DOGS

JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1) **TEMPLOR'S NOT YOUR AVERAGE COWBOY V. NIGHTHAWK** (Morigi/Mitchell) Smart Blenheim boy nearly 7 months, well broken, rich chestnut markings, sweet head, nice round dark eye, well-set ears, well put together, making a pleasing outline on the move - good tail carriage.
- 2) **BELLAROSE BECKHAM** (Becker) Hot on the heels of 1, this is another smart boy, well balanced throughout, sweet expression, not fazed by the occasion moving well coming and going, just preferred the attitude of 1, on the day could change places another time.
- 3) **FALLING SPRINGS POP OUT N SHOW EM.** (Christiansen/James) More lightly marked but still pleasing to the eye for this young man, a little older than 1 & 2 not quite as mature and together in body, moving well a lovely class to start the day with.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (6)

- 1) **FIELDSEGE SPOT ON** (Richard). Well-broken Blenheim, nearly 10 months, with a good coat coming, well set ears, nice large dark eye, good fore-chest, well laid shoulders keeping a level top line with good tail set whilst on the move - moved well back and forth. Pleased to award him **BEST PUPPY DOG** later in the day.
- 2) **KINGDOM ROVELLA BABIECA** (Neiser) Another Blenheim boy nearly 10 months, sporting the desired lozenge, a little heavier than 1, but on similar lines. Good neck and shoulder placement, moving steadily back and forth full of spirit close decision for 1-3

just splitting hairs on the day, no doubt they will change places many times over the coming year.

- 3) **JAYBA MY GUY** (Lander/Lander) Cleaner outline to this young man, beautifully presented a little more heavily marked than others in the class, but a gleaming coat, handsome head, good pigmentation, good neck and shoulders with a super top-line, leading to a good tail carriage, moved soundly coming and going felt he was holding back a little.
- 4) **STONEPIT MASTERMIND** (Gentil). Blenheim a little heavier set than the others, good expression, nice dark eyes, well presented in good coat which was well marked, moved steadily coming and going

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1) **CHARDOMONT CHADWICK GHOST STORY OF CEILIMOR**
(McCarty/Eckersley) Lovely make, shape and size with a handsome head, well set ears, large round dark eye, rich chestnut throughout in his coat, his head held high on a moderate neck with no throatiness, good top-line moving and standing, good turn of stifle helping him drive through from the rear. Well set tail - loved his overall balance.
- 2) **SORELLA CHEESEBURGER IN PARADISE** (Savage Green) Well broken Blenheim dog, with well set, full ears framing a good head type, with large round eyes, good proportions throughout moved well coming and going just not as mature and together as 1, being a little heavier type lost his top-line a little when on the move, needed to go a little faster to increase drive in the rear - this is what held him back today.

NOVICE DOG (1)

- 1) **INTRYNZIK SYMPHONY OF ASPENGLow** (Peterson) On his own in this class- nice type attractive head, good ear set, his maturity belies his age of under 11 months, a little heavily marked, but rich chestnut, with lozenge, good pro-sternum, handsome boy - full of energy, a little proud of his tail on the move, - good turn of stifle, needs to tighten up in the front a bit.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (4)

- 1) **CH. KENDALLKASTLE LOVE IS IN THE HEIR JW** (Ogle) Lovely rich chestnut on this Blenheim boy, heavily marked but does not detract from his glamour masculine head, framed with long full ears which were well set, good dark eye, nice clean front with plenty of fore chest, in good coat, moderate neck sloping into well-laid shoulders - kept a level top-line on the move with a good tail set. Moved well coming and going! Delighted to award him **BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR** later in the day.
- 2) **BECKER'S BELLOROSE GUCCI GU** (Becker) Well-presented dog in great coat, just fractionally larger than 1. handsome head, nice large dark eyes, well-set ears, just

preferred the head of 1. Nice neck and shoulders moving well.

- 3) **IVYLINE KONO KAI** (Giampapa) moved nicely, in good coat, not the richness in colour of 1 & 2 and a little younger than 1 & 2. Good large dark eye moved correctly coming and going keeping a level top line with good tail set.
- 4) **CH. BLUEGARDEN CASINO ROYALS** (Motos/Bonaventure) What a great name! Flashy well broken tri, with tan in all the right places, in good coat, well presented, nice make and shape just a little proud of his tail today which spoilt his elegance in profile, control that and he challenges the best.

AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1) **NORTHPOINTE GLENFINNAN** (Jones/Mitchum) Richly coloured Blenheim dog well broken, in good coat, well bodied, good turn of stifle, top-line and tail set, moved soundly. Handsome head, nice dark eyes, lovely long ears.
- 2) **DEL SOL MAGIC MOMENT (Macrae)** I like the balance on this dog, a little lighter in colour than 1, and less mature body, moved well coming and going again a pretty head, with nice large round dark eyes.
- 3) **CROSSBOW BALOO FROM THE JUNGLE AT BLUESTARA** (Brezine/Alvarez) 4 yr old Blenheim in super coat slightly larger type than 1 & 2, beautifully presented moved soundly coming and going.
- 4) **FORESTCREEK MAN IN BLOCK** (Tegg/Marshall) A handsome tri male with tan in the right places good top line, pretty head, beautifully presented nice make and shape - a little lively and challenging for his owner who managed him well.

SECOND GENERATION AMERICAN BRED DOG (5)

- 1) **MAYFIELD CALL TO GLORY** (Mayfield) A dog in full bloom, being well coated, good colour and pigmentation, masculine head with large dark eye giving a soft expression, good neck and shoulders, level top-line and good balance throughout. Pleased to award him **AWARD OF MERIT 2.**
- 2) **KELLENE BAD TO THE BONE** (Carter/Enzo) Heavily marked tricolour in good coat, tan in all the correct places, presented in gleaming condition and demanded his place - giving a good profile when on the move and standing. Pleased to award him **BEST TRI-COLOUR DOG IN SHOW** later in the day.
- 3) **TRUELEGANCE CHASING THE MOON** (Sinn/Cramer) A little less coat for this tricolour but such a pretty head, nice make and shape but carrying his tail a little proud today, control that and he will easily move up the line in placement.
- 4) **BLUESTARA ALADDINS LIGHT AT HIGH FLIGHT** (Parris/Parris) Well marked Blenheim, would like a little more body on him, moved steadily just requires a little more composure and a coming together.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM DOG (3)

- 1) **FORESTCREEK ANDY** (Madden/Cline) Elegance & well broken with rich chestnut markings, symmetrical markings on his head with large dark lustrous limpid look to his eye, well set ears, set on a good neck which sloped into his well-set shoulders, level top-line and correct tall set and croup. Presented in an immaculate condition making the perfect package for me who ate up the ground when on the move, reaching out with his forelegs and driving with his rear. I liked him when he entered the ring and was not disappointed when I went over him. He owned the ring. I was delighted to award him **WINNERS DOG, BEST AMERICAN BRED DOG, BEST BLENHEIM DOG & BEST IN SHOW.**
- 2) **INTRYNZIK LOLLIEGAG** (Goodwin/Brock) Unfortunate to meet 1, today who was on top form - loved his head, make and shape, rich coloured chestnut markings, in good coat, would like a tad more neck on this one, if I were to be ultra critical, a quality dog who moved well coming and going. Another day he may well change places with 1.
- 3) **MINGCHEN YUKON RIVER AT HIGH FLIGHT** (Parris/Parris) Unlucky to meet 1 & 2 giving away on maturity, would like a little more cushioning in his head. Moved well coming would like a little more drive from behind.

SPECIAL LIMIT

RUBY DOG (3)

- 1) **PINACLEE NOBODY BUT ME AT STOREYLAND** (Gallagher/Glisson) Ruby dog

with rich colouring to his coat, masculine head, with well spaced round dark eye, gentle expression, good pigmentation, good fore-chest, moving well coming and going, keeping a level top-line throughout not forgetting his correct tail-set. Never stopped showing. Delighted to award him **AWARD OF MERIT 1**, with **BEST RUBY DOG IN SHOW**

- 2) **CLOSEBURN RED FOX TO THE FRONT** (Fairchild/Maddox) Mature in full coat moved well coming and going - correct neck and shoulders, good topline, pigmentation and a pleasing head.
- 3) **LNTRYNZIK FLIGHT OF THE B** (Goodwin/Cook). Nice type good rich colouring, with lovely dark eye, just lacking on his furnishings today more noticeable when meeting up with 1 & 2. Moved steadily throughout.

