Very nice Ruby, with pleasing head, lovely eyes & good pigment. Good for size & colour. Moved well keeping a level topline. **BEST RUBY DOG, BEST RUBY IN SHOW**

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1. **DELSOL DRESS TO IMPRESS** (Macrae/McHenry)

Small, compact, Blenheim with a lovely head, dark eyes & pigment. Well marked, richly coloured coat. Moved very well, keeping a level topline at all times.

2. **BROOKHAVEN DONOVAN** (Milosevic)

Nicely marked Blenheim with lovely dark eyes & pigment. Slightly longer than #1. Moved well with a level topline, but could drop slightly when standing.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (3)

1. **ALMEARA I BELIEVE** (Parente)

Very handsome, well marked Blenheim. Masculine head, with dark eyes & pigment. Good earset. Lovely size & shape. Moved well holding a level topline. Good tailset & carriage.

2. STARMARC MAN ABOUT TOWN (Rezowalli/Hooper)

Neat Tricolour with good head, eyes & pigment. Lovely size. Heavily marked coat, with slight wave. Moved well keeping a level topline & good tailset.

Heavier marked Blenheim & slightly larger than #1 & #2. Lovely eyes & good pigment. Moved well maintaining a level topline & good tailset.

Handsome head, with good eyes & pigment. Lovely size, small & compact. Moved well, holding a level topline.

Small, compact Blenheim with a lovely head & expressive eyes. Richly coloured coat. Moved well keeping a level topline & good tail carriage.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (4)

1. **DALVRECK STARSHINE** (Ayers/Martz/McInally)

Very handsome Blenheim with the most appealing head. Large, round, dark eyes giving a gentle expression. Black pigment. Good earset which he used to advantage. Lovely size & shape. Level topline at all times & really good movement, from his correct conformation. Good tailset & carriage. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG**

2. **BRAEMARRA RUBEN** (Gentil)

Another handsome Blenheim with a lovely head, soft expression & black pigment. Good size & shape. Level topline standing & moving, which he did well. Good tailset & carriage. Richly coloured coat.

Handsome, heavier marked Blenheim with good eyes & pigment. Shorter in body & not so good on the move. Level topline but tail carriage a bit high today.

Very masculine headed Blenheim. Heavier marked & larger built. Good movement & tailset.

Handsome head with good eyes, pigment & earset. Lovely size & shape, with level topline standing & on the move. Good tailset & carriage. Heavier marked, which didn't detract. **BEST TRICOLOUR DOG**

Nice head. Good eyes, but showing slight white. Lovely size. Nicely marked & moved well.

Masculine head with good pigment. Lovely size & well made. Moved well keeping a level topline.

Appealing head, but one eye closing slightly. Good for size & shape. Heavier marked. Moved well with level topline, but a bit close behind.

Pretty headed Blenheim with lovely eyes & dark pigment. Good for size & shape. Moved well keeping a level topline, good tailset & carriage.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

1. **PARLETT PINKY PROMISE** (Williams/Williams)

Very pretty Blenheim with lovely eyes & black pigment. Good size & shape. Moved well all round maintaining a level topline. Good tailset & carriage.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

Very pretty quality Blenheim with lovely head, eyes & pigment. Lovely size & shape. In good coat. Moved well, keeping a level topline. Good tailset & carriage.
