JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1) BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES THE SUN (Wells)

Five month old very well proportioned blenheim boy of super size and shape. Attractive head with nice dark eyes, good ear set. Nice neck and shoulders into level top line and good rear angulation. Moved well for one so young. Promising future. **BEST PUPPY DOG**

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (3)

- SERAPHAVEN CLARMARIAN QUINTESSENTIAL CLASSIC (May/Gogol)
 Lovely shape and size on this dog. Good ear set and dark eyes, small bit plain in head.
 Nice neck into well laid shoulders. Level top line and correct tail carriage. Lovely rear
 angulation and moved well both ways.
- 2) TUDORR RETURN OF THE VELVET TEDDY BEAR (Mixon/Mixon) Lovely head and expression. Good ear set and large eye, nice fill of muzzle. Nice reach of neck and well-placed shoulders. Lost his top line on the move.
- 3) GRANNSIL STRUDEL OF SUMARA (Gentil) B&T boy excellent in shape and size. Pleasing head but I would like better eyes. Good reach of neck and shoulders. Well-proportioned body but a little happy with his tail carriage.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (4)

- 1) CH CHADWICK PURSUIT OF PERFECTION (Eckersley) Another quality boy from this top kennel. Sweet head with soft gentle expression, large dark eyes and good ear set. Lovely reach of neck and level top line. Moved with drive round the ring. Pleased to hear that he is the sire of my Winners Dog. <u>RESERVE</u> WINNERS DOG, <u>BEST BRED BY EXHIBITORS DOG</u>.
- 2) CH NIGHTINGALE WIPEOUT (Mulligan) Another quality exhibit in this class, super head and gentle expression. Large dark round eyes. Super in neck and shoulder placement. Level top line and good tail carriage. Moved very well around the ring.
- 3) ORCHARDHILL AUTHENTIC II (Venier/Venier) Blenheim with super head and expression. Nice dark round eyes and good ear set. Would like a little more in neck. Level top line and tail carriage. Moved well.
- **4)** TASSAJARA LAWS OF MOTION (Seidman-McDonnell/Seidman) Well broken Blenheim. Good for shape and size. Pleasing head. Moved OK, just a bit close in rear movement.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1) BROOKHAVEN NUMBER NINE DREAM OF FINNICKYSKYE (Utych/Utych) Heavily marked Blenheim. Good ear set with nice dark eyes, I would like a softer expression. Good neck and front with level top line. A little weak in rear movement.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE HEART OF GOLD** (Weeks/Weeks) A well balanced dog with super head and expression. Lovely eye and nose pigment. Good reach of neck but a little up in shoulder. Level top line and good rear angulation. Moved well.
- 2) ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TUDORR (Mixon/Mixon) Excellent in shape and size. Just didn't have the head of 1. Good neck and shoulders and good front, carried himself well but just a bit close in the rear.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (4)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE LET IT BE** (Mulligan) Love the head and expression on this boy. He has that soft gentle expression and melting eyes. Super reach of neck into well laid back shoulders. Correct top line and tail carriage. Lovely reach and drive on the move. <u>AWARD OF MERIT 2</u>
- 2) **ORCHARDHILL NEWS TO ME** (Venier/Venier) Another good example of breed type from this kennel. Super head and expression with large dark eyes. Good ear set, nice neck and shoulders. Good rear angulation and moved well both way. Just preferred the outstanding outline of 1 on the move.

- 3) **FORESTCREEK I'M THE MAN** (Cline/Cline) Another dog with super head, nice soft gentle expression with dark eye and ear set. Nice size and shape with good shoulders and front movement. Would prefer stronger rear movement.
- 4) **FOXYN FINE YOUNG GENT** (Guzy/Baker Fox) Good masculine head with dark round eyes. Good neck and shoulders with level top line and rear angulation. Was just a bit excited with his tail. Moved well.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (2)

- 1) **CHADWICK BUGATTI AT HUDSONVIEW** (Glynn/Glynn) Well broken tri in good condition. Not my type of head but excelled in body confirmation. All angles correct with level top line and moved well. **BEST TRI DOG**
- 2) FALLING SPRINGS RAMBLIN GAMBLIN MAN (Curley) Preferred the head on this boy than 1. Nice shape and size but didn't have the movement of 1.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1) **BROOKHAVEN CATCHING FIRE** (Ayers/Martz) Nice for shape and size. Good head with pleasing expression nice eyes and ear set. Level top line and good angulation. Moved soundly around the ring. I would just like a little more neck. **BEST RUBY IN SHOW**

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN DOG (1)

