JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3) “A lovely class to start the day 3 smart puppies all with maturing to do.”

- 1) **GRANASIL RUM TUM TUGGER** (Gentil). 6-month-old Black and Tan. Good coat with correct tan markings. Compact shape standing four square naturally with correct bone. Moved out around the ring well carrying his tail well. Good reach of neck flowing into well laid shoulders. Nice head shape with dark round large eyes. Excellent personality happy and eager to please. An exciting prospect.
- 2) **LYNSFAIRE WINE AND ROSES** (Fairchild) 6-month-old Ruby. Nice texture coat coming through of good colour. Good bite. Nice shape with good bone slightly larger than first. Excellent dark nose and pigment. Moved well. Happy personality wagging his tail on the move. Head will need time to develop but components all present.
- 3) **FALLING SPRINGS FIREBIRD AT ASPENGLow** (Peterson/Peterson) Well-marked Blenheim, 5 months old. Good bite. Slightly finer all through and needing to body up but plenty of time on his side! Excellent personality constantly wagging his tail even on the table. Holds a good top-line on the move and standing. Good pigment with jet black nose.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3) “Three promising young males all just ‘finding’ their hormones.”

- 1) **CHARDOMONT FIRST EDITION OF CHADWICK** (Eckersley) 10-month-old Blenheim very well marked with a well broken coat. Loved his head, he has a lovely gentle expression. SoG melting dark round eyes. Good bite. Nice size and shape with nice level top-line, will fill his frame as he matures. Nice

reach of neck flowing into well placed shoulders. Moved out with purpose.

BEST PUPPY DOG.

- 2) **FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDORR** (Mixon/Mixon/Cline/Marshall) 9-month-old Blenheim. Very well marked with rich colour well broken up on a white background. Great size and shape, making a very smart outline. Well ribbed. Correct tail set and carriage. Gentle expression with nice eyes. Good bone and nice spring OF rib. Another promising puppy.
- 3) **BLUEGARDEN CASINO ROYALE** (DiBonaventura) 10-month-old Tricolour, well broken markings and tan in correct places. Loved his head, he has a true gentle expression. Large round dark eyes contributing to his gentle expression. Nice size. He was very full of himself today.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (6)

- 1) **KENDALL KASTLE LOVE IS IN THE HEIR** (Ogle) 17-month-old Blenheim dog heavier marked, lovely coat condition. Correct bite. Nice compact shape. Good bone and correct reach of neck. Moved out very well around the ring maintaining a solid level top-line. Well set on tail. Quite masculine in head but still with a nice expression. Lovely large round dark eyes. Good personality, outgoing and wanting to please.
- 2) **MARJORELLE THE AVIATOR WHEELS UP** (Conley) 13-months-old. Another slightly heavier marked Blenheim. Loved his head and expression, lovely large round dark eyes. Ears well placed. Good top line and nice bone. Dark pigmentation.
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES THE SON** (Wells) 13-months-old. Blenheim nicely marked with lozenge. Good bite. Heavier set with a masculine head. Well made with correct balance and angulations. Tail set on well and carried correctly. Happy personality.
- 4) **FIELDSEGE PADRAIG** (Slusher/Slusher) 13-months-old. Well-marked Blenheim with lozenge. Heavier set all through. Good bite. Nice make and type. Nice large round dark eyes. Moved ok with well carried tail. Thick coat seeming to be in the middle of a change and still losing his puppy 'fluff'.

