I wish to thank the committee of the Cavaliers of the South for inviting me to judge and especially Earline Barrois and Nancy Maddox for looking after Pauline and me throughout our stay, and my appreciation to Brenda Gear for her excellent stewarding on the day. I would also like to thank the exhibitors for their entries and allowing me to judge their lovely dogs. I considered my principal winners all possessed what I look for in a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel i.e. a Toy Spaniel. I look for a well-balanced profile, a level topline both standing and on the move and be short coupled in body; they should be sound in construction which allows them their true free movement and possess a soft or gentle expression.

# Junior Puppy Dog (4)

- **1. Darane Hellboy** (Kates) This 8 month old Ruby dog caught my eye as soon as he entered the ring, he has a level topline, a good spring of rib and he has all the signs of a good coat to come. Medium in bone throughout, he has a good turn of stifle and holds his elbows close to his body, his head is carried on a medium length of neck which is set into well laid shoulders. His skull is slightly rounded and he has ample cushioning under his large dark eyes. With dark nose pigment and long high set ears framing his face they combine to give him a soft expression. I was pleased to later award him *Best Puppy Dog, Best Puppy in Show, Best Ruby Dog*.
- 2. Closeburn Spencer Stirling Stuart (Cullen/Fairchild) A 7 month old Blenheim not as mature in the body as the first but he has a pleasing head with long high set ears and gently tapering muzzle, large dark round eyes and broad white blaze with lozenge. He has good width and depth to his chest which does not impede his straight front legs on the move. 3. Bonitos Companeros Eldorado (Magera/Mitchell) Another nice puppy very similar to the second dog. He too has a broad head, large dark eyes with ample cushioning, again, needs to mature in body but at only 8 months it will come. Slightly straighter in the rear than the second, but it did not affect his overall movement. 4. Piccadil Once In A Lifetime (York) This 6 month old Tricolour reminded me of my first tricolour at the same age. He is immature in the body and his head needs to break which I'm sure it will, given time. He has well-constructed front and rear quarters which allowed him to move true around the ring.

# Senior Puppy Dog (4)

1. Darane Frodo Baggins (Kates) This 11 month old Blenheim has a level topline and is well bodied for his age. Moderate in bone, he has straight front legs and is parallel behind which allowed him to move with drive around the ring carrying his tail level on the move. He has reasonably well broken markings, has good length to ears and has large round dark eyes. Not too deep in stop, he has dark nose pigment and a gently tapered muzzle. 2. Denham Superstorm (Maddox) Another at 11 months old, this Ruby was presented in excellent coat and condition. He has a broad head with long high set ears, dark round eyes, is not too deep in stop and has dark nose pigment. Level in topline with good width to chest he has a good spring of rib and good rear angulation. 3. Melrose Joker For Bonitos Companeros (Adair/Vorderstrasse/Kirschbaum) 10 month old Ruby with a happy disposition. He has dark expressive eyes set in a broad masculine head. He is well bodied with medium bone and he moved true around the ring. 4. Dreamvale Spotted Dick (Jones/Sage) 11 month old Tricolour with pearly white markings to his collar and blanket marking to body. Level in topline he has moderate length to neck which is set into well laid shoulders and he has well angulated rear-quarters. Broad in head he has a tapered muzzle, dark round eyes, rich tan markings; he just lacked a broad white blaze.

### **Graduate Puppy Dog (1)**

**1. Hiddencreek Hugo Boss, JW** (Green) A 17 month old heavily marked Blenheim who stood alone. Presenting a balanced profile, he is medium boned throughout and has a good spring of rib with well laid shoulders, a good turn of stifle and correct straight front legs. He has ample width and depth to his chest, a broad head with a soft expression provided by his cushioned large dark expressive eyes. He was another who moved freely around the ring.

#### **Bred By Exhibiter Dog (1)**

1. Ch Brookhaven Believe It Or Not (Ayers/Martz) What a lovely little dog this 2 year old Blenheim is. Not overdone in any quarters, he has a level topline which he held on the move. Sweeping stifles to the rear with straight front legs which allowed him to move parallel both coming and going. He has a good spring of rib and has ample coat which was straight, well broken and in excellent condition. He has high set well feathered ears which framed his large dark eyes combining with his gently tapered muzzle and dark nose pigment it gave him his soft expression. His head was carried proud on a neck of ample length which was set into a good lay of shoulders. I was pleased to later award him Reserve Winners Dog, Best Blenheim Dog, Best American Bred Dog, Best Bred By Exhibitor Dog.

