With regard to color, the standard calls for well broken up on a pearly white ground in both tri and Blenheim, yet we see many blanketed dogs winning at the highest level. If this is to be rewarded, then perhaps a change in the standard should be considered.

# **JUNIOR PUPPY DOG** (5)

- 1) FALLING SPRINGS JUST YOU WAIT AT CROWNROSE (Rosenberg/Rosenberg) A well-made puppy correct shape and size pleasing expression a lovely dark eye, well-placed ears, good lay back of shoulder good top line he moved freely with animation. <u>BEST</u>

# **SENIOR PUPPY DOG** (1)

1) **FOXWYN IN IT TO WIN IT AT NOONVALE** (Berton/Baker-Fox) A ruby dog well-constructed dark rich color good expression with lovely dark carried a good top line moving around the ring.

# **GRADUATE PUPPY DOG** (3)

1) **FOREST CREEK MAJOR TOM** (Cline/Cline) Well-made dog with a lovely head and expression he had a good eye correct ear placement an excellent mouth he moved well going in around the ring and carried himself with confidence.

- 2) **ORCHARDHILL AUSPICIOUS AT TUDORR** (Mixon/Mixon/Venier). Another lovely Blenheim dog with good coat and color lovely head and expression he moved well but he could've carried his top line better and showed more self-confidence.
- 3) **BROOKHAVEN CATCHING FIRE** (Ayers/Martz) A well-made dog with a good head and correct ear placement he could've had a softer expression he too needed a bit more confidence.

# **NOVICE DOG** (1)

1) **CARLEN B TWO SPIRIT BOMBER** (Close) A black and tan dog with good color rich tan markings moved confidence with a tail that was carried a bit high.

# BRED BY EXHIBITOR DOG (3) "A very lovely class of three beautiful dogs."

- 1) **CHADWICK BEST SELLER II JW, AW** (Eckersley) A beautiful dog with a lovely head and expression good coat and color he moved and carried himself well he was well made with good shoulder placement a great top line and tail set he would be my **RESERVE WINNERS DOG.**
- 2) **CROWNHEIR IRISH BLESSING** (Fadel) Well-made dog he made a good picture standing he could've carried his top line better when moving he had a good eye and ear placement.
- 3) **CH. INFINIDAD INSTANT GRATIFICATION, TKA** (Laiberte) Another very nice dog who is a bit straight in the shoulder and he's carried his tail a bit gay.

# JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED DOG (4)

- 1) **FALLING SPRINGS RAMBLIN MAN** (Curley) A lovely compact tricolor dog with a good outline and he moves very well he had a good expression and very well-placed ears of very dark eye and a lovely mouth.
- 2) **KB PRIDE RUEBENS AT HUDSONVIEW** (Glynn/Glynn) A Blenheim dog with a good head and great kind expression he moves well and carried his tail nicely he was in good condition and lovely rich color.
- 3) **LINRICA OVER THE MOON BABY** (Liu) A well-made dog with good coat and color in a lovely dark eye he had a good ear placement I thought he could have moved with more confidence.
- 4) **BLACKFIRE ALL NIGHT LONG** (Kennedy/Kennedy/Weidig/ McLoughlin) A well-made Blenheim dog who needs maturity at this time.

# **AMERICAN BRED DOG** (5)

- 1) **ORCHARDHILL NEWS TO ME** (Venier/Venier) A very well-made Blenheim dog with a nice head and expression he carried his tail well when moving he could have been stronger behind.
- 2) **NIGHTINGALE HEART OF GOLD** (Weeks/Weeks) This dog had a lovely coat and good color had a lovely expression I found him a bit straight at both ends and he had a tendency to pace.

- 3) **DREAMVALE NOT THAT KIND OF ANGEL** (Perini/Sage/Colbert) A well-made compact dog who moves well.
- 4) **ROSEHILL LEAD SINGER, SA** (Dingman) A well-made dog who carried himself well on the go he did tend to pace I thought he could have had a softer expression.

1) **BLUEDAY MR WONDERFUL** (Gross/Gross) This dog had a good outline a nice head and expression with good ear carriage he moved well going around and carried himself with confidence coming and going.

- 1) **ALMEARA FORESTCREEK PATRICK, MP** (Whimere/Cline) A lovely dog a good size and shape short coupled he has a lovely head and a soft expression well-placed ear moved well coming and going with good tail carriage.
- 2) **ORCHARDHILL AUTHENTIC II** (Venier/Venier) Another lovely dog with a nice head and expression not quite an soft expression as number one moved well going around could have been stronger behind.
- 3) **LOOKOUT SECREAT AGENT MAN AT TYCWN** (Knauss/May) Well-made dog with good coat and color lovely dark eyes was a bit straight behind.
- 4) **MILBU UNIQUE CHOICE** (Theodosiadis) This dog had a nice coat and a good head and expression a bit longer cast.
