A special thank you to everyone on the committee who worked so hard to put on these shows. I also want to thank the exhibitors for bringing me such nice dogs to judge. I thought that the quality of the dogs was exceptionally good and there were several that could have won top honors. There were several of these young dogs that should have an exciting future. The eyes were really good on almost all the dogs, nice, round and dark. We do need to be aware of all the bad bites. I saw more bad bites than the last time I judged, but overall I think the dogs are improving.

Junior Puppy Dog (6)

1. Jalesoto Super Trooper (Gentil) This 7 month old ruby boy caught my eye when he walked into the ring. This boy flowed around the ring like he had been showing forever. He had a dead level topline with a good front and rear and a correct tail set with a nice shiny coat. He had a lovely head and large dark eyes and a correct bite. He should have an exciting future. I was glad to give him this class. **2. Windnsea Starbucks** (Sutton) A 5 month old puppy who was showing like a show dog. Lovely blenheim boy with a shining coat. He moved well and looked good coming and going. He had a well-proportioned body with good height to length balance. He was well presented and showed well. Another boy with a promising future. **3. Tomnee's Would You Look** (Wise) An 8 month old tri puppy with a lot of promise. Good for size with an attractive head. He was heavy marked with a nice coat. I loved watching him move around the ring with a level topline. He also had a very nice rear and front. **4. Charnell Tomfoolery** (Gentil) This tri puppy had a heavy marked coat in great condition. He had one of the prettiest heads in this class with lovely dark eyes, correct ear set which framed his face to make a lovely picture.

Senior Puppy Dog (5)

1. Melrose Gold For Bonitos Companeros (Magera/Mitchell) This nice Ruby boy had a beautiful head, it was very soft and full with lovely dark round eyes. He had very nice rich color with a lovely coat and was groomed to perfection. He looked lovely going around the ring with a nice topline. He should really mature nicely and have a promising future. **2. Toraylac Desperado** (Rychlik) This blenheim boy had very nice overall construction. He had lovely movement with a good front and rear who also moved well going around the ring. He had a nice head with nice dark eyes and a well broken color with a nice coat. **3. Aubinwood Barkley** (Henderson/Gibson) Another Blenheim boy with well broken color and a nice coat. He was a perfect size with a lovely head, good eyes and nicely set ears which framed his face. **4. Dreamvale Olivander** (Sage/Hallsted) A larger Blenheim boy that moved very well with a good topline. He had lots of coat with well broken color. He was a very nice puppy who should do well in the future.

Graduate Puppy Dog (7)

1. Bonitos Companeros Kaleo at Diorchavon (Bialek) I loved this boy as soon as he came into the ring. He is very much my type, a lovely Blenheim boy with an elegant shape. He had nice reach of neck and shoulder layback flowing into a level topline that made him able to move around the ring with ease. He showed like he owned the ring, not only was he well structured, he had a lovely head with just the right amount of fill. He had nice dark round eyes that we look for in our cavaliers. His coat was lovely and in great condition. I loved this boy and was happy to give him *Best Puppy Dog in Sweepstakes*.

2. Infinidad Grandville Te Amo (Grandemange) A 17 month old black and tan boy with a beautiful head with pleasing expression. Good overall shape with correct topline and tailset. He had a lovely coat and showed well for his owner. He should have a great future. **3. Picketfence Moonlight Kiss** (Frey) This Blenheim boy had a lovely balanced head with flat skull, high set ears and lovely dark eyes. He moved well around the ring with a level topline. He also had a nice front and rear and was shown in great condition. **4. Chadwick Snow Drift at Woodbury** (Redniss) A very nice Blenheim boy with a lovely head, nice dark eyes and a lovely ear set. He had lots of lovely coat and was presented beautifully. He showed well and moved nicely. Overall a very nice dog.

Junior Puppy Bitch (13)

1. Piccadil Destined To Be Rich (York) This lovely 5 month Blenheim girl had a lovely coat with well broken color. She had an adorable face with nice dark round eyes. She showed well and looks good on the move. She stands showing a perfect outline and was in tune with her owner. She had a good length of neck and a level topline with correct tailset. **2. Darane Jezebel** (Glasgow/Kates) A lovely tri girl with the prettiest of heads and a soft expression. She had a lovely well broken coat with nice ears which framed her beautiful face. She had a well constructed body and was fluent on the move. I loved her head, it was just beautiful. **3. Bentwood Chloe of Forestcreek** (Cline/Harrison) A pretty little blenheim only 6 months old who showed her heart out for her owner. She was perfect for balance and outline with a lovely head, beautiful eyes and the softest expression. Lovely coat of a good colour. She had a very pleasing personality. **4. A good body shape, well marked and moved well around the ring. She had great attitude and showed well for her owner. I loved her personality and her head, she is another one to watch in the future. **2. Cobhill Golden Marguerite** (Brunson) Lovely Blenheim girl with large expressive eyes. She looked good going around the ring with a correct front and rear. She had lovely coat in great condition. She showed well for her handler. **3. Graduate Puppy Bitch (6)
