DOGS

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1. CHADWICK PERFECT TONIGHT (Eckersley) Blenheim - a lovely puppy with a large round eye, high ear set and slightly domed skull. He was sound coming and going & pretty on the go around. At just six months of age he is in a growth spurt and a touch high in the rear. A very promising puppy. [BEST PUPPY DOG](#)

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4)

1. CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley) Blenheim - a lovely young dog of just a year of age. Lovely head, ear set, eye shape and length of muzzle. He carried his topline level with good depth of chest along with a lovely arched neck. A beautiful shape with lovely carriage and sound movement showing reach and drive and clean on the down and back. Graced with a Blenheim Spot to top it off. [RESERVE WINNERS DOG](#)

2. NORTHPOINTE LETS START A REVOLUTION (Mitchum) Blenheim - A lovely balanced head, good ear set and level topline. Front and rear angulation in balance and proper tail set and carriage. Very nice on the move both coming and going and side gait.

3. GENTLE STAR UNFORGETTABLE DREAM (Gentil) Blenheim - a slightly heavier head that would be softened with an eye not quite so prominent and less white showing. He carried a lovely arched neck and a level topline. He moved soundly on the down and back as well as showing reach and drive on the go around.

4. NIGHTINGALE HELLO GOODBYE (Mulligan) Blenheim - nicely balanced head, pretty round eye, lovely arched neck. Carries a prominent prosternum thus his front is carried too far forward. This resulted in moving slightly wide both coming and going.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (1)

1. CH ORCHARD HILL OVERANALYZED (Venier/Venier) - Tri - nice domed skull and high ear set, he has an off square body, good depth of chest and nice well sprung ribs. **BEST TRI DOG**

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (3)

1. CHARMARIAN HEARTTHROB (Young-May/Gogol) Blenheim - my first note I wrote while judging was " he is melting me!" Such a lustrous, limpid look. Beautiful dark round eye set well apart, a balanced head overall, balanced front and rear angulations made him clean moving on the down and back and displaying reach and drive on the go around. He never put a foot down wrong. An off square body and in beautiful condition. Lovely arch of neck. He was confident, elegant, a true Spaniel. **BEST IN SHOW, WINNERS DOG, BEST AMERICAN BRED, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR & BEST BLENHEIM**

2. NORTHPOINTE SEQUINED BROGUE (Mitchum) Blenheim - Beautiful expression, high ear set, ears have lovely, lush furnishings. He carries a level topline and a beautiful coat. Nice mover as well with sound side gait.

3. CEILIMOR DRESS CODE (McCarty/Eckersley) Blenheim – Pretty, balanced head, correct ear set and length of muzzle with a pretty eye. Would desire a stronger topline. He looks young with some developing to come with age. Clean moving on the down and back.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1. CARLEN TINY TIM TATER TOT (Close) Blenheim - a nice head and correct ear set along with a nice round dark eye. Sadly, he was not co-operating on the lead making it nearly impossible to judge movement.

OPEN DOG (3)

1. CH FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDOR (Mixon/Mixon/ Cline/Marshall) Blenheim - best body shape in this class off square and balanced overall. Lovely head, correct length of muzzle, lovely round dark eye, beautiful ears and ear set. A sound clean mover.

2. CH. PROMONTORY HERE COMES HUDSON (Orns/Solomon) Blenheim - lovely cushion under the eye. Correct ear set, level topline and a sound mover. I'd like to see a bit more arch of neck. The chest is moderately deep with nice spring of rib.

3. CH. FALLING SPRINGS BLACK FLAME AT MADRYN (Weeks/Weeks/Curley) Black and Tan - a bit heavier in the head and muzzle but it fit this dog. He is a very masculine boy. Nice dark eye. Rich tan markings on this Black and Tan. Free moving and carried his topline level. Good substance and spring of rib. **[BEST BLACK AND TAN DOG](#)**

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (2)

1. HUDSONVIEW CRAZY DIAMOND (Glynn) Blenheim - Correct head, nice cushioning, pretty eye, high ear set, correct length of muzzle. Clean on the down and back and displayed nice reach and drive moving. Just six months old showing a lot of promise. **[BEST PUPPY IN SHOW & BEST PUPPY BITCH IN SHOW](#)**

2. KOFAS AFTER ALL THIS TIME (Barr) Blenheim - Nice dark round eye. Pretty arched neck. This baby is going through a growth spurt carrying her rear a bit high. Her head is changing shape with a slight upturn of muzzle with a lot of under jaw. Such a hard time at just 9 months of age with everything changing.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

1. GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA (Gentil) Ruby - pretty head with nice cushioning, high set ear, beautiful arched neck, balanced angulation front and rear. She could go level then go slightly high in the rear when standing but always level on the move. Clean moving on the down and back and has pretty side gait. A teenager with a lot of promise. **[BEST RUBY IN SHOW & BEST RUBY BITCH IN SHOW](#)**

2. NORTHPOINTE BOSTON TEA PARTY (Mitchum) Blenheim - a slightly broad skull but with a pretty dark round eye and jet-black pigment. Correct length of arched neck, she moved nicely in the front, slightly close in the rear. Another promising youngster that is growing into her angles.