NOVICE DOG (1)

- 1) **CHADWICK TRADE SECRET** (Lyons) 1.5-years-old. Blenheim, well-marked with rich colour. Good bite. Well coated dog beautifully presented. Nice head with correct gentle expression. Appealing round eyes. Good bone and substance. Moved out well holding a good top line. Carried his tail level with his back. Good depth of chest. Happy and concentrating on his owner.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (2)

- 1) **CH BROOKHAVEN CATCHING FIRE JW, AW** (Ayers) 2.5-years-old. Richly marked Ruby, presented immaculately. Lovely dog very sound. Masculine head but still maintaining the desired gentle expression. Ears set correctly. Large, dark, round eyes that you could just melt into. Moved out very well around the ring with good reach and drive, seemingly effortless. I could have watched him move all day. Carried his tail level at all times. Good bone and excellent spring of rib. Good reach of neck flowing onto well laid shoulders. Correct proportions. I liked him a lot and was delighted and surprised to learn later he is the sire of my Blenheim Best Puppy in Show. **[BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG & BEST RUBY IN SHOW.](#)**
- 2) **LYNSFAIRE PAINT IT GOLD** (Fairchild) 1.5-years-old. Well broken Blenheim. Coat of good texture. Lovely gay Cavalier personality. Finer all through. Moved well holding a good top line. Correct reach of neck. Carried his tail well. Correct bite. Nice dark pigment and eyes.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

- 1) **DEL SOL IN THE DARK AT FIELDSEDGE** (Slusher) 15-months-old. Black and Tan just a little short on feathering but well textured, shiny coat. Nice head with sweet expression. Good bite. He holds a good top line moving and standing. Good reach of neck. Good tail carriage.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (5)

- 1) **FALLING SPRINGS JUST YOU WAIT AT CROWNROSE, JW, MP** (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) 2-years-old. Mature Blenheim, well-marked with large white collar. Could use just a tad more feathering to complete him. Good bite. Very nice expression, masculine yet still gentle. Large round dark eyes. Great movement really striding out around the ring and powering from his hocks. Excellent reach of neck flowing into a super level top-line finished by a well set on tail carried level. Attentive to his handler. A lot to like.
- 2) **EVERA TRUE ETHAN ALLEN MIRACLE** (True) 1.5-years-old. Smartly marked Blenheim. Beautifully presented. Well-proportioned head with excellent gentle expression. Ears well set. Moved out well around the ring holding a good top line and carrying his tail well. Excellent pigment. Nice size and shape with good bone.
- 3) **ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TUDORR, JW** (Mixon/Mixon) 2.5-years-old. Well-marked Blenheim with excellent rich colour. Well presented. Nice head and expression. Well placed ears. Correct bite. Moved out nicely maintaining a level top line. Good size and shape with moderate bone.
- 4) **NIGHTINGALE REVOLUTION, MP** (Cameron) 3.5-years-old. Heavier marked Blenheim. Slightly finer all through. Pretty head with good expression, nice round dark eyes. A little unsettled today.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (6)

- 1) **TASSAJARA LAWS OF MOTION** (Seidman/Seidman) 2-years-old.
Beautifully marked dog. Good bite. I absolutely loved his head and expression, and gentle with large round dark eyes that just draw you in. Well placed ears framing his head. Good reach of neck and excellent well laid-back shoulders. Lovely size with compact body and moderate bone. Nice spring of rib. Good top line and well set on tail. Very well put together which all came together when he showed his super movement.
- 2) **TUDORR RETURN OF THE VELVET TEDDY BEAR** (Mixon/Mixon) 1.5-years-old. Another super dog splitting hairs between 1st and 2nd. Smartly marked. Good bite. Excellent size, shape and type. He has a beautiful head, and gentle yet still masculine. Great eyes, large dark and round just completing his headpiece. Good reach of neck and good top line on the move.
- 3) **NIGHTINGALE HEART OF GOLD, AW** (Weeks/Weeks) 3.5-years-old.
Well-marked dog. Very showy beautifully presented and schooled. Trying to always please his handler enjoying his job wagging his tail. Very good reach of neck and nice top line. Good size. Nice head with a typical expression. Lovely large round dark eyes.
- 4) **MILBU UNIQUE CHOICE** (Theodosiadis) Just shy of 3-years-old. Heavier marked dog. Full coat well presented. Excellent breed type and substance. Nice shape and size. Good bone and spring of rib. Nice head and expression. I wish he was a little more co-operative and confident.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR DOG (3)

