- **2. Darane Hellboy** (Kates) Baby Ruby of just 5 months. Pretty head with large, dark eyes. Moved well for his age. Good coat just darkening to a rich Ruby. **3. Mileslip Bells N Whistle** (Skidmore) 8 month old Ruby boy. Nice compact body with a pretty head and large eyes. **4. Bentwood Imagistic** (Borton) 8 month old Blenheim. Very mature for his age. Nice body shape with richly coloured coat.

1. Canidan's Collision Course (Gentil) 11 month old Black and Tan. A little fine in head. Moved well with strong hindquarters and correct tail set. Needs muscle.

- Hiddencreek Hugo Boss, JW (Green) Stylish Blenheim with proud head carriage. Moved very well and looked good on the move. Pretty head with large dark eyes and good pigment.
 Briarcrest Burberry (Katz) Moved well with correct shoulders, level topline and good tailset. Paler in colour and not as good pigment as 1st.
 Truluv Carlos (Nikaci) Compact boy who moved well especially at the front. Not as attractive in head as those above him.
 Blackfire Room Service at Kalais (Hess/Kennedy/Weidig) Immature Tricolour who
- relaxed more on the move. Pretty head. **Novice Dog** (1)

1. Crystalkane Dream Maker (Alexander) Heavier Blenheim boy. Would like better shoulders and croup. Moved OK.

Bred By Exhibitor Dog (5)

1. Ch Brookhaven Believe It Or Not (Ayers/Martz) Compact Blenheim boy. Enough good coloured coat. Pretty head with dark pigment. Lovely picture on the move. Just preferred his size. *Best Blenheim in Show* 2. Ch Piccadil Peppermint Twist (York) Well marked Blenheim who is a little paler and larger than 1st. Moved really well. 3. Ch Veribas Point Break (Cusick) Well marked Tricolour who moved well but looked a bit bored. 4. Chewcreek Three Amigos Dusty Bottoms, JW (DePhillip) Finer in head than those above. Nice shaped body and moved well.

Junior American Bred Dog (1)

1. Darane Frodo Baggins (Kates) 8 ½ month old Blenheim. Looked good on the move with accurate movement. Would prefer a shorter muzzle.

American Bred Dog (8)

1. Dreamvale Ollivander (Sage/Hallsted) Blenheim boy with well marked coat. Good shoulders, topline and tailset. Moved well with constantly wagging tail. 2. Brookhaven Jessie (Parente) Heavier marked Blenheim boy who is shorter in face than 1st. Nice shape with strong hindquarters and straight front. 3. Chadwick Snow Drift at Woodbury, JW (Redniss) Would prefer a more masculine head but had large, round, dark eyes. Good level topline but held tail a little high on the move. 4. Nightingale Wish Upon A Star at Nebyula (Birbeck) Paler Blenheim. Would prefer a stronger head.

Health & Conformation Dog (1)

1. Ch Silverspoon Nutcracker (Silverman) 5 ½ year old Black and Tan with a lovely shine on his coat. Shapely body and moved well. Good pigment but would like a darker eye.

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (5)

1. Chantismere Caruso of Chadwick (Eckersley) Smart, well broken, richly coloured Blenheim. Pretty head with dark pigment and eyes. Good shoulders and front. Moved with style. 2. Jayba Southern Voices at Autumnhill (Parente/Hayes) Well made with good chest, shoulders and level topline. Strong rear with good stifles and well muscled hindquarters. Happy dog who moved well. 3. Coedgwylum Hot Chase At Truluv (Nikaci) Richly marked Blenheim with nice eyes. Moved well but a bit longer than those above. 4. Orchardhill

Letters Home (Slusher/Venier) Happy boy who was a tad larger than those above him. In good coat and with dark pigment and eyes.

Special Limit Tricolor Dog (3)

1. Kellene The Black Orlov (Carter) 3 year old mature Tricolour with well broken up markings on his silky coat. Strong hind movement, good front and correct croup and tailset. Gentle expression. 2. Aubinwood Griffen (Chaples-Burke/Gibson) Another well broken Tricolour. A bit longer in body so did not look as balanced on the move. 3. Dreamvale Tri Your Luck, JW (Parker) Younger boy who needs to strengthen at the rear. Falls away at his croup. Pretty head with a lovely expression.

