JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1) ALMEARA BLADE RUNNER (Whitmire)

6-month-old heavily marked tricolour but well-made. Pleasant headed, nice dark eyes and ear set. Correct bite and pigmentation. Has a short back and moderate neck. Tidy front and strong rear on the move with a level top line.

Exuberant and in smart condition.

BEST PUPPY DOG

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1) BLACKFIRE BAKER STREET (Weidig/Kennedy/Kennedy/McLaughlin)

11-month-old Blenheim with a broad head and lovely big round eyes. Well angled and short Coupled. Of a nice size, decent markings and chestnut colouring.

2) LYNSFAIRE HAVING A PARTY (Bright/Fairchild)

10-month tricolour with a moderate head and dark eyes. Decent angles and moderate Neck. Larger than 1, lacking some coat but a friendly nature.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4?)

1) **STONEPIT MASTERMIND** (Gentil)

Super type Blenheim. Widthy head and round dark gentle eyes. Well filled fore face, Good ear set and teeth. A moderate neck, well laid-back shoulders, short coupled, and Angulated hindquarters give a pleasing outline and as such, moved seamlessly and fluent keeping a perfect top line and ideal tail carriage. Covered in a wealth of coat In fine condition. Topped off with a super temperament. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW & BEST OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST IN SHOW**

2) **CEILIMOR DRESS CODE JW** (McCarty/Eckersley)

Well-marked Blenheim with dark eyes, black pigment and a kind face. Short backed and a

neat outline. Sound moving in good condition and a great temperament.

3) FIELDSEDGE BURNING DOWN THE HOUSE (Slusher/Slusher)

Smart richly coloured Ruby of a lovely type. Big eyes, nice head and muzzle. Well made with good angles and ample neck. Could move well but giving his handler a hard time!

4) **FIELDSEDGE NO EXCEPTIONS** (Slusher/Slusher)

Nicely marked Blenheim having an unexaggerated head and expressive eye. Decent make and sound moving.

NOVICE DOG (1)

1) **NIGHTINGALE TAKE IT EASY** (Mulligan)

Quality dog with a lovely head and large round dark eyes with a soft expression. Ideal pigment and ear set. Good for neck, shoulders and rear angles. Sound On the move and a rich chestnut colour. Just needs more confidence but it was his first show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (4)

1) TUDORR BRINGING HOME THE BLUES JW (Mixon/Mixon)

Such a rich Chestnut colour and typy Blenheim. Broad head and well-filled under eyes. Correct muzzle. large round, dark eyes with an appealing, soft expression. Ample neck and angulated all through. Short coupled and moved well, exhibiting an ideal temperament.

2) CH. SORELLA TWO TICKETS TO PARADISE JW, AW (Savage Green)

Quality Blenheim close up to 1, with a well-marked coat in good order. Moderate head with Large dark eyes giving a kind outlook. Very nice to go over having good shoulders, rear angles, and a level back. Moved with ease and a pleasing outline.

3) CH RIVERLEIGH HOT OFF THE PRESS JW (Dingman)

Another quality Blenheim that's pleasant to go over and very sound moving. Good body on him and pretty face but I'd like a slightly more masculine look. In pleasing condition.

4) CH FALLING SPRINGS BLACK FLAME AT MADRYN JW, AW (Weeks/Weeks/Grimm Curley)

Black and Tan containing plenty of qualities from his angulated quarters, good bone and Body to his raven black coating. Firm on the move carrying a broad head with dark Round expressive eyes and good pigmentation.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1) **FIELDSEDGE SPOT ON** (Richards)

A Blenheim of good overall type. He has large round dark eyes, correct pigment, teeth and ear set. A short coupled well marked body giving a nice outline. He moved soundly and confidently. **AOM#2**

AMERICAN BRED DOG (5)

1) CLARMARIAN HEARTHROB JW (Young-May/Gogol)

Attractive outline and coloured Blenheim of a pleasing type. Has large round dark eyes with a gentle expression. Good ear set, muzzle, bite and pigment. Ideally made he moved with a nice stride holding a level top line and tail possessing a friendly nature.

2) **KENJOCKETY SILVER KISS** (Webber)

Blenheim with well broken markings and great temperament. Nice headed with a kind Face and dark eyes. Good angles front and rear, short backed and good top line. Moved soundly positively.

