DOGS

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

1. **CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW** (Glynn/Glynn) Well-marked blenheim dog with very nice make and shape. Pleasing head, flat skull, well set ears. Good bite, dark pigment, round dark eyes giving a sweet expression. A good size, well bodied and boned. Good neck and shoulders leading into a firm topline that he held moving and standing. Happy temperament, moving well both ways.

Pleased to award him BP and I found nothing to beat him for RWD. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW &**

<u>RESERVE WINNERS DOG</u>

2. **GRANASIL STRUDEL OF SUMARA** (Gentil) B/T, elegant light mover, floated around the ring. Flat silky coat with rich tans. Dark eyes, good ear leathers. Firm topline leading into short level back. A sweet boy. **BEST B/T IN SHOW.**

3. **TUDORR OF THE VELVET TEDDY BEAR** (Mixon/Mixon) Blenheim boy in full silky coat. Well boned with good neck and shoulders. A tad longer in back than first two. Nice dark eyes but showing some white.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)

1. **MEADOWLAKE SWEET WILLIAM DIANTHUS** (Swanson) Tri boy of nice size with short level back held standing and moving. Pleasing head with bright tans. He could use his ears to better advantage. Well boned moved soundly but could have more drive behind. **BEST TRICOLOUR DOG**.

2. **BROOKHAVEN NUMBER NINE DREAM OF FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych/Utych) Richly marked blenheim in lovely coat. Moved out well around the ring but a tad long in back and tends to lose his topline on the move. Used his ears well, well boned. Needs more filling under his eye.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (2)

1. **FORESTCREEK MAJOR TOM** (Cline/Cline) Glamorous blenheim beautifully presented. Lovely topline standing and moving. Round dark eyes, good pigment, well boned. I would prefer a touch more muzzle. Moving well in profile around the ring but moving a touch close behind going away from me.

2. **CROWNHEIR IRISH BLESSING** (Fadel) Another glamorous boy, full of life with pleasing head, well used ears, correct muzzle, pigment a touch off. Good drive behind but lost his topline on the move and a bit proud of his tail.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG. (2)

1. **BLACKFIRE ALL NIGHT LONG** (Weidig/Kennedy/McLaughlin/Kennedy) Well broken blenheim presented in good condition. Well made, good shape, moved out soundly holding his outline. Pleasing head with well used ears with good fringing. Nice round eye giving a good expression.

2. **CROSSBOW BALOO FROM THE JUNGLE AT BLUESTARA** (Brezine/Alvarez) Heavier marked blenheim in full silky coat A larger type than 1, well boned moved well holding a firm topline. A touch longer than 1 and not so soft in expression.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (4).

1. **ORCHARDHILL THEATRE KID AT KINGDOMRUN** (Degen/Mixon) Glamorous boy in full coat. Nice head with well used ears, good bite. Lovely eyes and expression, good pigment. Moved out well in profile, could be a bit firmer behind. Well presented in good coat.

2. **FORESTCREEK JAZZFEST** (Goodwin/Cline) Masculine boy, nicely marked, well boned with pleasing head. Good pigment, nice eye and expression. Good neck and shoulders, held his topline on the move but tends to roll. Moving a tad close behind.

3. CHADWICK CHARISMATIC OF BLUEBONNET (Vezina) Full headed Blenheim, a bit short in muzzle. Nice eye and pigment. Well boned, good ear leathers, full coat. Rather proud of his tail on the move which spoils his outline.

4. **MEADOWLAKE GIGGLES AND GRINS** (Swanson) Blenheim boy, rather overweight. Well presented, good coat and bone. Pleasing head with nice eye and good expression. Rather long cast.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (1)

1. **MAYFIELD HERCULES AT HIFIT** (Parris/Parris) Heavier marked blenheim, pleasing head shape, well used ears, round eyes (that could be darker). Moved out well both ways with a level topline. A good firm backend.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI DOG (1).

1. **EMENKAY DREAM LOVER** (Vezina/Orns) Heavier marked Tri boy of good shape, nice front and bone. Typical head with bright tans and full ear leathers. Held his topline moving and standing, went well in profile but needs more drive behind.

SPECIAL LIMIT B/T DOG (2)

1. **CANYONCREST AUGUST RENOIR** (DuRoss) B/T with nice head & eye with pleasing expression. Elegant free mover covering the ring easily. Coat rather unruly and could use a bit of work but I preferred his head, expression and movement.

2. **MEADOWLAKE PHILOSOPHERS STONE** (Swanson) B/T with a flat silky coat in good condition. Pleasing head with bright tans. Good eye and pigment. Carried himself with a level topline. Not as easy on the move as 1.

