DOGS

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1. **CHADWICK PERFECT TONIGHT** (Eckersley). 5 months old puppy, with an outstanding balance. Level bite. Really sound with an absolutely correct moderate coat. He moved from front to rear in total balance and totally parallel back and forth. Stood in four square with all his feet standing correctly. Correct front and rear angulations. Correct top line, e moved with no effort. Well broken, with a moderate coat. Really well built, and the nicest of temperaments. Really well pigmented, with a charming and soft expression. Ear set high. One of my favorite dogs in the show. He has a really bright future ahead of him. Loved him and I gave him the best puppy dog in show due to his soundness, attitude and type. Best puppy in show.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1. CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley). 11 months old puppy dog. I

would prefer a little softer expression, really well pigmented. Well broken with the lozenge. Has a a really good neck slightly arching. Excellent temperament. Excellent front conformation, he does close a little bit from behind. Scissor bite. Moves with grace, but he carries a bit his tail up.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)

1. **GENTLE STAR UNFORGETALBE DREAM** (Gentil). 17 months old Lovely soft head with a charming expression. The head is the type of head the standard calls for. Scissor bite. He needs a bit of pigmentation on his right

eye, as very slightly shows some white. Correct ear set, with a really sweet and soft expression. Front and rear angles, very correct. Loved his rich color. I would prefer a little bit of more neck. When he moves his tail carriage is just a little bit high but with age his gay temperament might settle down.

2. CAMERONA RING OF FREEDOM (Cameron). 16 month old puppy, he needs a slightly more confident temperament and get more socialized, which it can certainly be worked. The ear set is a bit low. Good front, but rear is a bit straight and closes a bit from behind. Great rich beautiful color.

NOVICE DOG (1)

1. **CHADWICK TARTAN** (Eckersley). 9 month old blenheim. I would like a bit more fill on the head. Correct bite. Eyes very well pigmented. Lovely temperament. Very good and correct front. When he moves his croup is bit high which might change as he matures and gets balanced, this might be due to age. Tail carriage is correct.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (1)

1. **ORCHARDHILL OVERANALYZED** (Venier). 1 year and a half beautiful well broken tri boy. Lovely expression with an absolute moderate head. Round eyes and really well pigmented. Correct bite. Correct ear set. Shown in optimum conditions of coat, shinning and silky coat. Really well pigmented, with the right filling. He moved very balanced from front to rear. Excellent top line, really well constructed. I would just like him to carry his tail on the move a bit lower at certain times, as he does not carry it high all the time. A really quality boy absolutely moderate all throughout.

I could not deny him the <u>AOM #2</u> due to his soundness and moderation. Loved him, really considered him to be in the top honors due to his high quality. <u>BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR AND BEST TRICOLOR DOG IN SHOW AND BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW.</u>

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (2)

- 1. **CLARMARIAN HEARTHROB JW** (Young-May/Gogol) 16 months old blenheim. Lovely head with a really soft expression, loved his head with the most glamorous of expressions. A really classic head with great eyes and really strong pigmentation. Correct scissor bite. Good neck with a lovely outline. Love his rich color. Great temperament and really well handled.
- 2. **CEILIMOR DRESS CODE** (McCarty). 8 months blenheim boy. Would like more fill below his eyes to make the expression a bit softer. Correct ear set. Rich color with a really well broken coat. The front is really good, but the rear is a bit overangulated. So in the movement you can see he does not push from behind but rather from the front. His top line is not steady, can be due to age.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1. **KRYSTLE BLUE PERSUASION AT SAINTBRIDES** (Burkley/Torgersen). An almost two-year-old Blenheim dog, with a little overdone head. Round eyes and low ear set. Well broken. Really good front and sound. His tail set is low and carries the tail high.
- 2. **NIGHTINGALE REVOLUTION AW, MP** (Cameron). 4 year old blenheim boy with the most classic head. Really well pigmented with the correct size.

