JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1) **BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES THE SUN** (Wells) Just 7 months old, friendly young man. Good head developing well, large dark round eyes, tapered muzzle, Body coming together, Well sprung rib, level top line, moved out well when settled **BEST PUPPY DOG**

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1) **SERAPHEVEN CLARMARIAN QUINTESSENTIAL CLASSIC** (May/Gogol). A very mature boy who is just over 12 months old; stylish youngster built on flowing lines, pleasing head, ears set well, large dark eyes, correct length of muzzle. Compact body with good spring of rib, liked his well angulated hindquarters and strong hocks. Rich Blenheim markings
- 2) **GRANASIL STRUDEL OF SUMARA JW** (Gentil) B/T Expressive dark eyes and broad appealing head, but not overdone. Good neck and shoulders very well constructed and well bodied, good hindquarters and tail set. Moved well keeping his nice outline. **BEST B&T IN SHOW**
- 3) **TUDOR RETURN OF THE VELVET TEDDY BEAR** (Mixon/Mixon). Liked his quality and type. Pleasing masculine head with good broad skull and well set ears, good eyes and pigment. Well constructed, and well bodied with good moderate bone.

4) **THEODORE OF CLUB CAVALIER** (Richards) Heavier marked Blenheim with rich chestnut markings, nice head, lovely eye, good topline on the move, needs to be a bit more sporting in character.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (3)

- 1) **CH CHADWICK PERSUIT OF PERFECTION JW** (Eckersley) Richly coloured, well marked dog, with good bone, short coupled, good front, level topline and a good turn of stifle. Gorgeous head with well set ears, large dark eyes and well cushioned foreface, his clear cut facial markings are the icing on the cake. A willing showman that moves well. **AWARD OF MERIT #2**
- 2) **CH NIGHTINGALE WIPEOUT JW** (Mulligan) A well balanced, appealing head with well feathered ears, large dark eye, good neck and shoulders. Just the right amount of bone for his size, good spring of rib, good topline, well-turned stifles. A steady mover
- 3) TASSAJARA LAW OF MOTION (Seidman-McDonnell/Seidman) Another nice Blenheim, a good headed dog, more ear featherings will complete the picture, good bone, firm topline, well-turned stifles, richly marked but not quite as mature as the winners.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1) **BROOKHAVEN NUMBER NINE DREAM OF FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych/Utych) A Blenheim with a gorgeous head and expression, large dark eyes, correct ear set, shown in wonderful coat, well boned, good spring of rib, good turn of stifle, moved well and showed nonstop, well presented.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE HEART OF GOLD** (Weeks/Weeks) Elegant Blenheim with attractive head and dark eye. A nice type with well set ears and good reach of neck, well boned and a level topline, well marked but not yet in full coat. A good mover both ways and looks a picture going round the ring. His extroverted temperament will always get him noticed.
- 2) **ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TUDORR, JW** (Mixon/Mixon) Blenheim of quality, lovely type, attractive head and eye, well cushioned foreface, well bodied, short coupled, good topline, lovely bone, nice size. I thought this would be my winner but he was not moving as well as the winner.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

- 1) **NIGHTINGALE LIE IT BE, AW, MP** (Mulligan) Headed a very strong open class. Richly coloured well marked Blenheim, with a lovely head and eye, nicely balanced with the right amount of bone for his size. Cobby bodied, good front, level topline, well bent stifles. Shown in good coat and well presented. <u>AWARD OF MERIT #1</u>
- 2) **FORESTCREEK I'M THE MAN** (Cline/Cline/Cline) A masculine headed richly broken Blenheim, who had found his form today. Great body depth and spring of rib. When he gets into his stride moves soundly and with verve. A silky well-presented coat completed a nice picture.
- 3) **ORCHARDHILL NEW TO ME MP** (Venier/Venier) Well broken Blenheim with a silky coat of a rich colour. Of a charming type rarely seen. Masculine, but with a head and outlook that are quite beautiful, with that super eye size, shape & set giving the hard to find soft expression. When he moved he really strode out using his soundly constructed body.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR DOG (2)

