DOGS

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (5)

- 1) **FIRST EDITION OF CHADWICK** (Eckersley)
Smart little Blenheim. So well balanced and fluid on the move. Scored highly for his outline with a super neck and shoulder. Good tailset. Well balanced and stood four square. His front needs to tighten but he is only 8 months so lots of time. Very promising. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**
- 2) **CHADWICK WELL TEMPERED CLAVIER AT INTRYNZIK** (Goodwin)
Close up to winner. This 7-month boy is a neat package. Well balanced overall, stood four square. Scored highly for pigment. Ideal coat texture. Rich markings. Super temperament. Should do well. Very pleasing head and expression.
- 3) **FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDORR**
(Mixon/Mixon/Cline/Marshall)
Liked the type of this young boy but didn't hold his outline quite as well on the move. Again, he has plenty of time. Scored for breed type and temperament. Ideal coat and markings.
- 4) **DEL SOL MAGIC MOMENT** (Macrae)
A lot to like about this well-balanced youngster. Still in puppy coat. Well balanced and good bone. Pleasing head and expression but lacking some essentials.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1) **DULCE GIDDY UP** (Covell)
Smart more heavily marked blenheim. Very rich in colour. Round dark eye. Very good pigment. Scored well for angulation. Moved out well around the ring. Well off for bone. A handsome young dog. Slightly longer cast than ideal but did not distract.
- 2) **CHADWICK EIGHTEEN CARAT GOLD** (Mitchell)
Smart well broken Blenheim, attractive head and expression with large round eye. Good angulation, nice substance. True cavalier temperament. Good headpiece with nice fill.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1) **PROMONTORY HERE COMES HUDSON** (Orns/Solomon)
12-month-old Blenheim. Neat size, make and shape. Held topline well at all times, moved out with style. Very good breed type. Looked smart standing, good spring of

rib, well broken markings, coat of lovely texture and in good condition. Pleasing head and expression. Large dark round eye, good pigment, should make a smart dog.

- 2) **JAYBA STROKE OF GENIUS** (Vanderfriff/Lander)
Liked the type of this boy. Just a size larger than the winner. Well off for bone and substance. Well broken coat. Smart outline. Very well angulated. Pleasing head and expression. Smart boy should do well. 14 months.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (1)

- 1) **ASTARRING ALL THE CATS PAJAMAS** (Foster Flowers)
2-year-old Blenheim. Ultra glamorous. In full coat, and plenty of it. Such a glorious head and expression. Pleasing head piece with plenty of cushioning. Large round dark eye giving soft melting expression framed with beautiful ears. Loved his colour and glamour. So well presented. A pleasing dog overall looking in great shape. JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

- 1) **DULCE BACK IN THE SADDLE** (Covell)
12 month Blenheim boy. Well balanced, good outline, very stylish and eye catching when standing. Moved well around the ring. Very attractive head and expression. Loved his large dark eye. Super rich tan markings, well broken. Smart boy.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (1)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TUDORR, JW** (Mixon/Mixon)
2-year-old boy. Good size, make and shape. Scored for substance and shape. Very happy temperament. Well broken coat. Large dark eye. Pleasing head and expression. Good spring of rib and well-toned. Pleasing overall and a good type.

HEALTH AND CONFORMATION DOG (1)

- 1) **KINGLYS MOVES LIKE JAGGER AT MEADOWLAKE** (Swanson)
7-Year-old male. Very well made, moved out with style and drive. Happy Cavalier temperament. Well-constructed throughout, pleasing head and expression. Smart little dog who was eager to please.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

- 1) **MARILEE INDICA FRED** (Collins/Max)
This boy stood out here. Typey Blenheim with a lot to like. Such a smart outline, and a neat shape. Glamorous but not overdone. Just a well-balanced, correct toy spaniel. Ideal neck and shoulder, good spring of rib, correct bone, ideal tailset. Rich markings. Nose a little bit off today but did not distract.
- 2) **NIGHTHAWK GAME CHANGER** (Crail/Mitchell)

Also, well balanced and well made, good make and shape. Nice coat. Pleasing head and shape. Would prefer a darker eye to give the desired melting expression, but overall, a pleasing exhibit. Well angulated and moved well.

