JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1. FORESTCREEK JUST OWN IT (Cline/Marshall) Very attractive little blenheim puppy who was very well constructed throughout. Good reach of neck with a short body can be hard to find. Lovely head and eyes with dark nose pigment. Quality coat and condition. Moved and showed very well.
- 2. CEILIMOR DRESS CODE (McCarty) Blenheim puppy with gorgeous head and huge lustrous eyes. Well made, he drove around the ring with beautiful carriage. When he matures, he will trouble the best.
- **3. SARAFAYE YOU'RE THE TOP (Lapidus)** Blenheim puppy, very well marked. Another glorious head with large dark eyes. A little rangier than 1 and 2 and moved a little close behind today.
- 4. BROOKHAVEN AMERICAN PIE (Gregory/Ayers) Ruby dog of correct size. Attractive head although a little chiny, hope this will correct as he is a very promising puppy, just needs more confidence. <u>BEST RUBY IN SHOW</u>

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

- 1. NORTHPOINT LETS START A REVOLUTION (Mitchum) Blenheim puppy who headed up a super class, placings could change on a different day. This boy just pipped the others on conformation with great angulation throughout, elegant neck and level topline which he held on the move. Gorgeous head, eyes and pigmentation. Shown in lovely coat and condition. <u>BEST PUPPY DOG</u>
- 2. CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley) Another nice blenheim with correct markings. Again, glorious head and eyes, elegant neck, level topline. Shown in excellent coat and condition, just pipped on drive around the ring. Another to watch out for.
- 3. AUTUMN HILL AMERICA'S TEAM (Parente/Green) Black and Tan dog with lots of appeal. Well made throughout he moved with level topline. Very attractive head and expression, he just lacked animation on the day. Very promising though.
- 4. KENJOCKETY SILVER KISS (Weber) Blenheim dog shown in excellent coat and condition. Very gassy with super temperament and ever wagging tail. Super size and very winsome. Unlucky to be in such a strong class.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1. CARLEN TINY TIM TATER TOT (Close) Richly coloured blenheim of ideal size and shape. Large round eyes and dense nose pigmentation. Plenty of cushioning on foreface which gave him a soft expression. Moved and showed well.
- 2. **RIVERLEIGH HOT OFF THE PRESSES, MP (Dingman)** Very well marked blenheim who was super sound and stylish on the move as he drove around the ring. A quality dog but I just preferred the head and dense pigmentation of the winner.
- **3. FIELDSEDGE BALDUR (Slusher)** Blenheim dog of larger type. Lovely head and eyes. I felt his coat condition could be better and he could cooperate more with his handler.
- **4. GENTLE STAR UNFORGETTABLE DREAM (Gentil)** Blenheim dog with super bone and substance. He was well made and moved well when he kept his head up. Rather strong in head and showing white in one eye detracted from his expression.

NOVICE DOG (2)

- 1. NIGHTINGALE HELLO GOODBYE (Mulligan) Blenheim dog with super happy temperament, full of life. Very well-constructed and angulated throughout, he moved well holding a level topline. Shown in beautiful coat and condition. Nice head, his cushioning should fill out more as he matures.
- 2. DREAMVALE HOLLYWOOD NIGHTS (Sage/Perini) Black and Tan of super quality. Gorgeous head with large dark eyes and correct tan. Lovely bone and substance and very well made. So sad to hear that he had had a shock and was so very apprehensive.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (2)

- 1. BLUEGARDEN CASINO ROYALE, MP (Matos/Di Bonaventura) Quite the charmer! This lovely tri greeted me with a huge hug. Super, typical Cavalier temperament. Gorgeous head with soft expression. Well-constructed and shown in super coat and condition. Moved a little close behind today and was proud of his tail at times.
- 2. LYNSFAIRE AND I LOVE HER (Fairchild) Blenheim who was very well marked. Nice head with gorgeous large dark eyes but nose pigment could have been denser. A very stylish dog, though a little long in loin. He was in tickly mode on the day!