- 1) **CHADWICK BUGATTIE AT HUDSONVIEW** (Glynn) Glamorous Tricolour with super head and eye, and well set ears. Another well balanced dog with good bone, well developed chest, level topline and well turned stifles. Shown in a lovely coat which was well broken with rich tan markings, moved and showed well. **BEST TRI DOG IN SHOW**
- 2) **FALLING SPRINGS RAMBLIN GAMBLIN MAN JW** (Grimm Curley) Particularly well marked Tri, very eye-catching. Nice size with strong moderate bone. Full masculine head with sweet expression and nice eyes, nicely constructed, good hind angulation.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1) **BROOKHAVEN CATCHING FIRE JW** (Ayers/Martz) Super rich coloured Ruby, that was shown in good coat and condition. A lovely type that is well put together. Appealing head with a soft expression, good neck and shoulders, level topline, nice turn of stifle, well boned for size, Excellent gait moved out true and showed well. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG & BEST RUBY DOG IN SHOW**

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK & TAN DOG (1)

1) Sreya Brookhaven Finders Keepers (Ayers) A Black and tan with a good head, soft well cushioned foreface, large dark eyes framed by well feathered ears. Lovely size and bone, good front, well angulated hind quarters. Coat coming in well. <u>BEST B&T DOG IN</u>

OPEN DOG (3)

- 1) CH CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW JW (Glynn/Glynn) This young man turned my head the minute he trotted into the ring. Lovely type Blenheim with an appealing head, his eyes just draw you in. Good neck, well laid shoulders, level topline, well turned stifles. Good size, well boned, short coupled, well broken markings. A good moving dog with the right attitude for the show ring. I was impressed by the overall balance and breed type of this young dog, So please to award this dog top honors. A well-balanced dog throughout, good neck and shoulders, well boned, good topline, well bodied, good turn of stifle. Shown in lovely condition and gleaming coat, moved well however he was not as outgoing and happy today
- 3) **ORCHARDHILL AUTHENTIC II** (Venier/Vernier) Beautiful headed Blenheim dog with dark expressive eyes and well cushioned foreface, rich chestnut markings on a pearly white. A compact dog with level topline and good substance. Shown in lovely bloom and condition. A good moving dog that showed well.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

1) CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE AW (Utych/Utych) A quality 7 year old dear blenheim boy built on cobby lines. Has a full set of gleaming teeth and moved and showed with enthusiasm. Is a great credit to his owner and must be a joy to treasure. A beautiful Cavalier.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (7)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES LOGAN** (Ayers) Sound attractive 6-month-old Blenheim with just the size, bone and type I was looking for. Lovely head with large dark round eyes, excellent nose pigment and sweet expression. Well-marked, complete with lozenge. Moved well holding a level topline and if she had used her elegant neck to more advantage, she would have pressed hard for best puppy bitch
- 2) **CHADWICK MASQUERADE** (Eckersley) Delightful, eye-catching. Small and compact with plenty of bone. Appealing head with limpid dark eyes. Well-constructed with level back and good angulation front and rear. Quality coat of silky texture. Moved happily displaying her outgoing temperament.
- 3) **NIGHTINGALE THE FARMERS DAUGHTER AT MADRYN** (Weeks/Weeks) Very pretty well broken Tri with rich tan highlights, body developing well, she excelled in length of neck and shoulder placement, a very pleasing exhibit of promise who moved with drive keeping a level topline and tail carriage.
- 4) **CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART** (Young-May/Gogol) Well broken Blenheim of quality who is still very immature, sweet head with large dark eyes and appealing expression, text-book neck and shoulder placement, firm cobby body, moved and showed happily, just need time to fulfil her undoubted potential.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

