THE DOG CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (6)

1. **DIOCHAVON NOTHING LIKE THIS** (Bialek)

Delightful Tricolor boy with a black saddle that outlines his strong topline. Beautiful head and very nice shape. Well developed for his young age.

2. **HUNTLAND LEOPOLD** (Land/Land)

Lovely immature Blenheim with such a pretty head and well-placed large eyes. Excellent angulation, short hocks, and good bone. Just needs to body up a bit and he will develop proportionately well balanced.

3. **HOWLINWINDS ENDLESS LOVE** (Curtiss)

Look out for this super showman. Waggy and ready to take center stage with age. Nice neck and lay of shoulder. Good angulation. Shows promise.

4. MARILEE BE TRUE TO YOUR SCHOOL (Weinstein)

Another fine lad. Lovely head with large expressive eyes. A bit longer cast but could alter his shape a bit with maturity. Well developed in body and good ribcage. Nice angulation. Excellent well-broken coat with rich color.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1. **BLUEDAY MICH E LOB AT CHEWCREEK** (DePhillip)

Extremely striking Blenheim boy that showed like a trooper. Lovely trimmings that were beautifully groomed. Well developed for his age. Beautiful head. Very good neck and shoulders. Definitely one to watch and admire.

He deserved **BEST PUPPY DOG** from a strong field.

2. LEGENDCREST FINNICKYSKYE DREAM CATCHER (Utych/Utych)

Beautiful young man with plenty of spunk. Glides around the ring with good reach and drive. Strong rear. Most impressed by his flawless movement. Well developed with good bone and substance.

3. HUNTLAND HUNTLEY VAILLANCOURT MCCOSH (McCosh/Land/Land)

Richly colored Blenheim with exquisite headpiece and the darkest large round eyes. Short muzzle with perfectly proportioned features. Richly colored, well fringed coat that was groomed to perfection. A very pleasing picture.

4. **HUNTLAND HEISMAN** (Land/Land)

Phenomenal head shape, ear set, well placed large expressive eyes. Moves well with good tail set and firm topline. Needs to mature and show a bit more confidence. That will come with time and experience. Quality dog.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (5)

1. TUDOROSE DALTON ANGEL KISSES (Dye/Mixon)

All four of these beautiful boys are a treasure trove of quality! This excellent specimen is glamour all over. Wonderful head, eyes, neck, angulation, shape, and balance. Short-backed and precisely proportioned. Moves and shows well.

2. **DIORCHAVON DOCTOR LOU ON CALL** (Bialek)

Heavily marked Blenheim with brilliantly colored, correctly textured coat. Wildly manageable, showing with style and attitude. Moves like a million dollars with good reach and drive.

3. WATERSEDGE NEW YEARS TREASURE (Walzer/Walzer)

Well placed white collar emphasizing another lovely neck settled tightly into nicely placed shoulders and balanced body. A bit smaller than his predecessors, but compact and well boned. Full fringed coat and wears it well. Very nice front, strong rear, and good angulation. Moves happily with a steady pace.

4. **DREAMVALE TIME WARP** (Perini/Sage)

Nicely shaped black-and-tan that works like a well-oiled machine. Stride is strong in every direction due to well angled hindquarters and sound construction. Excellent mover. **BEST BLACK-and-TAN IN SHOW, BEST BLACK-and-TAN DOG**

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1. MARJORELLE CATCH ME IF YOU CAN, JW (Conley)

Luxurious trappings adorn this happily wagging super showman. In perfect sync with his handler. Moves very well covering the ground with ease. Delightful exhibit.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (5)

1. **BROOKHAVEN FOREVER YOUNG** (Bolster/Avers)

This glamorous youngster exemplifies the appeal of the ideal Toy Spaniel. Pretty, but still masculine with a cushy muzzle and large dark eyes. He is brimming with quality. Great size with ample bone and substance. Moves very well covering the ground effortlessly. Exact footfall, coordinated reach and drive, under a level topline and accurately set tail. Well-turned behind with neat short hocks complete this appealing picture. Proud to award him <u>WINNERS DOG</u>, <u>RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX, BEST AMERICAN BRED DOG</u>, and BEST BLENHEIM DOG.