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1. CLARMARIAN HEARTTHROB, JW (Young-May/Gogal) Blenheim dog with very richly coloured chestnut coat which was in beautiful condition. Excellent temperament. Very attractive head and eyes. Still needs to mature but correct for age. Good front assembly but dropped off a little at the croup, .

AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

1. KRYSTLE BLUE PERSUASION AT SAINTBRIDES (Burkley/Torgersen) Blenheim dog dripping in well-marked coat. Very good substance and bone although a little heavy set. Attractive enough head but boy was he proud of his tail.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR DOG (3)

- 1. ORCHARDHILL OVERANALYZED (Venier) A stunning tricolour from the top drawer. Glorious head and eyes with desired soft expression framed with correctly positioned ears. Elegant neck and shoulders, level topline, well angulated rear, he moved with drive. He presented a really vibrant and balanced picture! Shown in beautiful coat and condition, this young dog could not be denied top honours. *BEST IN SHOW, WINNERS DOG, BEST TRI IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR, BEST AMERICAN BRED*
- 2 LINRICA OMEGA CONSTELLATION (Hsiung/Liu) This dog was of excellent size and substance. He excelled in head and had those huge lustrous dark eyes we all aim for. He was a little short in neck and I felt he could drive better.
- **3 TRISTAN DOBRY ROK OF LYNSFAIRE (Fairfield)** Dog of super make and shape. Loved his construction, especially his short hocks and drive when he moved. Lovely head and expression. Quality dog but not in show condition as his body coat was shaved off!

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1. DREAMVALE RED HAIR N BLACK LEATHER (Sage/Perini) Ruby of lovely rich colour who has a lot of maturing to do but the quality is all there. Super head, excellent temperament. Moved and showed beautifully.

<u>OPEN DOG</u> (4)

- CH. FALLING SPRINGS BLACK FLAME AT MADRYN, JW (Weeks) A very well made black and tan from the top drawer. His construction couldn't be faulted. Such a lovely showman with superb temperament, he owned the ring as he moved around with aplomb. Active and well balanced. Glorious masculine head and expression, I loved him. <u>RESERVE WINNERS DOG & BEST BLACK</u> <u>AND TAN IN SHOW</u>.
- 2. CH. BROOKHAVEN CHARCOAL, JW (Gregory) Another glorious dog, close up to the winner. Super construction with elegant arched neck, excellent angulation and table topline which he carried on the move. Rich tan colouring, coat silky and in gleaming condition. I just slightly preferred the head of the winner.
- **3.** CH. KRYSTLE HAMILTON (Torgersen) Blenheim who is very well made and a worthy champion. Lovely head and eyes with dense pigmentation. Moved well displaying a lovely outline. Unlucky to meet 1 and 2 but their coat presentation was perfect.
- **4. PASCAVALE FLOYD, MP (Cline)** Tricolour of lovely size and type. Very well marked with rich tan in all the right places. A little short in neck but moved well at one with his handler.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

1. CHADWICK PIPING HOT (Eckersley) Blenheim puppy bitch. Such a sweet baby. Very rich colouring with huge lozenge centre stage. Pretty head with dark eyes and dense nose pigmentation. Movement improved once she got used to the unfamiliar floor.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (1)

 CH. FIELDSEDGE OFF TO SEE THE WIZARD (Slusher/Smith) Blenheim bitch of top quality. Gorgeous head with lustrous dark eyes and appealing expression, framed perfectly by well set ears. Excellent construction and breed type. Shown in tip top condition she moved and showed beautifully. My notes say a star with a very bright future. <u>BEST PUPPY BITCH & BEST PUPPY IN</u> <u>SHOW.</u>

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1. **GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA (Gentil)** Ruby bitch with lovely angulation throughout, so well-constructed. Very pretty feminine head with desired soft expression. Moved and showed very well.
- 2 TASSAJARA PAYDAY AT VALENTYNE (O'Brien) Feminine little girl with very pretty head. Gleaming black/tan with good rich tan markings. Excellent temperament and very showy. She just didn't have the neck and scope of the winner.
- **3 CHADWICK LOOKING FOR TROUBLE (Eckersley)** Blenheim bitch of lovely make and type. Glamorous and well-marked, shown in good coat which needed a bit more attention. For me, a mark on her face detracted from her expression.
- 4 MADRYN HEART PIECE AT RAINHEART (Mautone) Blenheim bitch who showed beautifully at one with her handler. Well-marked with dark eyes and great pigmentation. Her head needs to mature and sadly she lost her topline on the move.