#### Junior American Bred Dog (2)

**1. Brookhaven Kid Rock At Almeara, JW** (Whitmire/Ayers/Martz) 13 month old well-bodied Blenheim with a level topline. He moved true and with drive due to his good rear angulation and his muscular hindquarters, carrying his tail level. He has adequate depth of chest and a good reach of neck which supports his broad masculine head. He has large dark round eyes which are softly cushioned and dark nose pigment and a nice wide blaze. **2. Bentwood Imagistic** (Borton) 12 month

old Blenheim who is slightly longer cast than the first and not as broad in the head. He has rich chestnut markings on a pearly white background and good length to ears. He has a broad blaze, is slightly smaller in the eye than the first, a gently tapered muzzle and is not too deep in stop. With a good depth to his chest he is moderately boned throughout and moved well.

#### American Bred Dog (8)

1. Brookhaven Jesse (Parente) This was a lovely class of quality dogs with the first two being very similar in type. I chose this 3½ year old Blenheim as he presented a lovely profile. His head held high on a good reach of neck, level in topline with a good turn of stifle. With a rich chestnut coat markings he is soundly constructed with a good spring of rib and well laid shoulders. Good width to his skull with a broad white blaze separating his large round dark eyes. With ample width to his chest he moved true with drive gently wagging his tail on the move. 2. Brookhaven Morgan At Lanmar, JW (Hubbard) Another 3½ year old Blenheim being very similar in type and size to the winner. He too has good rear angulation and has a medium length to his coat which was not quite as richly coloured as the first. He has medium bone, a nice spring of rib, well laid shoulders and a good reach of neck. His head is broad and masculine without losing the desired soft expression. He has a broad blaze and dark round eyes and a tapered muzzle. He too moved freely keeping his tail level. 3. Oggbrae Don Ottavio (Bales) Similar in age to 1 and 2, he is soundly constructed, with a level topline, a good spring of rib, with moderate bone throughout. Broad in head with large dark round eyes, not too broad in the muzzle, he has good depth to his chest and held his elbows close to his body. Another who moved freely and with drive. 4. Brookhaven Endless Journey (Crane) Richly coloured 2 year old Blenheim with a good turn of stifle and a level topline. His neck of medium length is set into gently sloping shoulders. He has high set ears with broad fringing atop his broad level skull. With clean markings to his face, he has a broad blaze, dark eyes and nose pigment. He has medium bone throughout and he too moved true.

# Special Limit Blenheim Dog (5)

1. Clarmarian Covertly Wicked (Gogol/Young-May) The first two were similar in type and size and on looking at the catalogue I see they were litter brothers. On standing he presented a balanced outline with his level topline, straight front legs set under his body, good turn of stifles and well let down hocks. Short coupled in body he has a good spring of rib. Broad in skull with high set ears he has a tapering muzzle and dark round eyes. He moved freely around the ring. 2. Clarmarian Classic By Design (Young-May) As I said litter brother to first so he possesses similar qualities. He has a slightly longer coat than his brother but they were both presented in excellent condition. He has a broad head with a wide blaze, a moderately cushioned muzzle, dark eyes and nose pigment. He has medium in bone with well laid shoulders and good muscle to his rear allowing his true driving action. 3. Brookhaven Dante (Ayers/Martz) A 3 year old with well broken coat of good length, medium in bone, he has dark round eyes set in a broad head with tapered muzzle and shallow stop and has good length to his ears. With ample spring of rib and medium turn of stifle, I would have liked him to have had more drive on the move. 4. Almeara Kiss The Girls (Whitmire) Slightly more heavily marked than 1-3 this 2½ year old has a level topline and is well bodied with a good coat, both in length and condition. Medium in bone he has a broad masculine head with dark eyes, broad muzzle and is not too deep in the stop. He has a medium reach of neck with a good lay of shoulder and well angulated rear quarters.

