He shows a friendly and happy temperament, and his coat is very promising, he is well balanced. He moves well with perfect tail carriage. What a bright future ahead he has!!! He is my **BEST PUPPY DOG IN SHOW**.

<u>GRADUATE PUPPY DOG</u> (4)

1) **GENTLE STAR UNFORGETTABLE DREAM** (Gentil) 17 months old puppy dog with handsome masculine head and so very large eyes that his left eye shows little white at times. This boy moves really well with perfect tail carriage and good drive from the rear. He keeps a perfect topline when moving.

2) **NORTH POINTE LETS START A REVOLUTION** (Mitchum) Blenheim boy with a lovely head, dark eyes and soft expression. He also has a lovely neck and strong back. This puppy is very nicely marked and shows a happy temperament.

3) CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley)

Very nice puppy with pretty eyes, happy and friendly temperament. He has good ribs, well placed elbows and perfect tail set.

4) **NIGHTINGALE HELLO GOODBYE** (Mulligan) Very nice boy with dark eyes, pretty head and good pigment. Ears are well-placed and he has a lovely neck. Stop is a little deep.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (1)

1) **CH ORCHARD HILL OVERANALYZED** (Venier) Very attractive tricolor boy. This dog moves really well with a lot of drive from the rear and a perfect tail carriage. He is short coupled. He is very well handled. His stop is a little deep which hardens the expression. Because of his overall qualities, he is my *BEST TRICOLOR DOG IN SHOWand BEST TRICOLOR IN SHOW*

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (3)

1) **CLARMARIAN HEARTTHROB**, **JW** (Young-May/Gogol) Very handsome and promising dog with typical expression of the breed. Very well placed and well feathered ears. He has good angulations and a strong back. He moves well.

2) **NORTH POINTE SEQUINED BROGUE** (Mitchum) Very nice dog with shallow stop and well-placed ears. He is short coupled. He has a lovely coat condition. He moves really well keeping a perfect topline when moving.

3) **CEILIMOR DRESS CODE** (McCarty/Eckersley) Attractive Blenheim dog with large dark eyes. Shallow stop. Good pigment and promising coat quality. Well balanced, he moves well and has good tail setting.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1) **KRYSTLE BLUE PERSUASION AT SAINTBRIDES** (Burkley/Torgersen) Good looking Blenheim dog with masculine head and dark eyes. He has a soft expression, lovely neck, strong back and good tail setting. His muzzle might be a little longer. He has good bone and good coat quality. He moves well.

<u>OPEN DOG</u> (3)

 CH FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDORR, JW (Mixon/Cline/Marshall) Here is a very attractive Blenheim dog with large dark eyes and soft expression. He has a beautiful head and a lovely neck as well. Good pigment and wide open nostrils, he also has good length of muzzle. Good shape of ribs, good shoulder. Good angulations. He keeps a perfect topline when standing and moving. What a perfect team with his handler! For all these reasons, he is my <u>WINNERS DOG</u>, <u>BEST AMERICAN BRED DOG IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM DOG IN SHOW, BEST IN</u> <u>SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW and BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW.</u>
CH FALLING SPRINGS BLACK FLAME AT MADRYN, JW, CTKN (Weeks/Curley) A sound black and tan dog moving like a king! He has a masculine head and lovely expression. Dark and soft eyes... He is short coupled and well balanced. He shows a very happy and joyful temperament. He is very well handled and is a great mover. So very attractive that I cannot resist to

Perfectly handled he is a tribute to the breed. He is my *BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG IN SHOW*, *BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW and BEST VETERAN IN SHOW*. It is so well deserved.

She moves well with straight topline and good tail carriage. This young girl already has a well developed chest but her metacarpus are still a little soft. This can change when getting older.

