JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

1) CHADWICK WELL TEMPERED CLAVIER AT INTRYNZIK (Goodwin) 6 month old wellmarked blenheim puppy. Excellent proportions. Wellshaped head with dark gentle eyes. Good foreface. Balanced neck. Well angulated. Moves with confidence keeping a level topline and correct tailcarrige. <u>BEST PUPPY DOG</u>

2) **DULCE GIDDY UP** (Covell)

9 month old, a bit heavily marked, blenheim puppy. Excellent head and expression. Lovely dark eyes. Excellent angulated. A bit long in loin. Moves well. Deep rich chestnut color.

3) TASSAJARA TRUMPET AT TWICKENHAM (Frederick)

7 month old, well marked blenheim puppy. Excellent proportions. Not as matured as 1 and 2 in the clas. A bit finer in head. Dark, round eyes. Excellent angulations. Moves well ... when he wants.

<u>GRADUATE PUPPY DOG</u> (2)

1) KENDALL KASTLE LOVE IS IN THE HEIR (Ogle)

14 month, a bit heavily marked blenheim puppy. Masculine head with dark eyes. Excellent forechest and ribcage. A bit short in neck. Balanced angulated, but moves a bit short in rear. Excellent coattexture and deep rich chestnutcolor.

2) MINGCHEN YUKON RIVER AT HIGH FLIGHT (Parris/Parris)

13 month old wellmarked blenhiem puppy. Excellent proportions. Excellent dark eyes. A bit finer headed. Excellent ears and earset. Still needs to mature in body. Falling croup. Moves close in front and rear. A little roached the topline on the move.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (1)

1) ASTARRING ALL THE CATS PAJAMAS (Foster Flowers)

Excellent overall picture. Correct head and expression. Excellent forechest and ribcage. Well angulated. Good bone. Moves very well with level topline. Excellent coat texture.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

1) FALLING SPRINGS JUST WAIT AT CROWNROSE (Rosenberg/Rosenberg)

Excellent wellbalanced classical head. Lovely eyes with melting expression. Excellent forechest and ribcage. A bit long in loin. Excellent angulations. Moves very well, keeping a super topline. Wellmarked with silky coat, would be lovely with a littel bit more.

2) MARILEE PLAY IT AGAIN (Collins)

A dog with a gloriouse head. Big, round , dark eyes. Excellent earcarrige and fringes Excellent neck, forechest and ribcage.. A bit falling croup. Proud of his tail on the move. Wellmarked with excellent silky coat.

3) COBRNIK RED RED WINE (Cook)

A bit finer headed male. Excellent ears. Could have darker eyes. Excellent neck. Enough body. Falling croup. Could be better angulated in rear. Tends to be a bit high in rear when moving.

4) NIGHTHAWK'S GREAT EXPECTATIONS (Dirks/Mitchell)

Strong headed male. A bit rounded skull. Could have bigger eyes. Short neck, Excellent body. Good bone. Excellent coattexture with deep ,rich color. Heavily marked. Proud tail on the move.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (4)

1) MARILEE INDICA FRED (Collins/Max)

Excellent masculine classical head with big, round, dark eyes. Excellent ears and earset. Excellent neck, topline and angulations. Moves very well with correct topline. Wellmarked with excellent silky coat texture.

2) CEDARCREEK CHANCES ARE AT CREEKSIDE (Mathies)

Excellent sized dog. Mascukine head with dark, round eyes. Could be flater in skull. Excellent ears. Excellent neck and topline. Needs to mature in body. A bit long in loin. Moves well from side, a bit close in rear. Excellent coat texture, heavily marked.

3) COVINGTON RHAEGAL (Gonyo/Mohn)

Excellent expression. Could be flater in skull. Excellent eyes. Enough neck. A bit falling croup. Well broken color. Tends to be a bit high in rear on the move.

4) **ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TURDORR** (Mixon/Mixon)

Masculine head with big, dark, round eyes. Wellset and carrige ears. Excellent neck. Balanced angulations. Moves a bit short in rear and close from behind. Tends to be a bit high in rear on the move. Very well marked with correct silky coat texture.

<u>SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG</u> (2)

1) HARANA FAT BOY SLIM (Robinson)

Excellent size and proportions. Masculine head and expression, could be a bit stronger in head. Excellent ears. Round, dark eyes. Enought neck. Excellent forechest and ribcage. Balanced angulations. Move very well. Could be a bit richer in colour. **BEST RUBY IN SHOW**

2) KOLACI CLIMBING THE EVEREST (Legerretta/Gray)

Strong headed malet that could have a bit softer expression. Short neck. Excellent forechest and ribcage. A bit long in loin. Good bone, but could be better angulated. Despite this moves very well. Excellent coat texture and deep rich colour.