- 3) **BROOKHAVEN NUMBER NINE DREAM OF FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych)
Nice size richly marked Blenheim. Scored well for pigment. A shade longer cast than 1 & 2 tended to fly his tail on the move. Liked his temperament. Well-presented but did not settle to show himself to his best on the move.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR DOG (1)

- 1) **PASCAVALE FLOYD** (Cline)
Wow! Super smart tri colour who seems to have settled in State side without any issues. Such a neat little dog. Well balanced and well made. Ideal tri markings, well broken. Coat of lovely silky texture. Good spring of rib. Short back. Lovely open expression, and full of character. At one with handler and shown to advantage.

OPEN DOG (1)

- 1) **CH DELSOL MAGIC CARPET** (Macrae/McHenry)
Blenheim boy 2 years old. Lighter marked, rich tan, in plenty of coat and well presented. Handled to advantage. Good angulation throughout, large round dark eye, moved well.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

- 1) **CH BROOKHAVEN THE DREAM LIVES ON AT FINNICKYSKYE**
(Utych/Utych)
7-year-old Blenheim boy. Smart exhibit liked his neat size, well-made throughout. When relaxed he wagged happily. Well put together, nice spring of rib, good angulation. Pleasing head and expression with large round dark eye. Smart boy. Rich Colour.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (6)

- 1) **DARANE OTHERWORDLY** (Kates)
A lovely puppy class. The winner caught my eye straight away. She is so well balanced, correctly stands every time. Lovely outline. Ideal head and shoulder placement. Correct length of body, well set tail. Ideal bone, feminine head. Pretty expression. Lovely coat just the right amount and lovely texture. Nice puppy!
BEST PUPPY BITCH
- 2) **FORESTCREEK RIGHT BEFORE YOUR EYES** (Sherman/Cline/Marshall)
Also, a quality girl. Not quite the lay of shoulder of one, but a similar type. Also, a pleasing outline. Very pretty feminine head. Good body. Correct for her age.
- 3) **CHARDOMONT SPECIAL EDITION** (Greak/Comer)

This bitch also has a super shape. Her head is carried proudly. Her neck and shoulders are lovely. Her short back is accentuated by her markings. Lovely bone. Nice size. She will do well.

4) **NIGHTHAWK'S JINX YOU'RE IT!** (Mitchell)

Lovely type here, would prefer slightly better laid shoulders but she scores highly for breed type. Lovely rich markings. Well broken. Such a pretty head and expression.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (2)

1) **UHLAN ANASTASIA** (Nechiporenko)

9-month Blenheim bitch, another with a smart outline. Very good round dark eyes with correct expression. Well broken coat and lovely silky feel. Good reach of neck. Well laid shoulder, Moved well.

2) **BENCHMARK ABRACADABRA** (Hoorman)

Richly coloured Blenheim broken coat. Not quite the head and expression of 1 but well balanced and moved well. Well angulated throughout and plenty of feathering.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

1) **DEL SOL GOLD DIGGER** (McHenry)

Close class here with 1st two able to swap places easily. Loved the type of this girl. 17 months old. Richly coloured Blenheim. Very silky coat and plenty of it. Lovely eyes. Head and expression so pretty. Dark rims illustrate her excellent pigment. A nice bitch who should do well for her owner.

2) **SUMACREEK BELLE AME** (Skaggs)

She has a super shape. Her eyes are lovely. Dark and round. Well made – a size bigger than 1 but not big. She is a good type and will win well. Very close to 1.

3) **MEADOWLAKE ROSE MADELEINE** (Swanson)

Pretty tri girl. Rich tan markings. Good neck and shoulder. Moved slightly close at rear but a pretty girl keen to please.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1) **BEKENHALL THE FIRST NOEL** (Hall/Kent)

A 2-year-old Blenheim. Apparently her first weekend showing, she went well, moving with ease around the ring. Well broken coat, feathering coming through. Large dark eye. Very feminine expression. Hopefully will gain confidence as she gets experience.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (1)

1) **CH FORESTCREEK SWEET SOUL AT HADARA** (Cline/Fadel)