- 1) LOWILANI SEW TO SPEAK (Brokopp) Caught my eye as soon as she entered the ring. Lovely shape, well angulated front and rear and moved accordingly. Small and cobby with good spring of rib. Feminine head framed by long ears. Her silky coat is developing well and she oozed personality and type. <u>BEST PUPPY BITCH</u>, <u>BEST PUPPY IN SHOW & AWARD OF MERIT 2</u>
- 2) **HARANA HARVEST MOON OF FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych/Utych) Very close up to the winner as I wanted to take them both home. Showy little Blenheim in superb condition. Stood four square displaying her attributes to the full and flowed gracefully around the ring. Animated personality and delightful attractive head. Another star.
- 3) **NIGHTINGALE MAKIN TROUBLE** (Mulligan) Yes, she lived up to her name! However, her vivacious personality was part of her appeal. Pretty, feminine head with dark eyes twinkling with enthusiasm. Well-proportioned body of ideal size and

construction. Moved beautifully, driving forward with short hocks and holding a level topline. A quality bitch.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (2)

- 1) **FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY** (Grimm Curley) Well broken markings which were bright and clear. Good breed type, gorgeous large eyes, gentle expression, good pigment. A shapely bitch with good neck and shoulders, straight front, good body with well sprung ribs, good bone, topline and tailset. Moved well. A very nice junior.
- 2) MANORHOUSE LIKE A LADY (Orns/McCaslin) Beautiful coat of a nice color and texture. Head soft and gentle, eyes dark and pigment correct. Good front, just hope her body comes together, topline not as level as 1 tending to slope toward her rear, hope this improves with maturity.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

1) CH CROWNHEIR HALLELUJAH (Fadal) Such a neat little package with enough neck, correct front and rear assembly, good chest and well sprung ribs, short loin and perfect topline and tailset. Ample bone for her size and plenty of substance with a richly marked, silky coat finishing the picture, a head of such quality, perfectly set out around clear, even markings, beautiful large dark eyes, plenty of cushioning, correct length of muzzle and shallow stop. Moved with accuracy and carriage covering the ground with ease whilst maintaining that super outline. A delightfully happy temperament finishes off a super little package. WINNERS BITCH, BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH IN SHOW& BEST OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST IN SHOW

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (7)

- 1) **HUDSONVIEW FIRST KISS** (Glynn/Glynn) I couldn't help but smile when I looked into this beautiful little face. Large dark eyes, gently tapered foreface. Well set and carried ears which are so well furnished. Good reach of neck, good depth of chest and correct bone, firm topline and good tail carriage, so compact, exceptional easy mover with strong driving action
- 2) **FOXCREEK OLIVIA ROSE EXTROVERT** (Johnson) Blenheim who showed extremely well, in lovely coat and condition, gorgeous head and expression with large

- dark eyes, nice neck and shoulders, good topline, moved freely with plenty of pizazz, a really nice exhibit.
- 3) **CHADWICK ICICLE II** (Eckersley) Another really nice Blenheim bitch which excelled in neck and shoulders, topline and tailset, lovely head, large dark eyes, with well-set ears. Moved out well both ways,
- 4) **ALMEARA SHES THE ONE** (Whitmere) Blenheim with rich chestnut markings, looked balanced going round the ring, very cobby, well angulated hindquarters, good front, beautiful head and large dark eyes, well set ears.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

- 1) **FIELDSEDGE ROISIN OF KENTUCKY** (McCulloch/McCulloch) This little blenheim out shone the rest. Her handler worked hard to get the most out of her. Well balanced in outline with moderate reach of neck, correct front assembly, level topline, correctly set tail and parallel rear. Pretty, feminine head without exaggeration having dark round eyes, short nicely padded muzzle, symmetrical markings and such a gentle expression. Smart on the move holding a good topline with tail carried well at all times.
- 2) **BROOKHAVEN MORE THAN SMART** (Ayers/Martz/Anderson) Loved her head properties with large dark eyes, short plush muzzle and gentle expression. Very nicely constructed with ample reach of neck, good topline, well sprung ribs and short strong loin with good substance and ample bone. Moved with a free, easy action maintaining an attractive outline in profile, carrying a beautiful coat and handled to an advantage.
- 3) **TUDOR GIGI JW** (Mixon/Madden) Another blen with a super temperament, good head shape just not quite as feminine as 1 & 2 but has pretty eyes with good fill beneath and cushioning to her short muzzle. A little heavier in type than I prefer but she makes the most of herself on the move with a free, easy gait. Soundly constructed throughout.
- 4) **ALTHOF RAIN OR SHINE** (Storey) Pretty face with large dark round eyes, correctly set and carried ears, good pigment, and short well cushioned muzzle all giving a pleasing expression. Compact frame with level topline, adequate neck, shoulders could be better but rear is nicely angulated and her ribs are well sprung.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (2)