Would like a little bit more muscled. Good neck and excellent front. He closes a bit from behind leaning down his croup.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (1)

1. **FORESTCREEK ANDY** (Madden/Cline). A year and a half Blenheim boy, with a nice expression but I would like a bit of more fill below his eyes to give him a softer expression. Round eyes. Overall, he is nice and looks very soft still. Good proportions of head, and flat skull. Correct bite. I would like a stronger front with well laid-back shoulders. The rear is correct, he keeps his top line on the move. But would like a stronger front due to a short humerus. Good coat conditions of a rich chestnut color. Tail set carriage is correct. A very classic dog and in type.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BOY (1)

1. **LINRICA OMEGA CONSTELLATION** (Hsiung/Liu). A year and 9 months tri boy. Beautiful absolutely stunning head, with the softer of expressions. Best tri head for me as is soft and with the right proportions. Level bite. Good pigmentation. Really glamorous. However I would like a stronger rear, is a bit overangulated which makes him push mainly from the front. H is a small dog that I would like slightly bigger for a male. Still a high quality boy with a really glamorous look

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1. CLOSRBURN RED FOX TO THE FRONT

(Fairchild/Maddox). 4 -year-old boy with the most amazing of heads. Moderation is the word that defines this dog, which I absolutely loved. Soft with the right fill and proportions. Loved every inch of him, his eyes could be slightly darker if I need to write a fault, but they are still dark brown. Level bite. Well laid back shoulders. Excellent and sound mover, but I would like to see him move in a looser lead, which make him fully show his drive. Loved his balance and proportions. His tail at moments goes up, which disappears when the lead is loose. Loved him. Lovely temperament and show a strong connection with the handler. He was my <u>AOM #1 AND BEST RUBY IN</u> <u>SHOW</u>, it is not easy to achieve this ruby head expression with absolute moderation and the sweetness of expressions, plus a correct outline.

OPEN DOG (4)

1. CH PROMONTORY HERE COMES HUDSON

(Orns/Solomon) Two ½-year-old Blenheim. When he came in I could not get my eyes of him. Really balanced head, flat head, correct ear set. Sound and balanced and never placed a foot wrong. He moved with no effort due to an absolutely correct structure. Dark chesnut color with a dark pigmentation. Loved him as he always kept his balanced all thought the ring, standing and moving. He was handled to perfection, with an absolutely correct amount of coat. I would add just a spark of softness to his head expression. Still gorgeous and sweet. So I could not deny him the <u>BEST IN SHOW</u> as he outshined during the day. <u>BEST AMERICAN BRED DOG</u>, <u>BEST BLENHEIM BOY & BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW</u>.

2. CH FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDOR.

(Mixon/Cline/Marshall) Beautiful glamorous head, sweet and soft. Moves with no effort. Correct front and rear. Always happy, and wagging. Loved him. A really sound dog and absolutely in type. Correct size. I could not deny him the RBIS, the overall quality of this dog speaks on its own. A glamourous dog in the correct size. The sweetness, type, temperament, outline and beauty made me select him for the *RESERVE BEST IN SHOW*.

- 3. CH FALLING SPRINGS BLACK FLAME AT MADRYN (Weeks). Black and Tan, 1 year and 9 months boy. I would like a slightly softer expression. Correct rear. I would like a more compact dog with a stronger front. Best black and tan dog in show.
- 4. **CH KRYSLE HAMILTON** (Torgersen/Torgersen). Two year old Blenheim boy. A little unbalanced on the movement. Beautiful classic head. Well broken. The rear is a bit over angulated with makes him moves unbalanced when he moves.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

1. CH ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE AT

CAMERONA, AW, VW (Cameron). 10 year old beautiful blenheim boy. Beautiful head, and a real pleasure to look at. Really in great condition for his age. A sound mover totally in balance with the correct reach and drive. Loved him. The best dog the handler shown under me. I am happy to see this quality seniors moving so well and so soundly in a ring. Would just love to see more like him.

- CHADWICK GIRLS NIGHT OUT (Eckersley). 1 year and a half blenheim bitch. Correct head for her age. Correct bite. Sound girl with a really rich Blenheim color. Great pigmented. Good rear and front. Gave her BEST PUPPY BITCH.
- 2. NIGHTINGALE FROM ME TO YOU AT SAINTBRIDES (Burkley). Loved her head of this beautiful blenheim 11 month old girl. Eyes are beautiful. Excellent rear and a really beautiful promising girl. Just needs to settle down on the move.
- 3. BLUEBONNET RUBRUM LILY (Orns/Vezina). 1 year old Tri girl. I would like a softer expression on her head due to lack of fill. Her rear is a bit straight, but she moves with a level top line and tail set.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (5)