## Special Limit Ruby Dog (3)

1. Meadowlake Licence To Kill (Swanson) A 3½ year old who stood out in this class. He has a masculine head with a level skull, his ears are set high and frame his large round dark eyes which are nicely cushioned. His muzzle is tapered and he has a shallow stop. He has good depth and width to his chest and a good reach of neck. His body has substance and a good spring of rib. He has well angulated rear quarters which allowed him moved true holding his tail level. 2. Cambridge Ruby Dream (Magera/Mitchell) A 5 year old smaller in type than the first. He has a level topline which he holds on the move. He has a masculine head but still retains a soft expression. Shallow in stop he has dark round eyes and a tapering muzzle with dark well developed nostrils. I would have preferred a higher ears set and for him to be more positive in his movement. 3. Sevenwoods Wildberry (Shidler) This 4 year old is immature in body which gave the impression of him being slightly longer cast than 1 and 2. He has large dark eyes, a tapered muzzle and shallow stop. He is slightly finer in bone than 1 and 2 and he moved slightly close in the rear.

#### Special Limit Black & Tan Dog (2)

**1. Brookhaven Bob Bailey** (Schilling) This 5 year old presented a nice profile being short coupled in body. He has a nice spring of rib and level topline with a good turn of stifles. He has a slight wave to his profuse coat and has ample feathering where it counts. Broad in head he has large round dark eyes which are slightly cushioned and a high ear-set. His head is carried on reasonable reach of neck which is set into a good lay of shoulders. He moved true both coming and going constantly wagging his tail. **2. Elyzian Double Take** (Arnold) A 20 month old dog slightly larger in type than the first. He was presented with a straight coat which was in excellent condition and he has very rich tan markings. He too moved freely around the ring

# Open Dog (4)

**1. Ch Turretbank Magic Spell** (Green/Sloan) Typifying what a toy spaniel should look like, this outstanding Black & Tan stood out as soon as he entered the ring. He presented a balanced outline and moved around the ring with style and drive

holding his head high on a good reach of neck. Well bodied with a good spring of rib and level topline he has good turn of stifles, a correct front assembly with straight front legs set well under his body and correct shoulder placement. He was presented in good coat with rich tan, a broad masculine head with high set ears, large dark round expressive eyes, dark nose pigment and he is not too deep in stop. He has ample width and depth to his chest and is not overdone in any quarter. I was pleased to later award him a worthy *Winners Dog, Reserve Best in Show, Best of Opposite Sex*, and *Best Black & Tan in Show*.

2. Ch Dreamvale Tri Your Luck At Parkbury, JW (Parker) 20 month old Tricolour with large dark eyes and black nose pigment. He has a good coat with pearly white and jet black markings. Straight front legs with a moderate depth to his chest he has a level topline, is reasonably short coupled in body and he has a good spring of rib. Well angulated in his rearquarters he has a good turn to his stifles and well let down hocks. Another who moved true with free driving action. Best Tricolor Dog 3. Ch Melrose Gold For Bonitos Companeros, JW (Magera/Mitchell) A 2 year old short coupled Ruby presented in good condition. He had excellent long ear feathering framing his masculine head with large dark eyes, cushioned muzzle and shallow stop. With medium depth to his chest he is straight in front with medium bone throughout and correct rear angulation allowing him to move with drive. 4. Ch Angel's Pride Love Vegas Of Sumara (Gentil) A heavily marked 3 year old Tricolour. He does not have the strength in the head of the others and is smaller in head and eye. He has medium bone and is well-constructed in his forequarters however I would have preferred more angulation to his rear as he lost his topline both standing and on the move.

# Senior Open Dog (1)

- **1. Closeburn Graham Macinnes** (Trad) Standing alone this 8½ year old Ruby shows no signs of grey which belies his age. He still has large dark sparkling eyes and dark nose pigment all set in a pleasing head with level skull with long high set ears. He has ample bone and a good spring of rib and a good turn to his stifles which allowed him to move freely. **Junior Puppy Bitch (8)**
- 1. Linrica Honey Girl (Liu) Four nice puppies in this class. The first a small, square, short coupled 8 month old Blenheim, her coat was richly coloured with well broken markings and showed signs of good coat to come. She has very feminine head with large dark eyes and nose pigment with a broad white blaze and a shallow stop and is well cushioned under her eyes giving her the sweetest expression. With a good depth and width to her chest, she has medium bone throughout with a good spring of rib and nice turn of stifle. She moved freely and happily waging tail at all times. Pleased to later award her *Best Puppy Bitch*.
- 2. Autumnhill Desire Me (Parente) Another short coupled bitch, this time an 8 month old Ruby. Again displaying signs of a good coat to come She has a good reach of neck supporting a balanced head with dark round eyes, a cushioned muzzle and dark nose giving her a soft expression. She has good depth and width to chest for her age and a good spring of rib. Not overdone in any way she too moved gracefully and with drive. 3. Marjorelle Love That Juliette (Conley) Lovely 7 month old Blenheim who is well bodied and presents a balanced profile. She has a beautiful head and expression with her large dark eyes and broad white blaze. With well broken markings and in good coat for age, she was another who moved well happily waging her tail. 4. Azalearun Were In The Money (Schilling/Ayers) At only 5 month of age this Ruby is immature in body and finish to that of the others, but she was the youngest. She does have nice balanced outline, with her short coupled body and level topline.