3) TASSAJARA HIGH LIFE (Seidman/McDonnell-Seidman)

Pleasant headed Blenheim with large round dark eyes, widthy muzzle and black pigment. Moderate neck and level back. Decent colour and coat. Movement is good but I would prefer a little more animation.

4) **NIGHTINGALE REVOLUTION AW, MP** (Cameron)

Broad-headed and typy Blenheim. Engaging large round eyes and decent ear set. Well bodied and nicely angled covered in a richly coloured jacket. Moved well.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

1) CHADWICK WELL TEMPERED CLAVIER AT INTRYNZIK (Goodwin/ Eckersley)

Super type Blenheim with a generous head and good ear set.

Large, round dark eyes give a gentle and expressive look. Nice muzzle and fill in fore face. Good teeth and pigment. Lovely to handle having well laid shoulders, a short back and well-turned stifles covered in a rich coloured tidy coat.

Moved out in style and energetically with plenty of reach keeping a decent top line and happily carried tail. Giving a good outline and attentive to his handler, rewarded with WINNERS DOG & RESERVE BEST IN SHOW

2) FIELDSEDGE CASEY JONES (Slusher/Slusher)

Smart Blenheim with a good headpiece. Large round dark eyes and pigmentation. Well-made and good outline with ample neck and a level back. Movement is good coming and going and clean in profile. Just wanted a bit more from him.

3) BLU SKYE'S NAPALS HIDDEN GEM-HARLEN (Colacchio)

Lively Rich coloured Blenheim. Large round dark eyes and moderately headed. Good pigment and teeth. Good front and rear quarters he moved well enough with a decent top line and great character.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR DOG (1)

1) TRISTAN DOBRY ROK OF LYNSFAIRE (Fairchild)

Upstanding and of a nice type. Broad head and muzzle. Nice eyes, teeth pigment and tan. Moderate neck, short coupled and profuse coat. Decent make and shape he moves firmly and with a level back.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1) LYNSFAIRE WINE AND ROSES (Fairchild)

Short-backed and well angulated all round. Large round eyes and moderate headed. Excellent colour and moved well enough, but a little underweight.

OPENDOG(5)

1) **BONITOS COMPANEROS ORINOCO** (Hess/ Meager)

Quality Blenheim with a super outline and appealing head. Broad and having ideal ear set. Soft expressive eyes and well filled fore face with correct muzzle. Well-constructed and moved out with purpose parallel fore and aft.

Carrying a level back and tail set. A conditioned coat of a desired chestnut colour.

2) CH CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR JW (Eckersley/McCarty)

Great tempered Blenheim with a pleasing head and dark round eyes which were Soft yet alert in outlook.

Excellent pigmentation and correct bite. Good angles front and rear and short in body. Well broken markings. Great animation he moved in style and sprightly with a level back and tail.

3) CH FALLING SPRINGS JUST YOU WAIT AT CROWNROSE JW, AW (Rosenberg/Rosenberg)

Broad headed, large round, dark attractive eyes. Pigment, teeth, and ear set all good. Ample neck and pleasing angulation. Satisfying on the move with good top line and tail

with attitude.

4) CH KRYSTLE HAMILTON (Torgersen/Torgersen)

More moderate in Head this Blenheim is very sound covering the ground Comfortably holding an ideal top line. Has dark eyes and pigment, correct muzzled and kind face. Nicely bodied, ample bone and well coated.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

1) CH ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE AT CAMERONA AW, VW (Cameron)

Big round dark eyes with the kindest look set in a full head with widthy muzzle. Well-constructed and sound holding an ideal top line and gently wagging tail. Blanket marking but of a good colour. Super condition for his age.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

1) **NIGHTINGALE ALTHEA** (Baker-Fox)

Pretty 6-month-old Blenheim of quality and type. Lovely eyes, pigment and teeth. Well-constructed with a good neck and suitable shoulders. A level back and short coupled. Of nice coat and condition, she was steady and free flowing on the move. More heavily marked but tidy outline and an attentive outgoing attitude.

BEST PUPPY BITCH & BEST

2) INGOLD LITTLE MISS UPSTICK (Pickett)

Lovely headed Blenheim with large round dark soft eyes, black pigment and nice earset. Pleasing construction and as such sound on the move. Good topline and tail carriage. Of a nice size, decent bone and ideal colouring.