2. **ORCHARDHILL NEWS TO ME** (Venier/Venier)

Two-year old showman with masculine, appealing, plush head and large expressive eyes. Elegantly coated with full thick ears framing his beautiful head. Compact shape and correct height to length ratio. Great spring of rib and well angulated hind quarters. Nicely turned stifles with short, well let down hocks. Firm and level topline and direct tail carriage. Excellent example of quality breed type. <u>BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG</u>

3. **BROOKHAVEN MR TAMBOURINE MAN, JW** (Ayers/Martz)

This is a dog who enters the ring and simply demands attention. Happily distracted, but stylishly demonstrative. Excellent shape, compact and well bodied. He is sporty with an air of expectancy. His head is expressive, and his large round eyes are liquid and enchanting. Neat muzzle. Great bone and compact firm feet.

4. **KRYSTLE LATITUDE ATTITUDE** (Torgersen/Torgersen)

Just the most appealing, soft, alert expression! Lovely make and shape. Carries himself with style and personality. Lovely lavish coat needs ironing.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (4)

1. **ORCHARDHILL INCLUSIVE** (Venier/Venier)

Maybe the best mover in the show. True glider with straight front and strong rear, he travels effortlessly with style and precision. Construction is equally appealing. Neck, shoulders, front and rear angulation is all good which shows in his effective movement. Blenheim of excellent quality and type. Soft muzzle, kind, gentle expression, good pigment and dentition. Prime exhibit.

2. **BILL BLASS GORSKA FANTAZJA** (Wells)

Such well-endowed furnishings, it is a bit difficult to decipher his alluring quality. Glam to the tenth degree. Unexaggerated, appealing headpiece containing large big lustrous dark round eyes,

squishy muzzle, and correct ear placement show a soft, attractive face. Moves soundly and positively with a touch of flair showing a clean outline highlighted by his showy personality.

3. MARILEE RAY NITSCHKE (Junk/Collins)

Four-year old Blenheim with exquisite eyes and appealing expression. Beautifully marked with lovely furnishings. Broad skull and cushy muzzle within a perfect ear set to frame the picture. Quality.

4. **AMMIK ONE PARTICULAR HARBOR** (Madden/Mixon)

Lovely, heavily marked super-showman. Well ribbed built on good bone with deep chestnut covering. Firm and positive movement locomoting out with animation and ideal balance. A bit attentive to his tail today.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (3)

"THIS WAS AN OUTSTANDING CLASS!"

1. **EMENKAY DREAM LOVER** (Vezina/Orns)

The leader in an outstanding class of quality tricolors. The headpiece on this handsome contender is exquisite. Lavish ears and glamorous furnishings presented in super condition. Well ribbed built on good bone. Happy showdog shown to perfection. Good lay of shoulder and angulated rear. Liked him on the move holding a level topline but relaxed too much standing leaving it a bit soft. Perfectly in tune with his handler. **BEST TRICOLOR DOG**

2. **PINNACLEE HUEY IN THE NEWS** (Bennett)

Beautiful, typey Tricolor adorning a lovely headpiece with a broad skull, large round eyes giving an embracing and kindly look. Excessive feathering framing his face to add to his appeal and softness. His white collar emphasizes his lovely neck and correct lay of shoulder. Short coupled and firm body with excellent topline and everything in its proper order. Movement is accurate and composed. Soundly made and groomed nicely.

3. ONE MORE TIME VOM KANINCHENGARTEN (James/Stahl)

Another pretty face and beautiful furnishings. Quite a captivating headpiece with nothing overdone. Lovely top skull and lavish ears frame his appealing expression. His topline is neat and straight built on elegant lines endowed with good angulation. Reachy, crested neck that delivers a great finish.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (2)

1. **CHEWCREEK UP IN SMOKE** (DePhillip)

Handsome ruby of excellent quality. Lovely typey head with large dark eyes, moderate muzzle, correct bite and black pigment. Earset adequately framing a soft, alluring and alert expression. Well-constructed body carrying a level topline and showing off sound movement. Ample bone and substance. Great disposition and consummate show attitude. Fun to watch! **BEST RUBY IN SHOW, BEST RUBY DOG**

2. **SNOWBIRD HOCUS POCUS** (Miller)

Neat Ruby boy with ample bone and substance. Masculine, balanced, appealing head. Moved confidently with likable temperament.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN DOG (3)

1. **DARANE HAPPY SONG** (Markijohn/Kates)

This Lovely black-and-tan jester zoomed into the ring like a lightening flash! Truly "active, graceful, and well balanced. Absolutely fearless and sporting in character". Very free in action with a topline you could set the table on. Absolutely as dead level as it can be. Moved well also. Exceptional quality!