# Senior Puppy Bitch (2)

1. Rutherford Byoncee (Jones) An 11 month old Blenheim with a broad feminine head containing her large dark eyes, tapered muzzle and nice broad blaze, which allows her soft expression. More mature in body than 2, she has ample depth to her chest, a level topline, good spring of rib and well-turned stifles. She is medium boned and held her elbows close to her body. Her movement was free and true. 2. Angel's Pride Evening Star Of Sumara (Gentil) Another pretty bitch of correct size however she is slightly longer cast than the first. This11 month old Blenheim has a nice straight coat with well broken markings and has a good reach of neck. Very feminine in the head she has dark lustrous eyes, a cushioned muzzle and good length to her ears. Her topline is level and is maintained whilst on the move. She too moved freely around the ring.

# **Graduate Puppy Bitch (3)**

1. Jayba Knockout, JW (Lander/George) A well broken 16 month old Blenheim presented in good coat, slightly shorter coupled than the second, she is soundly constructed with ample bone for her size. Not overdone in any way, she has a level topline with correct rear angulation and a good tail set. Her feminine head is carried proudly on a good reach of neck. She has long well-feathered ears are set high on a flat skull and she has large dark round eyes, shallow stop and tapered muzzle giving her an appealing expression. She showed very happily for her handler and moved with drive. 2. Brookhaven Sexy Sadie, JW (Ayers/Martz) A 1 year old Blenheim of ample proportions with well broken rich chestnut coat markings. Level in topline with a good turn of stifle to the rear. Good spring of rib and well-muscled throughout. She has an attractive head with dark nose pigment and dark round eyes, clear face markings and a good reach of neck. She needs to lift her ears on standing to complete the picture. 3. Brookhaven Rainy Night In Georgia At Lanmar (Hubbard) 16 month old Tricolour with rich tan and pearly white markings. She has a balanced head with a nice wide blaze, dark round eyes, cushioned muzzle and her head is framed by long high set ears which gives her a soft expression. She moved strongly from the rear however she was moving close in her front.