OPEN DOG (3)

1. **CH & ENG CH PASCAVALE HAIDEN** (Cline) Glamorous blenheim well presented in full coat. Well made with good neck and shoulders leading into firm topline which he held moving and standing. Moving very well fore and aft, well boned. Masculine head with good bite, excellent pigment, full well fringed ears that were used to advantage. Round dark eyes, which if I were being hypercritical, I would like a touch larger. He did all that was needed today and I was pleased to award him *WINNERS DOG & BEST IN SHOW*.

2. CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE (Utych/Utych) Smaller blenheim, cobby and well made. Moved soundly around the ring showing his firm backend. Typical head with large round eyes (could be a touch darker) nice expression. Presented well in good condition.

3. **CH LEGENDCREST FINNICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER JW AW** (Utych/Utych) Well marked blenheim, in good coat, presented well. Level topline moving and standing. Pleasing head with well used ears. Expression not as gentle as above. Moving ok but was tending to throw a back leg on the move which detracted from the overall picture.3

SENIOR OPEN DOG (2)

1. ALMEARA VISIONNAIRE (Utych/Whitmere) Masculine blenheim dog, moved out soundly both ways. He held a good outline and moved lightly and elegantly. Well boned with a good neck and shoulders, level topline and good tailset. Pleasing head with good round eyes. <u>BEST VETERAN IN</u> SHOW.

2. CH BECKENHALL SHIRMONT HE'S THE TICKET. (Glenn) Blenheim boy with lovely round dark eyes giving a gentle expression, well used ears. A tad overweight so not the outline or movement of 1. Well boned, presented in great condition. A touch longer in back than 1.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (7)

1. **CHADWICK HALO SPOT AT INTRYNZIK** (Goodwin/Goodwin) Blenheim pup, mature but not overdone. Pleasing head with nice pigment and good bite. Presented in a good coat, well boned and bodied. Moved out soundly and happily both ways holding a good outline, level topline, good neck and shoulders. **BEST PUPPY BITCH**

2. **STARMAC BLUE LAGOON** (Hooper) Tri pup, nice shape standing and moving, good front, level topline. Nice round eyes with a quizzical expression. Well marked with bright tans. Went well around the ring. *BEST TRICOLOUR BITCH*.

3. **SHEEBA PACIFIC ROSE AT APPLEBRANCH** (Bennett) Well bodied pup with a happy temperament. Nice shape standing and moving. Level topline, nice head with round eyes and well used ears. Not quite as balanced as 1 and 2.

4. **EVERA TRUE GEORGIA ON MY MIND** (Fulbright) Immature blenheim with pretty head and expression. Uses her ears well, well marked coat, nice size but needs body.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (3)

1. **FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY** (Curley) Mature bitch of nice shape. Moved well holding a firm outline. Pleasing head with well used ears and round eyes. (Eyes could be a touch darker) good neck and shoulders, firm front. Well boned, well set tail, nicely marked coat.

2. **NIGHTHAWK HOT GOSSIP AT RINGHILL** (Johns/Johns/Braun) Mature well bodied blenheim with a nice head, round eye and good expression. Well presented in good condition. Not the neck and shoulders of 1 so front not as good coming towards me.

3. **MANORHOUSE LIKE A LADY** (Orns/McCaslin) Smaller blenheim bitch with spot, well broken coat in good condition. Good head with pretty expression and well used ears. Moving well in profile but not as good coming towards me.

<u>GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH</u> (3)

1. **MANORHOUSE EMERALD ISLE** (McCaslin) Elegant free moving Blenheim correct head with very pretty eye and expression. Well used ears, well made with good neck and shoulders, nice front. Held herself well on the move with a happy temperament.

2. CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CEILIMOR JW (McCarty/Eckersley) Mature tri of nice size, well made with good bone. Nice neck and shoulders. Moved steadily around the ring. Bright tans but I would prefer a touch more muzzle.

3. **FORESTCREEK VIVIAN JW** (Cline/Marshall) Very glamorous, pretty blenheim with lovely head and eye. Lovely outline, well boned and coated. Unfortunately, not moving well behind today.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1. **BENCHMARK UNSINKABLE MOLLY** (Hoorman) Petite blenheim, well bodied and coated. Pretty head with nice eye and expression. Well boned for her size, a happy good mover. Her topline could be a bit firmer.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (4)

1. FORESTCREEK SWEET SONG AT HADARA. (Koch/Cline) Very nice bitch caught my eye straight away. Lovely well-balanced outline. Excellent topline, good neck and shoulders, moved out very well both ways and in profile with a lovely light action. Pretty classic head with good bite, lovely round eyes with a soft expression. Well set and feathered ears. She just kept taking my eye. Pleased to award her *WINNERS BITCH, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH IN SHOW.*

2. CH BROOKHAVEN MARY JANE JW (Ayers/Martz) Another very nice blenheim bitch. Lovely head with gentle expression. Well presented in good coat and condition. Moved out soundly with a firm topline, well made with a good neck and shoulders.