- 1) **PASCAVALE FLOYD** (Cline) 1.5-years-old. Very well marked young man beautifully presented. Tan in all the correct places. Compact size. Beautiful head and melting expression. Ears well set. Large round dark eyes well placed. Good bone and depth of chest. Correct reach of neck and well laid-back shoulders. Moved ok. Good bite. Lovely happy cavalier personality. ***BEST TRICOLOUR IN SHOW.***
- 2) **TRISTAN DOBRY ROK** (Fairchild) 15-months-old. Heavier marked with tan in correct places. Well made with good bone and substance. Nice size. Good reach of neck. Well placed ears. Slightly more masculine in head. Wide blaze. Good bite. Nice eyes dark and round. Correct cavalier personality.
- 3) **SHERAH TWIST OF FATE** (Crommett). Just shy of 3-years-old. Heavier marked with dark tan in correct places. Nice size with good bone and spring of rib. Good large, dark, round eyes. Hold and correct level top-line. Wish he would have enjoyed himself more and wagged his tail.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

- 1) **FOXWYN IN IT TO WIN IT AT NOONVALE** (Berton/Baker Fox). 2-years-old. Stood alone in this class but still a very deserved win. Lovely rich coloured coat. Perfect shape and size with a slighter frame. Excellent top-line

when moving, tending to slope off when standing. Well set on tail which floats off his back carried correctly. Excellent expression with large dark round eyes. So hard to achieve on a Ruby. Well set ears framing his head. Moved out with drive and precision. Very happy show dog. Good bite.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TANDOG (3)

- 1) **SREYA BROOKHAVEN FINDERS KEEPERS** (Ayers) 2-years-old. Very smart with correct markings of excellent bright tan. Very handsome head, soG yet still masculine. Broad skull with well placed ears creating the correct slightly rounded shape. Great size and pleasing outline. Good top line held at all times. Excellent well laid shoulders and good reach of neck. Moved out very well around the ring. A quality young dog. **BEST BLACK AND TANDOG.**
- 2) **CHEW CREEK BOOGIE WONDERLAND** (DePhillip). Beautifully presented 6-year-old in tip top condition. Moved out very well around the ring with good drive and holding a level top line. Well set on tail carried level with his top line. Beautiful dark round eyes. Nice head framed by well set ears. Showed very well constantly wagging his tail.
- 3) **LORANKA'S LIMITED EDITION** (Seidman/Seidman) 16-months-old. Well-marked coat of good texture and condition. Good for size and bone. Nice head with excellent round dark eyes. Moved ok.

OPEN DOG (6) “A lovely class with some stunning dogs with 1st and 2nd gaining Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Dog. It was a joy to watch them go around the ring.”

- 1) **CH. CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW, JW** (Glynn/Glynn) Just shy of 2- years-old. Smartly marked Blenheim with good depth of colour. Well-presented with coat of good texture. Loved his type caught my attention the moment he walked into the ring, moved out with drive and purpose. Excellent size with nicely balanced front and rear angulation. Good reach of neck. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Classic head shape with a typical soG and melting expression. Well set ears and slightly rounded skull. Dark round eyes. Good bite. Good black pigment. Loved his personality eager to please and constant tail wag. He shone in the Challenge for Best Dog and only narrowly lost out to the beautiful bitch in the Challenge. **WINNERS DOG, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW & BEST OPPOSITE SEX IN SHOW.**
- 2) **CH. ELLEMICH THE HUNTSMAN** (Wells/Schrank/Ireland/Chapman) 3.5-years-old Heavier marked Blenheim in good coat very well presented. Quality dog with excellent type. Gorgeous head and melting expression and large round dark eyes yet still maintains a masculine edge. Good bite. Loved his shape and size. Balanced angulations front and rear. Good bone and spring of rib. Level top line maintained at all times. Well set on tail carried well. Moved out well with good drive. Today he didn't always have his mind on the task, but he put in a good performance in the Challenge for **RESERVE WINNERS DOG.**