#### Novice Bitch (1)

- 1. Riverview Pink Champagne (Barrois) Standing alone this 11 month old Blenheim has well broken markings on a pearly white ground. Finer in body she has large dark round eyes and dark nose pigment with a gently tapering muzzle and shallow stop and her head is carried on good reach of neck. Medium in bone and medium spring of rib, she has a good lay of shoulder and holds her elbows close to her chest. She did move true around the ring and just needs time to finish her off. Bred by Exhibiter Bitch (3)
- 1. Ch Almeara Scrumpdillyicious, JW (Whitmire) I was spoilt for choice in this class having three quality bitches of the correct size and type to judge. My winner was what I had been looking for all day, a 2 year old Tricolour who I could not fault on movement, she has a gorgeous broad head, with a wide white blaze, large dark round appealing eyes, a well cushioned muzzle and black nose pigment. Her head is carried on a medium length of neck which flowed into her well laid shoulders. She has moderate depth and width to her chest is short coupled in body with a level back and a good spring of rib with sweeping stifles and well let down hocks. She is medium boned and is well furnished with feathering to her ears and good length to her coat. She did not disappoint on the move as she moved purposely and with ease around the ring. No hesitation to later award her Winners Bitch, Best in Show, Best Tricolor in Show, Best American Bred in Show, Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show.
- 2. Ch Kean Ultraviolet, JW (Keane) Unlucky to meet the winner, this 16 month old Blenheim is another sound bitch. She is short-coupled, stands straight in front, has a level topline and good turn of stifle. Her head is held high on a neck of medium length. On closer examination she has lovely balance to her head having fully furnished high set ears, large dark round eyes, black well developed nostrils and a cushioned muzzle giving her the desired soft expression. She is well bodied and has a good spring of rib. To complete the picture she has a long coat in excellent condition and she moved freely and with drive. I was pleased to later award her *Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Blenheim in Show*.
- **3. Ch Lanmar Pometini** (Hubbard/Beavers) Nearly 3 years of age, she like 1 and 2, is a nice size. She has a level topline which she held on the move and her tail, which is well set on, was carried level. She has a broad yet feminine head with a tapering muzzle with ample cushioning, dark round eyes and dark nose pigment giving her a pleasing expression. She is medium in bone and has moderate spring of rib, and is soundly constructed. Again I could not fault her movement. **Junior American Bred Bitch (3)**
- 1. Linrica Femme Fatale, JW (Liu) 12 month old Blenheim with a level topline, slightly longer cast in body, she is straight in front with sweeping stifles to her rear. She has medium depth of chest and a good reach of neck. Her head is not too broad and has high set ears. She has large dark eyes, is shorter in the muzzle with a narrow blaze and a dark pigmented nose. She moved freely with drive around the ring. 2. Denham Over The Moon (Maddox) 12 month old Black & Tan Immature in body, finer in bone and lacking the coat of the winner. She does have large dark round eyes and dark nose pigment and has rich tan markings where necessary. She did move freely around the ring. Best Black & Tan Bitch 3. Hiddencreek Juicy Couture (Green) Small well balanced 17 month old Blenheim with a good coat. She has a feminine head with dark eyes and is shorter in the muzzle. Her topline is level and she has a moderate spring of rib. Unfortunately her movement was a little erratic.

## American Bred Bitch (4)

1. Piccadil Gone With The Wind (York) 2 year old Blenheim well bodied Blenheim bitch, feminine in head with a nicely cushioned muzzle. She is well filled under her large dark eyes and her head is carried on a medium reach of neck. Medium in bone with a good spring of rib, she is straight in front with tight elbows. She has a good turn of stifle and moved with drive holding her topline level. 2. Marshelle I'm No Angel (Gogol) At almost 4 year old this Blenheim is richly marked with a well broken coat. Level in back with medium bone throughout, she is short coupled and well bodied and is not too deep in the chest. Her head has a level skull with lozenge atop, high set ears, broad white blaze, she is slightly shorter in the muzzle with shallow stop which combine to give her her feminine expression. A happy girl she never stopped wagging her tail. 3. Oggbrae Donna Elvira (Bales) Nice size 2½ year old Blenheim with well broken coat markings. Her movement was true both coming and going holding her topline level. She is not overdone in bone and has a moderate spring of rib. Her head is carried on a slightly arched neck of medium length. She has a shallow stop, clear blaze and a cushioned muzzle of correct length. 4. Brookhaven Mystic Sky (Ayers/Martz) 20 month old Blenheim of correct size and proportion. She has dark eyes and a cushioned muzzle set in a feminine head with a good reach of neck. She has a level topline, is medium boned and not overdone in body. She too moved well.

#### **Special Limit Blenheim Bitch (4)**

1. Brookhaven In The Garden, JW (Ayers/Martz) At 2 year old this bitch is compact and short coupled with a well broken coat. She has a good turn of stifle, is straight in front with her legs well set under her body. She has a good reach of neck, good spring of rib and well laid shoulder placement. She has a very feminine head with high set ears, large dark appealing eyes, shallow stop and gently tapering and cushioned muzzle. She moved true both coming and going. 2. Royalcaper Bluebell Bliss (Clayton) 3 year old with reasonably broken coat markings, sweeping stifles, level topline and short coupled in body. Not quite the coat length of the first she has medium bone and a good reach of neck. She has large dark eyes, a wide blaze, has a well cushioned muzzle and high set ears. She moved true both coming and going. 3. Jayba Valentina (Lyman) A 2 year old with rich chestnut markings. She is slightly longer cast than 1 and 2 and is slightly heavier

marked. She has a lovely head shape with large dark eyes and nose pigment. Well cushioned in muzzle she has a good length to her high set ears. With medium width to her chest she has a good spring of rib. She showed well for her handler.

