The shape of the eyes and color is quite good. I saw very few with any white. As breeders we have lost some ground on rear structure and movement and we must continue to work on the ongoing problem of high tails.

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

1. **Orchardhill Shirmont Back Story** (Henry/Henry)
Lovely breed type on this 9 month old Blenheim boy. Dark, round, well-spaced eyes, correct bite, neck blends into nicely laid back shoulders, level topline, and correct tail carriage.
2. **Glenellen Royal Rookie** (Murphy)
Blenheim, 6 months old, correct eye shape and color, correct bite, good fore chest, neck shoulder transition good.
3. **Kinvaar Magnus** (Gentil)
Rich Blenheim color, 7 months old, correct eye shape and color, moves true coming and going. Top line not as good as those ahead of him, but have seen this correct as they mature.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (1)

1. **Canyoncrest To The Leader of the Band** (DuRoss)
Tricolor, 11 months old, good tri color markings, large, round dark eyes. He has an inquisitive, melting expression. The blaze on his head, which can really effect the expression on a tri color, is not too wide, nor too narrow. Good neck/shoulder transition into level top line. He moved true coming and going. I really liked him. **WINNERS DOG, BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX, BEST BEST PUPPY IN SHOW, BEST PUPPY DOG, BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW, BEST TRICOLOR DOG**

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2) “A very competitive class of two.”

1. **Nightingale Diorchavon Baby Its You, JW** (Bialek)
Elegant Blenheim, nicely broken, long neck flowing into well laid back shoulders. Movement true.
2. **Dulce Carmel Awesome Sauce** (Covell)
Rich Blenheim color, good dark eyes, level topline, good reach and drive. First place dog slightly more mature.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (3) “Three very different type dogs – all quality.”

1. **Veribas Eye of the Tiger** (Cusick)

Blenheim, well coated, correct silhouette, generous head, round, dark, well-spaced eyes.
Movement a little erratic today.

2. **Mayfield Charming Chester** (Mayfield)
More size to this well broken Blenheim, dark, round eyes, correct bite, and good fore-chest, good moving dog coming and going.
3. **Ca Cambridge Rutledge** (Magera/Mitchell)
Black-and-Tan, with shiny black coat. Round, dark eyes, level topline, well-groomed and beautifully presented.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (3)

1. **Chadwick Jet Setter at Hudsonview, JW** (Glynn/Glynn)
Blenheim, dark round eyes, correct bite, and good neck shoulder transition, level topline.
2. **Linrica Milan, JW** (Liu)
Smaller, well balanced Blenheim with dark, round, well-spaced eyes, good bite, moved true coming and going.
3. **Dallarock Flight Thyme** (Geldermann)
Well broken Blenheim, level top line but not as mature as those above.

AMERICAN BRED (6)

1. **Almeara Extra Extraordinary, JW** (Whitmire)
Well coated Blenheim, good markings, correct silhouette for breed, bite good, forechest good.
2. **Belcarra Straight Shot Remington of Bear River** (Toepfer)
Well-broken, round, dark eyes, correct bite, true coming and going, good neck shoulder transition.
3. **Wymns Pip Georgie** (Swearengin)
Blenheim, well broken, lots of reach and drive from the side, round dark, eyes, good muscle tone.
4. **Bentwood Cartier** (Covell/Harrison)
Heavy marked Blenheim, dark round eyes, good bite and good fore chest, rear movement let him down today.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM (2)

1. **Bekenhall Shirmont He's The Ticket** (Henry/Henry)
Dark round eyes, soft expression on this elegant dog with long neck sloping into well laid shoulder. He is not sure he wants to play "dog show" today.
2. **Estancia Lord Stuart** (Swearengin)
Rich Blenheim color on this dog, good bite, neck flows into well laid back shoulders, preferred the outline of the 1st place dog.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI COLOR (2)

1. **Truelegance Pistols at Dawn** (Ogle)
Flat shiny black coat. Preferred this dog's overall balance and head shape to his competition.
2. **Briarcrest Going for Baroque** (Katz)
Another one with the much desired flat shiny black coat, lower on leg than the first place dog.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN (1)

1. **Nottingham Mugs** (Beebower)
Pleasing head on this boy, good tail carriage, good overall balance, lacking coat today.

OPEN DOG (2)

1. **Ch Brookhaven Here Comes Hogan, JW** (Ayers and Martz)
Blenheim, round dark eyes on a classic shaped head, correct bite, good fore chest, level top line moves true coming and going, great ring presence. ***Reserve Winners Dog***
2. **Ch Bonitos Companeros Vahir** (Lemon)
Blenheim, well coated, dark, round eyes, well spaced on head, correct bite, good fore chest, preferred the movement of the 1st place dog.