- 3) **PINNACLEE CHOCOLATE BUTTONS** (Norton) 3-years-old. Another stunning dog richly marked Ruby in full bloom well presented. Nice shape and size. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Tail set on correctly. Moved out very well around the ring holding a level top line and carrying his tail level with his back. Good reach of neck and well laid front assembly. Good bone. Masculine head with large dark eyes, still with the required softness. Correct bite.
- 4) **CH DREAMVALE GENTLEMAN JACK AT FIELDSEDGE** (Smith/Slusher/Slusher) 4- years-old. Very smart Black and Tan, correctly marked with good tan points. Moved out well around the ring really driving well with enthusiasm. Good personality. Nice large round dark eyes. Good head with well-placed ears. Correct bite.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (5) “I really enjoyed judging this class of wonderful showmen, they obviously still love their job and were a credit to their owners.”

- 1) **CH ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE, VW** (Cameron) 8-year-old heavier marked Blenheim, who I instantly admired. Smaller in frame but all in proportion. Moved out very well around the ring with precise action. Moderate reach of neck. Holds a level top line at all times, and carrying his tail level with his back. Loved his large, round, dark eyes and excellent pigmentation. Nice head with well set ears. Good personality constantly wagging his tail.
- 2) **CH CHADWICK JET SETTER AT HUDSONVIEW, JW** (Glynn/Glynn) 7-years-old. Another smartly marked Blenheim presented to perfection from this handler. Pushed 1 very hard. Lovely type. Well made with good bone. Excellent reach of neck which flows onto a lovely level top line. Well set tail. Good head, quite masculine. Excellent eyes, large, dark and round. Well set ears framing his head. He obviously loves showing wagging his tail constantly.
- 3) **CH KHATIBI ONE IN VERMILION AT DENHAM, ENG JW** (Maddox) 9-years-old. Richly coloured Ruby, another very well presented. Good type with excellent top line and tail carriage. Nice head and expression, with dark round eyes. Good reach of neck. Moved out well.
- 4) **CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE, AW, VW** (Utych/Utych) 7.5-years- old. Well-marked Blenheim. Excellent size and shape. Nice profile with good top line and reach of neck. Large dark eyes. Moved OK. Happy showman.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (11) “A great class of puppies with plenty not placed showing great promise.”

- 1) **TIBBEDIN SUMMER BREEZE AT VALENTYNE** (O’Brien) 9-months-old. Smartly marked Blenheim, with excellent depth of colour. Excellent coat coming through with correct silky texture. Very feminine head but still with substance and cushioning. Correct bite. Large dark limpid eyes with the stunning

dark eye rims accentuating her soft gentle expression. Well made with good bone and body. Moved out very well around the ring holding a level top line and carrying her tail well. Good depth and chest and spring of rib.

- 2) **AUTUMNHILL BEWITCHED** (Parente) 6 months old. Young Ruby with adult coat coming through her baby fluff. Still very immature but she has beautiful conformation. Very balanced angulations and excellent reach of neck. Moved out well with good motion coming and going. Good top line. Raw head but all correct with plenty time to mature. Lovely large, dark, round eyes. Correct bite. Good bone and depth of chest.
- 3) **TIBBEDON SUMMER LOVE** (Tibbetts). 9-months-old. Well-marked Blenheim with good depth of colour. Well-proportioned head with correctly set ears and eyes. Sweetest of expressions. Lovely large round dark eyes. Level top line. Good bone and spring of rib. Moved out well. Happy personality. Can see she is the litter sister to the class winner. What an exciting pair!
- 4) **FORESTCREEK RIGHT BEFORE YOUR EYES** (Sherman/Cline/Marshall) 7- months-old. Completing a set of 4 very nice young girls all with exciting futures ahead. Nicely marked Blenheim with lozenge. Excellent dark pigment. Nice head with large round eyes. Well put together with good bone and depth of chest. Moved out well carrying her tail correctly. A little raw but she has everything in the right places.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (6)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN DIAMONDS ARE A GIRLS BEST FRIEND**
(Ayers/Gregory) 10-month-old, My notes say “caught my eye coming into the ring and she continued to thrill!”. Very well broken Blenheim. I absolutely loved her on the move she floats along with elegance and drive. Nice type with excellent substance and bone. Very well put together, good reach of neck flowing onto level top line. Well laid shoulders and correctly balanced rear. Nice size with good substance. Excellent spring of rib. When standing she naturally holds a great shape. Lovely head with luscious large round dark eyes. Well set ears. Correct bite. Well carried tail. Happy personality gently wagging her tail. In the Challenge she kept catching my eyes and continued to move so effortlessly I could not resist her **RESERVE BEST BITCH, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.**