**4. Amantra Minuet At Marjorelle** (Conley) A 3 year old bitch with well broken coat markings, moderate reach to her neck and is moderate in bone throughout. She has a feminine head and expression and has high set ears with long feathering. She just did not show herself off on the day and lost out on movement to the others.

# **Special Limit Tricolour Bitch (2)**

- 1. Okayc Midsummers Night Dream At Signaturez (Crane) At 22 months old she has well broken coat markings and was presented in excellent condition and good coat length. She has sweeping stifles, a level topline, a good spring of rib and is medium boned throughout. She has a good reach of neck and her feminine head has a flat skull with high set long ears, large dark eyes and a well cushioned muzzle. Her chest is of medium width and she has well-constructed forequarters. She moved freely and with style. 2. First Capital Daisy Mae (Arnold) A 3 year old, not quite the head or coat as the first. She is the same size as the first and short coupled in the body with a medium depth to chest and is slightly finer in bone. She has a medium reach of neck supporting her head which was finer than the first. She has a tapered muzzle, dark eyes and a narrow blaze which did not spoil her feminine expression. She moved freely and showed well for her handler. Special Limit Ruby Bitch (2)
- 1. Darane My Darling Clementine At Chewcreek (DePhillp) A 2 year old who presented a balanced outline. Short-coupled in body with a level topline, her head is held high on a good reach of neck and she has a lovely straight coat to complete the picture. She is straight in front with well laid shoulders, a good spring of rib and is well-muscled to her rear with a good turn of stifle. She has the most appealing expression with her cushioned large dark round eyes and dark nose set in her broad yet feminine head with high set ears. Around the ring she moved like a dream. *Best Ruby in Show 2*.

  Dawnaquinn Paint The Town Red (Magera) A 3½ year old ever so slightly longer cast than winner, she is a well coated ruby of nice size, not overdone in any department with good rear angulation, level topline and ample feathering throughout. She has large dark eyes, is shorter in the muzzle than first but not too deep in the stop. She has a flat skull with high set ears, good width to her chest, she moved true both coming and going.

### Special Limit Black & Tan Bitch (1)

**1. Rutherford Venus W, JW** (Jones) A 21 month old Black & Tan with balanced head proportions. Her large dark eyes and wide well cushioned muzzle are framed by her long and broad ears. She has a good reach of neck, a level topline and good rear angulation. She too moved freely.

## Open Bitch (4)

1. Ch Bonitos Companeros Gianna Nannini, JW (Adair) At just under 3 years of age this Blenheim has a feminine head with a broad flat skull with no sign of coarseness and high set well feathered ears. She has dark round expressive eyes and a nicely cushioned tapering muzzle. She has adequate depth to her chest and a good reach of neck. Short-coupled in body she has a well sprung ribcage, a good turn of stifle and has medium bone throughout. She excelled in coat and moved true keeping her elbows close to her body. 2. Ch Darane Casablanca At Chewcreek (DePhillp) A 21/2 year old Tricolour presented in full coat with all the fringes and in excellent condition. She has a very attractive head with gorgeous long ears, large dark expressive eyes and the blackest of nose pigment and her head is carried on a good reach of neck which flows into her well laid shoulders. She has good bone and body, a level topline, a good spring of rib and sweeping stifles. She too moved true with drive and style. 3. Ch Bentwood Chloe Of Forestcreek, JW (Cline/Harrison) A soundly constructed 20 month old Blenheim with a well broken coat, a level topline and has she has medium bone throughout. With ample spring to her ribs she is well muscled with well-constructed forequarters. Balanced in the head, she has large dark round eyes and ample cushioning to her muzzle and is not too deep in the stop. She has good width to her well feathered ears and has a medium reach of neck which is set in a good lay of shoulder. 4. Ch Grandville Butterscotch Kiss Of Infinidad (Laliberte) A 5½ year old Ruby who is slightly longer in body than the winner, she too moved true with purpose around the ring. She has a level topline which she held on the move and her tail, which is well set on, was carried level. She has a broad yet feminine head, slightly deeper in the stop with a tapering muzzle. She has dark round eyes and dark nose pigment giving her a pleasing expression. She is medium in bone with a moderate spring of rib, and is soundly constructed.