OPEN DOG (9) -

- 1) **CH. PROMONTORY HERE HOMES HUDSON** (Orns/Solomon). A fabulous dog who could not be denied first place, lovely head with large dark eyes framed by the long well set ears, held high on a good neck sloping nicely into his shoulders. Level top-line throughout, with good tail-set, nice stifles moved well front and rear - immaculately presented. Delighted to award him **RESERVE WINNERS DOG** later in the day - it was a tough decision.
- 2) **CH. FORESTCREEK THE SHOWMAN AT TUDOR, JW** (Mixon/Cline/Marshall). Well broken, rich chestnut markings, handsome head good eye set, well set ears, good profile, not as much coat as 1, moved steadily for his owner coming and going - nice size.
- 3) **CH. FALLING SPRINGS JUST YOU WAIT AT CROWNROSE JW, AW** (Rosenberg) liked the dog a lot, clean markings in moderate coat when compared with one lovely head and dark eye, a little longer than 2. would like a little more leg for balance for me if I were to be ultra critical. Good turn of stifle well set tail. Moved well.
- 4) **CH. FALLING SPRINGS BLACK FLAME AT MADRYN, JW, CTKN** (Weeks/Curley) Lovely Black and Tan in gleaming coat, a little shorter on coat than those placed in front of him, rich bright tan in all the right places with a good texture to the coat. Nice make and shape, plenty of fore-chest with pretty head, moved soundly.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (2)

- 1) **CH. ROYAL MARK REMINISCENCE AT CAMERON'S AW, VW** (Cameron) 10 yr old Blenheim in super condition, handsome head, good neck and shoulders, well turned out, not exaggerated in any way, moved stylishly coming and going maintaining a level top-line.
- 2) **CH. KELLENE BACKSEAT BOY, JW** (Carter) A lovely 8 yr old tri-colour very flashy tan in all the right places - not in full coat today, but in gleaming condition and well presented. Good turn of stifle, who moved happily around the ring keeping a level top-line throughout - a pleasure to go over.

BITCHES

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1) **HUDSONVIEW CRAZY DIAMOND** (Glynn) A mature 5 month old blenheim girl, rich chestnut markings, nice profile, pretty head, large dark eye, well set ears, good neck and shoulders, kept a level top-line on the move and standing, with correct tail carriage.
- 2) **KELLENE ONE HIT WONDER** (Marshall) A nearly 8 month old tri-colour, moving soundly fore and aft, the black on the coat gleaming, pretty gentle expression, tan in all the right places, beautifully turned out and showing well for her handler.
- 3) **KENDALLKASTLE RAYNA JEWEL** (Neely/Ogle) A tri-colour with all the tan in the right places, sweet head, good eye colour, and shape, a jaunty mover, needs to strengthen her hind quarters a bit and she will fly!
- 4) **FALLING SPRINGS RUN THE WORLD** (Younger) Another blenheim girl nicely marked with rich chestnut markings not as mature as 1 in body, that will come, nicely put together, just lost out on maturity today.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1) **BECKWITH GINGERLICIOUS** (Smith) A lovely outline to this heavily marked Blenheim girl loved the head, nice large dark eye good ear set, nice head carriage, neck and shoulders leading to a level top-line -good balance throughout move steadily back and forth. Delighted to award her **BEST PUPPY BITCH** later in the day, ultimately **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW**.
- 2) **JAYBA SISTER FROM ANOTHER MISTER** (Lander) A well broken Blenheim carrying a little too much weight today on her shoulders, which pegged her back detracting from her stylish profile, nice head, round dark eye level top-line, good turn of stifle.
- 3) **LADY IN BLACK DE LOS URSIDOS KODAK** (Murphy/Echazarra) Black & Tan presented well, tan in all the correct places a little less mature than 1 & 2 a lot to like sweet head,nice profile just needs more furnishings (coat) and maturity - time is on her side.
- 4) **IVYLINE COWGIRL BARBIE** (Giampapa) A pretty bitch moved well, would like a little more cushioning in the fore face, nice large dark round eye, symmetrical markings on head, good coat coming, level top-line, nice croup with good tail-set.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1) **ALMEARA LOVE HER MADLY** (Whitmere) A well broken Blenheim, pretty head framed by good well-set ears, moderate neck, good shoulder placement nice coat, good rib cage with correct turn of stifle allowing her to drive around the ring from behind - the whole package, I was delighted to award her **AWARD OF MERIT 2**. I shall watch her progress with interest.

- 2) **BLUEBONNET RUBRUM LILY** (Vezina/Orns) This tri-colour in gleaming coat pushed hard for first place, pretty head, great neck and shoulders, beautifully presented, heavily marked yes, but the tan in all the right places lovely to go over, not quite the maturity and coat of 1, who pipped her at the post today.
- 3) **FIELDSEGE OUR GREATEST EXPECTATIONS OF NIGHTHAWK** (Dirks/Mitchell) A another Blenheim, finer type than 1. Sporting the desired lozenge, pretty head nice make and shape just needs to settle a bit more, coat coming through nicely.
- 4) **GOLD COUNTRY SPICY PARADISE** (Neiser) Lovely ruby girl probably the least mature in this class but time will put that right. Good colour, good pigmentation, nice make and shape beautiful round large dark eye - so much to like about her. This was a strong class.

