- **1. Forestcreek Double O Seven** (Cline) Good sized well balanced blen. Well broken, nice dark eyes giving a pretty expression. Good neck and shoulders with excellent top line and tail set. Moved well for one so young. Well presented and handled. *Best Puppy Dog*
- 2. Brookhaven Kid Rock (Ayers/Martz) Small elegant blen. Nice head and dark eye. Plenty of neck and good shoulder set. Good turn of stifle, moved well. Very happy youngster full of confidence. 3. Tudorose Rembrandt (Bragg/Mixon) Well marked blen. Good head and darkest of eyes. Nice bone. Straight topline and correct tail carriage. 4. Blackfire Exit Poll (Weidig/Kennedy) Blen, slightly longer in the body. Nice head with dark eye and kind expression. Correct bone. Moved with drive, correct movement around the ring. Senior Puppy Dog (7)
- 1. Chadwick Midnight Sun at Hudsonview (Yassky/Glynn) Small compact tri. Soft expression, well cushioned under the darkest of eyes. Correct ear set. Nice length of neck and crest. Good turn of stifle and short hock. Moved well both ways with confidence and drive. 2. Hiddencreek Hugo Boss, JW (Green) Heavily marked blen. Rich tan. Nice head with good reach of neck and compact body. Moved well. Straight topline. Moved with drive but just carried head to one side when on the move. 3. Blackfire Plaza Suite (McLaughlin/Kenny/Weidig/Kennedy) Blen. Slightly longer in the body. Well marked with a kind expression. Nice dark eye, good cushioning. Moved well, correct tail carriage. 4. Hiddencreek Ace in the Hole (Quillen) Blen. boy. Dark eye with pleasing expression. Moved ok but I would have liked to have seen a better topline. Happy young man.

1. Jayba Easy Does It, JW (Lander) A quality heavily marked blen. Very glamorous well coated toy spaniel. The prettiest of heads with well set ears. Good neck and shoulders leading into a level topline and tail carriage. Short coupled body with correct bone. Moved well around the ring. In excellent condition.; a very happy dog. 2. Bentwood Brighton (Cromer) Glamorous well marked blen. Attractive head with large dark eye. Good nose pigment and sweet expression. Moved with drive keeping a good tail set. 3. Harana Shakin Stevens (Bucy) Ruby in good coat. Not the best of toplines. Lovely dark eye and a well cushioned muzzle giving a gentle expression. Moved well, showed well. 4. Cavilera's Perfect Storm (Gentil) Well coated blen. Attractive head with large dark eyes. Elegant neck set into well laid shoulders. Would have liked to have seen better rear movement. Well presented.

Nice sized and well balanced. Moved with plenty of drive from behind.

- 1. Bookhaven Believe It Or Not (Ayers/Martz) A nice sized well coated blen. Dark round eyes and large full ears giving a nice expression. Pleasingly coupled and moderately boned. Ample spring of rib. Well balanced and moved with positive drive action from rear. Correct tail set. Very pleasing profile. Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog 2. Pinecrest White Lightning, JW (Eubank) Another well broken blen. Good head full in the muzzle. Large round dark eyes. Good shoulders and depth of chest. Lovely straight coat with generous feathering. Lovely level topline. Strong rear quarters. Stood four square. Moved with ease and confidence around the ring. A very happy dog. 3. Ch Mimric Consensus, JW (Hodges/Perkins) Blen. Longer in body and slightly larger in size. In good coat. Nice head with large eyes. Needs to settle on the move. Shown well and in good condition. 4. Tanglewood Rebellion (Saban/Fairchild) Nice size Ruby good head and eyes. Moved and shown well but tail carriage a little high.

Jalesto Super Trooper of Sumara (Gentil) Similar to 1. but slightly longer in body. Good head with enough cushioning below his large dark eyes. Good neck and shoulders. An alert expression. A very happy dog and a pleasure to go over. Moved soundly. 3. Autumn Hill Spencer, JW (Weinstein/Parente) Ruby dog shown in very good condition. Nice head with soft expression. Well ribbed short coupled and strong rear angulation. Moved well around the ring but carried his tail a little high. 4.