3) CHADWICK VIVID VIOLET (McCarty/Eckersley)

Blenheim of a pleasing structure with a nice head piece containing dark round eyes and correct pigmentation. Moderate neck and and short coupled. Moved with ease Keeping a level topline.

4) **CHADWICK RAVISHING ROSE** (Greak/Eckersley)

Wasn't surprised 3 and 4 placements were so closely related. Similar remarks Apply. She is very appealing and very sound on the move. Pleasingly marked giving a crisp outline but not as yet as animated.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

1) **CEDARCREEK LIP SMACKIN GOOD** (Mehrens/Owen)

Appealing young Blenheim having a correctly feminine head, large round dark eyes and black pigment. Decent neck and angles, level back and tail. Controlled and firm on the move possessing a likeable temperament.

2) LINRICA VARENNA (Hsiung/Lui)

Typy Blenheim with large round dark eyes and a soft expression. Nice head and earset, kind face and good pigment. Make and shape are good and pleasant on the move she has a good coat and rich colour.

3) **DELANEY UPTOWN GIRL** (Dingman)

Strikingly marked tricolour giving a smart clean outline. Firm topline and moved freely with reach. Moderate headed containing dark round eyes and great pigment. Good body and short coupled.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (1)

1) LOVEGOODS CELEBRATION (Wicker-Shaw/Hickey)

17-month-old Blenheim with an attractive head, large round eyes and warm expression. Decent ear set and correct bite. Nicely made with a moderate neck and good angulation. Composed on the move with a level back and tail.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

1) CH MIMRIC EIGHT SIX SEVEN FIVE THREE O NINE JW (Hodges/Perkins)

Glamorous and typy Blenheim. A gorgeous head containing Large round dark eyes, excellent pigment and a very feminine outlook with features correcting placed framed by long well feathered ears. Good to handle with ample neck, appropriate angles and a short coupled level back. Pleasant on the move showing confidence and in fine condition.

2) WELLSWORTH SUN MOON AND STARS (Wells)

Close up to 1, another typey Blenheim of quality in great condition. For me carrying a tad too much weight but very sound on the move from her excellent constructed build. Moderate neck, short back and well angulated quarters. A Broad head and well filled under dark round gentle eyes with black pigment and richly coloured coat.

3) LIVELYOAK DEFYING GRAVITY (Borton)

A more moderate headed Blenheim with large round dark eyes, super

pigmentation and good earset. Attractive make and shape she was pleasing on the move having a level topline and tail.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

1) FALLING SPRINGS FIRST STARLIGHT (Grimm Curley)

Young Black and Tan having the correct colour tan markings, great pigment and Teeth. Large round dark eyes with a sweet expression. Neck, shoulders and angles are ideal with a short back and smart on the move.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4?)

1) **INGOLD IN THE NAVY** (Pickett)

Charming Blenheim possessing a pretty head and smart outline. Soft and feminine eyes, black pigment and good dentition. Good for neck, shoulders and rear angulation. Composed and correctly moving with level back and tail. Of a nice size, type and colour.

2) **RIVERLEIGH EXPOSE** (Dingman)

Similar in make and shape to 1. Balanced with a short back and very good overall angulation. Has large round dark pleasing eyes and moderate head. A decent mover with correct topline and tail carriage displaying an outgoing temperament.

3) ABOSCOBEL IN A TWIST (Norton)

Black and Tan with a nice broad head and big round dark eyes. Lovely ears and pigment. Well laid shoulders, level back and firm on the move with a healthy raven black coat.

4) **NIGHTINGALE FROM ME TO YOU AT SAINTBRIDES** (Burkley)

A pretty Blenheim with a tidy well marked coat. Large expressive eyes and Classic head. Decent make and short backed she is sound moving and happy in nature.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (5)

1) ALMEARA LOVE HER MADLY JW, MP (Whitmire)

Outstanding quality girl who draws your eye entering the ring With a delightful outline moving with purpose covering the ground holding a firm topline and wagging tail set straight off the back. An almost flat skull with width and correctly set ears frame a face containing big round beautiful eyes, moderate muzzle and good dentition.

