NOVICE DOG (1)

- 4) **CH. KRYSTLE HAMILTON**. (Torgersen) Another pleasing boy, with good pigment, nicely angulated well ribbed correct tail set moved well.

SENIOR OPEN DOG (1)

1) **CH. ROYALMARK REMINISCENCE AT CAMERONA**. (Cameron) Absolutely stunning boy in pristine condition, loved his head beautiful eyes, and fabulous ears, a true toy spaniel.

- 2) **CHADWICK GIRLS NIGHT OUT**. (Eckersley) Very pretty puppy beautiful head, well placed ears, good neck and shoulders well presented.
- 3) **NIGHTINGALE FROM ME TO YOU AT SAINTBRIDES**. (Burkeley) Another nice puppy of good type loved her head and dark eyes, with beautiful expression, heavily marked, she is on par with one.

GRADUATE PUPPY BITCH (4)

- 1) **GRANASIL MOCHA OF SUMARA**. (Gentil) Beautiful ruby bitch of excellent type, pretty head lovely dark eyes, short coupled and nice front, good turn of stifle, flowed around the ring, well presented.

- 4) **KINGDOMRUN SPRING MAGNOLIA**. (Degen/Mixon) Feminine bitch of nice size and expression, moved well in lovely condition.

NOVICE BITCH (1)

1) **CLOSEBURN FIRE DANCING**. (Fairchild) Alone in this class, pretty head dark eyes, arched neck, short coupled, needs a little more time to body up.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR BITCH (3)

- 1) **CH. CLARMARIAN ECLIPSE OF THE HEART, AW**. (Young May/Gogal) Nice Blenheim in good coat, short coupled, beautiful feminine head with large dark eyes, good topline moved well.
- CH. DARANE OTHERWORLDLY, JW. (Kates) Nice head and expression, good bone and well proportion body moved well. <u>AOM #2</u>
- 3) CHADWICK MASQUERADE, JW. (Eckersley) Very pretty and full of character, smaller than one, lovely shape, good rear movement, could change places on another day.

JUNIOR AMERICAN BRED (3)

- 1) **CHADWICK LOOKING FOR TROUBLE**. (Eckersley) Could change placers with one on another day, pretty girl so well balanced, a lot to like about her.
- 2) WINDKISS SUMMER LOVIN. (Kates/Patkowski) Pretty head with good eye pigment, over all a honest bitch, needs to settle.
- 3) **KRYSTLE BLUE VELVET AT SAINTBRIDES**. (Torgersen/Burkley) Quality bitch, well broken, nice head, good neck and well-placed shoulders, good angulation, very fluent mover.

AMERICAN BRED (5)

- 1) **TUDORR BLUE ALLEY**. (Mixon) A pretty Blenheim, good ear set, sound rib cage, well balanced on the move.
- 2) CHARDOMONT SPECIAL EDITION. (Greak/Comer) Well-presented girl in good coat, nice clean markings, moved well.
- 3) AURORA JANE. (Lehn) Sound Blenheim, with gentle expression, good head and reach of neck.
- 4) **BENCHMARK WICKED WIPEOUT** (Vezina) Well presented girl in good coat, nice clean markings, moved well.

SPECIAL LIMIT BLENHEIM BITCH (4)

- 1) **CHADWICK WISHFUL THINKING**. (Eckersley) Real quality bitch to go over, she has a beautiful head, correct neck and shoulder placement, good rib cage and sound hind quarters, giving her plenty of drive.
- 2) **KINGDOMRUN GENESIS OF AN EMERALD DREAM**. (Degen) Good typical head, lovely expression, good front and rear angulation, moved out well.
- 3) **CAMERONA SPITFIRE**. (Cameron) Pretty girl small but everything in proportion, nice dark eyes, moved well both ways.
- 4) MADRYN COUNTRY ROADS. (Weeks) Confident girl nice head and ear set well turned out.

SPECIAL LIMIT TRI BITCH (1)

1) **CHADWICK BACCARAT OF CEILIMOR**. (Eckersley/McCarty) Nice bitch full of character, pretty head, well set ears, good body, solid angulation, moved soundly both ways.
