JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1. **AUTUMN HILL IN MY WILDEST DREAMS** (**Parente**) Well broken Blenheim of correct size and full of personality. Nice sweet head with soft expression. Nice dark eye and ear set. Lovely length in neck. Good bone for age with all the right angles. Moved well both ways. Very promising puppy. **BEST PUPPY DOG**
- 2. **CARLEN MYRDDIN WYLIT** (**Close**) B&T a little plainer in head than 1. Nice dark eye with a good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Level top line and correct tail set. Hope he fills out.
- 3. **INIFINIDAD PENALTY BOX** (Laliberte/Laliberte) Another B&T boy of larger frame. Sweet head with nice expression. Dark eye and correct ear set. Nice silky coat. Nice in front but moved a little close behind

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4)

"Lovely headed class."

- HUNTLAND BROOKHAVEN MARCO (McCauley) This boy caught my eye as soon as he
 entered the ring. Sweetest of heads with that typical expression, nice eye and ear set. Good reach of neck
 into well laid shoulders. Level top line and tail carriage. Ideal size and move well. Just in between coats
 and I don't think his handler got the best out of him. But I was glad to award him

- 2. **LEGENDCREST FINNICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER** (Utych) Another boy with a pretty head. Dark eye but I would prefer them a size bigger, good ear set. Well laid shoulders into good front. Ideal size and shape. Moved a little close behind and I would like to see him a bit more animated.
- 3. **MARILEE BE TRUE TO YOUR SCHOOL** (Junk/Collins) Pretty blenheim boy with good expression and large dark eye. Super rich colour, well broken and of good texture. Nice size and proportions. Moved well but was just a bit happy with his tail.
- 4. **CHADWICK ONE WAY TICKET (Dodd/Eckersley)** Again another with pleasing head. Good dark eye, nice in neck and shoulders. Level top line. Dropped off in croup and rear movement was a bit close.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (3)

- CH CHADWICK BEST DRESSED (Robinson/Eckersley) Pleasing head on this boy. Maybe I would like a slightly softer expression. Richest of chestnut colour. Nice large dark eye, good ear set. Good reach of neck into well laid back shoulders. Level top line and tail set with good spring of rib. This boy won the day purely on his conformation. He excelled in movement. Pleased to award him WINNERS DOG & RESERVE BEST IN SHOW & BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW & BEST OPPOSITE SEX
- 2. **DIORCHAVON DOCTOR LOU ON CALL** (**Bialek**) Pleasing head with large round eye, good ear set. Nice reach of neck into well laid shoulders and good front. Level top line and tail set. Moved well both ways. A little out of coat today.
- 3. **INFINIDAD INSTANT GRATIFICATION** (**Laliberte**) Stronger than 1 and 2. Nice dark round eye. Good reach of neck into well laid back shoulders. Good in front. Level top line but was carrying his tail a bit high.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1. **BLUEDAY MICH E LOB AT CHEWCREEK (DePhillip)** Small well broken dog of nice shape. Sweet head with nice expression. Good neck and front. Level top line. Moved well but carries his tail a bit.
- 2. **KALAIS CAPTAIN JACK SPARROW AT JEMANDA** (Weinstein) B&T boy with a pleasing head. Nice eye and expression. Good reach of neck. Dips a bit in top line and drops off behind.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (2)

- 1. **ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE** (Cameron) Smart little dog of correct size. Rey pleasing in head with lovely soft expression. Nice dark eye and ear set. Good reach of neck and front. Level top line and correct tail set. Moved slightly close behind.
- 2. **ALMEARA I BELIEVE (Parente)** Stronger in head than 1. Dark round eye and good ear set. Moved well but just lost his top line at times.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (1)

1. **ORCHARDHILL INCLUSIVE** (Venier/Venier) Strong headed boy with nice expression. Nice large round eye framed by well set ears, Good reach of neck, well laid shoulders and good front. Level top line and tail set. Coat in good condition. Moved slightly close behind.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR DOG (3)

- 1. **EMENKAY DREAM LOVER (Vezina/Orns)** Large heavily marked boy with a pleasing head. Nice round dark eye. Good reach of neck leading into a good strong front. Level top line and tail set. Coat in good condition. Moved well but was a bit close behind.
- 2. **BELLA SOGNI DOLCI DE AMOR (Weeks)** Similar to 1. Typical head with dark eye. Well marked and moved well
- 3. **CHADWICK ACE OF SPADES AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn)** Nice size with pleasing head. Good reach of neck and good in front. Dips a little in top line and was a bit erratic on the move.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN DOG (1)

1. **AUTUMNHILL SILVER JUBILEE** (**Parente/Woodard**) Nice shape and size with a soft gentle expression. Nice large dark eye. Coat in top condition and presented well Level top line and moved well but a bit close behind.