2) **KOFAS AFTER ALL THIS TIME** (Barr) An 8 months old pretty girl with sweet expression. She has a perfect stop and length of muzzle and very nice dark eyes. I wish she could put a little weight on. She moves with a happy tail.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1) **KRYSTLE BLUE VELVET AT SAINTBRIDES** (Burkley/Torgersen) This very pretty girl will be one year old in a week time (Happy birthday!). She has very large dark eyes, good teeth and pigment. She has a strong back and moves with perfect tail carriage and shows a lovely coat quality. She is my *BEST PUPPY BITCH IN SHOW and BEST PUPPY IN SHOW*

<u>GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH</u> (3)

1) **GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA, JW, MP** (Gentil) This pretty bitch is short coupled and has a lovely neck, good bone, good hind quarters and well placed shoulder. She moves well with a good tail carriage. To be critical, I wished the color to be richer. She is my <u>BEST RUBY BITCH</u> IN SHOW and BEST RUBY IN SHOW

2) **NORTH POINTE BOSTON TEA PARTY** (Mitchum) 13 months old puppy bitch, with a pretty head and feminine expression. She shows a shallow stop and good pigment, good chest and lovely neck. Her back could be stronger and her metacarpus as well. She moves well a little close behind.

3) **KINGDOMRUN SPRING MAGNOLIA** (Degen/Mixon) Nice bitch with a pretty head and well-placed ears. Muzzle should not be shorter. She shows a lovely neck, good chest, good ribs and perfect tail setting. Elbows are slightly out and metacarpus have to strengthen. So should her back when moving. This may come with age.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1) **FALLING SPRINGS ROSE OF SHARON AT JEMANDA** (Weinstein) 17 months feminine bitch with well-placed and spaced eyes. She has a shallow stop and well filled muzzle, good pigment and bite, lovely neck and strong back, good ribs, good chest. She has the perfect expression of the breed with large eyes. The color could be richer. I would like more drive from the rear.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

1) **CH FALLING SPRINGS SHINING BRIGHTLY, AW** (Curley) 2 years old sparkling Blenheim bitch, with lovely eyes and pretty head. She has a lovely neck and a strong back and a well-balanced body. She is a happy girl enjoying being here. She moves with an ever-wagging tail. Cute!

2) CH CLAMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART, AW (Young-May/Gogol) Very pretty head with dark eyes. This bitch has a typical expression of the breed, with well-placed and well fringed

ears framing her face. She has good coat quality and is well balanced. Her back is a little soft. She moves well.

3) CH TASSAJARA JALAPENO PEPPER, AW (Seidman)

A pretty feminine bitch with a good stop and soft expression. Sha has a good bite and a lovely neck. Muzzle should not be shorter. She is well balanced and has a strong back and well-set tail. Back could be more tense when moving.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

1) **NORTH POINTE SEQUINED PARTY SHOES** (Mitchum) 16 months old bitch with a pretty feminine head and soft expression. Ears are well placed and well feathered, eyes are dark, bite is good. She shows a strong back, well laid shoulder, good chest, good bone and pretty feet. She moves really well with a good tail carriage.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

1) **VALENTYNE NOTORIOUS AT SUNJAYS, JW, MP** (Hellman/O'Brien) Very very pretty bitch. She has a lovely head with typical expression of the breed, large dark eyes, lovely neck, good ribs, well placed elbows. Good bone. She is short coupled. Wow !!She moves really well with perfect tail carriage. Awesome ! and so, she is my *RESERVE WINNERS BITCH*

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

 CHADWICK WISHFUL THINKING (Eckersley) 2 years old. Nice size bitch with soft expression, she is a happy mover. She has a lovely neck, good shoulder, good chest, good bone. She moves well with a lot of drive from the rear, the right foot turning slightly in when moving.
KINGDOMRUN GENESIS OF AN EMERALD DREAM (Degen) Pretty Blenheim bitch with nice expression, lovely eyes, well filled muzzle, pretty neck, good shoulder, good hind quarters, moves well.

3) **GENTLE STAR NEVERENDING STORY** (Barr) 3 years old bitch with a pretty feminine head, with a good stop and good length of muzzle. She has a strong back, she is well balanced and has good bone. Elbows are slightly out. She moves well.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (1)

1) **CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CEILIMORE, JW** (McCarty/Eckersley) Lovely tricolor bitch with pretty head and incredibly soft expression. Ears are really well placed and well feathered. Lovely dark eyes. Wel filled muzzle. Lovely neck. Good shoulder. Strong hind quarters. She moves very well with a happy tail. She is my *BEST TRICOLOR BITCH IN SHOW*

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH (1)
