A good mover that showed well, just lost out on maturity for top honours. Award of Merit 2. Quail Garden Lochlomond Deja Vu (Mittelman) Short coupled Blenheim who is a lovely type, pleasing head and eye, good top line, in nice coat, moved and showed well. 3. Barrowmore Ivyline It's a Me Wegee (Giampapa) Nicely marked Blenheim with an appealing head, needs to body up to complete the picture. 4. Dancasa Cute As A Button, JW (Tiedmann) Nice type Blenheim with a lovely head and eye, moved okay and showed well.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (5)

Pascavale Nathan (Cline) Beautiful typey Blenheim with lots of ring presence, dark eyes, well cushioned fore face, good ears, lovely neck and top line, a little more body needed to complete the picture. A good mover that showed well. 2.
