Junior Puppy Dog (9)

1. BlueGarden Holiday Party at Hudsonview (Glynn/Matos) 6 month old Blenheim with soft expression with large eye and dark pigment who moved easily and kept his topline. **2. Rutherford Eros** (Jones) 7 month old richly colored Blenheim with level topline; preferred the expression of #1. **3. Angel's Pride Just A Gigolo** (Gentil) Another 7 month blenheim puppy with easy movement who kept his topline as he went. His dark eye and pigment are pleasing. Hope his bite improves. **4. Valentyne Kilimanjaro** (O'Brien) A pretty 5 month old Blenheim with large round dark eye and black lip pigment. Hope his bite improves.

Senior Puppy Dog (6)

- **1. Nightingale The Eyes Have It** (Mulligan/Duke) 9 month old Blenheim whose name matches my first thought about him. He has a dark round eye and sweetest face and his movement is elegant. Kept his topline while easily floating around the ring—down and back and around. Promising puppy. *Best Puppy Dog*
- 2. Du Jardin De Claire Ilow (Gentil) Richly colored 10 ½ month ruby with straight coat. His eyes are dark and round and match his black pigment. Held his topline when he moved. Pressed the winner for the class. 3. Chewcreek Red Solo Cup (DePhillip) 9 month old tri who is a real toy spaniel with expressive round dark eyes. He has a silky black coat which gleamed as he moved easily around the ring. 4. Chadwick It's A Paper Moon (Eckersley) 9 month old tri who moved easily and kept his level topline. He is a bit longer cast than prior; preferred the expression of previous dogs.

Graduate Puppy Dog (1)

1. Bonitos Campaneros Eldorado, JW (Magera/Mitchell) Fully coated young Blenheim with level topline and correct tail set. He moved well on the go around.

Novice Dog (1)

1. Kellene Win Lose Or Draw (Ezzo/Meiers) Such a happy young B/T with a soft, silky coat. His eyes are large and dark. He kept his topline and tail carriage when he moved. He enjoyed his time in the spot light.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (3)

1. Ch Mileslip Licorice, JW (Skidmore) Won this class with his large dark eyes and masculine head. His coat is a silky and luxurious B/T. Happy showman. Award of Merit, Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog 2. CA Cambridge Dream Weaver (Magera/Mitchell) Lovely B/T with elegant movement. His crest of neck slopes into level topline. Pressed the winner of the class. His coat is not quite that of #1. 3. Ch Dreamvale Motley Crew (Sage/Colbert) Richly colored Blenheim with beautiful eyes and pigment. Preferred the topline and movement of previous.

Junior American Bred Dog (2)

1. Chadwick Cheers at Hudsonview (Glynn) 1 year old tri with a beautiful head and dark round eyes and a nice size. He has a silky black coat. He worked well with his handler going and coming and around. 2. Foxwyn A Storybook Romance (Baker-Fox) Promising 1 year old blenheim who moved well and with ease and kept his topline and tail carriage. Preferred the expression of #1.

American Bred Dog (6)

1. Roi L Stings Like A Bee (Carter/Lessig) Very pretty young B/T dog. The crest of his neck slopes into a level topline and correct tail set. His expression is soft and kind with dark round eyes and highlighted with deep rich chestnut points. His movement is flowing and elegant. A promising young dog who needs to mature. 2. Nightingale Wish Upon A Star at Nebyula (Birbeck) 3 year old blenheim with melting expression and nice shape. He moved well but without much animation. 3. Dancasa Cute As A Button, JW (Tiedemann) Nice size and shape. He has a round eye and dark pigment and was enjoying the ring. Preferred the head and expression of #2. 4. Dreamvale Ollivander (Sage/Hallsted) Larger type. His eyes are round and pigment dark. Happy, free moving dog.

Health & Conformation Dog (2)

1. Avia Sgt. Pepper (Marler) 7 year old who won this class on elegant movement and outline. His rich chestnut coat was sadly missing, but his crest of neck, level topline, and correct tail set were not to be ignored. His eyes are large and dark and invited a good look. **2. Windham Lost Sailor** (McCauley/Hashagen) 6 year old rich ruby color and glamorous ears. He was happy to be out with his handler today.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (4)

- 1. Nightingale Jackson Browne (Birmingham) 3 year old with lovely head and shape. He is elegant in movement with reach and drive and he showed off his good nature. 2. Brookhaven Enchanted Dreamer (Brown) 3 year old with nice shape and size who moved well. Preferred the head of #1. 3. Clarmarian Covertly Wicked (Gogol/Young-May) This blenheim has rich dark coloring and pigment. Well presented. Preferred the topline and tail set of #1-2. 4. Blackfire Plaza Suite (McLaughlin/Kennedy/Weidig) Richly colored Blenheim, but not the pigment or movement of previous. Special Limit Tricolor Dog (2)
- **1. Blackfire Room Service at Kalais** (Hess/Kennedy/Weidig) Compact body with neck which held his beautiful head to advantage. His eyes gave him a soft expression. **2. Chadwick Midnight Son at Hudsonview** (Glynn) Sweet boy who moved well and kept his level topline. Preferred the expression and movement of #1.

