JUNIOR PUPPY DOG (4)

1. **Orchardhill Shirmont Back Story** (Venier/Henry) Baby at 6 months. Such a sound, well balanced Blenheim whose movement followed his correct balance and structure. Pretty head that will only get better.
2. **Rosearbor Never Give Up** (Sage) Beautiful headed Black-and-Tan who took off around the ring with confidence. Moved well.
3. **Clarmarian Heir Apparent** (Young-May) Quite a large sized Blenheim who I am sure will stop growing. Movement was correct. Head needs to develop.
4. **Carlen Ordinary Miracles** (Close) Tri a bit up on leg. When the chest falls and the coat comes in, he will look less so. Moved well around the ring. Attractive head.

SENIOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1. **Linrica Milan, JW** (Liu) Short cobby young Blenheim with excellent balance. His coat is gorgeous, straight and looks easy to care for. He moved correctly from all angles with a level topline. His head type was ideal for this age – not too overdone but full enough so that he is male through and through. Great show attitude. He will go a long way, I am sure. I was pleased to award him **BEST PUPPY DOG and BEST PUPPY IN SWEEPS.**
2. **Crossbow Greyhawk Daniel A Kickapoo of Zoots** (Schiffman/Kubin) Larger and longer cast Blenheim who moves beautifully with reach and drive but his head needs to fill out and develop. He needs time.

GRADUATE PUPPY DOG (3)

1. **Mimric Amrican Hearthrob** (Bolster/Hodges) Very showy Blenheim boy, sturdy and big enough. Lots of gleaming dark correct coat. He moved with drive around the ring. His body is well balanced. Pretty headed boy, very masculine.
2. **Brookhaven The Dream Lives on at Finnickyskye** (Utych) Small compact Blenheim with excellent balance in body and lovely angles especially in the rear. Level topline. Adequate neck. His head is beautiful with such lovely big eyes.
3. **Rutherford Oliver** (deHaas/Jones) Lighter marked Blenheim, chunky and a bit overdone in head. Well balanced body. Moved well around the ring.

JUNIOR PUPPY BITCH (6)

1. **Rutherford Ulalee** (Jones) Petite Blenheim girl with short cobby body. A bit wild but her angles front and rear were correct. Allowed her to move well. Adorable head type, big eyes. She should have a promising future
2. **Rutherford Ursuula** (Jones) Litter sister to first place – same comments. I went back and forth between the two of them. There were things I liked on this bitch better, but overall, preferred her sister. Wise move to keep them both.
3. **Sikeleii Wish Upon a Star** (Johnson) Attractive Blenheim with sound movement going around the ring. Lovely neck. Slight bone. Head needs to develop.

4. **Brookhaven Temptation** (Ayers/Martz) Beautiful headed puppy with huge eyes. Lovely neck. She is betwixt and between in her growth right now. That will change over time.

SENIOR PUPPY BITCH (4)

1. **Delsol Love in An Elevator** (McHenry) So much to like about this bitch. She moves beautifully from all angles, her deep rich Blenheim is ideal. Great show attitude. Super head, big eyes. I was happy to award her ***BEST PUPPY BITCH IN SWEEPS***.
2. **Chantismere Carrianna** (Tibbetts) Blenheim with good body, balance and movement. Level topline and plenty of gleaming coat. Her head needs to develop and it will.
3. **Linrica Mignon Mochi, JW** (Liu) Well balanced Blenheim with cobby body. Coat in beautiful condition. Moved well. Beautiful head and eyes.
4. **Windsea Dancing Queen, C-RN** (Peterson) Blenheim who was a bit high on leg. When the chest falls and coat comes in and she fills out, it will look better. Light in bone. Moves true coming and going. Needs time.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (3)

1. **Hiddencreek Kourtney** (Green) Rich colored Blenheim with plenty of bone and body for her size. Moved well but a bit short on leg. Beautiful head, big eyes.
2. **Kissabella Bianca** (Bronowicka/Carter) Well balanced small Blenheim with well broken coat color. She moved well going around the ring. Needs to like it a bit better, but she did what was asked of her. Sweet head, big eyes. Would like to see her in another year when she fills out.
3. **Clopsville Willow** (Mandeville/Rychlik) Gorgeous head on this Blenheim, coat in beautiful condition and she loved being in the ring. She is up to size for a bitch and a bit on the plump side, which made her movement a little erratic. Once she matures, all that will settle down.
