DOG CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1) **BROOKHAVEN CATCHING FIRE** (AYERS/MARTZ) A well balanced ruby of good substance with an attractive head, good eye and generous coat. He moved smoothly around the ring with a good presence about him. One to watch. **BEST PUPPY DOG**

IN SHOW, BEST RUBY IN SHOW

2) **EVERA TRUE OUTLAW** (TRUE/MASCHER) A happy Blenheim with an attractive head. Slightly more up on leg than I prefer. Rear movement did not match the class winner.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1) **CYRANDALL LAST CRUSADE** (DINGMAN) A nicely broken tricolor with a good coat on the way. Good angles front and rear. He has a moderate head with large dark eyes and dark nose pigment. A good mover.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (1)

1) CHADWICK PERSUIT OF PERFECTION (ECKERSLEY) A super cute headed well proportioned Blenheim that immediately caught my attention. He is well balanced with a great front and an exceptionally angulated rear, which he used to his advantage moving around the ring. He maintained a level top line on the move and exhibited proper tail carriage. He flowed around the ring effortlessly. Certainly one to watch. He should finish quickly. <u>WINNER'S DOG, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN</u> SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW, BEST IN SHOW

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (1)

1) **BROOKHAVEN JUSTIFIED** (AYERS/MARTZ) A nicely shaped, heavily marked Blenheim of smaller size. He has good angulation front and rear with well let down hocks. He moved well but today tended to loose his top line at times. He has an attractive head with ample cushion.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (1) 1) BROOKHAVEN I'M A BELIEVER (DINGMAN) A well broken nicely shaped Blenheim with good balance. Though appealing, I preferred the heads of other dogs that received majors today. Certainly he was in the hunt for top honors. He moved confidently with a level top line that he maintained and had great tail carriage around the ring.

<u>SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG</u> (3)

1) LEGENDCREST FINNICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER, JW

(UTYCH/UTYCH) This is a short backed, well proportioned Blenheim of good substance. He has a nice topline and good tail set. He is well broken with a correct textured silky coat. He was not settled today and somewhat unsure of himself. A more moderate head with a sweet expression.

2) **ARANEL FARNIENTE** (TRUE/MASCHNER) A nicely shaped, well-broken, glamorous coated Blenheim in good condition. He has a stronger but pretty head with good pigment. Moved well but somewhat proud of his tail today. I preferred his movement to the third exhibit in this class.

3) **FOXWYN FINE YOUNG GENT** (GUZY/BAKER-FOX) A very nice headed Blenheim of different proportions to the first two in his class. He is lower in station and slightly longer in size. He has a dark rich coat with a level top line and a properly set tail, which he carries well.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (1)

1) **STARMAC ALMEARA GAME ON JW** (WHITMIRE) A beautiful, well-broken tricolor that loved to show. His energy was fun to watch and his handler used it to his advantage. He has a nicely angulated front and rear. He has a soft expression so difficult to get in this color. I liked the breadth of top skull. He has nice full ears, well set on his head, which he used to his advantage. He moved very well. *BEST TRI-COLOR IN SHOW, BEST TRI-COLOR DOG IN SHOW. AWARD OF MERIT*

OPEN DOG (3)

1) **LOWILANI RED LABEL JW** (BROKOPP) A glamorous, fully coated Blenheim that is striking on first impression. He is heavily marked with a beautiful head and expression. He has great reach of neck and a good topline, though slopes off in the croup a bit. He moves with reach and drive, though at times could loose his topline going around. Shown to his advantage. *AWARD OF MERIT*

2) **CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE** (UTYCH) This is a dog that I have admired for some time. He is a worthy champion. He has an ideal shape and size however lacks the elegance and finish of the first exhibit. I preferred the head properties and eyes and nose pigment of the first exhibit.

3) **FOXYN REVOLUTIONARY** (DINGMAN) This is a well-broken Blenheim slightly longer in cast than the first two exhibits. He has a gentle expression, but I preferred that of the first two exhibits. He moves well and carries a great topline.

BITCH CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1) CHADWICK JABOT (ECKERSLEY) A sturdy Blenheim girl with good bone and

substance. She is nicely shaped with a correct croup. She has a very attractive head, including rich nose and eye rim pigment. She presents a good picture going around the ring with correct front movement, a solid, well angulated rear with parallel hocks and maintains a nice topline and tail carriage. <u>AWARD OF MERIT</u>

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1) **SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE** (GREEN) A nicely shaped petite Blenheim with a good topline croup and tail carriage. Enough substance. Good angles front and a super angulated rear, which she uses to her advantage moving around the ring. She has a sweet expression with large dark eyes and dark nose pigment. A nice coat on the way of correct texture. *BEST PUPPY BITCH, AWARD OF MERIT, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW*

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (1)

1) LIVELY OAK NEVER STOP BELIEVING (BROKOPP/BORTON/HARRISON) A heavily marked Blenheim girl with a cute head and expression. She has a correct front and a decently angulated rear. She was somewhat erratic on the move and tended to roach her topline, possible just a little unsettled.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

1) FOXCREEK NEW YEARS EVE (JOHNSON) A diminutively sized richly coated Blenheim girl. She has ample bone for size with a well-balanced shape. I liked her croup and tail carriage. Her topline was nice while standing but somewhat soft on the move. She has a beautiful head with well-placed ears, large dark eyes and a gentle expression.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

1) **TIBBEDON MISTY MORNING** (TIBBETTS) A pretty headed well broken Blenheim with very dark eyes and deep nose pigment. She is slightly longer that tall. Good bone for size. She showed well and was very energetic.

2) BROOKHAVEN SEALED WITH A KISS (DINGMAN/AYERS/MARTZ) A correctly shaped Blenheim with a nice topline tail set and carriage. She moves well with a good front and nicely angulated rear. She, also, was energetic and showed well.
3) SERAPHAVEN STARLIGHT AND DEWDROPS (GOGOL/MAY) This is a very pretty headed girl with full ears and a sweet expression. She was not happy on the table and seemed to be uninterested in showing today.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (2)

1) **BROOKHAVEN SEEING IS BELIEVING** (AYERS, MARTZ) An ideally sized girl with a very good shape, croup and and tail set. She has great rear angulation. Would prefer a richer color especially on her face. She moves with drive and purpose keeping a good topline. She wins on Shape, balance and type. *RESERVE WINNERS BITCH*

2) **ISLEPOSEA WHISK ME AWAY** (HOEHN) A deeply pigmented Blenheim with good bone and a sweet expression. She has a nice topline on the stand but tends to loose this on the move, dipping in the shoulders. She has good substance with a nice spring of rib.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (1)

1) **AUTUMNHILLSUMARA JUST FLIRTING WITH YOU** (PARENTE, GENTIL) A cute headed b/t that is a nice size and shape. She was not very happy to be in the ring today and therefore a little difficult to assess movement.

BEST TRI-COLOR IN SHOW, BEST TRI-COLOR DOG IN SHOW.

OPEN BITCH (1)

1) **LEGACY CHENIN CLAMC WITH EVERA** (TRUE, LINDAMAIER) A petite bitch that immediately caught my attention. She has a pleasing expression that is not exaggerated. Though small she has excellent bone and good spring of rib. She has a straight silky coat and was groomed to perfection. She moved well and was very attentive to her handler. She moved well, with drive, and kept a good topline. *WINNERS BITCH, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW*

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

1) **SERAPHAVEN PUT A SPELL ON YOU** (GOGOL) A stocky deeply pigmented Blenheim of good shape. She has a sweet expression with large dark eyes. She moves well with a level topline. She has a slightly wavy coat that appears somewhat difficult to manage.