3. **CROWNHEIR HALLELUJAH** (Fadel) Another lovely blenheim, just carrying a touch too much weight. Good outline. Elegant head with good eyes, well set ears. Moved well.

4. **ONTHEMARK MY SHOT** (Chan/Mitchell) Sweet blenheim with pretty expression. Went well and happily around the ring. Not as elegant in outline as the first 3. A tad shorter in neck.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1).

1. **BROOKHAVEN SMARTY PANTS** (Whitmere/Ayers) Very nice, liked this blenheim, nice elegant mover, good both ways. Held a firm topline and lovely outline. Pretty head with good eye, good bite, presented in nice coat. Well made with good neck and shoulders.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (6)

1. **NIGHTINGALE OVER THE TOP** (Mulligan) This Blenheim impressed me on the table. Well made with a nice outline. Good neck, straight front. Feminine head with lovely round eye giving a sweet expression, good bite and pigment. Moved out well around the ring with a happy disposition.

2. **BLUEGARDEN FINAL EDITION OF CHARDOMONT** (Greak/Comer) Blenheim of nice shape, sweet head with pretty eye. Good neck and shoulders, firm level topline. Looked well moving in profile with a happy gentle temperament.

3. **FORESTCREEK MOET** (White/Cline) Bigger blenheim that moved out well. Pleasing head with nice round dark eyes. Well made with good neck and bone. Carrying a little too much weight and a tad longer in back but a nice type of bitch.

4. **MIDDLEMARSH SWEET SOUTHERN BELLE AT ALDERBRIDGE** (Alders) Lighter made bitch with sweet head, round dark eyes with a gentle expression. Nice front, moved elegantly around the ring.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (5)

1. **RIVERWYN SIKELEI BLOWING IN THE WIND** (Nel/Pivovar) Nice type of blenheim with classic head, good eye, well set ears with lovely feathering. Nice size and shape with well broken markings. Moved steadily around the ring with a well carried head and level topline.

2. **CHADWICK FLYING ON CLOUD NINE MP** (Greak/Comer/Eckersley) Heavier marked blenheim of good colour. Pretty head with nice round dark eyes, well feathered ears. She went steadily around the ring but her topline was not as firm as 1.

3. **HADARA FAITHFUL SOUL AT CLOUDBASE** (Koch/Johnson) Elegant bitch I thought was my winner on the table. Classic head with lovely dark round eyes and good expression. Good pigment, lovely shape with excellent neck and shoulders, unfortunately not moving very well behind today.

4. **MATLYNE TICKLE ME PINK** (Young) Blenheim with a pretty head, round eyes and well used ears. I could do with a touch more muzzle. Presented in full coat. Looked good on the table and moving in profile but a tad narrow through her chest coming towards me.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR BITCH (3)

1. **CANYONCREST OH OH OLIVIA** (DuRoss). Blanket backed tri, pretty head with round eyes, bright tans and good bite. Moved out soundly both ways, good topline, short back but a bit overweight.

2. **CANYONCREST MARY CASSATT** (Nechiporenko) Another blanket backed girl, again overweight. Slightly longer than 1. Moved smartly around the ring, good bone and front. Pleasing head but not as soft in expression as 1.

3. **STARMARC SHOW ME** (Hooper) Sweet headed tri with lovely round dark eyes, good pigment and bright tans. Not the front of above 2 and tends to fall away over her croup.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

1. **GRANASIL FLORENTINE OF SUMARA JW MP** (Gentil) Nice ruby of lovely colour. Sweet head with good bite, nice round dark eyes. Lovely neck and shoulders, excellent front and good

behind. Held a good outline standing and moving. Possibly a tad long in back. **BEST RUBY BITCH**.

OPEN BITCH (3)

1. CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE JW (Green) Lovely blenheim, nice size, excellent shape. Well made with a firm level topline. Pretty feminine head, but not overdone. Nice eye and mouth. Silky coat presented in lovely condition. Moved well fore and aft and carried herself well around the ring in profile. *RESERVE WINNERS BITCH*.

2. **CH ORCHARDHILL PRETTY CLOSE** (Venier/Venier). Another lovely bitch, excellent presentation, full coat in good condition. Sweet head with lovely quizzical expression. Well set ears, nice reach of neck, good shoulders. Not quite as firm behind as 1.

3. **BECKENHALL DAISEY-HEAD MAYZIE AT PINECREST** (Eubank/Eubank) Lighter marked blenheim, well presented and handled. Pleasant head with round eye, but she needs more filling under her eye. Moved smartly around the ring.

VERTERAN DOG (1)

1. ALMEARA VISIONNAIRE. <u>BEST VETERAN IN SHOW</u> (as above)