2. LYNSFAIRE CELTIC CHARM (Fairchild)

A bit longer cast than number one but holding that same level topline. Excellent tail carriage showing true movement both coming and going. Excellent reach of neck and lay of shoulder giving way to a smooth steady gait. Beautiful angulation and impressive elegance.

3. CORBONA'S FIREHEART OF NOONVALE (Bertron)

Well ribbed with adequate bone and substance. This young black-and-tan boy has some developing to do. Moved a bit close in the rear and wide in the front, but advanced freely around the ring with an agreeable attitude.

OPEN DOG (4)

1. CH DREAMVALE DEVIL WITHOUT A CAUSE (Perini/Sage)

Extraordinary example of breed type, this outstanding, quality two-year old stole my heart when he entered the ring. A Toy Spaniel with a big personality, he moved with style, grace, and attitude. Put together with excellent neck and shoulders, level back, good turn of stifle, short rear pasterns and a well-set tail. Perfect size with good bone and attractive broken markings on a silky well-groomed coat. A well-proportioned masculine head with large, dark, round eyes, correct muzzle, and correct ear set. Short coupled with perfectly proportioned size and shape. I was honored to award him *RESERVE WINNERS DOG*.

2. CH FOXWYN COOL WATER (Norton/Baker-Fox)

Heavily-marked Blenheim with deep chestnut jacket and lovely white collar. Extraordinary example of breed type. Love his outline and ample neck. Long, beautiful thick feathered ears that framed his stunning headpiece. Plenty of prosternum because his shoulders are adequately laid with well-sprung ribs and a dead level topline coming and going. Really used his strong rear to his advantage on the move. Quality throughout.

3. CH CHADWICK CODE BLACK OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley)

Nicely marked tricolor with tuxedo highlights accenting his graceful neck that flowed into a well laid shoulder. Good return of upper arm and excellent boning down to compact tight feet. Good level topline, well-turned stifle and superb angulation.

4. CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LOVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE (Utych)

Not too excited about his job today but managed to put on a decent show. Beautiful boy with the prettiest, softest expression. Nice size, short coupled, and well-balanced. Capacious chest and firm, level topline.

VETERAN DOG (1)

1. KARVALE BROOKHAVEN FINN (Utych)

Handsome 11-year old Blenheim. Seasoned trooper with superfluous feathering, good markings, and appealing expression. Moving soundly and securely with positive pizzazz and incredible spirit.

THE BITCH CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (11)

1. WATERSEDGE CURTAIN CALL (Walzer/Walzer)

Everything about this amazing little lady is spot on including her Blenheim spot stamp of perfection! Beautiful, well-broken Blenheim youngster with a lovely feminine head and soft gentle expression. Classic shape of head with tapered muzzle and shallow stop. Large dark captivating eyes that follow her handler attentively. Developed body and coat for her age adding to the glamour. Excellent crested neck folding into a nice shoulder set and depth of chest. Moves with drive and pizzazz keeping a level topline. Well on her way to a promising future in the winner's circle. I just couldn't resist awarding her

BEST PUPPY BITCH, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW and RESERVE WINNERS BITCH!

2. **NIGHTINGALE OVER THE TOP** (Mulligan)

As lovely as the winner is, she had a tough battle topping this extraordinary Princess. It was a close call. Exceedingly eye-catching attraction with much to appreciate. Wonderful size and balance, large dark expressive eyes on a most appealing headpiece. Good proportions with accurate shape and level topline. Stylish and happy on the move adding poise to her presentation. Adorable!

3. **NORTHPOINTE WIND IN THE WILLOWS** (Mitchum)

This beautifully marked Tricolor girl was definitely working the room. She performed with attitude, and genuine decorum. Exceptionally lovely head, correct shape and precise size, superb outline when standing and on the move. Well balanced which means she glides around the ring elegantly moving with reach and drive.

4. **CROWNROSE SKY FULL OF SONG** (Rosenberg/Rosenberg)

Well-marked Tricolors are rare these days, but here comes another one. Just dazzling with a lovely white collar supporting an attractive headpiece, luscious eyes, and melting expression. She

shows with exuberance perfectly in tune with her handler. A bit longer cast but she uses her body with accuracy moving freely with drive from the rear.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (2)

1. ALMEARA ONCE SMITTEN TWICE LOVED (Whitmire)

BEAUTIFUL lightly marked Blenheim girl groomed and presented to perfection. All her assets are visibly displayed to her total advantage. Lots of drive from behind due to such good construction. Short coupled with well-turned stifles, good reach of neck and well-set shoulders. She is put together so accurately, it is not surprising how well she moves. Exuberant and enthusiastic attitude!