SPECIAL BLACK-AND-TAN DOG (1)

1) COBRNIK MAXWELL (Cook)

Glourios headed male with dark, round eyes. Well set and carried ears. Excellent neck, forechest and ribcage. A bit long in loin. Excellent angulated. Balanced angulations. Moves very well. A bit proud of his tail on the move. Excellent coattexture with ravenblack colour and clear tanmarkings. *BEST BLACK AND TAN IN SHOW*

OPEN DOG (4)

1) CH CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn)

What a lovely, masculine, classical head and expression with big, dark, round eyes. Correct cuisioned foreface, Well set and carried ears. Excellent neck and topline. Excellent angulations. Still young and still needs to mature in body. Moves very well with reach and drive. Well marked with correct coattexture. *WINNERS DOG, BEST OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST IN SHOW*

2) CH FORESTCREEK IM THE MAN (Cline/Marshall)

Excellent size and proportions. Masculine head with big, dark, round eyes. A bit rounded in skull. Excellent foreface. Excellent neck and body. Well angulated and moves very well. Excellent coattexture and markings. *RESERVE WINNERS DOG*

3) CH BROOKHAVEN ALMOST PARADISE (Ayers/Martz)

Excellent size. Masculine, gentle head with dark, round eyes. Enough neck. Excellent forechest and ribcage. A bit long in loin. Moves very well from side with excellent tail carrige. Excellent coat texture with deep rich chestnut colour.

4) CH DELSOL MAGIC CARPET (Macroe/McHenry)

Attractive male in profile. Could have stronger head. Big, round eyes, showing a little bit of white. Excellent neck and body. Very well angulated and moves very well. Well marked, could have more silky coat.

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

1) **TIBBEDON SUMMER LOVE** (Tibbetts)

Sweet headed girl. Excellent proportions. Excellent forechest and ribcage. A bit falling croup. Wellmarked.

2) ROSEGLEN DIAMOND IN THE SKY (Colombo)

Feminine head with correct dark eyes and correct expression. Excellent neck and body. Correct proportions. Moves well when she wants.

3) **KEAN PATINA** (Keane-Carcieri/Schramm)

Very feminin head with big, round, dark eyes. Excellent forechest and ribcage. A bit short on legs. Excellent coattexture but could be a bit deeper in colour.

4) BENCHMARK ABRACADABRA (Hoorman)

Feminine, a bit finer headed girl. Needs to fill out under the eyes. Excellent dark, round eyes. Excellent forechest. A bit long in loin. Moves very well. Well marked.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

1) KASTLE KISS FOR GOOD LUCK (Ogle)

Excellent overall picture and proportions. Correct feminine head and expression with big, dark, round eyes. Well angulated and moves very well. Wellmarked.

2) BROOKHAVEN PEACHES AND CREAM (Ayers)

Excellent size. A bit less matured then no 1. Very feminine head and expression. Dark, round eyes. A bit fine boned. Well angulted with correct easy movement. A bit heavily marked.

3) CEMPA CEDAR CREEK SILVER LINING (Owens/Creary)

Excellent feminine head and expression with big, dark eyes. Good neck. Excellent body. Well angulated. Could have some more drive. Wellmarked.

4) BEARIVER ROCKIN THE PARADISE (Toepfer)

Strong headed girl with correct expression. Need to stabilize the bite . Well set and carried ears. Excellent body. Could have better angulated rear. Moves well with correct tailcarrige. A bit heavily marked.

<u>GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH</u> (5)

1) **DEL SOL GOLD DIGGER** (McHenry)

Excellent type. Very sweet correct head and expression with big, dark, round eyes. Excellent skull. Wellset and carried ears. Excellent neck and body (carrying a bit weight today). Excellent angulated. Moves very well. Excellent coat texture.

2) CROSSBOW WHITNET FLIRTING WITH LIFE (Schiffman)

Excellent head and expression with big, round, dark eyes. Excellent carried ears. Excellent neck and body. Balanced angulations. Moves well from side, a bit close in front and rear. Lightly marked and today a bit short in coat.

3) PINNACLE BABY YOU'RE A FIRWORK (Gregory/Ayers)

Excellent feminine head with big, round eyes. Excellent neck and topline in standing. Good body. A bit long in loin. Moves well, just a bit proud of the tail. Excellent ravenblack coat.

4) WYMNS DOROTHY (Milosevic)

Excellent proportions. Feminine head with a bit finer head. Need to stabilize the bite. Excellent neck and topline. Well balanced angulations. Moves very well. Wellmarked, just a bit short coat on the day

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1) **ONTHEMARK MOONSTONE MAGIC** (Chan/Mitchell)

Young bitch that needs some more ringtraining to look the best. A bit finer headed. Excellent ears. Could have bigger eyes. Still needs to mature in body. A bit long in loin.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

1) CH FORESTCREEK SWEET SOUL AT HADARA (Koch/Cline)

What a WOW factor. Excellent, sweet, feminine head with correct big, round, darke eyes. Everything in correct place which shows when she moves. Perfect topline and tailcarrige. Not in her best coat today, but absolutely nothing to hide. <u>WINNERS BITCH & BEST IN</u> <u>SHOW & BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR & BEST AMERICAN BRED &</u> <u>BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW</u>

2) STARMARC BLUE LAGOON (Hooper)

Very feminine tri bitch. Correct feminine head and expression. Big, Round eyes. Wellset and carried ears. Good neck, correct topline. Well angulated with correct movement. Excellent coattexture and well marked. *BEST TRI IN SHOW*

3) WYMNS BEATRICE (Milosevic)

Feminine head and expression. A bit finer headed. Excellent eyes. Wellset and carried ears. Good neck. A bit long in loin. Balanced angulations. A bit falling croup. Excellent color and coat.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

1) ALMEARA SHES SO FINE (Whitmire)

Exellent picture. Very feminine head. Correct big, round, dark eyes. Exellent ears. Well cushioned foreface. Excellent neck and toplie. A bit long in loin. Balanced angulations. Moves well. Wellmarked.