- 1. GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA (Gentil). 1 year and a half ruby girl. The head has a beautiful soft expression, with a really dark pigmentation, which I really remarked. Sound and absolutely in type. Wonderful outline, with the right balance on the move. Substance and moderation. I would like her to have a bit richer color coat. Really loved her. She truly deserved the <u>AOM #2</u>, <u>BEST RUBY BITCH IN</u> SHOW AND BEST RUBY IN SHOW.
- 2. ALMEARA LOVE HER MADLY (Whitmere). 12 months old girl. Compact girl with a really well laid back shoulders and great front.
- 3. KINGDOMRUN SPRING MAGNOLIA (Degen/Mixon). 1,5 year old blenheim bitch. Wonderful expression with lovely round eyes. I would like a little more of substance, and that she will push more from the rear.
- 4. BLUEBONNET SHE IS EVERYTHING (Orns/Vezine).

 1 year old blenheim girl. Really really well handled. I
 would like just a bit more filling in the head for the head to
 be softer. Wonderful front assembly, but I would like a
 better rear.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1. CLOSEBURN FIRE DANCING (Fairchild). Really

love her sweet stunning expression, of an absolute glamorous head. I would like more consistency on the move. The croup is a bit round and goes slightly up on the move.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (3)

- CH CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART,
 AW (Young-May/Gogol). Two years old blenheim girl.
 Loved her head and expression, with lovely dark eyes
 and flat skull. The coat condition looked wonderful.
 Good front, short coupled that carried an always leveled
 top line with a correct rear. Moved with soundness.
 Loved this glamorous girl.
- 2. CHADWICK MASQUERADE, JW (Ecklersley). 2 year old blenheim girl with a lovely head. She needs to loose a bit of weight. Still moves with grace although I would prefer a better rear as she closes a bit from behind and slightly shorter on the loin. Would like to see more pigmentation.
- 3. CH DARANE OTHERWORDLY, JW (Kates).

A two year blenheim girl with a wonderful expression. Eyes are to die for, and well pigmented. Well broken but I would like a stronger rear as she does not push from behind.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (3)

1. KRYSTLE BLUE VELVET AT SAINTBRIDES (Burkley). 11 month old blenheim girl. Lovely head with a real strong pigmentation. The front is really correct but would have liked a stronger rear as she is over angulated.

2. CHADWICK LOOKING FOR TROUBLE

(Eckersley). Lovely head with sweet expression. Excellent rear but the front could be more laid back which will prevents her move in total balance. **3. WINDKISS SUMMER LOVIN** (Kates/Patkowski). Girl with a really sweet head. Lovely front. I would like a more compact bitch. She misses a bit her balance in the movement due to a close rear which does not allow her to push.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (5)

- TASSAJARA SWEET PEA AT KINGDOMRUN (Degen).
 year old Blenheim bitch. Sound and beautiful bitch with a strong pigmentation, although her eyes could be slightly darker. She keeps her balance all the time on the move. Correct structure which allowed her to move with no effort.
- 2. TUDOR BLUES ALLEY, JW (Mixon) 1 and a half year old blenheim girl. A head to turn around, stunning. She is really sound and love her front. Love the deep chestnut color, slightly straight turn of the stifle.
- 3. AURORA JANE (Lehn). 2 year old girl. Lovely lovely head of a stunning classic expression. Would like less coat. Really correct as a mover. Loved her, one of the best girls of the day.

4. CHARDOMONT SPECIAL EDITION

(Greak/Comer). 2 year old blenheim girl. Lovely head but would like a longer muzzle. Well broken with a really correct front. Would like a stronger rear.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (4)

- 3. CAMERONA SPITFIRE (Cameron). 4 year old blenheim girl. Lovely head but misses fill below the eyes. Moves steady from the front, but I would add a stronger rear. Misses a more wide rib cage.
- 4. MADRYN COUNTRY ROADS (Weeks). 3 year old Blenheim girl. Not handled in the best coat conditions, as ears are teared down. Great front, well laid back shoulders but she closes a bit behind on the move. She has a slightly descending croup.

SPECIAL TRICOLOR BITCH (1)

 (McCarty) Really beautiful tri girl with a correct
 head and very sweet expression. Her front is
 correct as is her rear. Her coat is kept in optimum
 condition and is well broken. BEST TRI BITCH