Special Limit Ruby Dog (3)

- 1. Jalesto Super Trooper of Sumara, JW (Gentil) Richly coloured Ruby who had a good neck and shoulders and was deep in chest. Good pigment and attractive expression. Moved well. *Best Ruby Dog 2*. Autumnhill Spencer, JW (Weinstein/Parente) Glamorous boy with good body shape. Just preferred the expression of 1st. 3. Sevenwoods Wildberry (Shidler) Lighter in colour and build. Nice body shape and moved well. Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (5)
- 1. Mileslip Licorice, JW (Skidmore) I have loved this boy since I first saw him at Clinton two years ago as a Junior Puppy, and was pleased to see how well he had matured. Lovely topline and style on the move. Full in head with good pigment. 1. Ch Chantismere Chandos of Valentyne, JW (O'Brien) Short coupled Blenheim who moved very well, showing off his level topline and correct tailset. Lovely expression from his dark eyes. 2. Ch Bozi VH Lamslag (York) 4 year old Tricolour who moved very well. Plainer in head than 1st. 3. Ch Linrica I Dreamed A Dream (Liu) Blenheim boy with a level topline and good tailset. Attractive head but not as good on the move. 4. Ch Chadwick Scotch on the Rocks at Hudsonview JW (Yassky/Glynn) Paler in coat and finer in head than those above, Nice shape and moved happily.

Junior Puppy Bitch (12)

- 1. Rutherford Byonce (Jones) 8 month old Blenheim. Well broken coat markings on a good body. Well balanced with a good neck and shoulders which gave her elegance on the move. Pretty head with dark pigment. Best Puppy Bitch, Best Puppy in Show, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Blenheim Bitch, Best Bred By Exhibitor Bitch
- **2. Kean Pristine of Valentyne** (Keane/O'Brien) Smaller, compact Blenheim of just 5 months. Pretty head and expression. Well angled shoulders and moved well. **3. Angel's Pride Evening Star** (Gentil) Larger girl who moved well. Well broken Blenheim coat. Pretty head and expression. **4. Linrica Femme Fatale** (Liu) Heavier type with deep chest. Moved well.

Senior Puppy Bitch (2)

1. AutumnHill California Dreaming (Parente) Ruby with richly coloured coat. Shapely body with especially nice tail set. Moved well showing off strong hindquarters. 2. Blackfire I Approved This Message (Weidig/Kennedy) Dark eyes and pigment in her pretty head. Good neck and topline but I would prefer a better tailset.

Novice Bitch (4)

1. Valentyne Vanilla Sky (O'Brien) 6 month old Blenheim. Very pretty with an attractive expression. Good body shape with a nice tailset and carriage. Moved well. **2. Nightingale Goldilocks** (Birbeck) Not as chunky as 1st. Well coated and good on the move. **3. Chadwick Bizet** (Comer/Greak) Sweet Tricolour. Very pretty and compact. Moved well but didn't like her tailset. **4. Hollytree First Noel** (LeVerso/Seymour) Tricolour who was heavily marked and lighter in body.

1. Piccadil Gone With The Wind (York) Pretty Blenheim with dark pigment and large eyes. Well bodied with well muscled rear. Moved well. 2. Blackfire Understudy at Hytea (Reichardt) Larger Black and Tan who showed off her good neck, shoulders and level topline on the move. I would like a softer expression. 3. Truluv Giselle of Foxwyn (Baker-Fox) 3 year old Blenheim who was not as balanced as those above. Moved well in profile. 4. Kissabella Arabella (Bronowicka/Carter) Blenheim girl who was longer in muzzle and smaller in eye than those above. Looked good on the move.

Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (6)

- 1. Lickertysplit Maybe I'm Amazed (Geohegan) Well balanced bitch with especially good rear. Moved well.
- 2. Cobbhill Golden Marguerite (Brunson/Rose) Heavier marked Blenheim. Attractive head and expression with large, dark eyes. Moved well with wagging tail. 3. Orchardhill Ever After (Venier) Heavier type of bitch. Good pigment but head not as attractive as those above. 4. Dancasa Summer Thyme (Rutino/Tiedemann) Not as attractive picture on the move. Would like better shoulders and neck.

Special Limit Tricolor Bitch (1)
