct front and good rear angulation which needlessly to say showed when he moved, as he covered the ground with such drive and confidence. I could

not pass him in the challenge and finally awarded him Winners Dog and Best in Show. **Winners Dog, Best in Show, Best Tricolor in Show, Best American Bred in Show, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show**

**2. Legacy Bentlane's My Precious** (Benton/Linddmaier) 3 year old Tri boy of excellent size, lovely head, just a little heavier in head than my winner but a lovely soft gentle expression, lovely body well made and moving correctly.

#### **Special Limit Ruby Dog (2)**

**1. Little Knight Truffle** (Tyler) Ruby boy, lovely cobby and nicely balanced dog with excellent lovely head, dark eye and soft expression, so important in a ruby. Very good front and excellent angulation which gave him plenty of drive and excellent movement. **Best Ruby in Show** **2. Kabaret Double Take That Red** (Lindemaier) 14 month old Ruby, again good size but a little longer cast than winner, nice colour, good dark eye and nice expression, moved well.

#### **Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (3)**

**1. Darane Smooth Criminal at Nightingale** (Mulligan) B/T boy beautifully presented in full coat, cobby in size, good outline and nice angulation, excellent male head with dark eye and lovely soft expression, correct bite. He moved so well, and in fact reminded me of my very first B/T. **Best Black & Tan in Show** **2. Brookhaven Bob Bailey** (Schilling) Similar in size and outline to winner, just preferred the expression of the winner, again he had a lovely dark full eye, excellent coat and moving freely and with ease. **3. Legacy Winchester** (Lindemaier) Slightly larger in size, not the overall balance of other two, however he was well put together and moved correctly.

#### **Open Dog (3)**

**1. Ch Benchmark Up In The Air of Onthemark** (Chan/Mitchell) Bl boy with good head, dark eye and good mouth, nice cobby balanced body with good movement both to and fro. **2. Ch Turretbank Beaujolais** (Green) Ruby boy not quite as well balanced and size of winner, however has nice Ruby head with soft dark eye and expression, good quality coat, nice level topline carried well on the move. A little on the serious side today with no wagging tail to complete the picture, otherwise could change places at any time. **3. Deeriem Cosmopolitan Man at Quail Run** (Kornhi) Bl boy nicely balanced overall, a little heavier in head for me, however he has good dark eye and nice expression. Not giving of his best moving today.

#### **Senior Open Dog (1)**

**1. CanCh Legacy Crsmatic Reflection** (Stevens) 11 year old Bl boy of lovely size, cobby and well balanced overall, has nice head with good dark eye and correct expression. Can show some of the youngsters how to move.

#### **Junior Puppy Bitch (3)**

**1. Darane Jezebel** (Kates) 7 month old Tri baby, nicely marked, sweet expression and dark eye, good mouth, and moved well both ways. **2. Legacy Hell On Wheels of Kendall Kastle** (Ogle/Lindemaier) Lovely sized Bl. Compact and well balanced, with good head dark eye and nice expression, little between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> and can change places anytime. **3. Dulce Salt Water Taffy** (Covell) Bl, the baby in this class, just needs a little more time to fill under eye, nice size, and moving well

#### **Senior Puppy Bitch (5)**

**1. Cedar Creek Isa Jewel** (Owens) Bl quality lady beautiful in size, balance and outline, with lovely head full dark eye and expression, so happy to show herself off as she moved with such confidence and ease around the ring. **Best Puppy Bitch**

**2. Chadwick Papparazzi, JW** (Matos) Bl girl with sweet expression and lovely head with dark eye, very little between winner, but preferred the movement today of the winner. **3. Windnsea Party Girl** (Sutton) Bl girl slightly smaller in size and a little longer cast, nice reach of neck, good head and expression, and moved well. **4. Greyhawk Rumor Has It at Del Sol** (McHenry) A baby needing more time, nice size good topline, and moving well.

#### **Novice Bitch (1)**

**1. Nottinghill Kiss Me Kate** (Barnfather) 2 year old Tri, heavily marked, good eye with slight blemish on face which loses expression, small cobby, and could do with a little more drive on the move.

#### **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch (2)**

**1. Royalmark April's Aisle of Hope** (McCoy) Cobby, nice size with good outline and balance, dark eye and lovely expression, quality coat, and moved very well. **Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Bred By Exhibitor Bitch**

**2. Truluv Pirouette** (Nikaci) Bl girl of lovely size, with good eye and expression, not moving or showing her best today.

**Junior American Bred Bitch (2)**

**1. Huntingridge Ruff Velvet** (Lindemaier) Bl. Small in size, nicely put together, nice head and good bite, moved well. **2. Pinecrest Mountain Dew** (Rosenberg) Bl. Not as well balanced as winner, but however had good eye, nice pigment, and moved well

**American Bred Bitch (3)**

**1. Cedar Creek Miles of Style** (Owens) Lovely Bl girl with full dark eye giving sweet expression, good mouth, excellent conformation, nicely marked and carrying herself with level topline and plenty of drive. **2. Jayba Tiramisu** (Lyman) Bl girl a little longer cast than winner, with very little between, so could change places anytime. **3. Quail Run Cosmic Candy** (Kornhi) Bl girl slightly smaller, needing a little more reach of neck to give the balance and complete the outline., however had good eye sweet expression, and moved well.

**Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (3)**

**1. Callioux Fire Dancer** (Lawson) Compact, well made and nicely marked with sweet expression, good size and moved soundly and with drive. *Winners Bitch, Reserve Best in Show, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Blenheim in Show, Best American Bred Bitch*

**2. Loranka's Sweet Seraphim at Cuddlemore** (Moulton) Sweet Bl similar in size to winner, but not as good in topline, has good eye and nice expression, moving with not quite the drive as winner. **3. Legacy Puttin On The Ritz** (Lindemaier) Bl. Cobby size, would prefer a little more neck to complete the overall balance, however nice lady with sweet expression and moving well.

**Special Limit Tricolor Bitch (1)**

**1. Legacy Temptation** (Lindemaier) 4 year old Tri lady, lovely size, nicely marked, with lovely dark eye, sweet expression, moving correctly with plenty of confidence. *Best Tricolor Bitch*

**Special Limit Ruby Bitch (1)**

**1. Little Strawberry Cream** (Tyler) 4 year old Ruby, nice compact well balanced overall, with sweet soft expression, well angulated and moved soundly and correctly. *Best Ruby Bitch*

**Special Limit Black & Tan Bitch (1)**

**1. Pensrick Ace Of Spades** (Lockleer/Liebeler) 2 year old, nice size, sweet feminine expression, lovely size with nice topline and moved correctly and with confidence. *Best Black & Tan Bitch*

**Open Bitch (1)**

**1. Quail Run The Avenger** (Kornhi) 2 year old Bl, still a little immature and out of coat, was surprised to see her in Open, however she has nice head, good dark eye, sweet expression. Needs a little more time to mature, she moved well and with confidence.