1) SREYA BROOKHAVEN FINDERS KEEPERS (Ayers) Nice for size with good head and expression. Nice glossy silky coat. Good reach of neck and shoulder placement. Lovely in profile but lacked a bit on the move. BEST B&T IN SHOW

OPEN DOG (5)

- 1) CH CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn) This boy caught my eye as soon as he entered the ring and he didn't disappoint as I went over him. He has a super head with lovely expression. Lovely eyes and super pigment. Level skull and ear set. Excellent in neck and shoulders leading into a level top line and tail set. Good rear angulation and moved around the ring with ease. This dog is correct in so many ways and gladly awarded him <u>BEST IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW AND BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW.</u>
- 2) CH & ENG CH PASCAVALE HAIDEN (Cline) Another super example of the breed. Lovely head with soft gentle expression, dark round eye and good ear set. Nice reach of neck but just up a little in shoulder, level top line and tail carriage. Good rear

- angulation and moved well around the ring. Just seemed a little tired and not the drive as *AWARD OF MERIT 1*
- 3) CH ELLEMICH THE HUNTSMANN (Chapman/Ireland/Schrank) Super head with that soft gentle expression. Largest of round dark eyes with good fill of muzzle. Good reach of neck and well laid-back shoulders. Good bone and the richest of colour. Moved well but lost his top line on the move and dropping his tail which ruined the outline. Also has to be mentioned that his coat was heavily trimmed.
- **4) ORCHARDHILL THEATER KID AT KINGDOMRUN** (Mixon/Degen) Sweet head. Nice shape and size. Good bone and coat condition. Moved ok both ways.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE
 (Utych/Utych) Lovely shape and size with sweet head and soft expression. Good neck
 and shoulders, level back and tail carriage. In good condition and still moving well for
 age.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (7)

- 1) ALMEARA SHES SO FINE (Whitmire) Well broken pretty girl with nice outline. Super feminine head and expression. Round dark eye well pigmented. Nice reach of neck and well laid shoulders. Level top line and tail carriage. Nice rear angulation and moved with ease around the ring.
- 2) CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART (May/Gogol) Another pretty girl of correct shape and size. Pleasing head and expression but I would like better pigment. Good bone and angles in a compact body. Moved well both ways.
- 3) **CHADWICK MASQUERADE** (Eckersley) Nice shape and size. Good dark eye and ear set. Nice neck and shoulders into a level top line and tail carriage. Good rear angulation and moved well. Just preferred the heads of 1+2.
- 4) **ROYALMARK GOLDEN GIRL AT NIGHTINGALE** (Mulligan) Larger than the rest but all in proportion. Pleasing head with good neck and front. Level back and good angulation. Moved well.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

- 1) **LOWILANI SEW TO SPEAK** (Brokopp) Well broken girl in good coat and a pleasing head. Nice round large dark eyes, level skull and good ear set. Good reach of neck and well laid shoulders. Level top line and tail set. Moved well both ways.
- 2) **NIGHTINGALE MAKIN TROUBLE** (Mulligan) Nice size and good coat texture. Nice feminine expression, I would like a slightly larger eye. Nice neck and shoulder placement. Level top line and moved well both ways.

3) **HARANA HARVEST MOON OF FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych/Utych) Good in shape and size. Plainer in head than 1+2. Eyes large and round and good ear set. Nice silky coat and good angulation. Moved well.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (2)

- 1) FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY (Curley) Lovely shape and size, pretty head with soft expression. Nice eye and ear set. Good coat condition. Good neck and front. Level back and tail set. Moved ok but would like to see her stride out a bit more.
- 2) MANORHOUSE LIKE A LADY (Orns/McCaslin) Another pretty girl close to 1. Pretty head and expression with dark eye. nice reach of neck, level back. correct tail carriage and moved well.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

1) CH. CROWNHEIR HALLELUJAH (Fadel) On her own in this class but I could see the quality as soon as she came in. The confirmation of this bitch is exactly to the breed standard. Nice compact body, excellent neck and shoulder placement, table top back, correct tail. Good bone and all correct angles. Moved a dream round the ring maintaining a lovely outline. Pleasing head with super pigmented eyes, good ear set and level skull. If I was super critical I would like a slightly sweeter head.