NOVICE BITCH (4)

- 1. NIGHTINGALE FROM ME TO YOU AT SAINTBRIDES (Burkley) Blenheim bitch, very wellmarked. Extremely pretty with round dark eyes and feminine gaze. Well-constructed, she presented a very elegant outline and moved beautifully. Excellent temperament and showmanship.
- 2. SHERAH MY CHERIE AMOR (Crommett) Ruby who excelled in head with huge dark lustrous eyes and correct cushioning. Well made throughout although a little unsure of herself on the move. A little between coats on the day.
- **3. WINDKISS SUMMER LOVIN (Kates/Patkowski)** Tri shown in gleaming condition. Very showy with excellent temperament. Well made. Pretty enough head but tan markings were pale and this detracted from her expression. Very proud of her tail on the day.
- 4. FIELDSEDGE THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME (Slusher/Smith) Blenheim with correct bone and substance. Very pretty with gorgeous head. Excellent size. On first sight I thought she would be my winner but she was upset on the day and I had to penalise her for her behaviour.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

1. CH. CLARMARIAN AFFAIRS OF THE HEART, JW, AW (McFarland/Young-May/Gogal) Quality Blenheim from the top drawer. Very glamorous shown in full coat and superb condition. Such a pretty, feminine head with huge round dark eyes and dense pigmentation. Desired soft expression framed by lovely ear feathering. Well-constructed throughout, she moved around the ring well, showing her qualities to advantage. <u>RESERVE WINNERS BITCH.</u>

- 2. CHADWICK WISHFUL THINKING (Eckersley) Another very pretty bitch who was close up to the winner, just less mature. Exceptionally pretty head. Well-constructed throughout, she moved and showed well. Unlucky to meet the winner in full coat.
- **3.** CH. DARANE OTHERWORLDLY, JW (Kates) Beautifully presented Blenheim shown in huge coat. Another quality girl with a very pretty head. Well-constructed she presented a lovely outline when standing but lost her topline a little on the move.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

- 1. BROOKHAVEN TREASURE HUNTER (Parente/Ayers) Blenheim bitch nice overall size and type. Richly marked with gorgeous head, although unevenly marked. Very good construction, she moved soundly, positively and held a lovely level topline.
- 2 KRYSTLE BLUE VELVET AT SAINTBRIDES (Torgersen/Burkley) Blenheim of a lighter colour, though quality coat. Very good conformation but a little up to size. Dark eyes and pretty head. She moved and showed well.
- **3** MADRYN TEAR IN MY HEART (Weeks) Very well marked richly coloured blenheim. Super size and temperament, she showed very well. Eye staining detracted from her head and expression and she lost her topline on the move.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (4)

- 1. NIGHTINGALE SUGAR BABE (Mulligan) Blenheim, rich chestnut colour and well marked. Very pretty and feminine. Delightful head. Excellent temperament and shown in good coat and condition.
- 2. VALENTYNE SCANDALOUS AT PIAFFE (Rychlik/O'Brien) Blenheim bitch, well marked with a double lozenge! Gorgeous head, huge eyes and dense pigment. Well made but I felt she was a little too twee.
- **3.** CHARDOMONT SPECIAL EDITION (Greak/Comer) Blenheim with super affectionate temperament. Very good size, bone and substance. Showed well but was inclined to lift her front legs too high on the move.
- **4. SHERAH SPRING TIME (Crommett)** Very attractive Blenheim of nice size and bone. Gorgeous head with large dark eyes. Beautiful coat with pearly white background. Could move more positively behind.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (5)