Lovely 2-year-old Blenheim. Shouts quality from every angle. Ideal size, lovely make and shape. Rich colouring and ideal silky coat. Stood 4 square whenever she stopped. Such a sweet head and expression. Neck and shoulders are superb. Spring of rib, short loin. Super feminine head and expression. Lovely eyes with a soft gentle expression.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED BITCH (2)

- 1) **FORESTCREEK DIAMOND OF THE SOUTH** (Cline)
Very glamorous bitch in full coat. Well-made throughout. Lovely head carriage from her super reach of neck and well laid shoulder. Needed to use her ears to show her super feminine head and expression – she can drop them at times. Large round dark eye. Good pigment. Well broken and lovely substance. Nice bitch.
- 2) **SPICE RACK SAVANNAH** (Collins)
Another lovely girl. Super make, her outline is lovely. Was not as settled moving as 1 today but she is well balanced overall – not overdone in any way. Pretty head and expression. Large dark round eye. Pleasing and one that will do well.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (5)

- 1) **SHERAH PERFECTLY WICKED** (Crommett)
Lovely sized blenheim of such a rich dark colour. She's extremely pretty having a lovely coat – well broken and lovely texture. Stood well at all times. Would like her slightly more animated but could not deny her the class. Well angulated. Moved out well and at one with handler. Very feminine throughout.
- 2) **MANORHOUSE LIKE A LADY** (Orn/McCaslin)
Close up here, I loved her shape/outline. Super reach of neck. Ideal shoulder placement. Of good substance. Large expressive dark eye. Moved out will and never stopped showing.
- 3) **TUDORR GIGI JW** (Mixon/Madden)
Slightly heavier set but very feminine. Very good neck and shoulder, level topline which she held on the move. Good spring of rib. Nice croup. Well of bone. She is a nice bitch who will do well.
- 4) **UHLAN CATHERINE THE GREAT** (Nechiporenko)
Ideal size tri. Rich tan markings. Moved well around the ring. Very animated. She showed well. Nice substance, Pleasing shape.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (2)

- 1) **CHADWICK HALO SPOT AT INTRYNZIK** (Goodwin)
2-year-old Blenheim. Another of ideal size, make and shape. Super outline. So animated she has true cavalier temperament. Loved her coat though she could do with slightly more of it. Super neck and shoulder, good spring of rib. Super feminine expression. She is a lovely, neat bitch.
- 2) **HARANA HARVEST MOON OF FINNICKYSKYE** (Utych)
Blenheim of pleasing type. She needed to settle and move slower around the ring. She has a pleasing outline standing and her large dark eyes and good pigment. Pleasing neck and shoulder and good topline.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOR BITCH (2)

- 1) **STARMARC BLUE LAGOON** (Hooper)

2-year old tri well broken. Pleasing outline, feminine head and expression. Happy show girl. Well angulated. Rich tan. Correct amount of coat. Good neck and shoulder. Topline level. Moved well. Large dark round eye.

BEST TRICOLOR BITCH

- 2) **DARANE PEARLY WHITES AT KISSABELLA** (Bronowicka/Carter)
Pretty shaped girl. Not quite as rich tan as winner. In profuse coat, blanket tri markings. Soft melting expression. Moved well.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (1)

- 1) **MEADOWLAKE DANCING QUEEN** (Swanson)
4-year-old bitch. Pleasing large dark round eye. Neat size could have a slightly better laid shoulder. Well off for bone, good spring of rib, reach of neck. Topline good. Showed well for owner. **BEST RUBY BITCH & BEST RUBY IN SHOW**

OPEN BITCH (3)

- 1) **CH SORELLA HERE COMES CHLOE JW, AW** (Savage Green)
2 ½ year old bitch, shouts quality. Never stops showing. Loved her size, make and shape. She has a sharp outline. Ideal reach of neck, super lay of shoulder. Lovely rich tan. Silky Coat. Her head is so pretty. Eyes you could fall in to. Dark rims, large ears. Very pretty overall. Just my type! **RESERVE WINNERS BITCH**
- 2) **CH CHADWICK TRIVIAL PURSUIT JW** (Reed)
Liked the make and shape of this girl. Left some of her furnishings at home. Very well animated. Super head and expression. Topline level and held well. Moved out well. Nice bitch.
- 3) **FORESTCREEK BUCKLE BUNNY AT MIMRIC JW** (Hodges/Perkins)