3. KINGDOMRUN SPRING MAGNOLIA (Degen/Degen/Mixon) Blenheim - such a pretty head and expression on this girl. Balanced head, correct ear set, lovely eye and length of muzzle. She carried a level topline. Not as balanced moving as other placements.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1. FALLING SPRINGS ROSE OF SHARON AT JEMANDA (Weinstein) Ruby - nice rich red color, dark round eye and jet black pigment. This girl wanted to pull on the lead and when not pulling she wanted to race around the ring thus making it hard to judge movement.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

1. CH. CLARMARIAN AFFAIRS OF THE HEART (McFarland/Young May/Gogol) Blenheim - This girl is so pretty, with that lustrous, limpid look. Very balanced head shape, body shape, balanced angulation. Lovely on the down and back as well as the go around. Beautiful head with gorgeous furnishings framing her face. Very nice length of arched neck. Simply a lovely bitch. **RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, WINNERS BITCH, BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH, BEST BRED BY BITCH & BEST BLENHEIM BITCH**

2. CH. TASSAJARA JALAPENO PEPPER (Seidman/Seidman) Blenheim - also a lovely girl. Correct head with nice cushioning under the eye and a high ear set. Body is off square with a level topline. Sound on the move both down and back and on the go around.

3. CH. DARANE OTHERWORLDLY (Kates) Blenheim - a slightly heavier head with a lower ear set but with fabulous furnishings and a nice dark eye. She is slightly longer in upper arm than in her shoulder layback thus not as good on the move as my other two placements but over all a nice girl in a very competitive class.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

1. NORTHPOINTE SEQUINED PARTY SHOES (Mitchum) Blenheim - a balanced headpiece with a pretty, lustrous round eye. She carries a level topline free standing and on the

move. Lovely coming and going and displayed beautiful reach and drive on the go around. In very nice condition coat and muscle tone. **RESERVE WINNERS BITCH**

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

1. VALENTYNE NOTORIOUS AT SUNJAYS (Hellman/O'Brien) Blenheim - very elegant girl with the sweetest expression, lovely head and eye, correct ear set and length of muzzle. Beautiful coat. Lovely arched neck and just off square. Pretty on the go around. A strong contender.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

1. GENTLE STAR NEVERENDING STORY (Barr) Blenheim - Nice shape being off square, moderate angles with nice reach and drive. Lovely balanced head, correct eye and ear set. I'd like to see a bit more length and arch of her neck. The best mover of this class.

2. KINGDOMRUN GENESIS OF AN EMERALD DREAM (Degen/Degen) Blenheim - nice head with pretty dark eye and good cushioning. Nice side gait with reach and drive.

3. CHADWICK WISHFUL THINKING (Eckersley) Blenheim - Her head not as pleasing as her competition with a little too much lip. But with a pretty dark round eye and jet black nose pigment. She is off square and with nice substance. I'd like more arch to her neck which has an effect on her front movement.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (2)

1. CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley) - Tri - balanced head, pretty dark round eye, ears to die for with lush furnishings that frame her face. Balanced angulation and carries a level topline. Very nicely marked jet-black markings and rich tan.

2. WINDKISS SUMMER LOVIN (Kates/Patkowski) - Tri - lovely head, and high ear set. Just a year old and I think currently in a growth spurt as she can go high in the rear but has pretty reach and drive side gait. A promising youngster.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (1)

1. MYRNAC TINA TURNER TO SHERAH (Cromett/Reid) Black and Tan - Rich tan markings. Nice dark round eye with a correct ear set. Good substance and depth of chest. She is off square and has balanced angulation both front and rear. ***BEST BLACK AND TAN IN SHOW & BEST BLACK AND TAN BITCH IN SHOW***

OPEN BITCH (4)

1. CH. CHADWICK FOXY COUTURE AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn) Blenheim - a solid body on this off square girl. Very pretty balanced head piece, nice dark round eye, proper length of muzzle and correct high ear set. Lustrous expression. Moves clean on the down and back and has a correct side gait.

2. CH. CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART (Young-May/Gogol) Blenheim - A beautiful head piece with a dark round eye and well cushioned with the desired limpid expression, so pretty. She tends to carry a dip in her topline when standing but then she levels out on the move.

3. CH. FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY (Curley) Blenheim - This girl is off square shape with a level topline. She carries a nice length neck with a pretty arch. of arched neck. She has a nice front but could use a touch more bend in stifle.

4. KINGDOMRUN RUN FOR THE JULIP (Degen/Degen/Mixon) Blenheim - Lovely dark eye with beautiful ear furnishings. Nice length of neck with elegant arch. A nice mover but too long in body and length of loin.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

1. DARANE TRUE COLORS (Kates) Black & Tan - Solid body on this black and tan girl, sound moving, nice head and eye shape, she is off square and at 9 1/2 years of age she is still carrying a dead level topline.

VETERAN BITCH (1)

1. CH. DARANE RED SONJA (Kates) Ruby - 15 years young! And still holding a level topline! Nice head, good ear set and this old gal is dead sound coming and going and on the go around. ***BEST VETERAN IN SHOW & BEST VETERAN BITCH IN SHOW***