- 2) **GENTLE STAR OVER THE TOP AT HUDSONVIEW** (Glynn/Glynn) 11-months-old. Smartly marked Tricolour with correct bright tan markings. Good size and shape. Well made with good angulations. Precise movement. Correct level top line which she held standing and moving. Tail carried level with top line. Nice head with well set ears framing her sweet expression. Good bite.
- 3) **CHARDOMONT SPECIAL EDITION** (Greak/Comer) 9-months-old. Well-marked Blenheim with rich markings. Good size and shape. Good reach of neck with level top line and well set on tail. Well boned with nice spring of rib. Nice head with beautiful expression. Large, round, dark eyes. Good bite.
- 4) **TIALULLY STREET LEGAL** (Rubino) 9-months-old. Extremely rich coloured Ruby. Good head with well set ears and nice eyes. Plenty of time to mature. Moved out well holding a good top line and carrying her tail correctly. Correct bite.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (9) “A beautiful class of top-quality junior bitches. I was spoilt for choice and my top 4 are sure to have good futures.”

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES LOGAN** (Ayers) 13-months-old. Very smart well broken Blenheim with coat of excellent texture. Compact in frame but she oozes quality, so balanced. Good type with excellent shape. She holds a good top line and all times with tail well set on. Good bone and lovely spring of rib. Moderate reach of neck fitting into well angulated shoulders. Moved out with style. Excellent front action. Pretty head with beautiful gentle expression. Stunning eyes, large round and dark. Excellent dark pigmentation. Good Bite. Considered in my final line up in the Challenge.
- 2) **CEMPA CEDAR CREEK SILVER LINING** (Owens/Creary). 13-months-old. Heavier marked Blenheim who had a beautifully presented coat of excellent texture. Moved out very well with good drive. Great shape with good bone depth of chest. Correct top line and tail set. Beautiful feminine expression accentuated by stunning large round dark eyes. Well set ears framing her head. Good bite. Happy showgirl constantly wagging her tail.
- 3) **DREAMVALE AMERICAN DYNASTY AT CROWNROSE** (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) 12-months-old. Heavier marked Blenheim with perfect lozenge. Excellent texture with rich colour. Another cracking young girl in this class. Good for size and shape, good bone and substance. Moved out very nicely around the ring with good drive. Good reach of neck. My notes say “Love, love her eyes”, large round and dark! Nice head with gentle expression framed by well set ears. Good bite.

- 4) **ALMEARA SHES SO FINE, JW** (Whitmire). 15-months-old. Rounding off a lovely quartet of girls, well-marked Blenheim, with rich colour. Good type. Nice expression with excellent large round dark eyes. Correct dentation. Good size and shape. Good bone and spring of rib. Level top line, tail well set on. Good personality.

