Dreamvale Tri Your Luck (Parker) Tricolor. Sound mover with good drive. Well balanced. 3. Darane Suddenly Seymour (Kates) Blenheim. Correct head type, well balanced, another sound mover. 4. Elyzian Double Take (Arnold) B&T. Another great mover, sound and well balanced. Would like a bigger eye.

### Senior Puppy Dog (6)

- 1. Chewcreek Three Amigos Dusty Bottoms (DePhillip) Blenheim. I love this little guy. Perfect in so many ways, size head eyes expression balance movement... he's adorable. One of my favorite exhibits of the day. Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show
- **2. Jayba Easy Does It** (Lander) Blenheim. Well balanced, excellent mover. I liked the bigger eyes on #1. **3. Toraylac Desperado** (Rychlik) Blenheim. Great temperament. 2. Autumnhill Spencer, JW (Weinstein/Parente) With a little more finish this little guy will do some winning. He's lovely, correct movement, lots of drive, perfectly balanced, love his head and expression. Still a puppy, did not have quite the overall finish of #1. 3. Tanglewood Rebellion (Saban/Fairchild) Shown in gorgeous coat and condition, another that moved out with drive. Level topline, great temperament. Not the layback of shoulder at the 1<sup>st</sup> two and his nose was a little pale today. 4. Blackfire Aquavit N Bordeaux (Lauve) Beautiful dark Ruby pigment, moved out well, well balanced. A little too thin today and his head a bit overdone for me.

### Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (4) Lovely class.

- 1. Mileslip Licorice, JW (Skidmore) One of the strongest movers of the day. Moved out on correctly made rear quarters. Shown in gorgeous coat and condition, love his head and expression. Level topline. Best Black & Tan in Show 2. Darane Leonardo Da Vinci at Nebyula (Birbeck) Pleasing outline, level topline, correct coming and going. Handsome head and expression, well-muscled with gorgeous coat. A bit longer in loin. 3. Brookhaven Bob Bailey (Schilling) Moved right out on strong rear quarters, short in loin, lovely head piece. Lots of cute attitude. Did not hold his topline going around the ring today. 4. Lynsfaire Country Gentleman (Hallsted) Another nice mover, good coming and going. Pleasing head, great temperament. - 2. Ch Castlekeep Cimaron Triplecrown Panache (Keane/Brouck) Blenheim. Another ideal size, good movement, attractive head and expression. Shown in super coat and condition. Moved out with drive. 3. Ch Bonitos Companeros Halli Galli (Eubank/Kirschbaum/Vorderstrasse/Morrison) Blenheim. Eyes and expression most breeders only dream about. Shown in gorgeous coat and condition, moved out with drive and level topline. 4. Ch Chadwick Scotch On The Rocks at Hudsonview, JW (Yassky/Glynn) Blenheim. Another strong, well-muscled mover. Level topline, correct coming and going. Super attitude. His blenheim pigment lighter than others in the class, but a gorgeous dog just the same.

Chadwick Rhumba** (Lauve/Eckersley) Blenheim. The most distinguished of the three, fourteen

years old and showing competitors half his age how it's done. I love his eyes and the gorgeous gray on his face. He moved right out with a level topline, happy and genteel. Just out of coat today.

Junior Puppy Bitch (10) These we're high 10 quality exhibits, all these little girls were absolutely delicious.

- **1. Nightingale Gold Digger** (Mulligan) Blenheim. Could have eaten her with a spoon. Correct head, short back, well-balanced, great bone. Moved right out with super movement. Loved her expression. Nicely marked with dark blenheim pigment. *Best Puppy Bitch*
- 2. Piccadil Destined To Be Rich (York) Blenheim. Another darling. Adorable expression, well-balanced, moved right out with level topline. Sound and well-muscled. Good coming and going. 3. Lickitysplit Maybe I'm Amazed (Geoghegan) Blenheim. Another correct head, lovely large dark eyes. Super temperament. Dark blenheim pigment, moved out with drive and level topline. 4.
