DOG CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1. CHADWICK HOT PURSUIT AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn) A real showman and well-built puppy of appropriate size and bone for his age. He's handsome and oozes breed type. The best is yet to come with this boy <u>BEST</u> <u>PUPPY DOG, BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.</u>
- 2. NIGHTHAWK'S HEAVEN CAN WAIT (Ellenson/Ellenson/Mitchell) This handsome young boy has a good rear which he used to his advantage. Not as mature as the first place, so time will help him. Nice pup.
- **3.** Cobrnik Red Red Wine (Diana Cook) Lots of angulation on this cute puppy which he needs to grow into. He is immature and needs a little more ring experience.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1. **PARLETT FERNANDO EL MAGNO** (Williams/Williams) a handsome tri puppy. He is compact with good front and rear angulation. His head needs to fill out.
- 2. FALLING SPRINGS JUST YOU WAIT AT CROWNROSE (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) a well-made dog who just needs to body up. He has really nice eyes. Give this dog another year.
- **3.** LAREINA HERE COMES THE SUN (Roberts-Espinosa) A little longer dog then the first two. He is immature compared to the other placers and needs more ring experience.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (1)

1. COBRNIK WALK THE LINE (Cook/Goodwin) A extremely outgoing tri pup who is well built.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (4)

- aSTARRING ALL THE CATS PAJAMAS (Flowers Foster) I really liked this handsome dog's breed type. He is short coupled and nice to go over on the table. Expertly handled and groomed. <u>BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG</u>
- 2. CH HARRINGTON THE BEAR NECESSITIES, AW (Marina-Tompkins/Gonyo/Gonyo) A very nice sporty 3 yr. old champion dog who is well built and has great movement.
- **3.** CH. CHADWICK PURSUIT OF PERFECTION, JW (Eckersley)I liked all three of these dogs for different reasons. This dog has the whole package but today he was just not into showing.
- **4.** CH BROOKHAVEN ALMOST PARADISE, JW (Ayers/Martz) The essence of a toy spaniel, very compact, sweet face, nice structure. I've seen him shown before but today he acted tired.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (3)

- 1. ORCHARDHILL THEATER KID AT KINDOMRUN (Mixon/Degen) lovely head eyes, and breed type. He is well angulated and moved out nicely. A lot to like about this dog.
- 2. CROSSBOW BALOO FROM THE JUNGLE AT BLUESTARA (Glines/Alvarez) Sweet dog who is well balanced, good structure and moved well. I would like to see a fuller head.
- **3. COBRNIK MAXWELL** (Cook) A young dog who was not trained was so he was hard to judge properly.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (3)

- **1. NIGHTHAWK GAME CHANGER** (Crail/Daviann) a nice package of good structure and movement. He has lovely eyes. Well presented.
- 2. SWEETGOLD BRADELY (Anton) A lovely head, not the structure or movement of number one. Could use more coat.
- **3.** Intynzik Sauvignon (Goodwin/Cook) A pleasing dog but lacking in finish and movement. <u>BEST BLACK AND TAN DOG</u>

Special Limit Blenheim Dog (7)

1. FORESTCREEK MAJOR TOM, JW (Cline/Cline). A lovely dog with with very pretty face and eyes. He has good structure with loads of reach and drive. He

was beautifully groomed and presented. **RESERVE WINNERS DOG**, **BEST AMERCIAN BRED**

- 2. ALMEARA FORESTCREEK PATRICK, MP (Whitmire/Cline) A small compact dog who is very well made. He has a sweet, nice eyes, and loads of silky coat.
- 3. NIGHTHAWKS GREAT EXPECTATIONS (Dirks/Mitchell) a larger boy with a full head and nice eyes. Good movement with nice reach and drive. He is a very exuberant show dog.
- <u>4.</u> **COVINGTON RHAEGAL** (Gonyo/Mohn) This dog is very similar to number three only a little less dog. Pretty face and eyes.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI COLOR DOG (4)

- 1. CHADWICK BUGATTI AT HUDSONVIEW (Glynn/Glynn) a nicely marked tri who is a very compact dog with substance. He has good structure and movement. A lot to like about this boy.
- **2. BROOKHAVEN DON'T STOP BELIEVING** (Ogle) A larger boy then number one he too is a well-built good moving dog.
- **3.** NOBLE FLAIRE DE LOS USIDOS KODIAK (Williams/Williams/ Echazarra) A pretty dog but not quite the level topline of the first two placings.
- **4.** LAREINA SPLAIN IT TO ME (Roberts-Espinosa) A nice looking larger boy who liked being showing.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY DOG (1)

1. COBRNIK INTRYNZIK (Hudspeth/Cook) a nice four-year-old dog who is soundly made. <u>BEST RUBY DOG</u>

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN DOG (1)

1. ROBINS NEST MASQUERADE (Prodanovic/Kaecbling) A smaller dog with good structure. He could have more show attitude.

OPEN DOG (1)

1. CH AND ENG. CH PASCAVALE HAIDEN (Cline) A truly lovely dog. He is an excellent example of the breed he represents. Everything about him is in moderation. The hands on was a delight. He has beautiful breed type, with ample bone and coat, a pretty head with big dark, soft liquid eyes that give the desired melting expression. This dog was so very smooth on the move using his balanced angulation correctly. He strode out perfectly, and never put a foot down wrong. He can do all of this because of his exceptional structure. It's easy to see why he has earned so many major wins. I'm pleased to have had the opportunity to judge him **BEST IN SHOW**, **WINNERS DOG**, **BEST BLENHEIM IN SHOW**.