2. HYTEA PUDDLE JUMP (Greak/Comer)

Small, compact Black-and-Tan enchantress in wonderful condition showing like a pro. She was so focused on her handler, she got a bit serious standing, but moved out freely with a spirited, accurate gait. She also made the perfect profile standing. Just what you look for in a typey, well-balanced Cavalier. Happy to award her <u>BEST BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH</u>

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (6)

1. **ORCHARDHILL CHARGE IT TO DAD** (Venier/Venier)

Exquisite example of breed type, this beautiful young bitch just sparkled her way into the ring. I loved everything about her. Her head is glamorous with large dark alluring eyes and magnetic expression. Her outfit is fashionably fabulous including well-fringed ears and stylish furnishings. Her movement is effortless and accurate due to such a well-constructed, compact body with all the parts precisely placed.

2. NORTHPOINTE HEDERA COLCHICA (Mitchum)

Heavily marked Blenheim with deep chestnut saddle and lovely white collar defining her regal reach of neck and her excellent shape and size. Well balanced, cobby body with nice bone and great angulation. She held her topline as she moved around the ring with grace and sophistication.

3. **BROOKHAVEN HERE COMES WINTER** (Ayers/Martz)

Extremely nice feminine Tricolor girl with countless attributes. Very stylish with good substance and bone in a small compact package. She made a picture perfect profile standing as well as side gait. Unfortunately, she was not as confident as she will eventually become with experience. Positive promise.

4. AUTUMNHILL UNFORGETTABLE AT TIDEWATER (O'Brien/Tatum/Parente)

Happy Ruby showgirl that could teach the rest about owning the ring. Such exuberance encourages recognition of her distinct conformation attributes. This was complimented by her elegant performance.

NOVICE BITCH (2)

1. **HOLLYTREE GOOD DAY SUNSHINE** (Markijohn/Seymour)

This delightful Ruby has an appropriate name. She definitely shines! Such an adorable face with affective embracing expression illuminates **JOY**. She never stopped wagging. Correct size with good front and very nice turn of stifle. She gave a solid and acute performance showing off her balanced body and precise movement. She deserves **BEST RUBY BITCH**

2. KRYSTLE DAISY MAE (Monroe)

Nice Blenheim girl having a good time and totally in tune with her handler. Standing four square and moving with determination.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (2)

1. BROOKHAVEN FORBIDDEN FRUIT, JW (Ayers/Martz)

Sporty with a sophisticated gait that sets her apart, this sassy little lassie got my attention immediately. She exemplifies the type called for in the breed standard. She travels freely with every step in place, so it was easy to access her well angulated hind quarters and level topline. She is magic on the move. Beautifully marked with the prettiest head. Adorable!

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH

2. **CHEWCREEK DANCING QUEEN (DePhillip)**

Lush coat loaded with glamour, this beautiful bitch stood out in many ways. Her head piece is just captivating. Framed by excessively feathered ears, her expression is captivating with large dark eyes. Her ornamentation continues with a luxurious coat and fancy fringing. She is short coupled, compact, and stands four-square. Sound coming and going. She made a brilliant exhibit.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

1. CHADWICK PURPLE PASSION (Eckersley)

This lovely little Tricolor girl is only 8 months old but held her own splendidly to win this very attractive class. Evenly broken with large white collar and long, full glamorous ears that framed a charming feminine face. She stood out even more as she waltzed around the ring with style, grace, and accuracy. Exceptionally well-constructed with a balanced body, short coupled, standing four-square. She moves cleanly covering the ground with ease and precision. She presented herself beyond her time. I predict a positive future in the showring for this complete package.

2. TASSAJARA THIS IS US WEE (Seidman and Seidman-McDonnell)

This heavily marked "Toy-Torturer" was having the best time in the ring, focusing much more on the adventure than the performance. Her action was exciting and showed an amazing spirit. I was impressed by her precision and impeccable construction. Very very pretty young tricolor that should mature with promise.

3. BYREWOOD YOU SEND ME (Torgersen and Baldwin)

Another happy, pretty Tricolor. She glided around the ring with a spirited dance very much in tune with her handler. A bit stuffy in the neck and shoulders, but your attention focused on her beautiful headpiece and glamorous furnishings.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (5)

1. CHADWICK SAY YES TO THE DRESS (Eckersley)

The head has it on this brilliant bitch. So beautiful with the face I love from this kennel. Her big, dark eyes are mesmerizing framed by long luxe ears. She shows off her glam as she propels herself around the ring effortlessly with confidence and style. A precise showgirl that never lets down her performance precision.