2) MARILEE SAVANNAH (Collins)

Very sweet feminine head with big, dark eyes. Excellent neck. Well proportioned. Could have better angulated rear. Moves well from side, a bit close from rear. Well marked.

BEST PUPPY BITCH & BEST PUPPY IN SHOW

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

1) SHEEBA AMELIA BEDELIA AT INTRYNZIK (Goodwin/Goodwin)

Correct feminine head and expression with big, dark eyes. Excellent ears. Excelnet neck and topline. Well bodied, a bit long in loin. Well angulated. Moves very well from side. Excellent coat and markings.

2) SHADOWBROOK WISH UPON A STAR (Moody)

Classical feminine head with dark, round eyes. Excellent ears. Enough neck. Well matured in body. A bit falling croup. Moves well.

3) CHIYODA JUST MY CUP OF TEA OF GLENELLEN (Murphy)

Feminine headed bitch with dark, round eyes. Excellent body. Could be better angulated. Moves a bit short and could be better balanced on the move.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (7)

1) FORESTCREEK DIMOND AND LACE (Cline)

Excellent overall picture. Very feminine head and expression with dark, round eyes Excellent neck, topline and body. Well angulated. Moves well. Exclelent coat and markings.

2) CHADWICK HALO SPOT AT INTRYNZIK (Goodwin/Goodwin)

Also a quality bitch. Correct overall picture in excellent size. Very feminine head and expression. Big, round, dark eyes. Excellent forechest and ribcage. Moves very well. Excellent coat.

3) **BEARIVER CHANEL** (Toepfer)

Feminine head and extression. Big, round eyes that could be a bit darker. Good body. Excellent angulated. Moves happily and easy.

4) **ONTHEMARK WHOOPSIE DAISY** (Chan/Mitchell)

Correct feminine, soft head and expression. Excellent ears. Correct big, round eyes. Well constructed. A bit long in loin. Moves well but a bit proud of her tail. Well marked.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (1)

1) SHEEBA FIREWORKS OF WINDNSEA (Sutton/Sutton)

What a lovely tri head. Soft, gentle expression with big, dark, round eyes. Excellent neck. And well bodied. Excellent angulations. A bit falling croup. Could move with more drive. Well marked, just a bit short coat on the day.

<u>SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK-AND-TAN BITCH</u> (2)

1) **BROOKSHAVEN FIDDLE-DEE-DEE AT BEARIVER** (Toepfer/Ayers/Martz) Excellent overall picture and proportions. Feminine head. Big, round eyes that could be darker. Excellent body. Could have some more angulations. Moves well but could have more drive. Excellent raven-black coat.

2) MYRNAC TINA TURNER TO SHERAH (Crommett)

Excellent feminine head with correct round eyes. Excellent neck. Body under development. Balanced angulations. A bit falling croup. Moves well but a bit proud of her tail on the move. Excellent ravenblack coat.

OPEN BITCH (4)

1) CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE (Green)

A true toy-spaniel with a real WOW-factor. Very feminine head and expression. Dark, round expressive eyes. Very well made in body and angulations. Moves very well from side, using

her tail in a correct way. Just a bit wide from front. Excellent silky coattexture and rich colour.

RESERVE WINNERS BITCH & RESERVE BEST IN SHOW

2) CH BROOKHAVEN SMARTY PANTS (Whitmire/Ayers)

Excellent head and expression. Lovely dark expressive eyes. Well set and carried ears. Excellent neck and body. A bit long. Well angulated and moves very well.

3) CH C=]['8/ROWNHEIR HALLELUJAH (Fadel)

Fantastic head and expression with excellent big, round eyes. Well set and carried ears. Good neck. Excellent body. Good bone. A bit long in loin. Well angulated. Moves well.

4) NIGHTHAWKS GOING BACK TO CALI (Morigi & Daviann Mitchell)

Excellent proportions. Very feminine head and expression. Correct big, round, dark eyes. Excellent body. Could have som more angulations. Moves a bit short. Wellmarked.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

1) HARRINGTON COVINGTON PEARL OF A GIRL (Gonyo/Gonyo)

What a lovely veteran !! In super condition, moves like a youngster with reach and drive. Correct proportions. Excellent classical feminine head and expression with big, round, dark eyes. Excellent body and angulations. Excellent level topline and tail-carrige. A bit wolly and light coat.