Special Limit Ruby Dog (4)

1. Numen Bryan (Sage) 2 year old, a bit long cast at this time. He has a silky coat and his neck flows into level topline. His pigment is black and his eyes are dark and round. He moves well. 2. Autumnhill Spencer, JW (Weinstein/Parente) 3 year old with large dark eyes and pigment. He moved easily and kept his topline and tail carriage. Preferred the softer expression of #1. 3. Darane Hellboy (Kates) True toy spaniel with dark pigment and round eye. Well-presented, promising 15 month old. 4. Regis Westgate Under Lucky Star (Weber) Richly colored, 16 month old with straight coat and who moved well. Preferred expression of previous.

Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (6) Beautiful masculine heads in this class.

1. Elyzian Double Take (Arnold) 2 year old who moves easily and so well with his handler. His beautiful head was well carried by his crest of neck which flowed to a level topline and on to a gloriously full tail (missing is so many black and tans). He has the silkiest of coats. 2. Charter Oak Claude Monet (Obadowski) A lovely 4 year old dog who pressed the winner. 3. Lacouture King of Rock of Sumara (Gentil) Promising 13 month old dog who was proud of his tail today. He moves well. 4. Copperhill Big Tuna (Mitchell) Promising 23 month old dog. Not the movement of previous but obviously enjoying his moment in the spotlight.

Open Dog (7) Best class of the morning with those in it who could easily be #1 another day

His lovely size and cavalier shape, his neck which gave him presence and showed his beautiful head to advantage, all made a complete picture with his elegant, flowing movement. - **2. Ch Melrose Gold for Bonitos Companeros, JW** (Magera/Mitchell) Beautifully colored ruby dog with classic outline. He's in wonderful condition and beautifully presented. He moves with reach and off short hocks with drive—an eye-catching picture. *Reserve Winners Dog, Best Ruby in Show*
- **3. Ch Brookhaven Kid Rock at Almeara, JW** (Whitmire/Ayers/Martz) Mature 18 month old blenheim. He was well presented and moved well. His topline and tail carriage never faltered. *Best Blenheim Dog, Best American Bred Dog* **4. Ch Kellene Barnaby Jones** (Carter) The sweetest of expressions for this 4 ½ year old richly colored ruby. He flows around the ring for a short coupled dog. His eyes are dark and his pigment is inky. Sadly, he left his glamorous ear fringes at home.

Junior Puppy Bitch (15)

- **1. Rutherford Electra** (Jones) 7 month old pretty, feminine, richly colored blenheim. Loved her shape and size, her dark round eye with good cushion beneath, and dark pigment. - **2. Kellene Copacabana** (Marshall) Sweet 8 month old blenheim. She maintained her topline and tail carriage as she moved. Preferred the expression of #1. **3. Orchardhill Painted Pony** (Venier) An elegant 5month old tri who held her own in the large class. Very promising youngster who can move very well. Preferred the expressions of #1-2. **4. Orchardhill Yes It's True** (Venier) Another sweet 5 month old tri whose movement flows around the ring. This one has much to like and one to watch. Very similar to kennel mate.

Senior Puppy Bitch (3)

Valentyne Portabello Rd (O'Brien) 8 month old blenheim who was missing her owner. Her eyes are dark and round and her pigment dark. She moved well.

Graduate Puppy Bitch (7)

1. Kenjockety Mia (Weber) Charming 13 month old tri with sweet face and lovely size and shape. Her eyes are dark and round. She maintained her topline and tail carriage when she moved. *Award of Merit, Best Tricolor Bitch* **2. Linrica Honey Girl** (Liu) Pretty 14 month old blenheim with sweet face and pretty outline. She moved well but was proud of her tail today. **3. Chadwick Pimms** (Eckersley) 1 year old blenheim with very sweet face and she moved well.

4. Four Willows Fair Oaks Fantasea (Meager) Richly colored 14 month old blenheim with dark eyes and pigment. Promising young bitch.

Novice Bitch (4)

1. Autumnhill Turn On The Radio (Weinstein/Parente) Lovely, compact 10 month old ruby who moved with reach and drive. She never put a foot wrong. Her eyes are dark as is her pigment.