WINNERS BITCH. RESERVE BEST IN SHOW. BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW. BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (7)

- 1) ORCHARDHILL CHARM OFFENSIVE (Venier/Venier) Another quality bitch from this top kennel. Lovely shape and size with a pleasing head. Good dark round eye and ear set. Nice reach of neck into correct shoulders. Level back and tail coming straight off. Good rear angulation and moved with drive around the ring. A bright future in store for this girl. Pleased to award her. <u>BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.</u>
- 2) CLARMARIAN AFFAIRS OF THE HEART (Young/McFarland) Another quality girl with feminine head and soft expression. Nice dark eye and correct ear set. Good neck into well laid shoulders. Level back and tail carriage. Nice angles and moved well both ways.
- 3) ALMEARA SHES THE ONE (Whitmire) Well broken in good coat. Pleasing head and expression good eye and reach of neck. Level top line and tail carriage. Well constructed and moved well.

4) TAASSAJARA SOME BUNNY LOVES ME (Seidman/Seidman-McDonnell) Super pretty feminine head. Great size and shape. Good neck and front movement. Dropped off behind on the move.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

- 1) **FIELDSEDGE ROISIN OF KENTUCKY** (McCulloch/McCulloch) Pretty girl with a lovely outline. Good eyes and ear set. Nice neck and shoulders, level top line and correct tail carriage. Good rear angulation and moved well around the ring.
- 2) ALTHOF RAIN OR SHINE (Storey) Lovely outline and close to 1. Super shape and size. Nice dark eyes and correct ear set, level skull. Nice reach of neck and shoulders, level back and moved well both ways.
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN MORE THAN SMART** (Ayers/Martz/Anderson) Prettiest head in this class with nice soft gentle expression. Lovely dark round eyes. Good neck and shoulder in nice compact body. Good front construction just lost it in rear movement.
- **4) TUDORR GIGI** (Mixon/Madden) Pleasing girl of correct size. Nice dark eyes and level skull with good ear set. Just didn't have the movement of the rest.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

- 1) **SORELLA BROOKHAVEN TRINITY** (Ayers) Lovely size with correct head. Soft gentle expression, good fill of muzzle, dark eye and good ear set. Lovely top line and tail set. Nice shoulder placement and good rear angles and moved well.
- 2) MAGNOLIA RUN LIGHTENING STRIKE (Guzy) Good shape and size with pleasing head, just preferred the eyes of 1. Nice neck and shoulders with level back. Good angulation and moved well.
- 3) **RIVERWYN SIKELEI BLOWING IN THE WIND** (Nel/Pivovar) Prettiest of heads with that desired soft gentle expression. Darkest of eyes with correct ear carriage. Just didn't have the movement of 1+2.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (1)

1) CH CHADWICK ROULETTE (Eckersley/Reed) Nice shape and size with pretty head. Good expression with large dark eyes. Good neck and shoulders, level top line and tail set. Good rear angulation and moved well both ways. <u>BEST TRICOLOR</u> IN SHOW

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

1) GRANASIL FLORENTINE OF SUMARA (Gentil) Nice rich colour with pretty feminine head. Excellent for shape and size. Dark eyes, level skull and correct ear set. Good reach of neck and front. Level top line and good rear angles. Moved well. BEST RUBY BITCH

OPEN BITCH (3)

"Super class with all 3 having the prettiest of heads. All 3 could change places at any time."

- 1) CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE (Green) Outstanding in shape and size with very pretty head, darkest of eyes. Excellent reach of neck, level top line and correct tail set. Very good in rear with correct angles and good rear movement, just lost out to the Winners Bitch on her front movement. RESERVE WINNERS BITCH
- 2) **BROOKHEAVEN SMARTY PANTS** (Whitmire/Ayers) Another super little bitch with the most feminine head. Super large dark eyes and correct ear set. Nice compact body with all correct angles and moved well. *AWARD OF MERIT 1*
- 3) CH ORCHARDHILL PRETTY CLOSE (Venier/Venier) Again a very pretty girl with soft gentle expression. Good fill of muzzle, darkest of eyes, correct skull and ear set. Lovely front and level top line, good drive from behind. Just lost out on her tail carriage. AWARD OF MERIT 2

VETERAN DOG (1)

1) **CH. BELLA SOGNI DOLCI DE AMOR** (Weeks/Weeks) Tri boy of 9 years. Up to size but everything in proportion. Pleasing head with dark eyes, good ear set. Nice reach of neck, level top line and tail carriage. Moved well.

VETERAN BITCH (2)

- 1) **CH. CHADWICK LEURA** (Eckersley) Super pretty girl with lovely shape and size correct head and soft expression. Everything is in the correct place, good front and shoulders with level back. Good rear angulation and and moved with ease around the ring. **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW**.
- 2) **CH. PINECREST MOONSHINE AT MARKLEY** (Storey) 12 year old girl and still showing great. Nice feminine head, dark eyes and good ear set. Lovely shape and size and moved well for her age.