1) **SORELLA BROOKHAVEN TRINITY JW** (Ayers) An exquisite lady. Most appealing head with huge dark lustrous eyes, black nose pigment and sweet expression. Elegant

- arched neck with well laid-back shoulders, level topline and good rear. So well balanced and shown in gleaming condition.
- 2) **RIVERWYN SIKELEI BLOWING IN THE WIND** (Nell/Pivovar) Stood four square, showing off her construction and condition. Move with drive. Attractive head, large eyes, dark pigment, richly marked. Extremely pretty and feminine with a delightful disposition.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (1)

1) **CH CHADWICK ROULETTE JW** (Eckersley/Reed) A really lovely quality 18-month-old tri in full bloom. Beautiful head and melting expression with lovely eyes, shallow stop, short nicely padded muzzle and well-furnished ears framing her face and enhancing her lovely expression. Lovely to go over with moderate reach of neck, good depth of chest and spring of rib, short loin and nicely constructed rear. Sound on the move, accurate coming and going with good drive from the rear. In fabulous coat and condition .Reserve Winners Bitch and best Tri Bitch in Show

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

1) **GRANSIL FLORENTINE OF SUMARA JW, MP** (Gentil) This Ruby has a rich, silky coat, so often missing in the wholecolours. I liked this lady's soft expression. Good neck and shoulders, front, and body. She is quite small but has enough bone for size. Good topline and tailset. Moved out elegantly

OPEN BITCH (3)

- 1) **CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE JW AW** (Green) An attractively marked blenheim. Very soundly made, moved well, maintaining a good outline and the correct tail carriage. Good reach of neck leads to well laid shoulder, straight front, well developed body for age, good rear angulation, Her head is correctly shaped with a nice expression, large dark eyes with good fill beneath and neatly finished muzzle of the correct length, she could use her ears more to her advantage. In a beautifully presented coat and perfect show condition, I'm sure she appeals to many.
- 2) **CH ORCHARDHILL PRETTY CLOSE AW** (Venier/Venier) Quality blenhiem richly marked, dark pigment. Good head shape just not quite as feminine as 1 but has pretty eyes with good fill beneath and cushioning to her short muzzle. Makes the most of herself on the move with a free easy gait, soundly constructed throughout.

3) **BROOKHAVEN SMARTY PANTS JW** (Whitmere/Ayers) A well broken Blenheim with a very sweet, feminine expression. Nice eyes and good pigment. Good neck and shoulders, excellent front, good body and bone Moved with drive, good tail carriage. Lovely temperament.

VETERAN DOG (1)

1) **CH BELLA SOGNI DOLCI DE AMOUR VW** (Weeks/Weeks) A well broken tricolour with good head, eyes and pigment. In a good coat, his lovely well feathered ears add to her gentle outlook. A balanced dog, with a good ribcage. Moved well, driving off from his well let down hocks.

VETERAN BITCH (2)

- 1) **CH CHADWICK LEURA JW** (Eckersley) Glorious nine year old blenheim who can still show the younger girls how to command the ring as she swept around with arched neck, level back and correct drive and tail carriage. Sweet head and full dentition. An old favourite. **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW**
- 2) **CH PINECREST MOONSHINE AT MARKLEY JW** (Storey) Small, cobby bitch with an exceptionally pretty head and a stamp of quality. Correct substance and bone. Animated and outgoing.