NOVICE BITCH (2)

- 1) **PUPIETE BEATRICE SWEET NEW STYLE** (Vizmeg) A well broken Blenheim, feminine head, with large dark eyes, well set ears framing the head, nice neck and shoulders, level topline, well let down hocks, nice profile. Moved well.

- 2) **MARILEE A DASH OF BUTTERS** (Collins) A pretty head with the large round dork eyes I so look for, framed by well set ears. Carrying bit too much weight on her shoulders which did not show her neck to her advantage. When I went over her, I could feel the correct proportions underneath, just a bit off the shoulders and she will be showing herself to the best advantage.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR (8)

- 1) **CH. MIMRIC EIGHT SIX SEVEN FIVE THREE O NINE JW.** (Perkins/Hodges) Spoilt for choice in this quality class. 1, is a good size, make and shape, with silky textured coat, rich chestnut markings in gleaming condition, pretty feminine head, framed by gorgeous full ears, head carried on a good neck into excellent shoulders which sloped back into a level top-line with correct tail-set, good rib-cage with good turn of stifle facilitating good drive from the rear. Nice straight front. Moved elegantly coming and going. I was delighted to award her **WINNERS BITCH, BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH IN SHOW, BEST AMERICAN BRED BITCH IN SHOW AND BEST BLENHEIM BITCH IN SHOW,** and later in the day **BEST OPPOSITE SEX & RESERVE BEST IN SHOW**
- 2) **CH. CLARMARIAN AFFAIRS OF THE HEART JW AW** (McFarland/Gogol) Another lovely Blenheim girl, slightly finer head and body to 1, gorgeous round dork eyes, lovely long ears, well set, good pigmentation throughout, well put together, moving effortlessly around the ring in full coat,
- 3) **CH. CHADWICK TRIVIAL PURSUIT JW** (Reed/Eckersley) A good make and shape to this girl, a well-marked Blenheim, symmetrical head markings, nice large round dark eye, head well framed by full ears in good coat, moved soundly back and forth - just my cup of tea close decision between 2 and 3.
- 4) **CH. TASSAJARA JALAPENO PEPPER AW** (Seidman/McDonnell-Seidman) She could be one of mine, pretty head, large dark eye, glamorous ears in good coat, well broken, wanting to please her handler, moving steadily with good tail carriage, a little longer in body.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (2)

- 1) **BROOKHAVEN TREASURE HUNT** (Parente) A very elegant girl, lovely Blenheim great neck and shoulders, needs a little more coat for top honours, but has nothing to hide beautiful head, framed by glorious well-set ears, nice dark round eyes, good neck into those lovely shoulders, keeping a level top-line standing and on the move.
- 2) **CHADWICK FEATURE STORY II** (Reed/Eckersley) A pretty head to this Blenheim girl a little tired today, maybe carrying a bit of extra weight on her shoulders. Lovely type, with large dark eyes in good coat, just holding back a bit.

AMERICAN BRED BITCH (3)

- 1) **ABOSCOBEL IN A TWIST** (Norton) A lovely black & tan, beautiful gleaming coat, could do with a fraction more weight and coot for top honours, moved well coming and going, well balanced with good neck and shoulders giving her elegance.
- 2) **CHIYODA JUST MY CUP OF TEA OF GLENELLEN** (Murphy) Another nice girl, a Blenheim, in good coat doesn't want to put on any more weight, moved well coming and going, good head and shoulders.
- 3) **NIGHTHAWK'S JINX YOU'RE IT** (Mitchell) Ideal size in this girl, nice large round dark eye, i would like a little bit more coot on the hind quarters to give the finished look moved well, need to watch the weight as a little more could throw off the movement on the shoulders.

SECOND GENERATION AMERICAN BRED BITCH (1)

- 1) **DEL SOL BREAKFAST IN BED** (McHenry) On her own in the class, lovely pretty girl nice size and shape, moved well coming and going, well broken, deep chest with good angulation.

SPECIAL LIMIT

BLLENHEIM

BITCH (9)

- 1) **IVYLINE HONOLULU LULU** (Eubank/Giampapa) A glamorous girl in tip top condition good body, make and shape, good angulation to the rear well set on tail, moved effortlessly around the ring. Delighted to give her **RESERVE WINNERS BITCH** later in the day which i believed finished her according to her owner - congratulations!
- 2) **ROCKCREEK DIAMOND DUST** (Adam/Smith) Another glamorous girl in full coat, correct depth of colour, well-presented pushed 1 hard for first place generous dark eye, super long ears, lovely textured coal, well-turned stifle moving welcoming and going.
- 3) **ROCKCREEK NICOLE** (Stegall) Another nice girl, not quite the maturity in coat and body as 1 and 2, but that will come, plus a little more heavily marked. Good dark eye, well set ears, good rib1 goad topline standing and on the move.\
- 4) **TUDOR BLUES ALLEY, JW** (Mixon) A pretty head, sweet expression, large dark eye, tapered muzzle well balanced needing a little more coat under her torso but splitting hairs between 3 & 4. Lovely to go over. Moved steadily back and forth.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRICOLOUR BITCH (2)