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (6)

- **1. CH CHADWICK HALO SPOT AT INTRYNZIK** (Goodwin/Goodwin) Nothing exaggerated about this cobby girl with her pretty femine face. She is happy and well built.
- 2. CEDAR CREEK ALL ABOUT PRETTY (Owens) cute face, very showy, a little larger than number one. I liked her.
- **3. STARMARC BLUE LAGOON** (Hooper) A cute little tri with good rear angulation. I'd like a better shoulder
- **4. NIGHTHAWK I'M SIMPLY IRRESISTIBLE** (Greene/Ceresa/Mitchell) Petite girl, cute, nice expression. Needs more time to mature.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

- CHADWICK ROULETTE (Eckersley) Very cute face and lovely eyes on this little well marked tri girl. Well-made, moves nicely. <u>BEST TRICOLOR IN</u> <u>SHOW, BEST TRICOLOR BITCH</u>
- 2. FORESTCREEK VIVIAN, JW (Cline/Marshall) Another cute face and lovely eyes on a puppy, well made, more bone and size then number one. A little longer. Both quality pups.
- **3.** CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CELLIMOR, JW (McCarty/Eckersley) nice face and eyes, short coupled, falls off a little in the croup.
- **4. COBRNIK COAT OF MANY COLORS** (Hudspeth/Cook) Very cute and sweet compact girl but could use a better topline.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

- **1. PARLETT LONDON FOG** (Williams/Williams) Attractive, cute face, strong hindquarters. Straighter shoulders.
- **2. COBRNIK ALL THE WAY** (Cook/Goodwin) Larger girl, well made, lightly marked and showing some white of eye.
- **3.** LOCKSTAR'S GOBLET OF FIRE AT MERAKI (Miller/Lockleer) Smaller Black and Tan with dark round eyes.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1. BENCHMARK UNSINKABLE MOLLY B (Hoorman) well broken coat, small girl, very sweet looking.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (4)

- 1. CH BROOKHAVEN MARY JANE (Ayers/Martz) a structurally sound bitch, beautiful face with melting eyes, nice shape and movement, a real show girl who never puts a foot wrong. <u>RESERVE WINNERS BITCH</u>
- 2. CH INTRYNZIK DANCED ALL NIGHT (Goodman) A pretty Ruby with beautiful color and shinning coat. Good structure and movement. A lot to like about her. <u>BEST RUBY IN SHOW, BEST RUBY BITCH</u>
- **3. ROCKCREEK GUCCI GIRL** (Steagall) A larger girl who is sweet looking and is built well.
- **4. MAGNOLIA RUN LIGHTENING STRIKE** (Guzy) Cute face and eyes. A little too spirited today.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

- 1. CROSSBOW THE RELUCTANT DEBUTANTE (Schiffman) a Blenheim girl with the sweetest face, pretty eyes. Very good angulation and she used it on the move.
- **2.** CHADWICK LACE COLLAR (Eckersley) Happy girl, sweet face, moves out well. Good topline on the move but could be better while standing.
- **3. SHEEBA AMELIA BEDELLA AT INTRYNZIK** (Goodman/Goodman) Very cute but a little too happy on the table.

AMERCIAN BRED BITCH (7)

- **1. HADARA FAITHFUL SOUL AT CLOUDBASE** (Koch/Scanlan Johnson) nice head and eye, well made and in good condition. I liked this bitch a lot.
- **2. BEARIVER CHANEL** (Toepfer) a smaller bitch with moderate bone and coat. Unfortunately, her ears looked chewed.
- **3.** CHIYODA JUST MY CUP OF TEA OF GLENELLEN (Murphy) a larger with a really good rear but not showing well today.
- 4. NIGHTHAWK GOIN BACK TO CALL (Morigi/Glines) larger girl with nice head and eyes, well-made except close in rear

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (3)

<u>1.</u> BEARIVER CALIFORNIA GIRL (Toepfer) pretty head and eyes, level topline,

balanced, good front and rear. She moved really well.

- **<u>2.</u>** ON THE MARK HAPPY ENOUGH (Chan/Mitchell) A small compact bitch, pretty face, nice eyes, good front and rear, moved well.
- 3. IVYLANE SHIRLEY TEMPLE AT GYLDEN (Ellingson/Ellingson/Gianpapa) A nice bitch with good front and rear, moves well but loses her topline.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITICH (2)

- 1. TRUELEGANCE MOONLIGHT RHAPSODY (Cromer/Cromer) a really nice tri with a great head, lovely eyes, very showy, well made and in top condition. She moved and showed well with a happy temperament. She was short listed for a major win.
- 2. CEDAR CREEK JELLY BEAN (Owens) A larger girl of nice quality, she seemed tired.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK AND TAN BITCH (1)

1. ROBINS NEST AUDREY HEPBURN (Prodanovich) seven year old bitch who was happy to be showing. Very Sweet.

OPEN BITCH (3) "This was a tough class of worthy competitors."

- 1. CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHOLE, JW (Green) A lovely, petite bitch who proves good things come in small packages. The most femine of heads with lovely eyes. She has a very balanced shape with equal angulation front and rear. Her movement from the side flows and she constantly maintains a level topline both moving and standing. Her front and rear movement is equally good. She is moderate in every way. A true toy spaniel and a delight to watch. <u>RESERVE BEST IN</u> SHOW, BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX TO BEST IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED IN SHOW, BEST BRED BY ESHIBITOR IN SHOW, WINNERS BITCH.
- **<u>2.</u>** CEDAR CREEK JELLY BEAN (Owens) Another very pretty bitch who is a little larger than number one but still ticks all the boxes of good structure and movement.
- **<u>3.</u>** CH HARRINGTON ONCE UPON A TIME, AW (Gonyo/Gonyo) A really nice tri who's a larger solid girl. Structure and movement are excellent. She is a worthy champion.