NOVICE BITCH (4)

- 1) **CAMERONA SPITFIRE** (Cameron) 2.5-years-old. Heavier marked Blenheim with rich colour. Very showy, constantly wagging her tail which she held level. Good head with lovely large round dark eyes with dark rims. Level top line held at all times. Moved out ok. Slightly finer bone. Correct bite.
- 2) **NIGHTINGALE PINK MOON** (Mautone/Mautone) Just shy of 2-years-old. Well broken Blenheim bitch with a full coat. Nice size with good bone. Moved out steadily with good top line. Good tail carriage. Correct bite. Well set tail which was in constant motion. Good personality.
- 3) **KRYSTLE I WILL REMEMBER YOU** (Torgersen/Torgersen) 7 month old puppy looking quite raw in this class, still with plenty of maturing to do. Well-marked Blenheim with coat of good texture. Good size and shape, plenty of promise. Nice head with excellent eyes, dark, round and melting. Although hesitant she moved well. Correct bite.
- 4) **CHARTEROAK ROSE ALL DAY** (Obadowski) 2.5-years-old. Richly marked ruby well presented. Slightly heavier in head than my preference but good components. Well set ears. Large round, dark, eyes. Held a good top line and moved out well. Correct bite.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

- 1) **CH FORESTCREEK SWEET SOUL AT HADARA** (Cline/Koch) 2.5-years-old. Stood alone in this class but she deserved the win. A beautiful bitch. Well broken Blenheim coat, well-presented of good texture. Excellent reach of neck flowing into a lovely level top line. Tail well set and carried level. Good depth of chest. Compact size with good bone. Standing she holds a great shape standing naturally four square. Exquisite head with melting expression, correctly set on ears with long feathering. Moved out well with good drive and accuracy. Happy showgirl with constantly wagging tail. Correct bite. Pulled into my final cut of consideration in the Challenge.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (6)

- 1) **CHADWICK MASQUERADE** (Eckersley/McCarty) 14-months-old. Well broken Blenheim markings with good colour. My notes say "All through a lovely bitch, absolutely moderate in all departments". Good size and shape, with well-balanced angulations. As you would expect she was excellent on the move, with good drive. Carried a super level top line with a level tail which was in constant motion. Good bone and spring of rib. Good head with sweet

expression. Meltingly soft large, round dark eyes.

- 2) **PINNACLE BABY YOU'RE A FIREWORK** (Gregory/Ayers) 14-months-old. Black and Tan with bright tan markings in correct places. Very eye catching, with excellent ring presence. Excellent condition with shining coat of good texture. Loved her shape and compact size. Excellent reach of neck flowing into a dead level top line. Moved out well around the ring with good drive. Good bite. Pretty head with gentle expression and nice round, dark eyes. [BEST BLACK AND TAN IN SHOW.](#)
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN PEACHES AND CREAM** (Ayers) 14-months-old. Smartly marked Blenheim bitch with excellent colour and pigmentation. She has an absolutely rock-solid top line held at all top lines and perfect set on tail. Compact in size but still with good bone and rib. Lovely head with melting dark round eyes. Moved out well with good drive. Good bite. Tail carried well.
- 4) **FORESTCREEK DIAMOND OF THE SOUTH** (Cline) 13-months-old. Well broken Blenheim just past a year old and still with plenty of maturing to do. Well presented. Good head with sweet expression. Makes a nice shape standing with excellent reach of neck and good top line. Moved out well with plenty of drive and enthusiasm. Good bite.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (7)

- 1) **FIELDSEGE ANGELS FLYING CLOSE** (Slusher/Slusher) 2-years-old. Very well marked Blenheim with lozenge. Good size and shape. Moved out very well around the ring with good drive. Precise fore and aG movement. Moderate reach of neck. Nice bone with good depth of chest and spring of rib. Nice head with soG round dark eyes. Well set ears framing her head. Good bite. Good personality very attentive to her handler.
- 2) **FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY** (Curley) 2-years-old Another well marked Blenheim. Very animated always trying to please her handler. Good shape with head held on moderate reach of neck. Good top line. Good depth of chest. Tail well set and in constant motion. Sweet expression with nice eyes. Well set ears. Good bite.