2. HOWLINGWINDS PRINCESS IDA (Curtiss)

Poetry in motion, this elegant girl is quite the proper package. Very well made with correct angles front and rear which she puts to good use on the move. Complete the presentation with her lovely head and large dark eyes with the blackest of noses. A quality exhibit with bone and substance in a feminine frame.

3. **CHADWICK HPNOTIQ BLU** (Taub/Eckersley)

Handsome lightly marked four-year old blessed with the spot atop a lovely headpiece with a very nice, sweet, gentle expression. A bit apprehensive, but cooperative. Coat in full flower. Well-constructed and looked in the groove on the move.

4. CARLEN AMBER MARSALA SPICE (Close)

It was raining Blenheim spots in this crowd. Another crowning for this nice four-year old ladybird. Beautiful girl with typical sweet temperament although she did not turn it up today. Not quite as refined as the others.

HEALTH AND CONFORMATION BITCH (1)

1. SUNJAYS MODERN DANCER (Hellman)

Perfection right down to the Blenheim spot! This Ab Fab six-year old has everything you could possibly want in a Cavalier, even beyond her excellent health record. She is compact and elegant in build and shape, smooth and precise in her movement, the prettiest face with large, dark expressive eyes and cushioned moderate muzzle. Sound all around with a level topline and **EXQUISITE** crested neck. She showed all of her superlative features as she waltzed proudly about the ring. Loved her!

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

1. **FOXWYN MAYFLOWER** (McHenry)

Lovely three-year old Blenheim beauty with bedroom eyes and luxury plus! So well put together, compact yet elegant, with exceptional front and rear angulation. She moved like a dream and showed her spirited little heart out. She is the perfect size and shape. Sound and sturdy, but completely feminine.

2. **ORCHARDHILL GOTTA ADORE ME** (Venier/Venier)

This two-year old Princess is also a visual knock out. Just the most beautiful headpiece with large, dark, eyes and melting expression. Her lovely face is framed with full thick fringed ears. She moves like a well- oiled machine...animated, effortlessly smooth with perfect precision. She

was a bit longer cast than her frontrunner with not as much neck to emphasize her fine head carriage. It took close comparative details to separate the two. They are both so lovely.

3. ANGEL'S PRIDE NESSAJA (Charen)

More excellent breed type! Another very pretty girl, glamorous with good, rich coloring. Mushy mushy muzzle and exquisite eyes. Very nice front and rear angulation, sound movement, and pleasing body shape. Probably more animation another day.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH

1. **DELSOL ADORED** (McHenry)

Heavily marked Tricolor with healthy, shiny coat fully furnished with long silky ears. A beautiful headpiece with dark eyes, good ear-set, well cushioned muzzle, and soft, seductive expression. This is truly the head I love. Put together with perfection. It was very close between these first two tricolors. She won by an eyelash and moved forward into **BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW, BEST TRICOLOR BITCH**

2. CHADWICK WISH UPON A STAR (Eckersley)

This Tricolor girl was also a treat to meet! Similar markings as number one with those same large, dark captivating eyes. Classy showman, small and compact with good bone and a smart outline. Solid mover with excellent overall quality.

3. KRYSTLE MALEFICENT (Torgersen/Torgersen)

Very pretty Tricolor, nicely broken with precise proportions, shape, and balance. Very pleasing outline. Nice type. She was a bit unsettled on the move that spoiled her chances.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

1. **BROOKHAVEN I BELIEVE** (Ayers/Martz)

When this lovely dancing Queen propelled herself into the ring, I was afraid she might ascend skyward! Her tail was wagging like a pair of windshield wipers. Such excitement! She is the perfect size, shape, and outline. Sweet feminine head, well made, compact body with good shoulders, nice topline, short loin and strong rear. Promising future.

OPEN BITCH (2)

1. CH CHADWICK IN MY OPINION, JW (Eckersley)

This ravishing young lady was a bit more mature and confident showing off every element of her detailed refinement. Her well-constructed, compact shape defined breed type. She has a soft melting expression, enhanced by large dark round eyes and dark pigment. Lovely reach of neck leading to well laid shoulders, good spring of rib, level topline and proper tail carriage which she kept on the move. I am glad her body was easy to access because I could not take my eyes off of

Her outline is lovely with short coupling, balanced shape, nice short hocks, beautiful, feminine headpiece, big, round, dark eyes with lovely ears framing the inimitable picture.