- 1. FORESTCREEK RIGHT BEFORE YOUR EYES, JW, MP (Sherman/Cline/Marshall) Richly coloured, well-marked blenheim with lozenge. Exceptionally pretty. Excellent size with correct bone. Elegant neck, well laid back shoulder, good spring of rib and well-angulated hindquarters which she used to drive around the ring with aplomb. She headed up a class of top-quality bitches.
- 2. TIBBEDON SUMMER LOVE, JW (Tibbetts) Richly This girl had the best head of the day, it took my breath away. A head which illustrates the breed standard. Well-marked Blenheim of top quality. Well constructed front but she dropped a little at the croup and didn't have the drive of the winner.
- 3. CLARMARIAN BE STILL MY HEART (McFarland/Young-May) Blenheim who again was very close up to the winners. Gorgeous head and eyes. Well-placed ears framing a lovely expression. Super

coat which was richly coloured and well-marked. Sound throughout but a little longer in loin than the winners.

4. FIELDSEDGE DANCING QUEEN (**Slusher**) Blenheim bitch in superb condition. Very pretty, feminine girl. Well made and moderate in every way. She just looked like she wanted to be somewhere else. These four placings could easily change on a different day.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR BITCH (5)

- 1. KRYSTLE DREAMVALE KEEPING SECRETS (Sage/Colbert) Ideal size with correct bone and substance. Pretty head with large dark eyes. Well made throughout with good neck, well laid back shoulders, good spring of ribs and well angulated behind. Moved and showed beautifully.
- 2. **PROMONTORY CLOVER (Dingman/Solomon)** Another very pretty, feminine tri with correct tan markings. Quite petite but well-constructed and drove well around the ring.
- **3.** CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CEILIMOR (McCarty/Eckersley) Quite a character and very showy. Very good size and substance although a little matronly. Very pretty head and expression. Between coats on the day.
- 4. **KENJOCKETY MOON MAGIC (Weber)** Tricolour of finer type. Shown in beautiful coat and condition. Pretty enough girl but appeared tired at this stage of the weekend.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (3)

- 1. MYRNAC TINA TURNER TO SHERAH (Crommett/Reid) Small compact, very feminine and pretty girl. Rich tan markings. Well-constructed front and rear. Super temperament. Very attentive to her handler, she showed beautifully.
- **2. ABOSCOBEL IN A TWIST (Norton)** Small compact girl who was quite solid. Nice head with lovely eyes and good rich tan. Nice temperament. Moved OK.
- **3. TIALULLY TATTOO TOOTSIE AT CARLEN (Close/Rubino)** Black and Tan who was very sound and showy with excellent conformation. Tan could be richer and she was rather too masculine.

OPEN BITCH (2)

- CH. TIBBEDON SUMMER BREEZE AT VALENTYNE, JW (O'Brien) Very feminine and pretty girl exuding breed type. Of excellent size with exactly the right amount of bone. Moderate in every way with nothing exaggerated. Extremely well put together with good angulation throughout, she moved beautifully, displaying her level topline. Delightful head and expression, she could not be denied top honours. <u>WINNERS BITCH, RESERVE BEST IN SHOW, BEST OPPOSITE SEX TO</u> <u>BEST IN SHOW, BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW</u>
- 2. CH. CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART, AW (Young-May/Gogal) Well broken blenheim shown in excellent condition. Exceptionally pretty with huge, lustrous dark eyes, well cushioned muzzle and dark nose pigmentation. All framed by beautiful silky ears. Well-constructed, but she dropped off a little at the croup so didn't have the topline of my winners.

VETERAN DOG (1)

1. STELLAR ROMANCING THE STONE AT TYCWN (Knauss/Gregg) Very sound, wellconstructed eleven year old tricolour who was so appealing in every way. Lovely masculine head with large round dark eyes and a gentle expression. Excellent dentition. Moved beautifully around the ring holding a level topline. Could win in any company so well-deserved award for <u>BEST VETERAN</u>.