Straight boned and decent substance topped off with a straight soft quality coat. A pleasure awarding her

Richly coloured, well-made and sound moving with a pleasing unexaggerated head piece having gentle dark and large round eyes, black pigmentation and correct teeth. Held a perfect topline showing a sweet nature.

3) CHADWICK WISHFUL THINKING (Eckersley)

Exuberant natured and likeable head with large round dark eyes and good ears. Good lay of shoulders and turn of stifles, level short back and good colouring in attractive condition she moved with verve. However, a little proud of her tail.

4) CHADWICK LOOKING FOR TROUBLE (Greak/Comer)

Pleasingly marked with a broad head, feminine face and suitable condition. Good make, short in loin and sound moving. Level back and an attractive outline.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR BITCH (4)

1) **BLUEBONNET RUBRUM LILY** (Orns/Vezina)

Heavy marked but really nice quality. Attractive headed, large round dark eyes With an engaging look. Appealing construction with good neck, angles and cobby body. On the move she is parallel and up on her toes, displaying an excited nature.

2) **PROMONTORY CLOVER** (Dingman/Solomon)

Good quality, again heavily marked but well-angulated all through. With a broad head, good earset and kind eyes. Good bone, substance and composed on the move with firmness and attitude.

3) **INGOLD RHYTHM IN THYME** (Mullis/Pickett)

Pleasant headed, containing large round dark eyes, correct bite, and rich tan markings. Nicely made with ideal angles and sound moving. Level back and happy temperament.

4) WINDKISS SUMMER LOVING (Kates/Patkowski)

Large eyes and correct tan on a moderate head. Decent make and fine on the move keeping a level topline and tail.

OPEN BITCH (5)

1) CH TIBBEDON SUMMER BREEZE AT VALENTYNE JW, AW (O'Brien)

Delightful Blenheim of excellent quality. Lovely head and adorable face having large dark round eyes that are soft and feminine. A moderate neck, well laid shoulders and angulated hindquarters carrying a short coupled level back a tail. Free flowing on the move and a super outline. Good colour, lovely size and likeable temperament.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH

2) CH LIVELYOAK SPILL THE TEAJW (Borton)

Scrummy headed Blenheim with luscious, big, dark round eyes and plush face. Super construction, which shows in her firm and accurate movement. Ample well broken rich coloured coat and plenty of substance. An attractive outline having a moderate neck, firm topline and happily carried tail. <u>AOM #1</u>

3) CH GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA JW (Gentil)

Pretty headed Ruby that's unexaggerated with appealing kind Eyes and good earset. Well made with ample neck, angulated quarters and perfect topline. She moves with ease and pleasing head carriage showing off her confidence. Decent coat of a good colour and condition. **BEST RUBY IN SHOW**

4) CH FIELDSEDGE OFF TO SEE THE WIZARD JW (Slusher/Smith)

Another of noticeable quality. Attractively marked Blenheim and smart outline with splendid angulation. Broad but not overdone head containing gentle large round dark eyes and correct ears. Good for bone and body she moves with precision covering the ground Well. Just not as animated.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

1) DARANE TRUE COLORS (Kates)

Charming 10year old Black and Tan. Large round dark eyes and good bite set on a typy moderate head carried on an arched neck leading to great angulation. A short coupled back that's level she moved stylishly with aplomb. Put down in super condition having a long straight quality coat.

VETERAN DOG (1)

1) MARILEE RAY NITSCHKE (Junk/Collins)

10-year-old Blenheim with a great nature. Balanced and of a good make. Big round dark eyes, pleasing earset and masculine.

VETERAN BITCH (3)

1) ANGELS PRIDE NESSAJA (Charen)

Heavily coated and typy Blenheim of 8 years old. In super condition, she has warm dark and large round eyes, correct muzzle and fill in fore face. Angulated all round and short back. Movement is good with some style keeping her topline and happy carried tail. **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW**

2) CHADWICK WISH UPON A STAR (Eckersley)

8-year-old tricolour with large round, dark eyes having a kind expression. Good pigment, tan and a nice head. Well-made and good movement. Firm body, level back and a nice size showing vitality.

3) CH DARANE RED SONJA JW (Kates)

15-year-old Ruby with a good outline. Moderate-headed with big round eyes and correct muzzle. Moved with a decent topline and gently wagging tail. Sweet and friendly.
