JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1) ORCHARDHILL DONE TALKING (Venier/Venier)

Beautiful puppy with nice breed type. Standing and on the move, it was easy to see that he was well put together with proper structure and balance. His head was spot on, so lovely in expression with beautiful dark eyes. He is another puppy that I believe has a bright future ahead.

2) CLOSEBURN JON SNOW (Fairchild)

This Blenheim boy was the baby of the class. Well balanced, level topline and excellent tail set, moved well going around the ring as well as both coming and going.

3) NIGHTINGALE GOLD RUSH (Mulligan)

There was a lot to like about this young Blenheim. Perfect size with dark round eyes. He excelled in front assembly and excellent top line and tail set.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (1)

1) LEGENDCREST FINICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER, JW (Utych/Utych) This boy is the perfect size and shape with strong front and rear angles that he put to good use on the move; he glided around the ring, covering ground with ease. His moderate head was well cushioned with a very pleasing expression. I was proud to award him with *RESERVE WINNERS DOG*

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (3)

1) CH CHADWICK BEST DRESSED (Robinson)

A lovely Blenheim boy. He was very well made with correct angles front and rear. He looked good going around the ring. His head well cushioned but still moderate with a very pleasing expression. Just the type called for in the breed standard. I strongly considered this boy for top honors. 2) MARJORELLE CATCH ME IF YOU CAN, JW (Conley) A lovely Blenheim boy. He was very well made with correct angles front and rear. He looked good going around the ring. This was a great class and the placements could change any day.

3) WATERSEDGE NEW YEAR TREASURE (Walzer/Walzer) This boy had a nice moderate head and good top line. Could benefit from an extra pound in weight.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1) **KELLENE TOP GUN (Carter)**

This ruby boy has a very pretty head and rich color. Well angled front and rear. Like many young rubies he needs time to mature.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (3)

1) ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE (Cameron)

I have always liked this boy, he has a beautiful outline. Small with plenty of substance. He was presented in perfect condition. Dead level top line. He exhibits qualities of a true toy spaniel. He made the cut in the challenge and pushed hard for top honors.

2) JAYBA JEAN PIERRE, JW (Lander/Lander)

This Blenheim had one of the prettiest heads of the day with large lustrous eyes set on a beautiful head with the softest of expressions. He was well made and a clean mover, front and rear. Unfortunately, he was a bit apprehensive today.

3) CANYONCREST TO THE LEADER OF THE BAND (DuRoss) Nicely marked tri. Nice front and rear with level topline and good tail set on the table.

<u>SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG</u> (1)

1) **KIDDLE CAMBRYCE DAREDEVIL AT MADEE** (Hofschulte) Tri boy with lovely dark eyes and shown in lovely coat, he held his topline steady on the move. I would like to see a lower tail carriage.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (2)

1) KELLENE WHEN IRISH EYES ARE SMILING (Carter) Ruby with nice head and lovely eyes. He was shown in great condition; nice muscle and correct angles. I would like to see a lower tail carriage.

2) MYSTICKNIGHT DOG DAYS OF SUMMER (Brandvold) Nice dark eyes on a very pretty head. This boy also wanted to hold his tail a bit higher than I would like to see.

<u>SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN DOG</u> (1)

1) CANYONCREST AUGUST RENOIR (Du Ross)

This Black and Tan was well made and a clean mover, front and rear. I like his nice rich color and he was quite the showman. He just needs time to mature and body up a bit.

Very sweet little short coupled Blenheim girl. I love her size and shape. She has large eyes and good pigment. She was really moving well today with lots of drive. Good amount of bone for her size. Very animated in the ring and well presented.

2) KELLENE THIS IS IT (Marshall)

Balanced with good bone. Lovely expression from dark large eyes. Nice coat texture but would like to see the color a bit darker.

3) CHADWICK PURPLE PASSION (Eckersley)

Very pretty headed bitch that didn't want to show today; which made it hard to asses her movement. I love her size with just the perfect amount of bone. Well broken color which is hard to achieve. I think she will have a very promising future.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)