OPEN DOG (2)

- 1. **CH CHADWICK JET SETTER AT HUDSONVIEW_(Glynn/Glynn)** Pretty headed boy with lovely expression. Good round dark eye. Nice shape and size. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Level top line and tail set and good rear angulation. Was missing his coat today.
- 2. **CH CHADWICK CODE BLACK AT CEILIMORE** (McCarty/Eckersley) Pretty headed Tri boy of good size and shape. Nice dark eye and well set ears that framed his soft head. Good front and shoulders, level top line. Carries his tail a bit and moved close behind. **BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW**

THE BITCH CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (6)

- DIORCHAVON YOU AMAZE ME (Bialek) Well broken Blenheim. Nice shape and size with compact body. Good reach of neck, level top line and tail set. Moved well both ways. Head still to develop.
- 2. **BROOKHAVEN AZURAS STAR** (Weeks/Ayers) Pretty girl with feminine head. Would like a larger eye. Good reach of neck, nice front and shoulders. Moved freely around the ring.
- 3. **BLUE GARDEN LA DOLCE VITA** (Matos/Glynn) Well broken pretty headed girl. Good large round eye. Good neck and shoulders. Nice in profile but was a bit close in rear movement.
- 4. **BLUEGARDEN FIRST CLASS GOSSIP** (Matos/Glynn) Tri girl, larger than I would like at this age. Pleasing head. Nice in front and shoulders. Move well both ways.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1. **CHIYODA BLACK PEARL OF JOY AT FALLING SPRINGS** (**Grimm Curly**) B&T girl with the most sweet feminine head. All the tan in the right places. Beautiful silky coat in excellent condition for age. Nice compact body with level top line. Lovely angles and moved well both ways. One with a bright future when she matures. Pleased to award her **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (2)

1. **BLUEGARDEN ITSY BITSY (Matos/Glynn)** Pretty girl with a sweet soft gentle expression. Nice size and shape. Nice dark eye, good ear set. Nice neck and shoulders. Level topline and moved ok.

2. **Carlen Chateau Ste Michelle JW** (**Obadowski**) Ruby girl longer in body than 1. Nice expression with dark eye and level skull. Good in neck and front. Drops off a little in rear. Moved ok.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

- 1. **INFINIDAD AUTUMNHILL DREAMS** (Laliberte) Compact girl with sweet expression. Nice dark eye, good reach of neck. Gathers herself up sometimes on the move but at time showed that she could actually stretch out.
- 2. **CHADWICK PURPLE PASSION** (**Eckersley**) Tri girl not the expression of 1. Nice size. Moved ok slopes off a bit in croup.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (2)

- 1. ORCHARDHILL GOTTA ADORE ME (Venier/Venier) Lovely feminine head with soft gentle expression. Large eye and good ear set. Good reach of neck and nice shoulders placement. Nice shape and size and in excellent coat. Carries her tail a bit and moves ok.
- 2. BONITOS COMPANEROS XAVERIA OF WELMFORTH JW (Lasser) Another girl with a sweet expression. Nice eyes giving a soft expression. Good neck and shoulders. Moves a little close behind. Not the presentation as 1.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (2)

- INFINIDAD VELVET BOX (Laliberte) A bit plainer in head for me. Good eye and ear set. Nice reach of neck and front Level topline and tail set. Moved well. BEST RUBY IN SHOW
- 2. **AUTUMNHILL HONKY TONK ANGEL (Parente)** Prettier head than one but dips behind the shoulders. Moved well both ways.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (3)

"Not a good moving class."

- 1. **HYTEA PUDDLE JUMP** (**Greak/Comer**) Sweet head with nice eyes and expression. Nice size with good silky coat. Moved ok but rear end was not good.
- 2. **DARANE JANE EYRE** (Hossler/Kates) Again this girl has a sweet head with large eyes and correct ear set. Long silky coat presented well. Movement was a bit wide in front and close behind.
- 3. **DARANE TRUE COLOURS (Kates)** Plainer in head and not the finish of 1 and 2. Moved ok.

<u>OPEN BITCH</u> (4)

"If you were judging heads you could place any of these in 1st place."

1. **CH CHADWICK FREQUENT FLYER AT HUDSONVIEW JW** (Glynn/Eckersley) What a sweet expression this girl has. Eyes to die for. Excellent reach of neck in well constructed shoulders. Level top line and good spring of rib. Correct tail carriage and was the best mover in this

class. Glad to award her <u>WINNERS BITCH</u>, <u>BEST IN SHOW</u>, <u>BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW</u>, <u>BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW</u>.

- 2. **CH ORCHARDHILL CHARGE IT TO DAD JW (Venier/Venier)** Another with a head to die for. Super sweet expression on a well broken and excellently presented coat. Lovely size and shape in profile but she lacked the movement of 1.
- 3. **CH CHADWICK IN MY OPINION AT HYTEA JW** (**Reichardt**/ **Eckersley**) Again excellent in head with large dark eyes and good ear set. Nice reach of neck, was a little wide in front. Level top line and moved ok.
- 4. **BONITOS COMPANEROS JOSEPHINE OF WELMFORTH** (Lasser) Head same as the rest. Lovely soft expression. Moved well both way she just lacked the finish and presentation.

VETERAN DOG (2)

- CH CHADWICK MIDNIGHT SUN AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn) Tri boy of good size and shape. Pleasing head with good dark eye. I would like to see a higher ear set and flatter skull. Good neck and shoulders, level topline and tail set. Moved well both ways. BEST VETERAN IN SHOW.
- 2. **WINDHAM JUST BRILLANT** (**Maxwell**) 13 year old Blenheim boy who can still show some of the younger ones how to move. Larger and plainer in head than 1.

VETERAN BITCH (2)

- 1. **CH DARANE RED SONJA JW** (**Kates**) 10 year old Ruby. A bit plainer in head for me. Nice eyes and ear set. Good neck and shoulders, level top line and tail set. Moved well round the ring.
- 2. **KARLEE GRAY STONE HIGH SOCIETY (Brunson)** 11 year old Blenheim. Sweet expression. Nice size. Front movement not good.
