Thank you very much for inviting me to judge your Championship Show. I was impressed by the high standard of exhibits and their presentation. I feel that it was part of my role to ensure that all exhibitors had adequate time to show their dogs to their maximum potential and I hope that I fulfilled that aim. The only issues that arose for me were a lot of eyes that could have been darker (not light but could have been darker). I gave them the benefit of the doubt as the lighting in the hall was not complimentary to eyes. On the whole confirmation was very good but exhibitors must not neglect exercise to keep fronts tight and maintain the drive from the behind. I also felt that the heads on some dog exhibits could have been stronger. Although some of my decisions may have been controversial, particularly in the dog classes, it is important to bear in mind that these dogs (and bitches) are your future breeding stock. Not to be honest about the standard of the exhibits does a dis-service not only to the breed but also the exhibitor/breeder. The breed has been going through some hard times so we, as breeders, need to try to produce sound stock while still meeting the criteria of the breed standard.

1. Miletree Joshua at Shirmont (Henry) 14 month old Blenheim dog. Well cushioned head with dark nose pigment and dark eye. Correct ear set. Lovely length of neck with crest and well laid back shoulder. Good front and length of forearm. Good turn of stifle and short hock enabling correct movement coming and going. Quality coat with first class presentation. Showed well taking the day in his stride. 2. Clopsville Meridian (Rychlik) 12 month Blenheim dog. Super masculine head. Dark pigment, dark eye. Well sprung rib. Needs to settle to show full potential. 3. Ilow Du Jardin De Claire of Sumara (Gentil) 13 Month old Ruby dog with lovely soft expression in well cushioned head with correct eye and nose pigment. Good topline and short hock. Needs a bit more time to mature. Best Ruby Dog 4. Autumnhill Believe In Me (Parente) Well broken Blenheim in full coat. Good eye and nose pigment, correct ear set and good topline. Well presented.

Novice Dog (2)

1. Castlemaine Woodsman (Warme) Blenheim dog with well cushioned head with soft expression. Dark eye and deep nose pigment. Correct ear set. Ample length of neck with crest down to well laid back shoulder. Correct length of forearm and good front. Excellent bone, good spring of rib, Level top line and good set of tail. Well turned stifle and short hock. Moved with drive and enthusiasm. Showed himself off in the ring. 2. Rosehill Bears Repeating (Perini) Tri dog with good pigment, dark eye, rich tan.