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (2)

1. **Sheeba Mile High at Intryzik** (Goodwin)
9 month old well-broken, level top line, moves true coming and going. I liked this girl's silhouette.
2. **Parlett Pinky Promise** (Williams/Williams)
month old promising Blenheim girl, nice round eyes, sweet expression, short compact body.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (2)

1. **Briarcrest Coco Loves Pearls** (Van Luchene/Van Luchene)
9 ½ month old Blenheim, well-shaped, dark eyes, good neck/shoulder transition, level topline, elegant bitch. ***BEST PUPPY BITCH***
2. **Chadwick Oh La La** (Eckersley)
Another 9 ½ months old, Blenheim, eye color and shape good, bite good, muzzle needs to fill.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

1. **Marjorelle Rumour Has It** (Conley)
1 year old richly colored Blenheim bitch who won this class on her overall breed type, good pigment, eyes dark and round, level topline.
2. **Chantismere Carrieanna** (Tibbetts)
14 months old Blenheim, eye shape & color good, correct bite, good fore chest, needs to fill under the eye.
3. **Spice Rack Sorsha at Wymns** (Milosevic)
Tricolor, good round, dark eyes, nice fore chest. Preferred the heads of those in front of her

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

1. **Ch Kean La Ti Da, JW** (Keane)
Very pretty, ultra-feminine, good length of neck flowing into well-laid back shoulders, round dark eyes, level topline. Beautiful picture standing.
2. **Forestcreek Bewitching Girl, JW** (Cline/Cline)
Well broken Blenheim, round dark eyes, well-spaced on the head, in lovely coat, carrying a little too much weight.
3. **Rhapsodee Transcendence** (Fields)

10 month old Blenheim girl, nice length of neck flowing into well laid back shoulders, needs more fill under the eye. She did not like her leash today, therefore, it was hard to assess her movement.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

1. **Delsol Love in An Elevator** (McHenry)
Very curious to know the story behind this girl's name. Elegant Blenheim bitch 13 months old, dark, round eyes, good length of neck flowing into well-laid back shoulders, level top line.
2. **Bluegarden Aussie Girl at Chadwick** (Eckersley)
Blenheim, well broken, dark, round eyes, correct bite. A more compact body with level topline.
3. **Sonesta California Dreaming** (Ellingson/Pennington)
Small, well broken Blenheim, just 12 months old, correct bite, moves true coming and going.
4. **Windsea Dancing Queen, C-RN** (Peterson)
Blenheim, not as mature as those in front of her, good eyes, good fore chest, nice overall balance, needs bone.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

1. **Rosearbor Bijou** (Eckersley)
Black-and-Tan bitch with good flat shiny coat, large round eyes, well-spaced, good length of neck flowing into well laid back shoulders, moves true, correct tail carriage
2. **Brookhaven Simply Southern** (Toepfer/Martz)
Blenheim girl well broken, almost 2 years old, carrying a little too much weight, her tail let her down today.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (4)

1. **Cedar Creek Sugar N Spice** (Owens)
Well broken Blenheim, correct bite, round, dark eyes, liked this bitch's overall balance, top line slightly rounding
2. **Brookhaven Believe in Me** (Ayers/ Martz)
Well-broken Blenheim, rich color, correct bite, good fore chest, moves true coming and going. A close decision between her and the first place in this class.
3. **Sikeleli Emily Bronte at Quail Run** (Kornhi)
Well-broken Blenheim, nice round eyes, good bite, carrying a little too much weight. Much to like about her, coat a little unruly today.
4. **Bonitos Companerus Uhura** (Magera/Mitchell)
Well broken Blenheim, well presented, not the head type I am looking for.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI COLOR BITCH (3)

1. **Marilee Reggae** (Collins)
Well broken tri color with melting expression, good fore chest, dark round eyes.
2. **Rockcreek Bindi At Parlett** (Williams/Williams)
Heavier marked Tricolor, narrow blaze on head, straight shiny coat, preferred the head of the one above.
3. **Briarcrest Oh So Rococo** (Van Luchene/Van Luchene)
Heavier marked tri color, correct bite, soft topline

OPEN BITCH (3)

1. **Ch. Chadwick Drama, JW (Hoehn)**
Such an elegant Blenheim bitch with gentle expression. Lovely round large dark eyes, correct bite, neck flows into well-laid back shoulders, level top line moves true coming and going with correct tail carriage. **WINNERS BITCH, BEST IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM BITCH**
2. **Chadwick Sentimental Journey, JW (Eckersley)**
Blenheim bitch, correct bite, good fore chest, neck flows into well laid back shoulders, little longer than 1st place bitch. **RESERVE WINNERS BITCH, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH**
3. **Iloo Dite Ilan Du Jardin DeClaire of Sumara, JW (Gentil)** Pretty Black-and-Tan with large round dark eyes, correct bite, level top line, moves true coming and going, **BEST BLACK-AND-TAN IN SHOW, BEST BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH**