- 1) **HARRINGTON BEJEWELLED** (Gonyo) A beautifully presented bitch, gleaming coot, heavily marked on the body but it just accentuated the lovely neck and shoulders, level top line of this girl. Good deep chest, Good turn of stifle driving

her around the ring, Pretty head with tan in all the correct places.

- 2) **TSAREVICH'S BREEZE IN THE SIERRAS AT GOLD COUNTRY** (Neiser)
A finer type than 1. Pretty head, well set full ears, better marked than one, nice large dark eye, good make and shape moved steadily, lost out to 1, on animation.

SPECIAL LIMIT RUBY BITCH (3)

- 1) **GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA JW** (Gentil) A lovely class with three quality rubies, one moved elegantly account the ring good proportions to body a little lighter chestnut than 2, & 3. Good turn of stifle, pretty head with luminous dark eye giving a gentle expression. Pleased to award her **BEST RUBY BITCH** later in the day.
- 2) **FALLING SPRINGS YOU'LL ACCOMPANY ME** (Curley) a richly coloured Ruby girl in good coat, well laid shoulders good top-line, moving well coming and going good pigmentation, just preferred the whole package of 1.
- 3) **COBRNIK RED HEAD BUNTING** (Cook) A nice straight coat, not as much as 1. Pretty head, good pigmentation, a little heavier on the shoulders, but I later learned that she had a litter less than a year ago which you would never guess - watch out the girl is back.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLACK & TAN BITCH (1)

- 1) **MYRNAC TINA TURNER TO SHERAH** (Crommett/Reid) One on its own, but a nice one! In gleaming full coat, lovely bright tan in all the correct places, keeping a level top-line on the move - good pigmentation, and dentition, a nice example of the breed.

OPEN BITCH (3)

- 1) **CH. CHADWICK FOXY COUTURE AT HUDSONVIEW, JW** (Glynn/Glynn)
Pretty Blenheim girl, good make and shape, nice size, well balanced, pretty head with large dark eye, head with well set ears framing this lovely head held on a good neck which flowed into the shoulders giving an elegance to her when she moved. Good topline and correct turn of stifle assisting in her great movement around the ring. Delighted to award her **AWARD OF MERIT 1** later in the day
- 2) **CH. CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART, AW** (Young-May/Gogol) Such a pretty head, lovely round large dark eyes, with fabulous ears, nice rich chestnut markings not quite the neck of 1. Good shoulder placement needs to drive more from the rear to overtake 1.
- 3) **CH. FALLING SPRINGS CROWNROSE BLACK VELVET, JW, AW** (Rosenberg) Nip and tuck between 2 and 3, nice rich chestnut on this block and ton who is in full coat, good make and shape, level topline, good tail carriage splitting hairs in my choice. Delighted to award her **BEST BLACK & TAN BITCH IN SHOW** later in the day.

SENIOR OPEN BITCH (1)

- 1) **DEL SOL ADORED** (McHenry) Tricolour nice make and shape to this 8-yr old, good size, excellent coat, pretty head, nice generous eye, good neck and shoulders, and rib cage. Kept a level top-line on the move. Just pipped at the post for Best Veteran bitch but delighted to award her **BEST TRICOLOUR BITCH IN SHOW**, and later in the day **BEST TRICOLOUR IN SHOW**.

VETERAN BRONZE DOG (1)

- 1) **GOODWIN'S INTRVNZIK COBRNIK MALIBU** (Goodwin) Black and Tan boy, 7 yrs old. in full coat. On his own in this class. moved steadily, good tail carriage. Good shoulder placement. **BEST VETERAN DOG IN**

- 1) **DEL SOL ADORED** (McHenry) See above critique in Senior Open Bitch.

VETERAN GOLD

BITCH - (1)

- 1) **MAYFIELD QUINTESSENTIAL** (Mayfield) This 12-year-old, in beautiful coat, NOT over weight, good make and shape, nice neck and shoulders, moving well with her handler, the owner is to be commended for having such a senior girl in such tip top condition, enjoying her day out. I was delighted to award her **BEST VETERAN BITCH** culminating in **BEST VETERAN IN SHOW.**
